Notables:

Iona took both regular season meetings over the Saints, including a close 68-66 battle at the UHY Center on Jan. 21 and a 91-64 rout at the Hynes Athletics Center on Feb. 16. The Gaels shot 75.5 percent from the field in the most recent meeting, and just missed setting the NCAA record for field goal percentage in a game. Sophomore Anajah Brown went for double figures in both meetings, including a double-double of ten points, ten boards in the first meeting and 16 points and eight rebounds in the rematch.

Iona has taken the last three and five of the last seven meetings overall, with Siena's last win in the series coming in the form of its first win of the 2021-22 season - 56-51 - on Jan. 10, 2022 in New Rochelle.

HEAD COACH JIM JABIR | 35TH OVERALL SEASON



Nazareth College '84
Fifth Season at Siena | Second Tenure

Jim Jabir enters his fifth overall season at the helm of the Siena Saints in 2022-23, with it his second consecutive year leading the Green & Gold. A finalist for the 2013 Naismith National Coach of the Year Award, the Brooklyn, New York native has led his programs to eight NCAA Tournament berths highlighted by a 2015 Elite Eight appearance, while amassing 524 wins.

Before his first season back in 2021-22, Jabir said, "I would like to thank Dr. Gibson and John D'Argenio for the opportunity to come home and do what I love. Siena is a special place for me, and our goal from day one is to win championships and represent Siena in a first class manner. This is not my program. This program belongs to our students and all the fans who have supported the Saints for so long, and we will continue to represent you all well. We will build a family that you will be proud of. We will need you all at our games to help us achieve this lofty goal."

The 59-year-old Jabir has achieved a 524-465 (.530) overall record over 34 seasons as a collegiate head coach, including 33 at the Division I level. Currently standing 31st amongst all active DI head coaches in wins, he previously led the Siena Women's Basketball program for three seasons (1987-90), while also having served as the head coach at Florida Atlantic University (2017-21), University of Dayton (2003-16), Providence College (1996-02), Marquette University (1990-96), and Division III Buffalo State College (1986-87).

"We are delighted to welcome Coach Jabir back to Siena College, and couldn't be more excited to have someone with his tremendous coaching pedigree and acumen leading our women's basketball program," said Siena College President Christopher P. Gibson '86, Ph.D. "Jim has a proven track record of building championship caliber programs in a way that strongly aligns with our Franciscan values, and we can't wait to see him lead our Saints to new heights."

Jabir returns to the Capital Region following a four-year stint at Florida Atlantic where he took the Owls to unprecedented success in Conference USA. This past season, Jabir piloted FAU to an 11-11 overall record including an 8-8 mark in C-USA. The Owls capped the season by securing the program's first-ever C-USA Tournament win, which marked Jabir's milestone 500th Division I head coaching victory. During his first season at the helm in 2017-18, he guided FAU to a nine-win improvement which marked the fourth best turnaround nationally.

"Siena and our women's basketball team are fortunate to be able to have Jim return and lead our program," said Siena College Vice President and Director of Athletics John D'Argenio. "His record of basketball achievements is evident. His ability to engage the student athletes he leads, understand them as young women, and build a program that supports them as people has been the foundation upon which his on-the-court success has been built."

Jabir arrived in Boca Raton after a transformative 13-year run at Dayton, where he departed as the winningest coach in program history at 252-155 (.619). He built the Flyers from a 3-25 team in his first season, to a program which achieved a peak national ranking of No. 11 in both the Associated Press and USA Today Coaches polls in 2013. A two-time Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year (2008, 2013), Jabir led UD to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2010-15, in addition to three WNIT berths (2008, 2009, 2016).

Jabir guided Dayton to eight straight 20-win seasons while compiling a stellar 194-68 (.740) record from 2007-15. The Flyers captured the program's first A-10 Tournament Championship in 2012, and their initial two A-10 Regular Season Championships in both 2013 and 2014 under his leadership.

Jabir mentored the sixth youngest team in the country to a program Division I best 28-3 record in 2013, which culminated with Dayton's second trip to the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament in four seasons. The historic 2014-15 UD squad also won 28 games, highlighted by NCAA Tournament victories over Iowa State, No. 11 Kentucky, and No. 8 Louisville to advance to the Regional Final in nearby Albany at the Times Union Center in Jabir's triumphant return to the Capital Region. The Flyers finished the 2014-15 season ranked 17th nationally in the USA Today Coaches' Poll.

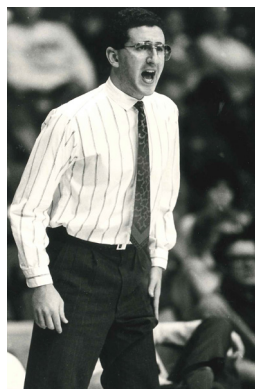
Player recruitment and development was key for Jabir at Dayton, where he signed a pair of top-20 recruiting classes (13th in 2015-16, 20th in 2013-14). During his tenure in the Gem City, Jabir recruited 22 A-10 All-Conference and 11 All-Rookie Team selections, including four A-10 Rookies of the Year. He mentored and developed the first three WNBA Draft picks in program history in Saicha Grant-Allen (2017), Andrea Hoover (2015), and Ally Malott (2015). Moreover, Jabir's program achieved unparalleled success in the classroom where they boasted a perfect 100% graduation rate for 11 consecutive seasons as well as 10 A-10 All-Academic Team selections.

Prior to his time at Dayton, Jabir served a pair of six-year stints at both Marquette (1990-96) and Providence (1996-02). He rebuilt Marquette into a program which secured its first three postseason tournament berths, earning a spot in the WNIT in 1993 before winning the Great Midwest Conference and advancing to the NCAA Tournament in both 1994 and 1995. A two-time Reebok/Great Midwest Coach of the Year, Jabir led the Golden Eagles to back-to-back 22-win seasons in 1992-93 and 1993-94. During his tenure at Providence, he recruited and coached a pair of BIG EAST All-Conference and All-Rookie Team selections.

Jabir broke into the Division I head coaching ranks when the late legendary Siena College Athletic Director and Men's Basketball Coach Bill Kirsch '56, HOF '76 appointed the then 24-year-old to take over the reins of the women's basketball program on Apr. 13, 1987. Jabir led Siena to a 50-29 (.633) record over three years (1987-90), including the program's inaugural season in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 1989-90. He recruited and coached Siena's first three All-MAAC selections in Val Higgins '91, HOF '98, Michelle Collins '92, and Peg Taylor '92, as well as six 1,000-point scorers.

Jabir began his collegiate head coaching career at Division III Buffalo State, which he led to a SUNYAC Championship and NCAA Regional appearance during his lone season at helm in 1986-87. He previously served as an assistant coach the year prior with the Bengals, following one season as an assistant at his alma mater Nazareth College in 1984-85. Jabir has also previously served as an assistant coach at the Division I level, where he helped guide Colorado to a Sweet 16 appearance in his lone season with the Buffaloes in 2002-03.

A 1984 graduate of Nazareth with his degree in English, Jabir earned his Master's in Student Personnel Administration from Buffalo State in 1986. The father of Lauren, Shane, and Jackson, Jabir and his wife, Angie, are the proud parents of son Jude.

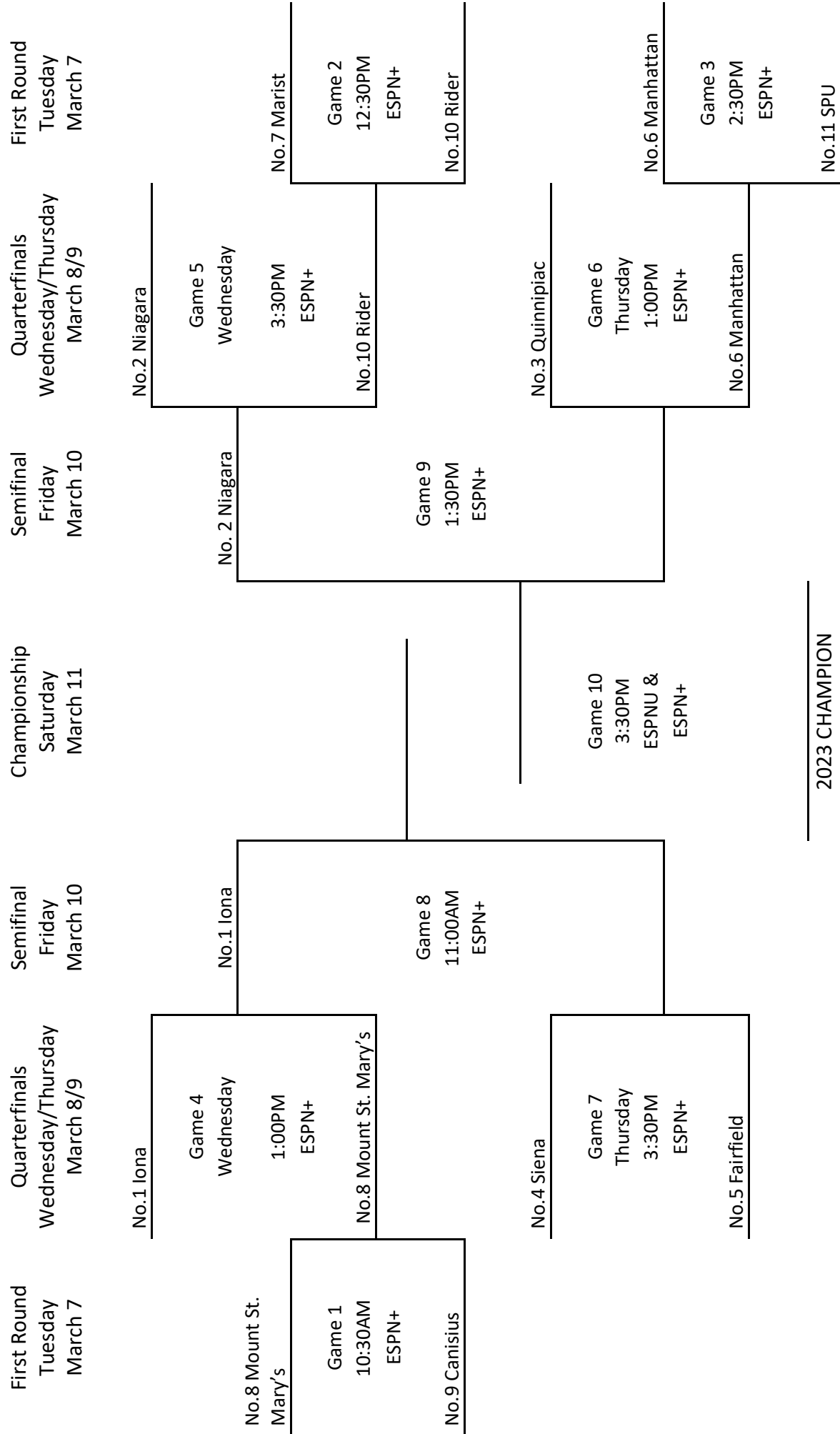

- Siena has advanced at least as far as the semifinal round 17 times
- Siena is 4-5 all-time vs. Iona in the MAAC Tournament
- Despite the back-and-forth postseason rivalry on the men's side, Siena and Iona will meet for the first time ever in the MAAC Semifinal round
- The Saints are 0-1 against the Gaels as the #4 seed, falling in a 67-47 decision in Albany in the 2017 MAAC Quarterfinals
- Siena is 2-2 all-time as the #4 seed and 0-6 against the #1 seed

QUICK HITS



- #4 Siena Women's Basketball advances to its first MAAC Semifinal matchup since 2018 when it faces off against MAAC Regular Season Champion #1 Iona on Friday morning in the 2023 MAAC Women's Basketball Championships.

- The Saints were victorious over #5 Fairfield in the MAAC Quarterfinals on Thursday to the tune of a 59-53 win at Jim Whelan Boardwalk Hall. Siena erased a ten-point late third quarter deficit by outscoring the defending MAAC champions, 20-10, in the final ten minutes of play, embarking on a 14-2 to close the third and open the fourth quarters. Siena won a game despite being out rebounded for the first time in ten tries this season, and held Fairfield scoreless for the final 3:48 of the contest. Sophomore Valencia Fontenelle-Posson and freshman Angel Jones each finished in double figures with ten points apiece.

- Siena matched the second-most All-MAAC selections in program history during last Monday's MAAC Postseason Award announcement. Brown and freshman Elisa Mevius were named Third-Team All-MAAC honorees, while Mevius and freshman Teresa Seppala were selected to the MAAC All-Rookie Team. Mevius went on to earn the program's sixth MAAC Rookie of the Year award during Wednesday's MAAC Major Awards Show.

- Siena has recorded its most wins in a campaign since 2014-15 (22), and matched its highest regular season win output (18) in 20 seasons.

- The Saints have collected six true road victories and eight total away from home this season, matching the most since the 2014-15 campaign (11 true road).

- At 11-5 at home this season, the Saints matched the most home victories in a single season since the 2002-03 campaign (12).

- The team ended the regular season with five sweeps over conference opponents (Marist, Fairfield, Rider, Saint Peter's, Canisius) matching the most since the 2002-03 season.

- All eight members of the Green and Gold got on the scoresheet in the win over Fairfield in the MAAC Quarterfinals, marking the 16th such occurrence for the Saints thus far this season. Twelve times all eight players in a game have scored, while once all six have done so, once all seven have done so, once all nine have done so, and once all ten have done so.

- Brown's 41 blocks so far this season have her tied for the eighth-most in a single season in program history entering the final contest of the regular season.

- Siena currently leads the MAAC in scoring offense (68.3) and ranks second in rebounding (39.9), defensive rebounds per-game (26.1), and steals per-game (9.5).

- Individually, freshman Elisa Mevius is the league's top free throw shooter (81.7), while Brown leads the league in offensive rebounds per-game (3.6) and ranks second in rebounds per-game (226), total rebounding (224), and total blocks (41).

- Siena held Marist to just 23 percent shooting from the field as part of its 77-49 road win on Feb. 18, good for its lowest shooting percentage allowed by an opponent in a game since holding Morgan State to 22.5 percent from the floor back on Nov. 28, 2015.

- The Saints claimed an 83-81 win over Niagara in thrilling fashion on Feb. 11 at the UHY Center. Siena held a 20-point lead just before the half on the Purple Eagles, but lost the advantage for the first time off a go-ahead left side layup from MAAC scoring leader Angel Parker with 4.4 seconds remaining. Following an in-bound on the right baseline from freshman Angel Jones, Mevius pranced up the court and threw up a 55-foot heave at the buzzer, which went in to secure a Green and Gold victory. The play received national attention and came in at #2 on that evening's Sportscenter Top Ten Plays.

- The performance was just the cherry on top to a fantastic week for action for Mevius, who recorded career-highs in scoring in both games. The Grunberg, Germany native went for 24 points against the Jaspers and 26 against the Purple Eagles, allowing her to become the first player in MAAC and program history to receive Player and Rookie of the Week honors in the same week.

- Siena has claimed 11 of the 15 total MAAC Rookie of the Week honors handed out so far this season, with Mevius having done so four times (Nov. 14, Nov. 28, Dec. 5, Feb. 13). The team also did so in each of the first five weeks of the year. Classmate Teresa Seppala has earned Rookie of the Week honors on Nov. 21, Dec. 12, Jan. 9, Jan. 16, Jan. 23, Jan. 30, and Feb. 6. Siena has now earned 12 MAAC weekly awards in a single season for the first time since the 2014-15 season, when it captured 13 total weekly honors and then-freshman Margot Hetzke won MAAC Rookie of Week accolades nine times. Eleven total MAAC Rookie of the Week accolades equals the most in a single campaign in program history, with Seppala ranking second for the most individual rookie honors won.

- Siena went 27-32 at the free throw line against Niagara on Feb. 11, matching the most free throws made in a game since Jan. 28, 2017 (30 at Monmouth) and the most attempted in a game since Nov. 13, 2018 (at Sacred Heart, 37). The team recorded back-to-back games with more than 20 free throws made after completing 25 in last Thursday's victory over Manhattan.

- Siena's 56 rebounds against Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 4 were its most in a single game since a 63-board total in an overtime loss to Navy on Nov. 27, 2015.

- Mevius stole a career-high seven balls in the win over Saint Peter's on Feb. 2, marking the most steals by a Saint in a single game since March 3, 2018.

- The Team's win at Saint Peter's on Feb. 2 marked the fifth time this season that the Saints grabbed a win by 20 points or more, marking the most 20-point victories in a single campaign since the 2002-23 squad tallied six.

- During the month of January, the Saints went 5-1 over six scheduled home games, marking the first time since January 2011 that the team hosted six home games in a single month.

- Siena's 94 points against Rider on Jan. 26 marked the first time since the 2001-02 campaign that the team recorded multiple 90-point games in a single season.

- Freshman London Gamble recorded a collegiate best 11 assists to her 13 points to record her first career double-double and become the first Siena player with a double-double in points and assists since Natalie Marchino on Jan. 9, 2004 (10 P, 11 A).

- The Green and Gold pulled off an improbable victory with the strength of only six active players on Thursday, Jan 19, taking home a 55-51 overtime victory from Fairfield which included a 13-point comeback, overcoming an 11-point halftime deficit, and winning despite the team's least amount of points scored in any half this season. Siena won its first overtime contest in nearly four years by out-scoring the Stags, 31-20, in the second half of regulation, with Gamble nailing a 12-foot jumper to tie the game at 46 with under ten seconds remaining, and Brown putting away the go-ahead low post bucket with seven seconds remaining in overtime. The team shot 47 percent from the field while collecting 49 rebounds and doing so while down to just five players for the final 15 minutes of play.

- Siena's 94 points against both Rider and Saint Peter's was the highest scoring total by a MAAC team in any game since Quinnipiac hung 113 on Hartford on Nov. 28, 2021, as well as the most by a MAAC opponent against a league foe since Marist scored 96 against the Peacocks on Jan. 4, 2020.

- Mevius nearly re-wrote the Siena record book with an outstanding 14-assist performance against Marist, putting her one help off the program single-game record, and making her the first Saint to cross the double-digit assist threshold in a game in a decade. Mevius' performance is tied for the second-most assists in a game nationally this season, with the Grunberg, Germany product holding the sixth-most helps among freshmen nationally so far this season.

- Siena went 5-3 during a stretch of six of eight contests away from home from Nov. 22-Dec. 29, including a season-long three-game win streak from Dec. 3-10. The Saints went 4-1 during the month of December, turning in its best performance in the last month of the year since December 2005 (5-1). The team also won three consecutive non-conference contests for the first time in eight years.

- Siena claimed victory over Binghamton on Dec. 5 despite going 0-13 from the three-point line, marking first time since Feb. 20, 2020 that the Saints had gone quiet from beyond-the-arc, and the first time since an 84-81 overtime victory at Rider on Feb. 29, 2008 that they pulled out a win with no three's made.

- Mevius scored ten of her 17 points against Dartmouth on Dec. 3 from the foul line, and went 10-12 from the charity stripe within the final minute of play to score the game's final ten points.

- Mevius' 16 points in her collegiate debut against New Hampshire on Nov. 10 were the most points scored in a freshman debut since Margot Hetzke scored 29 points in a Siena 58-50 victory over Buffalo to open the 2014-15 season. She became the first Siena player to eclipse 20 points in a game this season by scoring 20 at Duquesne on Nov. 22.

- The Saints opened their 2022-23 season with four consecutive home games, marking the longest home stand to begin a campaign since 2010-11 (five).

- The Saints enter their 49th overall season as a program, 41st in Division I program, and their 34th in the MAAC.

- Siena has spent their entire home life at the UHY Center, formerly known as the Alumni Recreation Center (ARC). Longtime Siena corporate partner UHY Advisors secured the naming rights to the facility in February 2021, and a ribbon cutting was held on November 14, 2021.

The Last Time...

Siena scored 100 points in a game: Siena defeated Rider 103-69 on Jan. 13, 2001.

Siena allowed 100 points in a game: No. 14/13 Syracuse defeated the Saints, 102-65, on Nov. 9, 2016 in Syracuse, NY.

Siena scored between 90-99: Siena hit 94 points for the second time in a single season with a 94-62 victory over Rider on Jan. 26, 2023. The Saints previously exploded for 94 points in a 94-45 win over Saint Peter's at the UHY Center on Jan. 14, 2023. This marks the first time the team has recorded multiple 90-point games in a season since 2001-02.

Siena won an overtime game: A shorthanded Siena squad with just six active players grabbed a 55-51 road victory at Fairfield on Jan. 19, 2023, marking its first OT triumph since a 78-66 win at Canisius on Feb. 22, 2019.

Siena lost an overtime game: The Saints dropped a 77-75 overtime thriller at the UHY Center to Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 4, 2023.

Siena held an opponent to 40 points or fewer: The Saints held Monmouth to shooting just 23.9 percent from the floor in a 51-39 win on Jan. 23, 2020 at the ARC. In that game, Lala Watts would set the single game record for blocks with eight total.

Siena was held to 40 points or fewer: Siena was stifled in an 69-38 loss against Rider back on Feb. 13, 2020. The Saints turned the ball over 28 times, in was their third loss of being held under 40 points on the season.

Siena won by more than 30 points: Siena took a 32-point rout over Rider to the tune of a 94-62 win at the UHY Center on Jan. 26, 2023. The Saints also recorded their largest margin of victory since 1994 in a 49-point, 94-45 victory over Saint Peter's at the UHY Center on Jan. 14, 2023.

Siena lost by more than 30 points: Siena fell to Manhattan by a final score of 80-50 on Jan. 16, 2020.

Five Siena players scored in double figures: Siena put up a whopping 56 rebounds for its most boards in a game since 2015 as part of a 77-75 overtime loss to Mount St. Mary's at the UHY Center on Feb. 4, marking the third time that season they hit the 50-rebound threshold. The Saints hit the 50 rebound mark twice during the 2021-22 season.

A Siena player scored 30 or more points in a game: Junior Sabrina Piper had a career night when she dropped 30 points on the Colgate Raiders in a Siena 55-53 win at the ARC on Nov. 29, 2018. Piper was 10-for-15 from the field, including a 4-for-6 clip from three-point range.

A Siena player recorded 20 or more rebounds in a game: Heather Stec pulled down 23 rebounds on Jan. 21, 2007 at Saint Peter's. She came up one rebound shy of the program record (24) set by Melanie Halter '97 on Feb. 23, 1997.

A Siena player had 10 or more assists in a game: Freshman London Gamble became the second Saint during the 2022-23 season to record double-digit helps in a game, marking 11 assists in a 94-62 win over Rider at the UHY Center on Jan. 26, 2023. Elisa Mevius previously came one assist away from tying the school record with 14 helps during a 74-67 win over Marist on Jan. 7, 2023. Siena had only had one player eclipse the ten-assist mark since 2013 prior to the season.

Siena featured multiple players with a double-double in a game: Anajah Brown went for 19 pts and 13 reb, while Teresa Seppala totaled 15 points and 11 rebounds against Mount St. Mary's on Feb. 4, 2023, marking the first time during the 2022-23 season that the Saints featured multiple players with a double-double in a game.

Siena failed to convert a free-throw: The Saints failed to score, as well as attempt a free throw in their 59-49 loss to Duquesne on Nov. 27, 2021. The Saints would go 0-0 in the game, marking the latest mark since Dec. 4, 2006 when Siena went 0-3 from the line at #1 Maryland.

Siena failed to convert a 3-pointer: Siena defeated Binghamton, 54-50, despite going 0-13 from the three-point line on December 5, 2022. The result marked the first time since Feb. 20, 2020 that the Saints had gone quiet from beyond-the-arc, and the first time since an 84-81 overtime victory at Rider on Feb. 29, 2008 that they pulled out a win with no three's made.

A Siena opponent failed to convert a 3-pointer: St. Bonaventure went 0-13 from beyond the arc in a 50-42 Bonnies win at the Reilly Center on November 11, 2021. It marked the first time in 10 years that Siena held its opponent without a three since Saint Peter's went 0-for-8 from distance on Feb. 19, 2011.

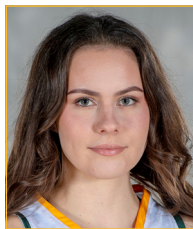

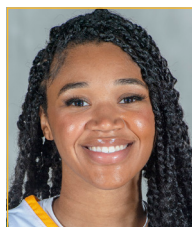
