# The Series With St. Bonaventure

## 45th Meeting: St. Bonaventure leads, 33-11

### Of Note

The sister schools meet for the 14th time since the Franciscan Cup trophy was devised by the schools' Presidents to commemorate the annual renewal of the rivalry  
The trophy was renamed the Br. Ed Coughlin Franciscan Cup in 2019 in honor of the late Siena President and St. Bonaventure alumnus

St. Bonaventure holds an 8-5 advantage through the first 13 official Franciscan Cups

The home team has won five straight and seven of the past eight Franciscan Cups

Siena is 4-2 at home in Franciscan Cups, and won two straight

The programs met 25 times from 1939-61, with the Bonnies nationally ranked in six games

**Gerry McNamara** is 0-0 vs. St. Bonaventure

**Mark Schmidt** is 8-5 vs. Siena (8-5 at St. Bonaventure)

### Last Meeting

St. Bonaventure shot 55%, including 42% from three  
The Bonnies led by 21 at the half and by no fewer than 19 in the second half

**Mike Adams-Woods** and **Chad Venning** combined for 43 points on 17-21 shooting to lead St. Bonaventure  
Seven different Saints scored between 6-9 points

### Siena vs. the Atlantic 10 Conference

39-78 (.333) vs. the 15 current members

44 of 117 games have come vs. St. Bonaventure

Played 14 of 15 current members (George Mason)

## Gerry McNamara

Syracuse '06

### First Season

5-5 (.500)



Syracuse legend and 2003 National Champion was named the 19th head coach in Siena College Men's Basketball history on Mar. 29

Now 41-year-old spent previous 15 years on staff with the Orange, and was elevated to Associate Head Coach last season

In 15 seasons on staff, "G-Mac" helped guide Syracuse to nine NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by trips to the Final Four in both 2013 and 2016

Primarily charged with recruiting, scouting, and guard development, McNamara mentored current NBA performers Buddy Boeheim (Detroit Pistons) and Cole Swider (Miami Heat), and former NBA players Michael Carter-Williams, Tyler Ennis, Michael Gbinije, Elijah Hughes, and Dion Waiters

One of the most decorated players in the storied Syracuse history, McNamara is the program's all-time career record holder for made threes (400), free throw percentage (.888), and minutes played (4,799), and ranks second all-time in steals (258), third in assists (648), fourth in scoring (2,099), and sixth in made free throws (435)

Started all 135 career games played spanning his illustrious career from 2002-06, and had his No. 3 jersey retired by Syracuse on Mar. 4, 2023

2006 Syracuse graduate with Bachelor's degree in Speech Communications

Scranton, Pennsylvania native was a two-time Associated Press Pennsylvania State Player of the Year (2001, 2002) and the 2002 Pennsylvania Gatorade Player of the Year and Parade Fourth Team All-American while starring at Bishop Hannan (now known as Holy Cross)

Finished scholastic career seventh all-time in scoring in Pennsylvania state history with 2,917 career points

McNamara and his wife, Katie, are the proud parents to four children: sons Gerry and Patrick, and daughters Maggie and Grace





# QUICK HITS



Siena returns to the Capital Region for its first home game in exactly five weeks

The Saints most recent game at MVP Arena was a 74-66 win over American on Nov. 12

Siena went 35 days between home games, tied for the fifth longest stretch nationally this season (Buffalo, Kennesaw State)

The Saints went 2-5 during the stretch which featured four true road games and three neutral site contests

Siena is also playing its first game in nine days, following the College's final exam period

The Saints will go a season-long 10 days between Friday's game vs. Holy Cross and their Dec. 30 matchup at Cornell

Siena has already surpassed its win total (five) from all of last season (four)

The Saints snapped a nine-game losing streak vs. MAAC opponents with their victory at Canisius on Dec. 8

Siena has been paced so far by the dynamic backcourt tandem of junior transfer guards **Major Freeman** and **Justice Shoats**

Freeman ranks seventh in the MAAC in both scoring (14.9) and threes (2.2)

The Mid-Major Madness MAAC Preseason Newcomer of the Year is the only Saint to score in double figures in all 10 games

The Preseason Second Team All-MAAC selections enters today just seven threes shy of 100 for his career

The JUCO transfer was an NJCAA Region 10 First Team selection after averaging 15.4 points, 5.1 rebounds, 4.4 assists, and 1.4 steals last season for Spartanburg Methodist

Shoats ranks sixth in the MAAC in assists (3.4) and eighth in scoring (14.5)

Shoats was one of five Division I players named a USBWA Oscar Robertson National Player of the

Week on Nov. 12

Shoats came off the bench to average 27.0 points, 3.0 assists, and 3.0 steals, while shooting 51% from the field in a pair of overtime victories against Brown and Bryant to open the season

Shoats also secured the first MAAC Player of the Week honors for the season on that Monday

First Siena player to earn MAAC Player of the Week since **Michael Baer** on Jan. 30, 2023

Shoats scored his 1,000th collegiate point at Niagara (Dec. 6)

The Division II Lock Haven transfer became the first player to reach 1,000 points while wearing a Siena uniform since **Jalen Pickett** on Jan. 9, 2021

The junior amassed 878 points in just 58 career games with the school

Shoats also stands just nine steals shy of 100 for his career

Shoats is averaging 21.8 points on 47% shooting in five Siena wins (7.2 points, 29% shooting in five losses)

Siena leads the MAAC and ranks 50th nationally averaging 4.7 blocks

The Saints registered 11 blocks at BIG EAST foe Xavier (Nov. 20), just three off the program single-game record

Eight different Siena players registered at least one rejection in the contest

**Peter Carey** ranks fourth in the MAAC in blocks (1.6), while **Myles Wilmoth** (1.2) stands seventh

November marked the Saints first .500 or better month since going 7-2 in January 2023

Siena had suffered seven straight sub-.500 months prior to last month

The Saints tipped off the program's 36th season of Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference competition earlier this month

Siena opened with the Western New York swing (Niagara and Canisius) by splitting the annual trip for the third straight season

The Saints have won at least a share of nine MAAC Regular Season Championships and claimed six MAAC Tournament titles

Siena was projected ninth (13 teams) according to the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll after finishing last (11th) in 2023-24

The Saints opened the "McNam-Era" with three straight wins

**Gerry McNamara** was the first coach to begin his Siena tenure 3-0 in 42 years since **John Griffin** also began 3-0 in 1982-83

The Saints had been led by 10 different head coaches between Griffin and McNamara

Siena achieved the program's first 3-0 November start in 21 years (2003-04)

The Saints had dropped their final eight games to end last season

Siena began the McNamara Era with consecutive overtime victories

First time in the program's 84 seasons in which Siena has played consecutive overtime contests to open a season

First time the Saints had played consecutive overtime games since bridging the final game of 2016-17 and first game of 2017-18

First time Siena had both played in and won consecutive overtime games since Nov. 24-28, 2015 at Bucknell and vs. Loyola (MD)

The Saints officially tipped off an exciting new era in the program's storied history on Nov. 4

The Syracuse legend and 2003 National Champion McNamara was named the 19th head coach in program history Mar. 29

"G-Mac" made his collegiate head coaching debut after spending the past 15 years on staff with the Orange

McNamara helped guide Syracuse to nine NCAA Tournament appearances, highlighted by trips to the Final Four in 2013 and 2016

One of the most decorated players in the storied Syracuse history, McNamara is the program's all-time career record holder for made threes (400), free throw percentage (.888), and minutes played (4,799), and ranks second all-time in steals (258), third in assists (648), fourth in scoring (2,099), and sixth in made free throws (435)

Siena tipped off the program's 84th varsity season and 49th at the Division I level with a 72-71 overtime win over Brown Nov. 4

Nov. 4 marked the earliest calendar season-opener in program history (previous earliest - Nov. 5, 2019)

The Saints played their first season-opening overtime contest since the 2017 lid-lifter at College of Charleston

Siena snapped an eight-game losing streak overall, and a program-record 11-game home losing streak with the victory

The Saints welcomed 12 newcomers as part of their 17-member 2024-25 roster

Siena added nine scholarship additions and three walk-ons

Five of the newcomers are true freshmen, and eight of the 12 had never before played a game at the Division I level

Freshmen **Tajae Jones** (sixth youngest) and **Gavin Doty** (12th youngest) are amongst the youngest DI freshmen nationally

Siena holds the 13th least Division I playing experience nationally (0.62 years) according to Ken Pom

The Saints returned just five players from their 16-member 2023-24 roster, and none of their top-seven scorers from a season ago

Siena welcomed back just 18% of their scoring and 17% of their rebounding from last winter

McNamara appointed juniors **Brendan Coyle**, Freeman, and **Marcus Jackson** as team captains for the 2024-25 season

Coyle entered the season as the only current Saint who had been on the roster for more than two seasons

Freeman (Spartanburg Methodist) and Jackson (UAlbany) are both first-year transfers

The Saints have ranked in the top-100 nationally in average home attendance for 26 consecutive seasons

Siena boasted the nation's top average home attendance amongst all Northeast mid-major programs for three straight non-COVID impacted seasons from 2019-23 (2019-20, 2021-22, 2022-23)

The Saints have drawn nearly 2.8 million fans spanning 436 games played at MVP Arena, marking an average of 6,403 spectators

There is nowhere to go but up for Siena as it looks to turn the page in the first season under McNamara

The Saints posted a 4-28 overall record last season, and finished last out of 11 teams in the MAAC at 3-17 in league action

The 28 defeats were the most in the 83-season program history

Siena ranked in the bottom-10 nationally in turnover margin (-5.8 - last), three-point field goal percentage (.280 - third worst), scoring (60.4 - fourth worst), assist-to-turnover ratio (0.68 - fifth worst), fast break points (4.7 - fifth worst), scoring margin (-14.0 - sixth worst), and turnovers (15.8 - sixth worst)

The Saints had players miss a combined 79 games due to injury or illness, leading to 19 different lineup combinations

Siena entered this season having dropped 34 of their previous 38 games overall dating back to Feb. 2023

## Previous Starters

### F - #21 Brendan Coyle

Ranks in the top-50 nationally in both made threes per game (3.3 - 27th) and three-point field goal percentage (.446 - 44th)  
Scored in double figures in eight of first ten games, while averaging 12.4 points in 10 starts  
Scored season-high 17 points, made career-high tying five threes, and corralled career-high nine boards at Canisius (Dec. 8)  
Junior captain from nearby Niskayuna is only current Saint who has been on the roster for more than two seasons  
Appeared in first 22 collegiate games (five starts), averaging 3.0 points in 12.5 minutes as a sophomore last season  
Averaged 8.5 points, 4.7 rebounds, and 1.8 steals while shooting 48% from the field and 46% from three over final six games  
Established career-high 19 points on a perfect 6-6 shooting (5-5 from three) vs. Niagara (Mar. 7, 2024)  
2023-24 MAAC All-Academic Team selection and two-time MAAC Academic Honor Roll honoree  
Named an All-NEPSAC Class AA selection while starring at Cushing Academy during his postgraduate year  
Previously played locally at Colonie Central and competed in AAU for the Albany City Rocks

### C - #13 Peter Carey

Ranks fourth in the MAAC averaging 1.6 blocks  
Averaging 4.8 points and 2.9 rebounds while shooting 59% from the field in 14.6 minutes while starting first 10 games  
Posted career-best performance with 16 points on 7-8 shooting and six blocks in win over American (Nov. 12)  
Red-shirt sophomore transfer matriculated to Siena with new head coach **Gerry McNamara**  
Appeared in 17 games over two seasons with the Orange (2022-24), amassing nine points and 15 rebounds in 91 minutes  
Saw action in 17 games, totaling nine points and 12 rebounds over 71 minutes last season  
Three-star recruit coming out of high school was rated as the seventh best player overall in Massachusetts and the 60th best power forward nationally in his class by 247 Sports  
Spent parts of two seasons at Northfield Mount Hermon - where he served as a team captain - after beginning and ending his high school career at Frontier Regional  
Played his AAU basketball for New York Lightning Select

### G - #44 Marcus Jackson

Ranks sixth in the MAAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.77)  
Started each of first 10 games, averaging 5.6 points and a team-high 4.6 rebounds in 28.8 minutes  
Scored collegiate career-high 17 points while adding eight rebounds against former UAlbany squad (Nov. 16)  
Junior captain from nearby Amsterdam joins program after spending first two seasons at crosstown rival UAlbany  
Appeared in 48 games (37 starts) in two seasons with the Great Danes, averaging 4.6 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 1.5 assists spanning 21.0 minutes while shooting 52% from the field including 37% from three-point range  
Averaged 5.6 points, 4.8 rebounds, 1.9 assists, and 1.5 steals, while shooting 57% from the floor and 42% from three last year  
Tied career-high with pair of 15-point performances last season  
Four-time team captain led Albany Academy to a 95-20 record and a pair of State Championships  
Earned 2021 *Albany Times Union* Large School Athlete of the Year after averaging 27.9 points, 9.2 assists, and 5.7 rebounds  
Spent a postgraduate year at Cushing Academy in Massachusetts  
Older brother, **Andre Jackson**, plays in the NBA for the Milwaukee Bucks after starring collegiately at UConn
