Jon Anderson **Head Coach**

Jon Anderson is in his sixth season as the head football coach at the University of Sioux Falls.

He was formally introduced as USF's 21st head coach on Tuesday, Dec. 6, 2016. Anderson has directed USF to a 39-16 record with a 39-15 mark in the NSIC.

In May of 2020, Anderson was appointed to the NCAA DII Football Committee. Anderson will serve on the committee from Sept. 1, 2020 through August 31, 2024. He became one of eight members on the national committee, which consists of two members from each of the four Super Regions. As a member, he will help sustain and advance the NCAA's mission, traditions, values and reputation. Anderson will regularly participate in committee meetings and conference calls. He will also serve on the football regional advisory committee for Super Region IV, assist in regional rankings and will also be responsible in assisting with the selection of teams to make the Division II football playoffs as a member of the national committee.

During his first season in 2017, he led USF to a 9-3 record and a fourth consecutive postseason appearance. The Cougars finished third overall in the NSIC with a 9-2 mark and tied for second in the NSIC South with a record of 5-2. In 2018, USF finished 7-4 and was again 5-2 in the NSIC South. In 2019, Anderson led the Cougars back to the NCAA DII playoffs for the second time in three seasons at USF. The Cougars registered their 26th straight winning season which ranks fourth across all divisions of the NCAA after finishing 8-4. The Cougars were third in the NSIC overall at 8-3 and third in the NSIC South at 5-2. The 2020 season was canceled by the NCAA DII/NSIC due to the CoVID 19 pandemic.

Prior to returning to The Coos in 2017, Anderson was the head coach at West Virginia State where he had a record of 10-34. Currently, Coach Anderson's overall head coaching record sits at 43-48 as of September 6th, 2022.

While serving as an assistant coach for USF from 2002-2012, Anderson helped lead the Cougars to a 134-26 record, three NAIA championships (2006, 2008, 2009), as well as the programs first, nine-win team at the NCAA DII level. Anderson spent three seasons as the defensive coordinator for the Cougars where their defense posted a 27-7 record and limited opponents to an average of 16 points per game. Prior to being named the Cougars' defensive coordinator, Anderson served eight years as the special team's coordinator and linebackers coach. In that role, he coached five All-Americans and eight All-Conference players.

Anderson, a native of Maryville, Missouri, played college football for four years at Buena Vista University in Storm Lake, Iowa, and coached the secondary at his alma mater during the 1999 and 2000 seasons.

He moved to Madison, South Dakota, to join the Dakota State University staff as the linebackers and special teams coach for the 2001 season. He arrived at USF for the 2002 season and earned his master's degree from South Dakota State University in 2003. He worked with legendary head coach Bob Young, and former head coaches Kalen DeBoer and Jed Stugart.

He and his wife, Amanda, have two sons, Trevor and Tyce.

Joe Ford **Defensive Coordinator**

Joe Ford is in his third season as the defensive coordinator for the University of Sioux Falls Football Program.

A native of Brandon, S.D., Ford has coached at FCS level South Dakota, and NCAA DII programs at Southwest Minnesota State, St. Cloud State and for two years at USF. He is a defensive coordinator for the third time (seven total seasons) after previous stints in the role at North Carolina - Pembroke in 2016-17 as well as with Minot State from 2007-12.

At USF, he has been part of one of the nation's top defensive units. The Cougars are 23-10 during his three-year tenure, which includes an 8-4 mark in 2019 where he was part of the staff that directed the program to its fourth NCAA DII playoff appearance.

Prior to USF, Ford was at UNC-Pembroke where he was part of a staff that directed the team to a 10-2 record in 2016 and a No. 13 ranking in the final AFCA poll. In 2016, UNC-Pembroke set a school record for wins with 10, including the program's first DII playoff victory (24-21 over Valdosta State).

As an assistant coach for South Dakota (2013-14), Ford mentored Tyler Starr, who earned Missouri Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Year honors after accumulating 71 tackles (15 tackles for loss) and nine sacks as a senior in 2013. Starr was later selected in the seventh round of the 2014 NFL Draft by the Atlanta Falcons.

Ford also spent five seasons as the defensive coordinator at Minot State (2007-12). In 2009, the Beavers registered a Dakota Athletic Conference-leading 17 interceptions and made their first playoff appearance since 2002. The following season, Minot State ranked 16th in the NAIA in scoring defense (18.4 points/game), while also posting the nation's sixth-best sacks per game average (3.0).

In his first four years at Minot State, the Beavers won 26 games before the school transitioned to the NCAA Division II level and the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in 2011. Under his watch, seven defensive stand-outs earned all-conference honors, including three during his final season with the Beavers.

Ford began his coaching career in 2004 at Southwest Minnesota State University as a graduate assistant, later doing post-graduate work at St. Cloud State in 2006 as the linebackers coach.

He and his wife, Stephanie, have three children, Brynn, Patterson and Sullivan.

Al Hansen **Kicking Coach**

Al Hansen enters his 20th season as the punters and kickers coach for the University of Sioux Falls. Throughout his time with USF, Hansen has coached five All-American punters and kickers.

In 2012, Hansen coached kicker/punter Braden Wieking to a fifth place rating in field goal percentage (84.2%) in the NCAA DII standings. Wieking also maintained a 94.7% PAT conversion rate while etching his name in the USF record books with the longest made field goal at 54 yards.

Hansen has helped coach numerous punters and kickers achieve All-American, All-Region and All-Conference awards throughout his time at USF. He has also helped lead The Cou to three of their four national championships (2006, 2008, 2009).

As an athlete for USF in 1987, Hansen earned all-conference and honorable mention All-American honors after averaging 40.3 yards per punt for the Cougars.

Luke Johnson Linebackers Coach

Luke Johnson enters his first season as the linebackers coach for the University of Sioux Falls.

Johnson comes to USF from Wofford College, an FCS program where he coached outside linebackers during the 2021 season. He joined Wofford in 2020 as a defensive quality control and video coordinator before being promoted to linebackers' coach in 2021.

Prior to coaching, Johnson played four seasons at the University of Wisconsin-Platteville. He was a leader on the team, including serving as a co-captain his senior campaign. Johnson was the recipient of the George Chryst Award for representing leadership and attitude both on and off the field. During his time at Wisconsin-Platteville, Johnson was named second team All-Conference in 2017 and was the team's Newcomer of the Year in 2016.

A native of Milan, Illinois, Johnson graduated from Rockridge High School, where he was an All-State football player and the Three Rivers Conference Player of the Year as a senior.

Hayden Mace Offensive Coordinator/Offensive Line

Hayden Mace begins his first season in 2022 as the offensive coordinator/offensive line coach and third year overall with the University of Sioux Falls Football program.

In 2021, Mace was part of the USF staff that directed the Cougars to its second NSIC South Division title and was fifth overall. USF led the NSIC in rushing at 217.6 yards per game (419 carries for 2,394 yards) and 28 TDs and ranked seventh in the NSIC with 413.3 yards per game. USF was 31st in Division II and third in the NSIC in third down conversions at 44.4%. The Cougars ranked fifth in DII and first in the league in completion percentage at 66.5%, which was enabled by an offensive front which allowed just 0.73 sacks per game for sixth in DII and second in the NSIC.

In 2021, one of Maces offensive linemen, Brennan Moran, was named All-NSIC First Team and named to the D2CCA All-Super Region 4 squad in 2022. Offensive tackle, Jasper Parks, was also named All-NSIC as a sophomore.

Prior to joining the USF staff, Mace worked under head coach Gary Anderson as a graduate assistant coach at Utah State University from January, 2019 to March, 2020.

From 2017-2019, Mace was an offensive quality control coach at Eastern Washington University where he assisted Head Coach Aaron Best and Offensive Coordinator Bodie Reeder with quarterbacks, the offensive line and tight ends. Eastern Washington made an appearance in the 2018-19 national title game and finished second in the country.

In addition, Mace served as an offensive analyst in 2016 at Linfield College, where he had been a team captain and was a standout offensive lineman from 2008-2011.

He and his wife, Katie, who are both from of Bend, Oregon, currently live in Sioux Falls.

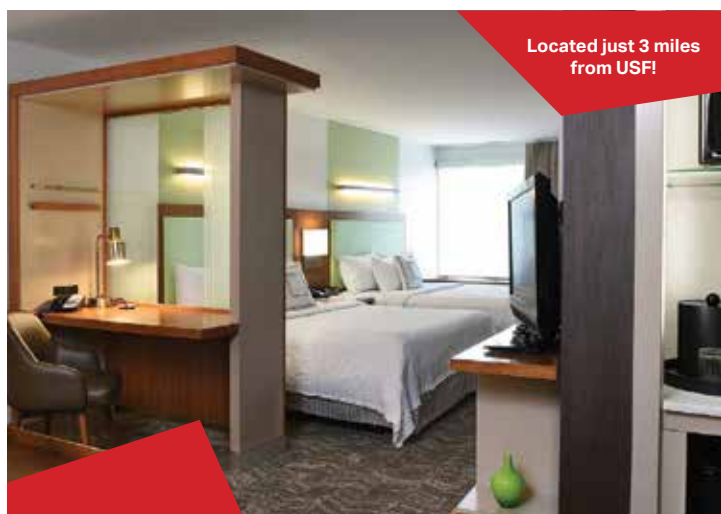

Brody Rohach Quarterbacks Coach



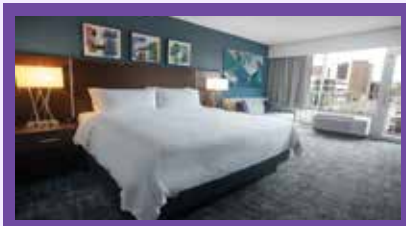
Brody Rohach is in his first season as the quarterbacks coach for USF.

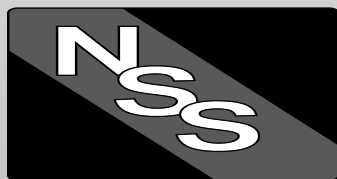

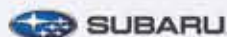
