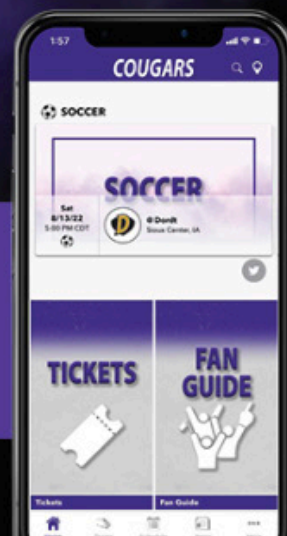

## Travis Traphagen Women's Basketball Head Coach

Travis Traphagen embarks on his 17th season at the helm of the University of Sioux Falls Women's Basketball program with an outstanding career record of 284-174 entering this season. Through nearly two decades of dedication and success, Traphagen has become synonymous with excellence, transforming the Cougars into a respected force in NCAA Division II basketball. With six 20-win seasons, two NCAA DII Regional berths, and an NSIC South Division title under his leadership, Traphagen's contributions have left an indelible mark on the program's history.

### Historic Firsts and Milestone Seasons

Traphagen's impact is highlighted by historic milestones, including leading the Cougars to their first NCAA Tournament berth in the 2015-16 season. That year cemented USF's status as a rising power in DII women's basketball, showcasing the program's ability to compete at the highest level under his leadership.

The 2019-20 season marked another milestone as Traphagen guided USF to its first NSIC South Division title. The Cougars achieved a 26-6 record and a 17-5 mark in conference play, earning their second NCAA DII Central Region Tournament appearance as the No. 3 seed. That season also saw the Cougars earn their first WBCA DII national ranking, climbing as high as No. 7, and finishing the year ranked 24th in the D2SIDA Poll. Along the way, Traphagen coached two All-NSIC First Team selections, and his team featured 10 All-NSIC Academic Team members and six Academic Team of Excellence honorees.

In 2020-21, USF continued to excel under Traphagen's guidance, earning the No. 4 seed in the NSIC Tournament. That season highlighted Traphagen's commitment to developing well-rounded student-athletes, with one All-NSIC First Team honoree, five All-NSIC Academic Team selections, and three members of the NSIC Academic Team of Excellence.

The 2018-19 season was another highlight, with the Cougars posting a 23-8 overall record and tying for first in the NSIC South. That year, Traphagen achieved a significant career milestone, recording his 200th career win. The Cougars produced two All-NSIC First Team athletes and seven All-NSIC Academic Team members.

Even in his earlier years at USF, Traphagen established a pattern of success. In 2017, the Cougars reached the NSIC Tournament Championship game and earned another 20-win season, finishing 22-8. That season also saw the program's first-ever NCAA DII All-American selection.

During his tenure, the Cougars have produced:

- 17 all-conference players
- Two NSIC Players of the Year
- Two NSIC Freshmen of the Year
- One NCAA DII All-American
- 30 academic all-conference honorees
- Nine NSIC Academic Team of Excellence members

### Coaching Journey

Before arriving at USF, Traphagen served as the lead assistant coach at Augustana College (S.D.) from 2001-2007. During his time there, the Vikings posted a 111-69 record, with three consecutive 20-win seasons culminating in a 25-7 record and an NCAA regional tournament berth in 2006-07. The Vikings also enjoyed a 20-game winning streak and were ranked No. 2 in the North Central Region that year.

Traphagen's coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Wayne State College, where he earned a master's degree in sports administration.

### Playing Career and Personal Life

A standout player at Black Hills State University, Traphagen was a two-time all-conference selection and team co-captain. During his tenure, the Yellow Jackets won three consecutive South Dakota Intercollegiate Conference championships. In the 1997-98 season, Traphagen set the school's single-season record for made three-pointers with 97. He graduated in 1999 with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He and his wife, Ann, reside in Sioux Falls with their three children: Grayson, Riley, and Luke.

# COACHING STAFF



## Carley Neumann Women's Basketball Associate Head Coach

Carley Neumann is in her second season as the associate head women's basketball coach at the University of Sioux Falls. A proven leader with a strong history of success both on and off the court, Jeffery brings a wealth of experience to the Cougars' program.

Neumann returned to USF after a three-year tenure at Presentation College in Aberdeen, S.D. During her time with the Saints, she served one season as an assistant coach before taking the reins as head coach for two seasons.

Her first stint with the Cougars came during the 2019-20 season when she was an assistant coach. That year, USF enjoyed one of the best campaigns in program history, posting a 26-6 record and capturing the 2020 NSIC South Division Championship. The Cougars earned the No. 3 seed in the NCAA DII Central Region Tournament before the season ended prematurely due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Before joining USF, Neumann spent four years (2015-2019) as an assistant coach at St. Cloud State University. During her tenure, she helped guide the Huskies to a 60-50 record while contributing to the program's growth and competitive success.

### Collegiate Playing Career

As a player, Neumann enjoyed a standout four-year career at St. Cloud State. She was instrumental in the Huskies' success, helping the team secure an NSIC North Division Championship in 2013. Over 97 games, she tallied 447 points and 106 assists, earning recognition for her performance on the court and in the classroom.

A dedicated student-athlete, Neumann was a three-time NSIC All-Academic Team member and received the prestigious Myles Brand Award during her senior year, a testament to her excellence in academics and athletics.

### Personal Life

Originally from Cambridge, Wisconsin, Neumann is proud to call Sioux Falls her home once again. She returned to USF with her husband, Clint Neumann, and officially resumed her role with the Cougars on June 1, 2023.

# COACHING STAFF



## Shawn Bergan Women's Basketball Assistant Coach

Shawn Bergan is in his 10th season as an assistant coach with the University of Sioux Falls Women's Basketball team. A key contributor to the program's consistent success, Bergan has helped lead the Cougars to a 138-59 record during his tenure, with seven winning seasons and numerous milestones.

### **Coaching Success at USF**

In 2019-20, Bergan played an integral role in guiding USF to its first-ever NSIC South Division title. The Cougars posted a 26-6 overall record and a 17-5 mark in the NSIC, earning a top-10 national ranking. That season, Sioux Falls achieved its highest-ever WBCA national ranking at No. 7 and held a top-25 spot for 10 weeks, including nine consecutive polls. USF finished the year ranked No. 24 in the D2SIDA Poll and secured its second NCAA DII Central Region Tournament berth as the No. 3 seed.

Bergan was also part of the coaching staff that led the Cougars to their first NSIC Tournament Championship in 2016. That team achieved a program-record 27-6 record, earning an automatic NCAA Tournament berth. The Cougars swept through the NSIC Tournament with four straight wins, including a dominant 75-57 championship victory over Augustana.

### **Other Notable Seasons**

2018-19: Helped guide the Cougars to a 23-8 record and a tie for first in the NSIC South Division. Seven players earned Academic All-NSIC honors.

2017-18: Assisted USF in achieving a 16-13 overall record, advancing to the NSIC Tournament Semifinals for the third straight year.

2016-17: The Cougars finished 22-9 and advanced to the NSIC Tournament Championship game for the second consecutive year.

### **Prior Coaching Experience**

Before joining USF, Bergan spent five seasons as a part-time assistant coach at Augustana, starting in 2008. There, he helped develop the program while balancing his role as the head coach of the Sioux Falls Lincoln High School girls' basketball team, where he coached for seven seasons. Bergan's coaching career spans over 23 years and includes experience at both the high school and collegiate levels, working with men's and women's basketball programs.

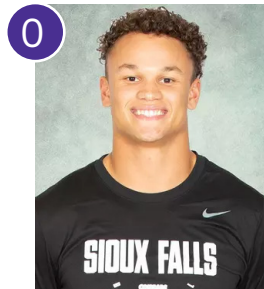
### **Education and Playing Background**

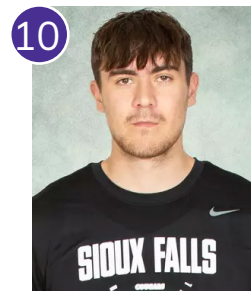

# COACHING STAFF



## Chris Johnson Men's Basketball Head Coach

Chris Johnson is entering his 17th season as head coach of the University of Sioux Falls Men's Basketball program, where he has established himself as a cornerstone of the program's success. Johnson, the winningest coach in Cougar Basketball history, boasts a career record of 263-189 at USF and an overall record of 279-204 coming into this season.

### Leadership and Success at USF

Since his arrival in 2008 as the program's 22nd head coach, Johnson has transformed USF into a competitive force in both the NAIA and NCAA Division II ranks. His tenure includes:

- Six 20-win seasons
- 10 NSIC Tournament appearances
- Two GPAC Tournament Championships
- One NSIC South Division title

The 2019-20 season marked a high point for Johnson and the Cougars. Under his leadership, USF posted a program-best 22-8 overall record and a 17-5 mark in conference play, capturing the program's first-ever NSIC South Division title. Johnson's efforts earned him NSIC Coach of the Year honors for the first time.

Johnson's impact extends beyond wins and titles. He has produced 14 all-conference players, including an NSIC Preseason Player of the Year, an NSIC Newcomer of the Year, and one All-American.

### Milestone Achievements

2017: Became USF's all-time wins leader with a 73-69 victory over Concordia-St. Paul.

2018: Secured his 200th career win with a victory over Minnesota Duluth.

2019: Reached his 200th win at USF with a triumph over Southwest Minnesota State.

Johnson is also the only coach in NSIC history to lead his team to five consecutive appearances in the NSIC Tournament.

### Transition to NCAA DII

During USF's transition from NAIA to NCAA Division II, Johnson guided the program to its first NSIC Tournament in 2013, where the Cougars nearly upset No. 2 seed Northern State in the opening round. That same season, USF broke an 11-game losing streak against crosstown rival Augustana, earning their first victory over the Vikings since 1994.

### Early Success in NAIA

In his second season at USF (2008-09), Johnson led the Cougars to a GPAC Championship and a Sweet 16 appearance in the NAIA Tournament. His efforts earned him GPAC Coach of the Year honors in 2011, following another conference title. During his NAIA tenure, Johnson coached seven all-conference selections and one NAIA All-American.

### Coaching Career Before USF

Before joining USF, Johnson spent three seasons as the lead assistant at the University of North Dakota. In 2004-05, he served as head coach at Culver-Stockton College (NAIA) in Missouri, where he was named Heart of America Athletic Conference Coach of the Year after guiding the Wildcats to their first home playoff game in program history.

Johnson's earlier coaching stops include stints as an assistant at Minot State (2001-04), Minnesota State (1999-2001), and Central College (1998-99).

### Playing Career and Personal Life

A four-year letter winner and two-year starting guard at Central College in Pella, Iowa, Johnson graduated with a bachelor's degree in exercise science. He later earned a master's degree in sports administration from Minnesota State University. Chris and his wife, Amy, reside in Sioux Falls with their four children: Bailey, TJ, Zeke, and Lucy.

# COACHING STAFF



## Drew Guebert Men's Basketball Assistant Coach

Drew Guebert is entering his third season as an assistant coach for the University of Sioux Falls Men's Basketball team, marking his fourth year on staff after serving as a graduate assistant during the 2020-21 season. In his role, Guebert plays a pivotal part in all aspects of the basketball program, including recruiting, player development, practice planning, and game strategy. He also assists in coordinating and running camps and supports the academic success of the program's student-athletes.

Before joining the coaching staff, Guebert spent two years playing professional basketball in Spain with Basquet Menorca, where he helped lead the team to the playoff semifinals in 2021. His professional experience abroad adds a valuable perspective to the program.

Guebert is a former standout player for the USF Cougars, where he cemented his place as one of the most accomplished players in program history. A two-time All-NSIC selection, including First-Team honors in 2018-19, he concluded his collegiate career ranked third on the USF all-time scoring list with 1,971 points. He also earned three NSIC Player of the Week honors and was recognized nationally as the U.S. Basketball Writers National Player of the Week.

Over his four-year playing career, Guebert appeared in 122 games (104 starts), averaging 16.3 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. Known for his sharpshooting, he set the USF program record with 264 career three-pointers made and became the first player in school history to record four consecutive seasons with 59 or more made triples. Guebert logged 92 double-digit scoring games, including 43 games with 20 or more points, and amassed five career double-doubles.

In conference play, he finished seventh on the NSIC's all-time scoring list (league games only) with 1,423 points and was a critical piece in USF's success, leading the Cougars to a 71-51 overall record during his tenure.

Originally from Apple Valley, Minnesota, Guebert graduated from Eastview High School before pursuing his collegiate career at USF, where he earned his degree in Business Administration, minored in Marketing and Economics, and completed his MBA. He currently resides in Sioux Falls with his wife, Jacey (Huinker) Guebert, a former USF Women's Basketball player who competed from 2015-2020.
