SEC's Missouri Tigers Visit Edwardsville

FIRST SWEEP: SIUE suffered its first series sweep loss of the year as Little Rock won all three games last weekend.

SERIES STUFF: Mizzou hold an 18-4 record in the series against the Cougars. That includes an 8-1 mark since SIUE made the move to Division I with the 2009 season. The Tigers won the only other meeting in Edwardsville 10-3 in 2019. Including the Mizzou series, SIUE is 4-22 against the current Southeastern Conference schools.

HOT START: SIUE began the year 10-2. It is the best start through 12 games since the 1990 team also started 10-2.

WEEKEND WINNERS: The Cougars won four of their six nonconference weekend series this year, taking two of three from Incarnate Word, Louisiana-Monroe and UIC while sweeping Western Illinois at home.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Senior designated hitter Brady Bunten earned OVC Player of the Week honors March 20. It was his first award this year, and the third of his career. Starter Jake Bockenstedt has won Pitcher of the Week three times, marking the most for an SIUE player in a single season.

LEAGUE LEADERS: SIUE hitters are fourth in the league with a .273 batting average, and lead the league in doubles with 82. SIUE pitchers are fourth in the OVC in earned run average at 6.09 and are third in total strikeouts with 307. The Cougars hold the highest fielding percentage in the league at .979, good for No. 21 in the NCAA. Additionally, Bunten leads the OVC and is No. 9 in the NCAA with 18 doubles. He also is ninth in the nation at 0.47 doubles per game. He also is 10th in the league lead with 36 RBIs. Brennan Orf leads the league in runs scored with 53 (8th in the NCAA) and leads in walks (37) which is 23rd in the NCAA. He is second in home runs with 14.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Orf has a career-long 15-game hitting streak coming into the week.

BUNTEN CLOSING IN ON RECORDS: Bunten is closing in on SIUE's career home run mark. Bunten has 33 home runs (tied 2nd). SIUE's career record for home runs is 35, held by Brock Weimer (2016-19). Bunten is tied for third in career RBIs in SIUE's Division I era with 134. His 17 doubles are two away from the single season record for doubles in the Division I era. He has 189 career hits, which is 10th on the career Division I list.

ROUNDTRIPPER RECORD: SIUE's 99 home runs last year set a school record. The 1998 team held the previous record with 69. The Cougars were second in the OVC and No. 21 in the NCAA. At 1.8 home runs per game, the Cougars were No. 15 in the country.

NEW NO. 1: Bockenstedt is the Cougars' top starter. While he primarily closed games last year, he has made 13 career starts. In 47 career appearances covering 146.1 innings, Bockenstedt has 158 career strikeouts and a record of 12-13. His 12 wins are tied for fifth all-time among SIUE pitchers in the Division I era.

NEW STAFF: The Cougars are relying on an entirely new starting rotation, and a largely new pitching staff in 2023. The only returning SIUE pitcher who made a start last year is Taylor Bruninga.

LAST YEAR: With 27 wins in 2022, SIUE had its most wins under Sean Lyons and the second most wins since moving to Division I. The most wins at Division I is 28 by the 2011 team, which was the year before SIUE played a conference schedule. The Cougars finished fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference. SIUE returned to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2015. For the first time ever, SIUE won at the tournament, finishing 2-2.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS: Before the season, the OVC's head coaches and sports information personnel tabbed SIUE for a sixth-place finish. D1Baseball.com also picked SIUE for a sixth-place finish.

5 Sean Lyons, Head Coach



SIUE baseball Head Coach Sean Lyons returns for his seventh season in the dugout in 2023. Lyons has a career record of 115-160 in six seasons at SIUE. With a 7-0 shutout of UT Martin April 3, 2022, at Simmons Complex, Lyons earned his 100th win at the helm of SIUE baseball.

In 2022, Lyons guided the Cougars to one of their most successful seasons since moving to Division I in 2009. SIUE finished 27-28, the second most wins the program has amassed at the Division I level. He led the Cougars back to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2015, where SIUE won for the first time, going 2-2 at the Championship and falling to eventual champion Southeast Missouri.

The 2022 campaign was undoubtedly the program's most successful offensive season since the transition. SIUE hitters combined to hit .303, ten points higher than any other season at Division I. The Cougars slugged .524 and reached base at a .384 clip both records at the Division I level. SIUE scored 430 runs, bettering the next closest season by 85 runs, despite playing just three more games. The Cougars established a new school record by blasting 99 home runs, which was good for second in the OVC and ranked 21st in the NCAA. SIUE racked up 585 hits and 1,013 total bases, both good for program highs at the Division I level. Under Lyons, Brett Johnson and Richie Well earned All-Region honors following their final seasons in a Cougar uniform. Johnson belted a program-record 23 home runs while driving in 63 runs, to set a new record at the Division I level. He was drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. Well had a breakout season of his own hitting 19 doubles to establish a new Division I mark. He hit 14 home runs, which ranks No. 4 on SIUE's single-season list. Well hit .571 (8-14) with eight RBIs at the OVC tournament and was SIUE's first-ever selection to the OVC All-Tournament team. Johnson, Brady Buntin and Kaid Karnes all earned first team All-OVC honors while Brennan Orf was named to the second team.

The 2021 team finished 23-27 overall, which matched the most wins under Sean Lyons (2017). SIUE was 13-17 in Ohio Valley Conference play, marking the most OVC wins for the Cougars since 2015.

SIUE's offense excelled in 2021. The Cougars led the OVC in slugging percentage (.462) and triples (15), while finishing second in the league in home runs (64), runs batted in (296) and total bases (804). Additionally, SIUE was third in doubles (98), fourth in batting average (.278), runs scored (315) and hits (484). Lyons oversaw a pair of All-OVC performers in Brady Buntin and Brett Johnson, both of whom were selected the second team following the season.

Off to a promising start before the suspension of college sports, the Cougars finished the abbreviated 2020 season at 8-7 overall and 3-0 in the Ohio Valley Conference. The schedule featured nonconference wins over Nicholls State, George Washington, Texas-San Antonio and Stephen F. Austin. The Cougars swept their only Ohio Valley Conference series versus Tennessee Tech while featuring a strong pitching staff and an improved lineup. SIUE hit .314 in its three-game sweep of Tennessee Tech, while limiting the visiting Golden Eagles to a .148 batting average. Cougar hurlers fanned 45 hitters over three days.

The Cougars won 19 games, adding four wins over the season before. SIUE won 11 Ohio Valley Conference games in 2019, tying for the most OVC wins under Lyons, but falling a game short of earning their first OVC tournament berth since 2015. SIUE earned OVC series wins over Southeast Missouri, UT Martin and Murray State in 2019.

As a team SIUE improved on both sides of the field. The Cougars hit .263 as a team, improving their team mark by nearly 20 points, while also dropping their team earned run average. SIUE remained one of the best fielding teams in the OVC.

Two longtime Cougars, Brock Weimer and Dustin Woodcock, wrapped up their Cougar careers under Lyons in 2019. Weimer connected on 12 home runs in 2019 and finished with a school record 35 long balls in his career. His 140 RBIs are ninth most in a career at SIUE. Woodcock finished eighth on the career list for games played and started at SIUE while racking up 48 doubles to rank No. 8 on the all-time list. He also appears in the top 20 with 120 RBIs during his time.

Pitchers Kenny Serwa and Colin Baumgartner continue to establish themselves as front of the rotation pitchers. Serwa earned All-OVC honors despite an injury-shortened season. Serwa made seven starts and tied for the OVC lead with two complete games. Baumgartner tied for third in the league with 15 starts. His 82 strikeouts led the team and is 9.93 strikeouts per nine innings was fifth best in the league.

Playing a challenging nonconference schedule, the Cougars finished at 15-37 overall in 2018. During the season, SIUE faced the likes of Louisiana Tech, Oral Roberts and top-25 ranked Wichita State, while also face a pair of NCAA regional teams - Tennessee Tech and Morehead State in Ohio Valley Conference play. Under Lyons, Jared McCunn finished his two-year career in 2018, leading the team in hitting with a .321 batting average. Weimer continued his strong play at the plate, leading the team in home runs and RBIs for the second straight season. Pitchers Mason McReaken and Nelson Martz finished their SIUE careers under Lyons and began their journey in to pro baseball. McReaken in his second season in the Atlanta Braves organization.

Finishing at 23-29, Lyons established a new school record for wins by a first-year head coach in 2017. In his first season in charge, Lyons oversaw a 14-win improvement from the previous season, marking the 13th largest turnaround in the NCAA.

The Cougars' turnaround came largely from a much-improved offense. SIUE enjoyed its best offensive season since the move to NCAA Division I in 2009. The Cougars combined for a .293 batting average, which was the team's highest average since 2010. In OVC play, the average jumped to .316, which was third best in the league.

SIUE's 530 hits were second most in the Division I era, and the Cougars' 340 hits during conference play ranked third in the OVC.

The Cougars scored 335 runs, hit 53 home runs and drove in 319 runs, all Division I era-bests at the time and all despite playing fewer games than several previous seasons. Under Lyons guidance, several players enjoyed breakout seasons at the plate. Sophomore catcher Brock Weimer earned first team All-OVC honors after leading the team with 15 home runs and 50 RBIs. His 15 home runs tied SIUE's single-season record. Senior second baseman Alec Skender ranked fourth in the OVC with a .388 batting average to earn second team All-OVC honors. His average was just one point off the Division I-era school record. He finished the year with 83 hits, which is the most in school history in the Division I-era. Redshirt-freshman Eric Giltz hit .302 for the year, on his way to earning an OVC All-Freshman team selection. Giltz hit .340 during OVC play. Senior slugger Keaton Wright (.317) and junior Dustin Woodcock (.330) each hit over .300 for the season while establishing new career highs in RBIs. Wright drove in 43 runs, while hitting a career-best 12 home runs. Woodcock knocked in 42 runs and tied his career high with six homers. In total, six players among the regulars hit .300 or better for the season.

Defense also proved to be a strong suit for the Cougars. SIUE led the OVC and finished 30th in the NCAA with a .979 fielding percentage. As a team, the Cougars committed just 40 errors in 1,870 total chances. SIUE turned 48 double plays which was second most in the Division I era.

Prior to coming to SIUE, Lyons was the associate head coach at Bradley. Named as the Cougars' head coach in June 2016, he is the fourth head coach in SIUE baseball history. The native of Byron, Illinois, spent seven total seasons on the Bradley staff where he served as recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor. The 2016 season was his first as the program's associate head coach. In his final season at Bradley, the Braves ranked No. 9 nationally averaging 2.32 doubles per game. The Braves were third in the Missouri Valley Conference with a .283 batting average and 116 doubles.

No stranger to the Ohio Valley Conference, Lyons spent six seasons on the Eastern Illinois staff before moving to Bradley. The Panthers won the OVC tournament title in 2008 and were OVC regular season champions in 2009. Also in 2009, the Panthers ranked second in the nation in hitting with a .362 batting average. At EIU, Lyons coached seven MLB draft picks, three Freshman All-Americans and eight OVC first team members.

Lyons played for Eastern Illinois from 1996-1999, leading the Panthers in hits for three straight seasons. He was selected as one of Eastern Illinois' 20 greatest OVC athletes during the Panthers' celebration of their first 20 years in the OVC.

He earned a Bachelor of Science from EIU in 1999. Lyons and his wife Jill have a daughter, Maleah and a son, Landry.

12 Joe Kelch, Assistant Coach

Joe Kelch returned to SIUE baseball in September 2022 as an assistant coach after spending three seasons on the staff at Illinois-Springfield. He spent last season as the Associate Head Coach and was the program's recruiting coordinator and hitting coach.

In 2022, Kelch assisted with the top UIS team in program history. The Prairie Stars won their first GLVC Championship Tournament, and captured NCAA Regional and NCAA Super Regional titles. UIS advanced to the NCAA Division II National Championship Tournament for the first time.

UIS ranked sixth in NCAA Division II at 10.0 runs per game, and was also top-10 offensively in walks, doubles, hits, home runs, on-base percentage, and slugging percentage. Kelch coached two All-Americans, including Zion Pettigrew, the GLVC and Midwest Regional Player of the Year. Four other players earned All-GLVC and All-Region honors.

The 2021 Prairie Stars won the GLVC Regular Season Championship, reached the finals of the GLVC Tournament, and was the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Midwest Regional Tournament. UIS finished the year with a 37-8 overall record, and a 30-5 GLVC mark. Kelch oversaw an offense which ranked fourth in NCAA Division II at 10.1 runs a game. UIS was second nationally in batting average, fourth in slugging percentage, and seventh in on-base percentage.

Among the offensive stars that Kelch coached was Pettigrew, who was named the GLVC and Midwest Region Player of the Year. Kal Youngquist was also a first-team All-American and first-team all-GLVC selection. Austin Alderman and Chris Mathieu both were All-Region picks, and Chris Monroe earned first-team All-GLVC honors.

In Kelch's first season in 2020, UIS went 10-4 in the pandemic-shortened season. The Prairie Stars had one of the top offenses in NCAA Division II that year. UIS led the nation with 1.86 home runs per game, and set a NCAA Division II single-season record with nine grand slams. The team was also in the top-15 nationally at 10.6 runs a game.

Kelch arrived at UIS after spending two seasons coaching at Bradley University, where he focused on infield defense and assisted with the hitters. While at Bradley, he helped the team's hitters win six all-conference honors, including four first-team accolades. In his first season at Bradley in 2018, the Braves improved by 12 wins and finished the year with a 32-19 record. With Kelch on staff, Bradley hitters hit .294 for the year, an improvement over a .268 mark from the previous season. Bradley also improved its on-base percentage and slugging percentage. In 2019, Bradley had another 30-win season after it finished the year with a 31-19 record.

Kelch's first stint at SIUE came in 2017 as the volunteer assistant where he worked with infield defense and the hitters. The Cougars went 23-29 that year, an improvement of 14 wins in just one season. In 2017, SIUE hitters hit .293 and averaged 6.6 runs a game, an improvement of 2.5 runs a contest. Two hitters earned all-conference honors, including one first-team award, and another was named to the all-freshman team.

As a player, Kelch appeared in 163 games, making 136 starts for Illinois State from 2012-2016. He hit .289 with a .382 slugging percentage and .366 on-base percentage. He scored 72 runs and drove in 63. He had 18 doubles, two triples, and nine home runs. He was named a second-team all-Missouri Valley Conference performer as a junior. That year, he hit .338 with an on-base percentage better than .400. He collected 18 runs, 24 RBIs, eight doubles, and four home runs.

Kelch, and his wife Emily, have a son, Jackson.



#51 Adam Vasil, Assistant Coach

Adam Vasil joined SIUE as the volunteer assistant in September 2021 and was elevated to a full-time assistant following the 2022 season. Vasil's primary focus will be on the Cougars' pitchers and catchers.

The Cougars improved by five wins with Vasil on staff and returned to the OVC Tournament for the first time since 2015. SIUE won a pair of games in the tournament, its first ever wins in the Championship.

Vasil came to SIUE after spending the 2021 season at Miami (Ohio) as the director of pitching development and bullpen coach. The Redhawks ranked fifth in the NCAA in strikeouts per nine innings (11.2), 16th in strikeout to walk ratio (3.07), 16th in earned run average (3.61), 22nd in hits per nine innings (7.78) and 25th in WHIP (1.27).

At Miami, Vasil coached three pitchers who went on to play affiliated baseball, including Sam Bachman, who was the ninth overall draft pick of the Angels in 2021.

Before his time at Miami, Vasil was the head assistant Coach at Coker University, a Division II school in South Carolina, where he also served as the lead recruiter and pitching coach. Under Vasil, the Cobras improved their total strikeouts, strikeouts per nine innings, walks and hits allowed.

The native of Cleveland, Ohio, spent the 2019 college season as a graduate assistant pitching coach at the University of Indianapolis where he also assisted game day scouting. There he helped the Greyhounds improve upon their overall earned run average, runs allowed, batting average against and WHIP.

Vasil also worked as a training specialist at the Florida Baseball Ranch (now Florida Baseball Armory) in Plant City, Florida.

Vasil began his college career at Ashland University where he was part of back-to-back conference championships and was a Rawlings Gold Glove nominee. He finished with one season as a graduate at Indianapolis.

He earned his bachelor's from Ashland in 2017 and an MBA from Indianapolis in 2019.
