Hinson 11-0 vs. Non-Division I

Hinson holds an 11-0 career record against non-Division I opponents during 15 years as a collegiate head coach. He's 3-0 while at SIU, with a 38-point win over Benedictine-Springfield in 2012, a 22-point victory over Missouri S&T in 2013, and a 16-point win over Olivet Nazarene in 2014.

Series vs. Missouri Southern State

The only meeting between the schools took place in Carbondale on Dec. 23, 1994. The Salukis won, 102-47, as Chris Carr led the Salukis with 22 points and all 13 players scored. SIU set a school record, that still stands, by out-rebounding MSSU by 38.

Statistical leaders

It's still early, but the Salukis have three players among the league leaders in a handful of statistical categories. Mike Rodriguez is seventh in scoring (16.5) and third in assists (5.0), Armon Fletcher is second in steals (2.5) and Thik Bol is 6th in blocked shots (1.5)

Mike Rodriguez has a 5-1 assist-turnover ratio

PG Mike Rodriguez (5-10, 165, Sr.) has 10 assists and only two turnovers for a sparkling 5.00 assist-to-turnover ratio. His ratio last year (1.88) was the ninth-best single-season mark in school history.

Rodriguez also leads the team in scoring and had a career-high 29 points in the opener against Wright State, nearly doubling his previous best of 15 versus Air Force on Nov. 13, 2015. Interestingly, that game was also the team's season-opener.

Dawg Bites

•The Salukis are in the middle of a five-game stretch in 10 days to start the season.

•SIU has given up the most points in a half in the Hinson era in both of its games — 56 in the second half at Arkansas and 54 in the first half versus Wright State.

•SIU has started a season 0-2 only four times in the last 50 years.

•SIU's roster has three foreign-born players — Rudy Stradnieks (Latvia), Thik Bol (Sudan), Leo Vincent (Liberia).

•SIU was 7-2 in games decided by five points or less last year. The Salukis are 0-1 this season.

Senior leadership

The Salukis' senior class (Sean O'Brien, Leo Vincent, Mike Rodriguez, Tyler Smithpeters) has the most returning career points and rebounds of any school in the Missouri Valley Conference. In fact, 25 percent of the returning scoring in the MVC comes from SIU's four seniors.

Sean O'Brien voted Preseason Second-Team All-MVC

F Sean O'Brien (6-7, 215, Sr.) is SIU's top returning scorer (12.1 points), rebounder (6.0 rebounds) and shot blocker (29 blocks). He was also second on the team in assists (63). The savvy veteran first cracked the lineup early in his freshman campaign, and has started 91 of the last 92 games, including a current streak of 69-consecutive starts.

Leo Vincent off to a hot start

G Leo Vincent (6-1, 192, Sr.) leads the team in 3-point shooting percentage (.556) having made 5-of-9. He is the team's second-leading scorer (14.5) and rebounder (5.0). Last year, Vincent was named to the MVC's All-Bench team last year. He played in all 32 games, never started, but was the team's fourth-leading scorer (8.1 points).

Saluki lineup features trio of junior college starters

Three Saluki starters (Mike Rodriguez, Leo Vincent and Thik Bol) came to SIU via the junior college route. The last time Southern started three juco players in a game was on Feb. 22, 2012 when Mamadou Seck, Jeff Early and T.J. Lindsay started at Drake.

School-record 17 home games at SIU Arena

Southern Illinois will host a school-record eight non-conference home games for a total of 17 home games this season — the most in school history.

The Salukis have a 522-184 (.740) record all-time at SIU Arena, which opened in 1964, including a 12-4 mark last season. The arena underwent a \$29.9 million renovation prior to the 2010-11 season.

Salukis take on Power Five foes

SIU plays at three Power Five opponents this year — Arkansas, Minnesota and Louisville. Prior to Monday's game at Arkansas, it had been more than three years since Southern Illinois last played a BCS program in men's basketball (at Missouri on Nov. 12, 2013). The last time the Salukis beat a BCS program was in 2008, when they defeated Oklahoma State in the first round of the NIT. Since that game, they have now lost eight straight.

Saluki turnaround

The Salukis won 22 games a year ago, the most wins since 2007. It was the program's first winning season since 2008. Three times last season, the Salukis rallied from double-digit deficits to win. They trailed Air Force (-15) before rallying to win, 77-75. They trailed at Sam Houston State (-18) before winning, 86-81, in OT. They trailed Illinois State (-12) before winning 81-78.

Road Warriors

The Salukis were 4-0 in non-conference road games last year, winning at Sam Houston State, North Texas, Murray State and Saint Louis. Prior to the loss at Arkansas, the Salukis had not lost a non-conference road game since falling at SEMO on Dec. 10, 2014. Hinson is 12-13 in non-conference road games at SIU.

Tyler Smithpeters climbing all-time 3-point list

G Tyler Smithpeters (6-4, 198, Sr.) ranks sixth all-time in career 3-point shooting percentage at SIU (.395). He is 20th overall in 3-pointers made (98). In his career, 69 percent of his shot attempts have come from 3-point range.

Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities... Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.



1967 NIT Champions

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

2002-08 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008. The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia. The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

Five at-large NCAA bids

Southern Illinois received four at-large NCAA bids in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He

was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them.

According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.
