Series vs. Minnesota

The teams have met twice before on neutral courts. Most recently, the Salukis beat Minnesota, 69-53, on Nov. 24, 2006 at the Old Spice Classic in Orlando, Florida. In that game, the Salukis forced 22 turnovers. When SIU pulled its starters from the contest with five minutes remaining, it led, 58-34. Matt Shaw scored a career-high 26 points.

The teams also met in Sacramento, California on March 18, 1994 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The Golden Gophers, prevailed, 74-60. SIU was led by Chris Lowery's 19 points.

Common Opponents

SIU and Minnesota have played two common opponents this season as part of the informally organized Golden Gopher Invitational. Minnesota beat Mount St. Mary's by 24, while SIU won by 10. Minnesota beat Arkansas by 14, while SIU lost to the Razorbacks by 25.

Salukis vs. the Big Ten Conference

The Salukis are 10-22 all-time against current members of the Big Ten Conference, including a 1-14 mark on the road. The lone road win came at Wisconsin in 1969.

Barry Hinson has a 1-2 record lifetime against the Big Ten, with two losses to Purdue and a win versus Wisconsin — all while coaching at Missouri State.

Offense among national leaders

The Salukis rank 88th in the nation in scoring (81.0), 28th in field goal percentage (51.2) and 32nd in 3-point shooting percentage (41.3) after five games.

Mike Rodriguez leads team in scoring, assists

PG Mike Rodriguez (5-10, 165, Sr.) has accounted for 31 percent of SIU's baskets this year, as the team's leader in scoring (14.6) and assists (231). He has a 1.92 assist-TO ratio. His ratio last year (1.88) was the ninth-best single-season mark in school history. Rodriguez scored a career-high 29 points in the opener against Wright State, nearly doubling his previous best of 15 versus Air Force on Nov. 13, 2015.

Sean O'Brien voted Preseason Second-Team All-MVC

F Sean O'Brien (6-7, 215, Sr.) is SIU's top returning scorer (12.1 points), rebounder (6.0 rebounds) and shot blocker (29 blocks). He was also second on the team in assists (63). The savvy veteran first cracked the lineup early in his freshman campaign, and has started 94 of the last 95 games, including a current streak of 72-consecutive starts.

Thik Bol among nation's top shot blockers

F Thik Bol (6-8, 205, Jr.) ranks 21st in the nation in blocked shots per game (2.8). He's coming off a career-high six blocks versus Mount St. Mary's. He also is tied for the team lead in rebounding.

Armon Fletcher with the hot hand

Armon Fletcher (6-4, 190, So.) is the team's top 3-point shooter so far, converting 12-of-22 (.545). He has made multiple 3-pointers in every game and is the only Saluki player to score double figures in all five games this season.

Senior leadership

The Salukis' senior class (Sean O'Brien, Leo Vincent, Mike Rodriguez, Tyler Smithpeters) has the most returning career points and rebounds of any school in the Missouri Valley Conference. In fact, 25 percent of the returning scoring in the MVC comes from SIU's four seniors.

Dawg Bites

- Minnesota starting C Reggie Lynch played four games against SIU while a member of Illinois State. His totals included 15-of-24 (.625) shooting, 43 points and 12 blocked shots.
- In the Salukis' three wins, they are a combined +84 in points scored in the paint. In the two losses, they are a combined -2.
- In the first three games, Sean O'Brien had 3 assists/13 TOs. In the last two games, he had 18 assists/6 TOs.
- O'Brien and Bol are co-leaders of the MVC in rebounding (9.0), which ranks 61st in the nation.
- The Salukis started 14-2 last season and did not lose their third game until Jan. 9, 2016 vs. Wichita State.

Salukis take on Power Five foes

SIU plays at three Power Five opponents this year — Arkansas, Minnesota and Louisville. Prior to the Nov. 14 game at Arkansas, it had been more than three years since Southern Illinois last played a BCS program in men's basketball (at Missouri on Nov. 12, 2013). The last time the Salukis beat a BCS program was in 2008, when they defeated Oklahoma State in the first round of the NIT. Since that game, they have now lost eight straight.

Saluki lineup features trio of junior college starters

Three Saluki starters (Mike Rodriguez, Leo Vincent and Thik Bol) came to SIU via the junior college route. The last time Southern started three juco players in a game was on Feb. 22, 2012 when Mamadou Seck, Jeff Early and T.J. Lindsay started at Drake.

School-record 17 home games at SIU Arena

Southern Illinois will host a school-record eight non-conference home games for a total of 17 home games this season — the most in school history. The Salukis have a 523-184 (.740) record all-time at SIU Arena, which opened in 1964, including a 12-4 mark last season. The arena underwent a \$29.9 million renovation prior to the 2010-11 season.

Tyler Smithpeters out 2-4 weeks

G Tyler Smithpeters (6-4, 198, Sr.) hurt his knee in the season opener against Wright State and is out 2-4 weeks. He ranks sixth all-time in career 3-point shooting percentage at SIU (.395). He is 20th overall in 3-pointers made (98). In his career, 69 percent of his shot attempts have come from 3-point range.

Saluki turnaround

The Salukis won 22 games a year ago, the most wins since 2007. It was the program's first winning season since 2008. Three times last season, the Salukis rallied from double-digit deficits to win. They trailed Air Force (-15) before rallying to win, 77-75. They trailed at Sam Houston State (-18) before winning, 86-81, in OT. They trailed Illinois State (-12) before winning 81-78.

1967 NIT Champions

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

2002-08 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008. The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia. The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

Five at-large NCAA bids

Southern Illinois received four at-large NCAA bids in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech,

but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.
