Southern Illinois (11-15, 4-11) at Creighton (21-6, 10-5)

Salukis have won two in a row and three of last four

Until last week, the last time SIU recorded back-to-back conference wins was when it beat Illinois State and Bradley on Jan. 1 and 4, 2012 — a span of 29 games. The last time it had won three out of four MVC games was at the start of the 2011 season.

Saluki defense improving

In its first 11 MVC games, SIU allowed opponents to shoot 50 percent from the field and 43 percent from 3-point. In the last four games, those numbers dropped to 44 and 37 percent, respectively.

The Salukis held Missouri State scoreless for a 4:54 stretch to open Saturday's game and held Evansville scoreless for 8:16 during a stretch of the second half last Wednesday.

Breaking the 65-point plateau

SIU has not surpassed the 65-point plateau on offense since scoring 66 at Bradley on Jan. 15 — a span of nine games. The last time Southern went nine-straight games without topping 65 points was during the 1948-49 season. The 1946-47 team went 11-straight games below the mark.

Road losing streak

SIU has a 14-game losing streak in road conference games. The last Valley road win came at Bradley on Jan. 4, 2012. The longest MVC road losing streak in school history is 15 games from 1982-84.

Recapping the last meeting

Creighton shot 63 percent from the field, including 12-of-20 from 3-point range, to beat SIU in Carbondale, 81-51, on Jan. 27. The Salukis suffered the third-worst defeat in arena history and by the largest margin since falling by 33 points to Saint Louis in 1989.

Trending

SIU shot 51 percent from the field against Missouri State on Saturday — the first time it topped the 50 percent mark at home since the opener vs. Benedictine-Springfield...G T.J. Lindsay (6-3, 169, Sr.) is 9-for-18 from 3-point range in the last six games...G Jalen Pendleton (6-2, 201, Fr.) is averaging 10.3 ppg in the last four games...The Salukis attempted a season-low 43 shots Saturday against Missouri State. It was the fewest shots attempted by a Saluki team since taking 39 versus Saint Louis last season.

Veteran starting lineup

In SIU's current starting lineup, four players are age 22 or older — Jeff Early (24), T.J. Lindsay (22), Desmar Jackson (22) and Kendal Brown-Surles (22). Early is the oldest player in the MVC. Dantiel Daniels is 20.

Beane ranks second in scoring MVC freshmen

G Anthony Beane (6-2, 171, Fr.) averages 9.5 points per game, third-best on the team and second among freshmen in the MVC. He has scored double figures in seven conference games. Beane originally committed to Illinois State, but came with his father to SIU.

Desmar Jackson a stat-sheet stuffer

Desmar Jackson (6-5, 173, Jr.) leads the team in scoring (15.4ppg), steals (48) and 3-pointers (33). He is second in rebounding (5.6 rpg).

Jackson reeled off three-consecutive 20-point games at Wichita State (28), versus Indiana State (29) and at Bradley (21). The last Saluki to score 20+ in three consecutive games was Kent Williams, who posted four-straight in Nov./Dec. of 2001 versus Illinois (23), UIC (21), Indiana (22) and George Mason (26).

Jeff Early second in nation in rebounding among under 6-foot-1

F Jeff Early (6-1, 187, Sr.) is second in the nation in rebounding (7.3 rpg) among players who stand 6-foot-1 and under. Evansville 6-foot guard Troy Taylor (7.4 rpg) is the leader. He has seven double-doubles on the season. Although he stands 6-foot-1, Early technically plays the hybrid "4" spot.

Jalen Pendleton named MVC Newcomer of the Week

G Jalen Pendleton (6-2, 201, Fr.) was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Feb. 11. The Evansville native averaged 12.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in a win over Wichita State and loss to Indiana State. He scored the final six points in the two-point win over the Shockers. At ISU, he scored a career-high 17 points. He was 9-of-13 from the field and 6-of-6 from the FT line on the week.

Tougher road in MVC play

With a non-conference strength of schedule of 296, the Salukis have found a tougher road in conference play, as seen in a comparison of non-conference versus conference stats.

Salukis post first win over ranked team since 2008

When the Salukis beat No. 22-ranked Wichita State on Feb. 4, it marked their first win over a ranked team since beating No. 15

Drake in 2008. SIU had lost nine-straight games to ranked teams since that time.

KBS is active scoring, assists leader

G Kendal Brown-Surles (5-9, 175, Sr.) is the active leader in scoring and assists at SIU with 695 career points and 266 assists during his four-year, 112-game career. He has made 64 career starts, more than any other player on the team. KBS ranks 16th in career assists at SIU.

Salukis surpass 2011-12 win total

The Salukis surpassed last year's overall win total of eight games. However, they still trail last year's conference win total of five games.

No starter taller than 6-foot-5

The Salukis have no starters and only one active player taller than 6-foot-5 (forward Davante Drinkard is 6-9).

Dantiel Daniels second in MVC in field goal percentage

It's been an injury-plagued season for F Dantiel Daniels (6-5, 230, So.), who has missed all or part of five games, but he is second in the MVC in field goal percentage (.613). He is also 10th in the league in blocked shots (0.9 bpg). Last year, he led the MVC in blocked shots (1.6) and was named to the MVC's All-Freshman team.

Salukis 2-8 without Daniels

In the last two seasons, Saluki F Dantiel Daniels has missed part or all of 10 games with injuries. SIU is 2-8 in those games, with its only wins coming at Chicago State and New Orleans.

Points off turnovers

One of the reasons why Southern is shooting better this year (.445) compared to last (.414) is its ability to score off of opponent turnovers. The Salukis are +5.3 in points off turnovers, out-scoring opponents 447-309.

Josh Swan out for remainder of season

Josh Swan (6-2, 181, So.) is out for the season with a knee injury. He made 24-of-47 (.511) shots from the field in conference games after going 10-for-29 (.345) in non-conference games.

2002-07 — Seven-Straight Postseason Bids

Southern Illinois advanced to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07, including two Sweet 16s (2002, 2007). They added an NIT appearance in 2008.

The 2002 Sweet 16 was a major breakthrough for the program. The team finished the season ranked No. 22 in the nation and won a school-best 28 games. Its biggest wins were against No. 22 Indiana, Texas Tech and No. 23 Georgia.

The Salukis were no underdog during their 2007 Sweet 16 run. Seeded No. 4 in the West Region, SIU beat Holy Cross and Virginia Tech before falling to top-seeded Kansas in a 61-58 heartbreaker. The team won 29 games, defeated five NCAA Tournament qualifiers and finished with its highest national ranking in school history (No. 11).

Two-year drought in double-figure scoring

The Salukis did not have a guard average double figures in scoring in each of the last two years. The last double-figure scoring guard at SIU was Kevin Dillard, who averaged 12.3 points in the 2009-10 season.

Simultaneous double-doubles

Desmar Jackson (6-5, 173, Jr.) and Jeff Early (6-1, 187, Sr.) have each recorded double-doubles in the same game (at SIUE and vs. Nicholls State) twice this year. Prior to this season, the last time two Salukis recorded a double-double in the same game was on Feb. 23, 2002, when both Jermaine Dearman and Rolan Roberts posted double-doubles at Indiana State.

Salukis snap losing streaks

By winning their season opener, the Salukis broke two losing streaks dating back to last year. SIU entered the game at New Orleans having lost seven-straight games overall and eight-straight on the road. The 17-point victory over UNO was the largest road margin since SIU won at SEMO by 21 points on Dec. 9, 2009 — a span of 35 road games.

Barry Hinson is 13th head coach in school history

Barry Hinson is the 13th head coach in 99 years of Saluki Basketball. He spent the past four years on Bill Self's staff at the University of Kansas. In that time KU posted a combined 106-20 record.

At home versus MVC

During six seasons from 2001-02 through the 2007-08 campaign, SIU posted a 62-2 record against MVC opponents on its home court. The last four+ seasons, however, the Salukis are 16-23 in league home games.

Transfer U

The downward trend in Saluki Basketball in recent years corresponded with the transfer of numerous key players to other successful programs. Former Salukis Brandon Wood (Michigan State) and Anthony Booker (Iowa State) helped lead their teams to the NCAA Tournament last year. Former Salukis Kevin Dillard (Dayton) and Gene Teague (Seton Hall) are currently among the leading scorers on their respective teams this year. Former Salukis Treg Setty (Ohio) and Harry Whitt (Utah) are sitting out this season after transferring during the off-season.

Four-year gap in postseason honors

The last time a Saluki player was named to the All-Conference team was 2008 (Randal Falker-1st, Bryan

20-loss seasons

In the 99-year history of the program, SIU has had three 20-loss seasons (1981, 1986, 2012). The 1981 and 1986 teams lost 20 each, while the 2012 team lost a school-record 23.

Hinson familiar with the MVC

Hinson was the head coach at MVC member Missouri State for nine seasons (2000-08). While at Missouri State, he guided the Bears to a 169-117 record (.591) with postseason NIT teams in 2000, 2005, 2006 and 2007.

Taylor returns

G Diamond Taylor (6-4, 173, Jr.) has played four games this semester after being suspended for the first semester.

Mullins-2nd). It is the longest period without a player on the First or Second team in school history.

NIT Championship in 1967

The Salukis won the NIT in 1967 behind future NBA stars Frazier and Dick Garrett. In addition to beating Marquette for the title, some of the prestigious victories of that season included an upset of No. 2 Louisville, as well as Duke at Madison Square Garden. At that time, the NIT was almost on par with the NCAA Tournament. The NCAA field that season featured 23 teams, while the NIT invited 14 teams.

True freshmen Bola Olaniyan and Chase Heins to redshirt

Coach Hinson said true freshmen forwards Bola Olaniyan (6-8, 219, Fr.) and Chase Heins (6-6, 264, Fr.) will both redshirt this season. Olaniyan must redshirt due to NCAA transcript guidelines, while Heins had surgery for a leg injury.

Five at-large NCAA bids

At-large bids to the NCAA Tournament are hardly uncommon for Southern Illinois, which received four in a row from 2002-05 and one more in 2007.

Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities... Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.

Salukis In the NBA

Saluki alum and Carbondale native Troy Hudson recently retired after completing 12 seasons in the NBA, including stops with the Orlando Magic and Minnesota Timberwolves. Other former Salukis who have played in the NBA are Charlie Vaughn (St. Louis, Detroit), Walt Frazier (New York, Cleveland), and Mike Glenn (New York, Atlanta, Milwaukee), Dick Garrett (Los Angeles, Buffalo) Chris Carr (Phoenix, Minnesota, Chicago, Boston), Joe C. Meriweather (New York, Kansas City) and Nate Hawthorne (L.A. and Phoenix).
