The Basics: The University of Northern Iowa football program will host the Southern Illinois Salukis on Saturday, Oct. 1 for its annual Homecoming game. The game is set to start at 4 p.m. CT.

About the Salukis: The Salukis have started the season 2-1 overall with their only loss coming against Florida Atlantic (L, 38-30) to open the season. SIU finished ninth in the Valley in 2015, but returned 14 starters in 2016. Southern Illinois brings a highpowered offense to the UNI-Dome, entering the game ranked No. 11 in the FCS. They are led by running back Daquan Isom, who ranks No. 13 in the country in rushing yards per carry (6.68).

Five Facts:

- UNI enters the game against Southern Illinois ranked No. 12 in all three polls.
- Karter Schult is now the all-time leader in career tackles for loss at UNI.
- Karter Schult earned Hero Sports Player of the Week honors for his performance at Eastern Washington (9/17).
- Head Coach Mark Farley earned his 130th career win against Iowa State (9/3), making him the all-time wins leader in program history.
- UNI welcomed the sixth-best recruiting class to campus this summer, ranked by Hero Sports.

MARK FARLEY
Head Coach (16th Year)

Record: 130-63
Alma Mater: UNI, 1986

UNI head coach Mark Farley, once known as the “walk on from Waukon”, has led the Panthers to a mark of 130-63 in his 15 years at the helm of the program, becoming the UNI all-time wins leader with his win over Iowa State on Sept. 3. Entering his 16th season as the head coach of the Northern Iowa Panthers, Farley is set to hit the ground running.

In Missouri Valley Football Conference play, Farley has guided the Panthers to a record of 78-34 for an impressive .696 winning percentage in league play. Farley is the MVFC’s all-time coaching wins leader with 78 league victories.

Included in that 15-year run for Farley and the Panthers are seven conference championships, nine playoff appearances, 12 top-25 final rankings, three national semifinal appearances and one national title game appearance in 2005. Farley holds the UNI record for postseason coaching victories with 13 with an overall playoff record of 13-9.

Through his leadership, the Panthers have returned to the glory days when they won seven straight conference titles and made seven consecutive FCS playoff appearances in the decade of the '90s. In Farley's 15 years at the helm, UNI has won at least a share of seven Missouri Valley Football Conference titles. UNI has also advanced to the quarterfinals (2003, 2007, 2011, 2015), semifinals (2001, 2008) and the national title game (2005) in seven of those nine playoff appearances. Twelve of Farley's 15 previous Panther teams have finished the season ranked in the top-25, defeating 79 top-25 ranked foes in the process.

Last Time Against Southern Illinois: The Panthers and the Salukis faced off last season for senior day on Nov. 21, 2015. UNI came away with a 49-28 win over Southern Illinois. Tyvis Smith rushed for 161 yds and a touchdown while Aaron Bailey threw for 181 yards and two touchdowns.

Homecoming: Since 1920, UNI has recorded a mark of 63-26-7 in Homecoming games. The Panthers have won 22 of their last 28 Homecoming contests in the UNI-Dome.

Conference Play: UNI currently holds a 150-56 overall record in the MVFC and 78-34 record during the Farley era. Farley's 78 league wins is the most by a head coach in Missouri Valley Football Conference history.

Conference Openers: UNI is 20-11 in MVFC openers since the league started in 1985. The Panthers are also 9-6 in conference openers under the direction of head coach Mark Farley.

Going the Distance: Senior Matt Easley scored a career-long 49-yard field goal late in the fourth quarter against Eastern Washington (9/17).

Quick Impact: In just his second season with the Panthers, Aaron Bailey has moved into a tie for No. 10 all-time at UNI in career rushing touchdowns, giving him a total of 22. He is tied with Pat Grace, who had 22 rushing touchdowns from 2006-09. The senior finished with two rushing touchdowns against Eastern Washington (9/17), marking the sixth time in his career at UNI that he has had multiple rushing scores in a game.

Record Breaking: Karter Schult became the UNI record holder for career tackles for loss with his 3.5 against the Eagles (9/17). He now has 44 total, passing James Ruffin who had 43 from 2005-09. The Tripoli, Iowa native has 12 TFL through just three games, the fastest start for any Panther in the Mark Farley era. The closest TFL number through three games in Collin Albrecht in 2012, who had six through the first three weeks of the season.

Jack of All Trades: Most football fans know defensive linemen for their sacks and tackles at the line of scrimmage, but Karter Schult has shown that with his size and speed, he can defend at all angles and all spots on the field. The senior lineman notched his first-career interception against Eastern Washington (9/17), returning it for 20 yards.

The Streak Continues: A.J. Allen has now either tied or set a new career-high in tackles for three consecutive weeks. The sophomore finished with 12 against Eastern Washington (9/17), surpassing his seven he set against Montana. His 12 tackles was a team-high.

Dual Threat: Michael Malloy has been an offensive threat for the Panthers since last season, taking snaps at wide receiver, running back and even fullback. He has started two games at wide receiver this season and added to his resume a career-long rushing touchdown at Eastern Washington (9/17). The senior scored a 30-yard rushing touchdown against the Eagles, his longest rush and longest rushing touchdown at UNI.

Strength in Numbers: The UNI defense has been ranked in the top-30 in the FCS in rushing defense in three consecutive seasons. In 2016 through the first three games, UNI is ranked No. 5 in the FCS and No. 1 in the Valley, holding opponents to an average of 67 yards on the ground. UNI has held its opponent to under 200 yards rushing for six consecutive games, dating back to Nov. 28, UNI's 53-17 win over Eastern Illinois in the first round of the playoffs.

Breaking the Line: Karter Schult tied the school record for tackles for loss in a game against No. 14 Montana (9/10), recording 5.5 to match John Hermann who had 5.5 against Northern Arizona in 2005. He finished the game with a career-high tying 10 tackles along with two sacks

Best in the FCS: Karter Schult has racked up 12 tackles for loss in the first three games, ranking him No. 1 in the country in tackles for loss. He has also brought down an average of 2.17 sacks per game, putting him at No. 1 in the FCS in total sacks.

Rushing Game: In the first two weeks of the season, the Panthers had a 100-yard rushing performance in each game. Against Iowa State (9/3), Aaron Bailey turned in 114 yards while against No. 14 Montana (9/10), Tyvis Smith posted 130 yards, averaging 6.5 yards per carry. UNI is averaging 194.5 yards per game, ranking them No. 33 in the FCS.

Success Comes in Threes: Prior to UNI's win over Iowa State (9/3), the last time UNI opened the season with a road win over an FBS opponent was in 2013 when UNI defeated the Cyclones, 28-20. UNI has now won three of the last six meetings between the Panthers and the Cyclones.

Multi-Talented: Charles Brown, who played wide receiver for the Panthers the last two seasons, started at cornerback at Iowa State (9/3), racking up three tackles and a key interception.
