AROUND THE HORN

- » Southern Illinois visits MVC-leading Missouri State for the final road series of the regular season.
- » SIU lost all four games against Missouri State last season, but the Salukis swept a three-game series at MSU in 2016.
- » Since the MVC started playing three-game series (instead of four-game series) in 2005, the Salukis are 11-9 against Missouri State in games played in Springfield, Mo.
- » In MVC play, Missouri State (2.98) and Southern Illinois (3.62) have the league's top-two team ERAs.
- » In his last five starts (including road starts at Dallas Baptist and Tennessee Tech), Michael Baird has a 1.25 ERA in 36 innings. On the season, Baird's 2.84 ERA leads the league among all pitchers with at least 50 innings (Baird has pitched 82.1 innings).
- » Ryan Netemeyer has 37 career saves, which is second all-time in MVC history, passing Missouri State's Bryan Young (2014-17).
- » Logan Blackfan had his 21-game hitting streak snapped at Evansville, the longest for an SIU player since Chris Serritella had a 24-game hitting streak in 2012.
- » Blackfan's 21-game hitting streak is tied for the fourth-longest hitting streak in SIU history.
- » Connor Kopach was named to the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award, given to the nation's top shortstop.
- » Alex Lyon has earned MVC Player of the Week twice this season. Most recently, Lyon was 7-for-14 with two doubles, a triple, 5 RBIs and four stolen bases two weeks ago in SIU's sweep at Evansville to earn the honor.
- » Nikola Vasic has reached base in 44 of the last 46 games. He had a 27-game reached base streak snapped against Valpo, but he followed that up by reaching base in 17-straight games, a streak that was snapped Sunday vs. Indiana State.
- » SIU ranks fourth nationally in stolen bases with 111.
- » Among active players, Connor Kopach ranks second nationally in career stolen bases (77), and Logan Blackfan ranks third in career doubles (66).

Introduction to 2018 Saluki Baseball...

- » The Salukis were picked fourth in the preseason MVC poll of head coaches. Starting pitcher Michael Baird, closer Ryan Netemeyer, and shortstop Connor Kopach were all named preseason All-MVC.
- » SIU returns two position starters, two starting pitchers, and its closer from 2017.
- » Netemeyer and Kopach were honorable mention All-MVC selections in 2017. Kopach was also named to the MVC All-Defensive team.
- » Senior closer Ryan Netemeyer was a semifinalist for both NCBWA Stopper of the Year and National Pitcher of the Year in 2017.
- » Southern Illinois stole 100 bases in 2017 after only swiping 38 bags in 2016. Southern's 100 stolen bases led the MVC by 42 and ranked 14th nationally. It marked the most stolen bases for SIU since taking 109 bags in 1991.

SALUKIS TRAVEL TO VALLEY- LEADING MISSOURI STATE

- » Southern Illinois visits MVC-leading Missouri State for the final road series of the regular season.
- » Missouri State leads the all-time series, 70-38.
- » SIU lost all four games against Missouri State last season, but the Salukis swept a three-game series at MSU in 2016.
- » Since the MVC started playing three-game series (instead of four-game series) in 2005, the Salukis are 11-9 against Missouri State in games played in Springfield, Mo.
- » In MVC play, Missouri State (2.98) and Southern Illinois (3.62) have the league's top-two team ERAs.

BAIRD WRAPPING UP STELLAR CAREER

- » SIU senior Michael Baird will make his 43rd career start on Friday night, fourth-most in SIU history. Assuming two additional starts (vs. Bradley and MVC Tournament), Baird will finish with the second-most starts in school history.
- » In his 42 starts, Baird has thrown 27 "quality starts" -- allowing three or fewer earned runs in six or more innings. He has eight quality starts this season.
- » Baird pitched a complete-game shutout at Evansville with a career-high 12 strikeouts.
- » Baird had two tough outings this season -- the season opener at Jacksonville State and vs. No. 24 Illinois.
 - » In his other 10 starts, Baird has a 1.75 ERA in 72 innings with 67 strikeouts against just 13 walks.
- » In his last five starts (including road starts at Dallas Baptist and Tennessee Tech), Michael Baird has a 1.25 ERA in 36 innings.
- » On the season, Baird's 2.84 ERA leads the league among all pitchers with at least 50 innings (Baird has pitched 82.1 innings).

RUN WITH US

- » SIU has stolen 111 bases through 48 games, which ranks fourth nationally. Already, SIU has stolen the fourth-most bases in SIU history and the most since 1981.

- » Since the start of the 2017 season, SIU has 211 stolen bases. Missouri State is second in the MVC during that span with 109.
- » SIU was just 4-for-8 stealing last week against Indiana State, which leads the MVC in fewest steals allowed. In the previous 35 games, SIU was 86-for-100 stealing bases.
- » Connor Kopach and Alex Lyon are tied for the MVC lead with 26 stolen bases this year, which ranks 14th nationally.
- » Alex Lyon tied an SIU single-game record with four stolen bases against Austin Peay. Kopach also holds that record, having stolen four bases against Tennessee Tech last year.
- » Four of the top six base stealers in the MVC are Salukis: Kopach and Lyon (26) are tied for first, Nikola Vasic (17) is fifth and Addison Fugitt (15)

is sixth.

ACTIVE STREAKS & NOTES

- » Nikola Vasic has reached base in 44 of the last 46 games. He had a 27-game reached base streak snapped against Valpo, but he followed that up by reaching base in 17-straight games, a streak that was snapped Sunday vs. Indiana State.
 - » Logan Blackfan had a 21-game hitting streak snapped last weekend at Evansville, the longest for an SIU player since Chris Serritella had a 24-game streak in 2012.
 - » Blackfan's hitting streak was the fourth-longest fourth-longest in SIU history.
 - » Since March 5, SIU is 21-7 against unranked teams.
 - » SIU has turned 41 double plays this year, which leads the league. The Salukis are on pace to lead the league in turning double plays for the fifth time in the last six seasons.
 - » SIU has committed at least one error in 12-straight games.
 - » Since dropping a 9-8 heartbreaker at Dallas Baptist on April 14, SIU's offense has struggled...
 - » Before (34G): .286 (333-1164) / 225 runs (6.6 rpg) / .374 ob% / .412 slg%
 - » After (14G): .217 (97-446) / 51 runs (3.6 rpg) / .309 ob% / .318 slg%
- SALUKI SENIORS AMONG ACTIVE LEADERS IN NCAA DIVISION I**
- » Four SIU seniors -- Michael Baird, Logan Blackfan, Connor Kopach and Ryan Netemeyer -- have been among the best in the country at their respective roles for the duration of their careers. Among active Division I players...
 - » Michael Baird ranks 5th in innings pitched.
 - » Logan Blackfan ranks 3rd in doubles and 19th in RBIs.
 - » Connor Kopach ranks 2nd in stolen bases and fourth in triples.
 - » Ryan Netemeyer ranks 2nd in saves.
 - » Kopach and Blackfan also rank among the national leaders in career games (12th / 22nd) and at-bats (12th / 21st).

- » SIU's pitching has also excelled in free-base rate, allowing only 4.2 free passes per game.
- » Last year, SIU allowed 5.5 free passes per game. This year's pitching staff is on pace to allow about 75 fewer free base runners than

- » In 2017, SIU took about 1.2 fewer free bases per game than it gave away. This year, SIU is taking 0.8 more free bases than opponents -- a 2.0 runners-per-game swing.

HOW ESPN+ AFFECTS SALUKI BASEBALL

- » Disney announced the addition of "ESPN+" -- a streaming service that was integrated into the ESPN app on April 12.
- » ESPN+ costs \$4.99 per month.
- » As part of the Missouri Valley Conference's agreement with ESPN, several Saluki Athletics events will be made exclusive to ESPN+.
- » In the future, SIU games will be noted as "ESPN3" or "ESPN+." Both are available through the ESPN app.
 - » ESPN3 games remain free on the ESPN app with a conventional cable or satellite subscription that includes ESPN.
 - » ESPN+ games require an additional subscription of \$4.99 per month.
- » In 2018, the following SIU baseball games will be on ESPN+.
 - » May 11-12 at Missouri State
 - » All games in the 2018 MVC Tournament

HARRISON'S DOMINANT STRETCH

- » Southern Illinois lefty Brad Harrison started the year as SIU's mid-week starter. Harrison earned a spot in the weekend rotation with a 1.12 ERA over four mid-week starts.
- » Harrison has earned the MVC Pitcher of the Week award three times this year. He pitched a two-hit shutout at Belmont (Feb. 27) and followed that up with eight shutout innings at SEMO (March 6). He struck out 11 in seven shutout innings against Valpo (April 8).
- » Earlier in the year, Harrison had a 19-inning scoreless streak that spanned four starts.

AWARDS SEASON

- » Michael Baird (starting pitcher), Connor Kopach (second base) and Ryan Netemeyer (relief pitcher) were all named preseason All-MVC.
- » Netemeyer also earned a spot on the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List.
- » Ryan Netemeyer was one of 21 semifinalists for the National Pitcher of the Year in 2017, presented by the College Baseball Foundation.
- » Netemeyer was also a semifinalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year award, presented to the nation's top closer.
 - » Netemeyer finished the 2017 season ranked sixth in the NCAA with 15 saves.
- » Baird was first-team All-MVC in 2016, his sophomore season, after leading the league in ERA (1.76)
- » Logan Blackfan was first-team All-MVC in 2016, his soph. season, after leading the league in doubles (23).

- » Logan Blackfan has 66 career doubles, a school record.
- » Blackfan led the MVC with 23 doubles in 2016 as a sophomore after hitting 19 doubles as a freshman in 2015.
- » Ryan Netemeyer had a school-record 15 saves in 2017, breaking Al Levine's mark of 13 saves in 1990.
- » Two of the top three single-season saves mark are by Netemeyer. He had 15 saves in 2017 and 12 saves in 2016.
- » Netemeyer's 37 career saves...

- » Are an SIU career record (broke record held by Bryant George (2007-10) -- 30 saves.)
- » Rank third among active players in Division I
- » Are second in MVC history
- » Connor Kopach stole 33 bases in 2017, the most for any Saluki since Bob Geary stole 34 in 1991.
- » Kopach tied an SIU single-game record with four stolen bases against Tennessee Tech (4/23/17).
- » Lyon tied that single-game steals record with four steals against Austin Peay (4/4/18).

COACH HENDU QUOTABLES

- » Quotes on the 2018 Salukis by SIU head coach Ken Henderson, taken from the 2018 season preview:
- » *On the expectations heading into the season...* "This group of guys takes care of business and practices extremely hard. We're a very fast club, the fastest club I think I've coached in 34 years. I think that leads to an exciting brand of baseball. We will fly around the park, steal some bases, and move the baseball offensively. Our pitching staff should throw a lot of strikes and allow our outstanding defense to make plays behind them."
- » *On the pitching ...* "We feel really good about the front and the back ends of staff with Michael Baird and Ryan Netemeyer. The big question mark is who will step up to fill those other starting roles. Overall, this staff has much more quality depth than in past years."
- » *On the infield...* "Infield play should once again be a strength for us, especially with more depth and flexibility than in years past. Connor Kopach is an outstanding defender and should have no issues sliding over to shortstop. Logan Blackfan has anchored first base for three years and is a really good glove guy."
- » *On the outfield...* "This is one area that could be really exciting due to the athleticism we will put out there. Crawford and Fugitt are both really physical and extremely fast and can play all three outfield spots. Moving Lyon to left field allows us to get another plus runner out there and a quality bat in the lineup. Kengott has the best arm and most pop of all the outfielders and could eventually be a middle of the order bat."

FUN FAST FACTS

- » Saluki Baseball has led the MVC in turning double plays in four of the last five seasons.
- » Mike Reis is entering his 39th years as the Voice of the Salukis. He is the fifth-longest tenured play-by-play voice in college baseball. Dave Nitz (Louisiana Tech) is in his 44th year. Jim Ellis (Miss. St.), David Kellum (Ole Miss), and John Cox (Southern Miss) are all in their 40th season.
- » Brad Harrison and Trey McDaniel combined to throw a 1-hit shutout at SEMO on March 6 -- the first multiple-pitcher 1-hitter for SIU since 2008 vs. Illinois. SIU has lost eight-straight extra-inning games. (0-5 in 2017 // 0-3 in 2018).

2017 RECAP

- » Southern Illinois went 27-30 in 2017. The Salukis finished the Missouri Valley Conference season 10-10, which was fourth in the eight-team league.
- » SIU finished in the top-half of the MVC for a second-straight season. If Southern finishes in the top half again this season, it will be the first time the program has finished in the top half three-straight seasons since 2002-05 (when now-associate head coach P.J. Finigan was a player).
- » Closer Ryan Netemeyer set a program single-season record with 15 saves.
- » During the spring of 2017, the Salukis set a program record with a 3.337 team-wide GPA.
- » After the 2017 season, five players earned All-MVC honors. Connor Kopach and Ryan Netemeyer were honorable mention selections that return for 2018. Kopach also earned a spot on the MVC All-Defensive team.
- » After the season, four SIU players were taken in the 2017 MLB Draft, the most for the program since 1990.

SALUKI BASEBALL: A RICH HISTORY

- » Southern Illinois has made five College World Series appearances, finishing second in the nation twice (1968, 71) and third twice (1974, 1977)
- » SIU has produced 24 Major Leaguers. Some notable MLB Salukis include Steve Finley, Duane Kuiper, Dave Steib, Jerry Hairston Jr., Al Levine, Jason Frasor and Jim Dwyer.
- » The Dan Callahan MVC Baseball Coach of the Year award is the only Valley coaching award in any sport named after a former coach. Callahan coached SIU from 1994-2010, amassing 595 wins.
