SOUTHERN ILLINOIS NOTES

All-Time vs. the Skyhawks

- SIU trails UT Martin, 9-11, in the all-time series that dates back to 1973.
- The two teams last met on Nov. 9, 2018, with the Skyhawks earning the 95-94 victory at Elam Fieldhouse.
- The home team has won each of the last three meetings.
- Southern's last win over UT Martin came at home- an 82-74 win on Nov. 10, 2017.
- The Skyhawks have been to either the NCAA Tournament or the WNIT in seven of the past nine seasons.

Last time they met - 11/9/18 (95-94 UT Martin win)

- The Salukis found themselves down 65-45 with 7:07 to play in the third quarter, but Southern went on a furious 29-7 run over the next nine minutes to take its first lead of the second half, 74-72 with 8:08 to play in regulation.
- Southern took its largest lead of the fourth quarter, 84-79 with 3:36 to play but the Skyhawks answered with an 11-0 run to build a six-point advantage to effectively seal the win.
- Makenzie Silvey scored a career-high 29 points in the loss while Abby Brockmeyer added 20 points and 11 rebounds.
- Silvey is averaging 22.0 points per game in two career games against the Skyhawks, while Brockmeyer is averaging 14.5 points/9.0 rebounds in two career meetings with UT Martin. Nicole Martin comes into her fourth career matchup averaging 8.0 points and 6.3 rebounds against the Skyhawks.

SIU vs. the Ohio Valley Conference

- The Salukis are 2-0 this season against Ohio Valley Conference opponents and have won five-straight over OVC programs.
- In 187 lifetime meetings against OVC schools, the Salukis sport a .721 winning percentage (135-52).

Stein vs. the OVC

- Cindy Stein is 29-12 all-time against OVC schools during her 21 seasons as a head coach.
- Stein sports a .500 or better career record against six OVC schools and a 3-4 record versus UT Martin.

Off to a good start

- With SIU's win over St. Louis, the Salukis improved to 4-2 on the season, which matched the best start through six games during Cindy Stein's seven seasons as head coach.
- It is the best start for the Salukis since the 2014-15 season, when SIU also went 4-2 and finished with a 7-4 non-conference record.

December to remember

- SIU went 4-0 last season in the month of December- which marked just the third perfect December in school history and first since 1987.
- Southern has won six-straight December games dating back to the 2017-18 season.

Getting to the basket

- Through six games, SIU leads the Valley, and ranks 14th nationally in field goal percentage (47.5%).
- SIU shot 55% from the field in its win at Eastern Michigan- which marked

the third time already this season that Southern has shot 50% or better from the floor. SIU's three games shooting 50% or higher is as many as it had during the entire 2018-19 season.

- Southern is 14-6 under seventh-year head coach Cindy Stein when making at least half of its shot attempts.

- Since 1988, SIU holds an .811% (86-20) winning percentage when shooting 50% or better.

- The Salukis won 18-straight games when shooting 50% or better from 1993 through 1997.

Upping its average

- The Salukis currently rank third in the Valley, and 35th in the nation, with a 78.2 points per game average.

- Southern scored 85 points in its win over Eastern Michigan, and it marked the fourth time in six games that SIU has scored 75 or more points in a game.

- Southern is doing so by ranking in the top-25 nationally of both field goal and three-point field goal percentage. SIU ranks 22nd nationally in 3-point FG percentage at 38.5-percent.

Protecting the Rock

- Southern ranks second in the Valley,

and 34th nationally, in fewest turnovers with 83.

- SIU's 13.8 turnovers per game are second to Loyola (12.8) in the Valley.

Points per 100 possessions

- Southern is averaging 108.6 points per 100 possessions- the best average in the Valley and 18th-best in the nation.

- SIU is doing so thanks to a .92 points per play average- the best average in the MVC and 22nd-best in the nation.

Leading the league

- Makenzie Silvey scored 14 points in SIU's win over St. Louis on Wednesday on 42-percent (6-of-14) shooting- which marked the 16th-straight game (dating back to last season) in which she has reached double figures.

- The Glen Carbon, Ill. native is averaging 20.3 points per game- which leads the Valley and ranks 18th nationally.

- Silvey became just the 30th player in program history to record back-to-back 20-point efforts and the first to do so since Nicole Martin in 2018 earlier this season.

- She also became the 34th Saluki to score 850-plus points in a career and

is 23 points shy of 900 for her career.

Martin leads the way

- Nicole Martin scored a team-high 18 points in SIU's win against St. Louis.

- Martin's 1,130 career points are the 21st-most in school history. She needs five points to crack the top-20 in program history.

1000 Point Watch

- The Salukis have a pair of juniors, Makenzie Silvey and Abby Brockmeyer, who are approaching the 1,000-point milestone.

- Silvey sits at 877 career points while

Brockmeyer scored her 700th career point in the win over St. Louis and currently has 703 career points.

Exclusive Club

- Abby Brockmeyer led the Salukis with a season-high 11 rebounds in the win over the Billikens on Wednesday, which marked the second time this season, and 19th time in her career, that she has snagged double-digit boards.
- Her 11th rebound against St. Louis was also her 500th career rebound.
- The junior forward is just the 7th player in program history, and first since Kylie Giebelhausen, to record 700 career points/500 rebounds/75 assists/75 blocks and 50 steals in a career.

Moving on up

- Brittney Patrick has 282 career assists- which is the 14th-most in a career in program history. She is nine assists shy of passing Sue Faber for 13th place. With 18 assists, she would become just the 13th Saluki to dish out 300 assists in a career.
- Patrick is also two steals shy of becoming the 30th player in school history to reach the century mark in career steals and would be just the 16th player with 250-plus assists and 100 steals.

All four of SIU's wins this season have come when the Salukis:

- Out-rebound their opponent
- Make more three-pointers than their opponent.

- Lead at the half
- Lead after the third quarter
- Hold their opponent to 70 points or less

Putting teams to bed

- The Salukis beat the Eastern Michigan Eagles by 31 despite trailing by two at the end of the first quarter.
- It marked the second time in the last five games SIU has defeated its opponent by 30 points or better. That's as many 30-point plus wins as the previous four seasons combined.

Most points in a second quarter

- SIU's 28 second quarter points in its win over Eastern Michigan were the most scored in a second quarter by the Salukis since the NCAA switched to quarters prior to the 2015-16 season.
- The school record for points in any quarter is 38- set in the third quarter of SIU's 102-63 win over Morehead State on Dec. 12, 2015.

First time in a while

- SIU's win over St. Louis last Wednesday marked the program's first win over the Billikens since 2008.

Double-double

- Abby Brockmeyer recorded her first double-double of the season (17pts/10 rebs) against Memphis.
- In doing so, Brockmeyer became just the ninth Saluki with at least 15 career double-doubles.

CINDY STEIN

Head Coach • Seventh Season

Cindy Stein enters her seventh season as the head coach of the Salukis in 2018-19. She was named the 10th head coach in Southern Illinois women's basketball history on April 3, 2013. A proven winner and a former NCAA Division II Coach of the Year, Stein has made an immediate impact at SIU much like she has in each of her previous head coaching stints.

At Southern Illinois 2018-19 (15-15, 8-10 MVC)

The 2018-19 season was yet another winning season for the Salukis under Stein. The Salukis posted a winning record in non-conference play for the fourth time in the last five seasons capped off with wins over Eastern and Northern Illinois to take home the inaugural Compass Challenge Championship. It marked Southern's first mid-season tournament title since the 1986-87 season. Nicole Martin was named to the All-MVC First Team for the second-straight season while Makenzie Silvey was honored on the All-MVC Honorable Mention team for the first time in her career. Martin is the sixth Saluki to repeat as an All-MVC First Team selection, and the fourth to do so under Stein. In the classroom, Southern had a banner year. The Salukis earned the No. 11 ranking in the WBCA's Academic Top-25 Honor Roll, which was the highest finish in program history. It was the second time in the last three seasons in which SIU has earned inclusion on the list, while its grade point average of 3.621 was its highest of the five times that the Salukis have earned a spot on the list. SIU also had three players earn MVC scholar-athlete honors, which was tied with Northern Iowa and Drake for the most of any Valley school. Southern has had at least one MVC Scholar-Athlete honoree in every season under Stein and have totaled 12 MVC Scholar-Athlete honorees during her tenure.

At Southern Illinois 2017-18 (17-14, 11-7 MVC)

The 2017-18 season marked the fourth-straight winning season for the Salukis

under Stein. SIU once again earned the No. 4 seed in the Missouri Valley Conference tournament and advanced to the semifinal game for the second time in three years.

Abby Brockmeyer became the first Saluki to earn MVC Freshman of the Year honors since 2012 and both Kylie Giebelhausen and Nicole Martin were honored as All-MVC First Team selections. Giebelhausen also took MVC Scholar-Athlete First Team and MVC All-Defensive Team honors and is one of just five Salukis to earn back-to-back All-MVC First Team nods.

On the court, the Salukis grit and determination was evident in their 4-0 record in overtime games, which broke the Missouri Valley Conference record for overtime wins in a season. Southern also finished top-3 in both steals and blocks for the first time in program history.

At Southern Illinois 2016-17 (16-15, 10-8 MVC)

The 2016-17 season marked the third-straight winning season for the Salukis under Stein. Southern advanced to the WBI tournament for the second-straight season, which marked the first time in nearly 30 years that the program has made back-to-back postseason appearances.

The Salukis once again shattered the school record for three-pointers in a season and broke the single game points record against Brescia on Nov. 25. Southern went on to earn the fourth seed in the MVC Tournament, which was its highest seed since the 1996-97 season.

The Salukis also got it done in the classroom, as their 3.51 GPA tied with Fairfield University for No. 22 on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Academic Top-25 Honor Roll. It marked the fourth time since the 2001-02 season that Southern has garnered a spot on the WBCA Academic Top-25 list, and the first time they have done so since the 2007-08 season.

2015-16 (20-13, 12-6 MVC)

The 2015-16 season kept with the theme of several program firsts within Stein's tenure while the squad's 20-13 overall record marked the program's 10th 20-win season. The Salukis beat every Missouri Valley Conference foe at least once and advanced to the semifinals of the MVC Tournament for the first time since the 1994-95 season. In doing so, Southern earned an invitation to the Women's Basketball Invitational, the program's first postseason berth since 2007.

2014-15 (17-13, 10-8 MVC)

Stein and the Salukis conducted an improbable change of gear in 2014-15. Southern went 17-13 overall with a 10-8 conference record with Stein at the helm, ushering in the largest turnaround from one season to the next in school history at plus-12 wins. In fact, that turnaround was third-best in the NCAA by the end of the regular season in 2014-15.

2013-14 (5-25, 3-15 MVC)

Stein's inaugural team at SIU went 5-25 after a slew of bad breaks left the team with only nine available players for the entire MVC schedule. Despite playing without three players who figured to be major contributors, including preseason All-MVC guard Cartaesha Macklin, Stein improved the team's field-goal percentage defense, 3-point percentage defense, scoring defense, rebound margin, blocks and assist-to-turnover ratio from the season before.

At Illinois Central College

Stein came to Carbondale after leading Illinois Central College to a 32-4 record and a third-place finish at the NJCAA Division II national tournament during her lone season at the school in 2012-13. Stein turned around an ICC team that went 16-16 the year before her arrival. Stein was named the NJCAA Region XXIV Coach of the Year following ICC's run.

At Missouri

Prior to ICC, Stein spent 12 seasons as the head coach at Missouri where she led the Tigers to 185 wins between 1998 and 2010. Stein inherited a Mizzou team that went 11-16 in 1997-98 and led the Tigers to a 22-10 record with a Sweet 16 run by her third year in 2000-01.

Stein's tenure at Mizzou saw the Tigers make seven total postseason appearances with three NCAA Tournament bids and four WNIT appearances. Stein's players at Mizzou earned a combined 24 All-Big 12 honors with four First-Team selections, and she coached five Tigers who were selected in the WNBA Draft. Additionally, Mizzou players earned a combined 46 Academic All-Big 12 honors under Stein's watch.

Missouri ultimately made it to the postseason six-consecutive seasons with WNIT berths in 2001-02 and 2002-03 before capping the run with an NCAA Tournament berth in 2003-04.

The Tigers also continued sending players into the professional ranks as three-time All-Big 12 selection Evan Unrau was selected in the third round of the 2004 WNBA Draft by the Washington Mystics.

The 2005-06 season was another banner year for the program as the Tigers went 21-10 for their second 20-win season of Stein's tenure, and made it back to the NCAA Tournament. Mizzou had two more players selected in the WNBA draft following the 2005-06 season as LaToya Bond was selected by the Charlotte Sting in the second round and Christelle N'Garsanet was taken in the third.

The 2006-07 Tigers gave Stein her sixth postseason win at Mizzou with a victory in the opening round of the WNIT. Stein coached Mizzou to the most postseason appearances and postseason wins in program history.

At Emporia State

Stein spent three seasons as the head coach at Emporia State prior to Mizzou, turning the Hornets from a sub-.500 team into a Division II national title contender. After going 12-14 in her first season at ESU in 1995-96, the Hornets improved to 20-10 the following season and made it to the second round of the NCAA Tournament before going 33-1 and finishing as the national runner up in 1997-98.

The 1997-98 Hornets went 16-0 in the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, earning MIAA Regular Season and Tournament Championships in advance of the historic run to the NCAA Division II title game. Stein coached two-time All-Americans Aneta Kausaite and Jurgita Kausaite at Emporia State in addition to recruiting All-Americans Emily Bloss and Tara Holloway, who both went on to earn National Player of the Year honors. Aneta Kausaite eventually became the first-ever Division II player to play in the WNBA.

Following ESU's run to the 1997-98 title game, Stein was named the National Coach of the Year by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association, the Molten Division II Bulletin and the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association. She was also selected as the 1998 Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association Coach of the Year and the District VI Coach of the Year.

Early Career/Playing Career

Prior to her head coaching experience, Stein was an assistant coach at Illinois (1993-95), Bradley (1988-1993), Cincinnati (1987-88) and Miami University (1986-87). Stein began her foray into coaching as a graduate assistant at Central Michigan from 1984-86.

Stein played collegiately at Illinois from 1981-83 after two years at Illinois Central College from 1979-81. Stein helped the Illini to the 1982 NCAA Tournament, and she still holds several Illinois assists records. A junior college All-American, Stein also helped ICC to back-to-back appearances in the NJCAA national tournament. Stein has a bachelor's degree in physical education from Illinois and a master's degree in physical education from Central Michigan.
