Series: Salukis lead, 7-1 (H: 5-1, A: 2-0)

Series versus UT Martin

The Salukis and Skyhawks have met eight times with Southern Illinois holding a 7-1 advantage, including a 6-1 mark at home. The last meeting between the schools was a first-round playoff game in Carbondale on Nov. 25, 2006. Nick Hill threw a game-winning 45-yard touchdown pass to Alan Turner in the final minute of the game and Arkee Whitlock rushed for 207 yards and four touchdowns to lead SIU to a 36-30 comeback victory. Early in the third quarter, Southern trailed, 27-7.

Versus FBS opponents

With the win at UMass last week, FCS Southern Illinois improved to 4-31 all-time against FBS opponents. Here are the Saluki wins:

SIU head coach Nick Hill was the team's quarterback in the wins at Indiana and NIU, and he combined to complete 31-of-51 passes for 370 yards, 7 TDs and 0 interceptions in those wins. Stone Labanowitz quarterbacked the UMass win and was 19-of-26 for 265 yards, 4 TDs and no interceptions.

RB Javon Williams Jr. is a multi-threat

The reigning MVFC Offensive Player of the Week is RB Javon Williams Jr. (6-1, 239, rFr.). Against UMass on Saturday, he touched the ball nine times (6 carries, 3 catches) for 167 yards. He became just the fourth running back in school history to record 100+ receiving yards, joining Derrick Taylor (1984), Melvin Dukes (1993) and D.J. Davis (2017). His 85-yard TD catch was the third-longest in school history. Williams is also a capable passer, having played quarterback in high school and starting his career at SIU under center.

DE Anthony Knighton moves up sacks, TFL lists

DE Anthony Knighton (6-4, 260, Jr.) has started every game (24) of his Saluki career and last week at UMass picked up career sack number 16.0 to move into ninth place all-time at Southern. His 8.5 sacks last season ranked seventh all-time at SIU and were the most by a Saluki since James Cloud had 8.5 in 2007. He also has

26.5 tackles for loss in his career, which is 13th all-time at SIU.

Qua Brown leads nation in tackles

Although Jeremy Chinn grabs the headlines as one of the nation's top safeties and NFL prospects, **S Qua Brown (5-11, 203, Jr.)** leads the nation in tackles per game (15.0) and solo tackles per game (11.0). He had 16 tackles at SEMO and 14 at UMass. He also has a pair of pass breakups to his credit.

RB D.J. Davis has rushed for 100+ yards in seven of the last 13 games

Dating back to last season **RB D.J. Davis (5-8, 170, Sr.)** has recorded seven 100-yard rushing games in the last 13 games. In the season opener at SEMO, he rushed for 125 yards and two TDs. Davis is one of 40 players on the 2019 preseason watch list for the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) FCS National Performer of the Year trophy. Davis led the Missouri Valley Football Conference last season and ranked 14th in the nation in all-purpose yards per game with 140.3. He rushed for 1,118 yards in 2018 — the most by a Saluki running back since Jewel Hampton in 2011 — and averaged 6.28 yards per carry.

S Jeremy Chinn moves up to 9th in INTs

With an interception at UMass, preseason All-American **S Jeremy Chinn (6-3, 212, Sr.)** moved into ninth place in interceptions at SIU with his 10th career pick. He is also third in pass breakups (24) and second in forced fumbles (6). A starter since his freshman season, Chinn was named the "Top FCS Target" by the Senior Bowl heading into the season. A year ago Delaware's Nasir Adderley earned the Senior Bowl's distinction and ended up as a San Diego Chargers 2nd round pick.

QB Stone Labanowitz among nation's passing leaders

QB Stone Labanowitz (5-10, 187, So.) ranks second in the conference and 15th in the nation in passing efficiency after two games. A transfer from ASA College (N.Y.), he has completed 64.8 percent of his passes (35-of-54) for 482 yards, 4 TDs and only one interception. He led SIU to a win over UMass with a 19-for-26, 265-yard passing performance.

Dawg Bites

- ♦ The Salukis are looking to snap a seven-game home losing streak. The last home win was a 42-7 victory over No. 15-ranked Illinois State on Oct. 14, 2017.
- ♦ SIU committed three penalties for 25 yards at UMass — the fewest penalty yards during the Nick Hill era and fewest since committing two for 25 yards vs. Youngstown State on Oct. 24, 2015.
- ♦ Southern's offense is evenly balanced with 467 rushing yards and 482 passing yards on the season. They have 19 first downs on the ground and 19 through the air.
- ♦ **DE Chucky Sullivan (6-2, 241, Jr.)** picked up his first two career sacks at UMass.
- ♦ After recording one tackle for loss and no sacks at SEMO, the Salukis generated nine TFLs and three sacks at UMass.

TE Nigel Kilby tied for team lead with six catches

One of SIU's most potent targets in the passing game is **TE Nigel Kilby (6-8, 243, Sr.)**. He is tied with D.J. Davis for the team lead in receptions with six. Of his 16 receptions in 2018, six of them went for touchdowns. Against South Dakota, he caught seven passes for 109 yards and two touchdowns. NFL scouts have shown increased interest in Kilby this fall, and he is one of three FCS tight ends on the preseason Senior Bowl watch list.

The Leg from Down Under

A native of Melbourne, Australia, **P Jack Colquhoun (6-2, 190, Jr.)** is the first Australian to play for the Salukis since Wayne Cowley punted 32 times in 1973. Colquhoun, who has two kicks of 50+ yards this season, had never seen an American football game in person prior to his college debut at SEMO on Aug. 29. Colquhoun (pronounced KUH-hoon) was a decorated rugby player back home.

WR Landon Lenoir is active leader in receptions

WR Landon Lenoir (6-0, 190, Jr.) had his streak of 12-straight games with at least two catches snapped last week. He is still the team's active leader in receiving with 60 catches for 571 yards. Lenoir has two relatives currently in the NFL. Brother Lance Lenoir (age 24), who holds the Western Illinois school record for career touchdown catches (28), is currently a member the Dallas Cowboys. Cousin Laquon Treadwell (age 24) is a wide receiver for the Minnesota Vikings.

True freshman RB Romeir Elliott shines

RB Romeir Elliott (5-5, 188, Fr.) has carried 16 times for 96 yards (6.0 ave.) through two games. He has five receptions for 31 yards and two TDs. **WR Tanner Corum (5-11, 185, Fr.)** and **S PJ Jules (6-2, 233, Fr.)** have also played. True freshmen can play up to four games and still apply for a redshirt.

Jason Petrino takes over defense that returns 10 starters

The Salukis return 10 of 11 starters on defense in 2019, including their entire defensive line and secondary. **Jason Petrino** was hired to become the team's defensive coordinator after SIU ranked No. 114 in the FCS in Scoring Defense in 2018.

Petrino is a cousin of former Louisville coach Bobby Petrino and Idaho coach Paul Petrino. He spent the last three seasons as head coach at NAIA Rocky Mountain College in Montana, where he led the program to a conference championship and playoff berth in 2018.

Offense returns three starters on the O-line, five overall

The Salukis return three starters on the offensive line — **C Jacob Marnin (6-2, 316, Sr.)**, **RG ZeVeyon Furcron (6-1, 320, Jr.)** and **RT Ernest Dye Jr. (6-2, 307, Sr.)**. The trio has 67 games combined of starting experience. Marnin was an Academic All-American in 2018 and holds a degree in criminology & criminal justice.

WR Je'Quan Burton made impact as true freshman

A member of the MVFC Preseason Team as a return specialist, **WR Je'Quan Burton (5-9, 175, So.)** is hoping to have a breakout season in 2019. He capped off the 2018 campaign with a school-record 100-yard kickoff return for



touchdown at North Dakota State. He also rushed 21 times for 105 yards and caught 11 passes for 139 yards on the year, earning MVFC All-Newcomer team honors.

True Scholar-Athletes

Four Salukis have already earned their undergraduate degrees — P Jack Colquhoun (finance), OLB Cody Crider (management), LT Ernest Dye Jr. (communications studies) and C Jacob Marnin (criminology & criminal justice). Marnin recorded a 4.0 GPA as an undergrad and was an Academic All-American in 2018.

Jared Petrino special teams coach

The Salukis hired Jared Petrino, the brother of defensive coordinator Jason Petrino, as the program's special teams coach and assistant defensive line coach. Jared Petrino spent three seasons serving under his brother at Rocky Mountain College (2016-18) as defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator and a defensive line coach.

Personnel notes

♦ **LB Bryce Notree (6-4, 248, Jr.)** suffered a broken foot at SEMO and is expected to miss 4-6 weeks. He led the team with 78 tackles and ranked 14th in the MVFC with 7.1 stops per game in 2018 to earn MVFC honorable mention status.

♦ **K Griffin Cerra (6-0, 157, rFr.)** has not missed a kick in his brief four-game college career. He is 26-for-26 on PATs and 4-for-4 on field goals, including a 50 yarder against South Dakota State — the 7th-longest field goal in school history.

♦ The Salukis have depth at kicker. **K Nico Gualdoni (6-0, 228, Jr.)** handles the kickoff chores and also has experience as a placekicker. In two seasons, he is a combined 9-of-11 on field goals with a long of 39 yards, and 33-of-33 on PATs.

♦ D.J. Davis is the school record holder in career kickoff return yards with 1,706. He has the second-longest kickoff return in school history — 98 yards versus Murray State as a freshman in 2016.

♦ Starting **LT Ernest Dye Jr. (6-2, 307, Sr.)** is the son of Ernest Dye, who played offensive tackle at South Carolina and six seasons in the NFL with the Arizona Cardinals and St. Louis Rams. His offensive line coach with the Cardinals was Saluki Hall of Famer Carl Mauck, who also coached at SIU (2006-07) under Jerry Kill.

♦ **DT Keenan Agnew (6-0, 274, So.)** is the son of Ray Agnew, who was the 10th overall pick in the 1990 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots and played six seasons in the NFL at defensive tackle. Ray Agnew is now the Director of Pro Personnel for the Los Angeles Rams.

♦ Both of Keenan Agnew's brothers played football at SIU. Fullback Ray Agnew (2010-13) played one season in the NFL for the Cleveland Browns. Running back Malcolm Agnew (2013-14) rushed for 1,708 yards and scored 19 touchdowns in two seasons. He is currently the running backs coach for North Dakota.

♦ **OLB Bryson Strong (5-10, 241, So.)** and **S Justin Strong (6-0, 212, rFr.)** are brothers, but no relation to **CB Tre Strong (6-1, 195, Sr.)**.

♦ The father of **DT Blake Parzych (6-3, 293, Sr.)** is 6-foot-8 Scott Parzych, who played basketball for Jim Valvano at North Carolina State. Scott was a starter for the Wolfpack in 1982, the year before they won the NCAA title.

♦ The Salukis have four players from Jones High School in Orlando — WR Je'Quan Burton, CB PJ Jules, DT Tyree Jackson and G Calvin Francis Jr.

♦ **WR Avante Cox (5-10, 175, Jr.)**, a transfer from Wyoming, has two catches on the season. He played high school football with QB Nic Baker (5-8, 191, rFr.) at Rochester H.S. (Ill.)

♦ **CB Tre Strong (6-1, 195, Sr.)** has earned a starting job at SIU after transferring from Utah...He also started 12 games in two seasons (2015-16) at Montana State.

Age 27 ... Drafted by Minnesota Vikings in 5th round in 2015 ... Has played 36 career games with 4 starts ... 21 career receptions ... Is SIU's all-time receptions leader (221).

Age 23 ... Signed as a free agent in 2018 with Atlanta Falcons and played in 1 game.

Philadelphia Eagles CB Craig James (Practice Squad)

Age 23 ... Signed as a free agent with Minnesota Vikings in 2018 and played in 3 games.

Miami Dolphins LB Chase Allen (Injured Reserve)

Age 26 ... Played two seasons with the Miami Dolphins (2017-18) ... Has played in 21 career games with 5 starts ... 43 career tackles ... Ranks 12th in career tackles at SIU (324).

Five Saluki losses by a touchdown or less in 2018

The Salukis lost five games by a touchdown or less in 2018. They held second-half leads of a touchdown or more in four of those losses. Against Western Illinois, SIU led by 17 points heading into the fourth quarter before losing by three points on a field goal with 12 seconds remaining.

Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities...The Southern Illinois region is informally known as "Little Egypt," hence the adoption of the Saluki (an Egyptian hunting dog) as the school mascot.

AD Jerry Kill

Athletic Director Jerry Kill was the head football coach at SIU from 2001 to 2007, leading the Salukis to five-straight appearances in the Football Championship Subdivision and winning three straight Gateway Football Conference Championships. While at SIU he also received the prestigious Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year Award in 2004 and the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award in 2007.

He left SIU to serve as head coach at Northern Illinois from 2008 to 2010, delivering three bowl-eligible teams. Kill went on to become head coach at Minnesota from 2011 to 2015. While there, he was named 2014 Big Ten Coach of the Year, sent three teams to bowl games and produced six NFL draft picks. He served as associate athletic director at Kansas State University in 2016 and offensive coordinator at Rutgers University in 2017, retiring from coaching in December due to health issues.

Kill inherited a program at SIU that had two winning seasons in its previous 15 years. His 2007 team, quarterbacked by Nick Hill, advanced to the semifinals in the playoffs, where SIU lost to Joe Flacco and Delaware. Hill played for Kill from 2005-07.

Coach Kill connections

Five assistant coaches on Southern's staff have direct ties to Coach Kill.

- ♦ Safeties coach Marty Rodgers played for Kill at SIU in his first two seasons, 2006 and 2007.
- ♦ Offensive line coach Trevor Olson played for Kill at Northern Illinois.
- ♦ Olson and running backs coach Nate Griffin were on the quality control staff under Kill at Minnesota before Hill hired them at SIU.
- ♦ Tight ends coach and co-special teams coordinator Pat Poore was an assistant coach under Kill at SIU, Northern Illinois and Minnesota.
- ♦ Defensive graduate assistant Jack Lynn was a four-year letterman at linebacker at Minnesota.

Versus ranked FCS opponents

The Salukis were 0-3 last year versus ranked FCS opponents, falling to No. 12 Illinois State, No. 6 South Dakota State and No. 1 North Dakota State. The last win over a ranked team was on Oct. 14, 2017, when SIU beat No. 15 Illinois State, 42-7.

Why the Saluki?

Southern Illinois had been known as the Maroons since intercollegiate athletics began in 1913. The name "Salukis" became official on March 19, 1951, when the student body overwhelmingly approved the dog as the new symbol of SIU athletics, easily besting "Rebels," "Knights," "Flyers," "Marauders," and "Maroons."

The oldest purebred dogs in the world with records dating back to 3600 B.C., the Saluki is an ancient Egyptian hunting dog known for its speed and hunting prowess.

So why is the name Salukis relevant to Southern Illinois? Natives of southern Illinois know that the region is frequently referred to as "Egypt." Historian Baker Brownell, in his book "The Other Illinois," explained how the region came to be known as Egypt.

He wrote, "There was a drought in the northern counties (of Illinois) in the early 1800s...the wheat fields dried up, the streams died in their beds. But in Southern Illinois, rain fell and there were good crops, and from the north came people seeking corn and wheat as to Egypt of old. Thus, the name, Egypt."

The 19th century drought in Illinois parallels the Biblical account of the country of Egypt.

"There was famine in all lands; but in all the land of Egypt there was bread. All the earth came to Egypt to Joseph to buy grain, because the famine was so severe. And (Jacob) said, 'Behold, I have heard that there is grain in Egypt; go down and buy grain for us there, that we may live, and not die.' So 10 of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain in Egypt." (Genesis 41:54b, 57, 42:2-3).

In Egypt at that time, Salukis were accepted as the finest animal a family could possess. Adopting such a well-respected dog as its mascot fit perfectly for a school in a region known as "Little Egypt."

King Tut's Tomb

King Tut was the school's first live Saluki mascot after the nickname change from Maroons to Salukis in 1951. King Tut died in 1954 after being struck by a car, and a concrete pyramid marked his burial at McAndrew Stadium. The marker was moved to its current spot outside Saluki Stadium in 2010. Before each home game, the Salukis walk from their locker room and pat Tut's Tomb for good luck.

Live pure-bred Saluki mascots continue to lead the team onto the field prior to each home game.

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.

Heading into his fourth season at the helm of Saluki Football, 34-year-old Nick Hill has brought the perfect balance of energy, passion and creativity needed to re-energize the program.

A native son of southern Illinois, Hill's journey to the top job at SIU started 16 years ago and just 20 miles north of campus, where he was a football and basketball icon at Du Quoin High School.

During his senior year of high school in 2002-03, Hill was the area's Player of the Year in both sports and guided the Indians to the Illinois High School Association 3A state championship football game.

The legend continued on the hardwood where Hill averaged 23 points as a senior at Du Quoin and chose Western Kentucky from a host of Division I offers. A broken hand prematurely ended his freshman season at Western but ultimately led him home.

In the spring of 2004, Hill transferred to SIU to switch sports and play football under head coach Jerry Kill, just as the program was beginning its rapid rise to the top of the league standings.

"I took a leap of faith with Coach Kill," Hill recalled. "Everyone needs someone who believes in him and for me, that someone was Coach Kill."

Hill initially sat behind league Player of the Year Joel Sambursky, before taking over the starting job in 2006. In two seasons as the starter, he went 21-6 and set the school record for passing yards in 2007. He still holds the best completion percentage (68.3) in school history.

Highlights of Hill's playing career include guiding Southern to a win at Indiana in 2006, in which he passed for four touchdowns as SIU became the league's first team to defeat a Big Ten opponent. Hill capped off his career in 2007 by leading the team to the Final Four of the playoffs, where the Salukis ultimately lost a 20-17 heartbreaker to Joe Flacco and Delaware. He was also a finalist for the Peyton Award in '07.

Hill played six seasons of professional football, mostly in the Arena Football League, where he played for head coach Jay Gruden, now the head coach of the NFL's Washington Redskins. Hill also had brief free-agent stints with the Chicago Bears in 2008 and Green Bay Packers in 2012.

Nick Hill was selected to attend the American Football Coaches Association's 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute in 2019.

Playing for Gruden, one of the game's top offensive minds, helped shape Hill's offensive philosophy. First as Southern's offensive coordinator and now as head coach, Hill has refined his own unique style of offense that combines

elements of Air Raid, spread and up-tempo.

In his first season at SIU, Saluki quarterbacks broke a school record for single-season touchdown passes with 29. The following year in 2015, Southern's offense averaged 498 yards per game -- the second most in conference history. Quarterback Mark Iannotti led the nation in total offense per game.

In 2016, the Salukis set program records for passing completions, attempts and yards while only throwing seven interceptions. Southern Illinois ranked in the top-10 nationally for passing offense, total offense and scoring offense for nearly the entire year.

The offense was on its way to surpassing those marks in 2017 before starting quarterback Sam Straub was injured early in the eighth game and missed the remainder of the season.

In 2018, the offense ranked third in the MVFC in total offense, first downs and time of possession, and ranked in the top half of the league in several more offensive categories.

Hill has assembled a talented mix of veteran assistant coaches and young, up-and-comers. First-year defensive coordinator Jason Petrino has head coaching experience, plus spent four years in the MVFC as defensive coordinator at South Dakota. Veteran tight ends coach Pat Poore is one of several former Kill assistants on the staff, and was instrumental in Southern's initial rebuild under Kill.

"I know what the blueprint looks like for our program to be successful, going back to my playing days for Coach Kill, and I know we can get there," Hill said. "Coaching my alma mater is a dream come true. I love everything about this region and what it stands for, that blue-collar mentality. This is not my team. This is our team. Our program is going to invest in the community and make us proud on and off the field."

Hill and wife, Alicia, a former volleyball player at SIU, reside in Carbondale and have two daughters, Skylar and Charley. His brother, former Saluki quarterback A.J. Hill, is the head coach at Du Quoin High School.
