Series versus Missouri State

The game against the Bears marks the 42nd meeting all-time between the two programs. The Salukis own an all-time record of 22 wins to 20 losses against Mo. State in a series that dates back to 1965. SIU has won three of the past five meetings with the Bears, and have won six of the last eight games played in Springfield.

In the previous match up on Nov. 11, 2019, SIU defeated Missouri State 37-14 at home in Saluki Stadium. On that day, QB Kare Lyles was 18-of-24 passing for 232 yards and four touchdowns - with WRs Avante Cox and Landon Lenoir each hauling in two scores. On the ground, RB Javon Williams Jr. picked up 113 yards on 10 carries, while Romeir Elliott added in 73 yards on 11 attempts.

Salukis remain in the Top-10

After the 44-3 loss to South Dakota State University on Saturday, the Salukis fell back in the FCS Stats rankings to No. 10. The Salukis have an all-time record of 64-19 in games in which the program is ranked in the top-10.

In all, the Salukis have been ranked No. 10 five times in the coaches poll and seven by the media poll. The last time the Salukis were ranked tenth in the nation by the media poll was on Nov. 17, 2008.

In the seven games that the program has played ranked 10th by the media, the Salukis own a perfect 7-0 record.

Qua Brown leading the defense

S Qua Brown (5-11, 206, Sr.) has recorded two forced fumbles in back-to-back weeks, bringing his career total to six, which is tied for the second most in program history with Jeremy Chinn (2016-19), Ron Geels (1976-79) and John Palmero (1977-79).

His four forced fumbles are the most in the country this season, and stand as the second-most in a single season in program history. Two more forced fumbles by the senior safety would tie him for the most in a single season and a career at SIU.

Saluki secondary is one of the top units in the FCS

SIU's secondary has been one of the most stout units in all of the FCS, as the group has allowed only 124.7 yards per game through the air, which stands as the

least in the Missouri Valley Conference and 11th in all of the FCS. Additionally, SIU's team passing defense efficiency is ranked as the fourth-best unit in the MVFC, while also coming in at 29th nationally.

QBs continue to be decisive through adversity

In total, five different Salukis have taken snaps at quarterback through the team's six games this season. Through it all, Saluki QBs have continued to remain decisive, as the unit has combined for a completion percentage of 65.2%, which stands as the best in the Missouri Valley Conference and 11th in the country.

Individually, QB Nic Baker (5-9, 194, So.) sits at a completion percentage of 67.6% on 74 passing attempts, which would stand as the second-best mark in program history if the season were to end today. Baker, however, is one pass shy of the minimum attempts needed to qualify and was recently declared out for the season by Saluki head coach Nick Hill.

All in the family

Saturday's game will be a family reunion of sorts. Missouri State head coach Bobby Petrino is the cousin of Saluki Defensive Coordinator Jason Petrino and Special Teams Coordinator Jared Petrino.

Bobby's son, Nick, serves as Missouri State's offensive coordinator. Meanwhile, Bobby's brother, Paul, is the head football coach at the University of Idaho. Jason and Jared Petrino's brother, meanwhile, is the head women's basketball coach at the University of Montana.

The family traces its roots to Carroll College, an NAIA power in Helena, Montana. Bobby's father, Bob "Putter" Petrino Sr., was the head coach for 28 seasons at Carroll and coached Bobby, Jason and Paul. Jared just missed being coached by "Putter", but went on to play on the same team at Carroll that Jason was an assistant coach on.

Knighton chasing sack record

Knighton is third all-time in sacks at SIU with 22.0 and is 2.0 sacks shy of breaking the school record held by James Phillips (1977-80). He also has 38.0 tackles for loss in his career, which places him fifth in program history. He needs 10.0 to tie first with Bryan Archibald (1998-2001).

WR Avante Cox continuing to improve on a weekly basis

Avante Cox (5-10, 170, Jr.) leads the Salukis with 40 catches for 472 yards, while sharing the team lead in touchdowns with two (Landon Lenoir, Justin Strong). On the ground, Cox has added 130 yards on 13 carries.

Cox's versatility has led him to gain 104.33 all-purpose yards per game, ranking him fifth in the MVFC. Additionally, his 472 receiving yards this season rank first in The Valley and 8th in the nation, while his 78.7 receiving yards per game is the top mark in the conference.

Cox needs 11 catches over the final two games to crack the program's top-10 list for receptions in a season. The junior stands 30 catches away from breaking into the program top-10 list for career receptions, while his 1,089 career receiving yards are the 25th-most in program history.

Emphasis on pass-blocking

Missouri State has racked up 24 sacks this season, which is the most in MVFC and third-most in the nation. 17 different Bears have registered at least half a sack, with DE Devin Ellis leading the team at 6.0 sacks.

Red zone success

Through six games, Southern Illinois is second in the Missouri Valley Football Conference in red zone offense, scoring on 18 of its 20 trips, which includes 13 touchdowns. SIU's success rate of 90.0% inside the opponents 20-yard line is the 22nd-best in the nation.

Third-down efficiency

Southern Illinois leads the MVFC and ranks ninth in the country in third-down conversion percentage at 53.3%. Additionally, the Salukis have converted on 54.5% of their fourth-down attempts, a mark that stands as the third-best in the Missouri Valley and 30th in the nation.

RBs continue to shine

RBs Romeir Elliott (5-6, 190, So.), Javon Williams Jr. (6-2, 245, So.) and Justin Strong (6-0, 215, So.) make up one of the most versatile running back groups in the country. Through five games this season, SIU has rushed for 1,035 yards and scored nine times, both of which are the fourth-best totals in the conference.

Individually, Elliott and Williams Jr. are third and fifth in The Valley in total rushing yards, respectively, while Williams Jr. is third in the MVFC with five rushing touchdowns.

Getting to the sticks

The Salukis have continued to move the ball well, as the team ranks first in the Missouri Valley and sixth in the nation in first downs with 121. The Salukis balanced offensive attack has led to 58 of its first downs coming via the pass, while 56 have come by way of a rushing play. Seven of its first downs have come from the result of a penalty, which is tied for the second-most in The Valley this season.

The Agnew family legacy

DT Keenan Agnew (6-0, 275, Jr.) is third Agnew brother to play at SIU. Fullback Ray Agnew (2010-13) played one season in the NFL for the Cleveland Browns. Running back Malcolm Agnew (2013-14) rushed for 1,708 yards and scored 19 touchdowns in two seasons. He is currently the running backs coach for North Dakota. The Agnews' father is Ray Agnew, who was the 10th overall pick in the 1990 NFL Draft by the New England Patriots and played six seasons in the NFL at defensive tackle. Ray Agnew is now the Assistant General Manager for the Detroit Lions. Keenan Agnew played in all 12 games and made 5 starts last season and was second on the team among defensive tackles with 23 tackles.

Defense continues to make great strides under Jason Petrino

The Salukis made tremendous strides on defense during Jason Petrino's first year in charge of the unit in 2019. In scoring defense, Southern improved from 10th (40.7) to 6th (23.0) — nearly cutting in half the amount of points allowed from the previous season. Similar gains were made in rushing defense (221.3 to 154.0) and passing defense (262.1 to 200.6).

His defense has taken another step forward in 2020-21, as the unit ranks sixth

in the MVFC in total defense, in addition to being the fourth-best unit in the conference in terms of team passing efficiency defense (111.84).

Jared Petrino special teams coach

The Saluki staff also features Jared Petrino, the brother of defensive coordinator Jason Petrino, as the program’s special teams coach and assistant defensive line coach.

SIU’s special teams flourished under Jared Petrino in his first season in charge of the units in 2019. The Salukis improved in the conference rankings in every category — kickoff coverage (+3), net punting (+4), punt returns (+4) and kickoff returns (+2).

That special teams unit has continued its success for the 2020-21 season, as Petrino’s group ranks first nationally in blocked punts (1), third in blocked kicks (2) 20th in kickoff return defense (14.67 YPG) and 32nd in kickoff return yards per game (20.25).

Jared Petrino spent three seasons serving under his brother at Rocky Mountain College (2016-18) as defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator and a defensive line coach.

Dawg Bites

- James Ceasar transferred back to Southern Illinois after spending a year at Ferris State University. His return has been a huge factor in the secondary’s ability to shutdown opposing quarterbacks. Ceasar ranks third in the MVFC and 19th in the nation with 1.6 passes defended per game.
- SIU’s five offensive line starters all have starting experience, with a combined 84 starts between them. All-Conference LG ZeVeyon Furcron (6-2, 327, Sr.) leads the group with 37 starts.

5-game win streak longest since 2009

The Salukis recorded a five-game winning streak during the 2019 season — their longest since 2009, when the team went 11-2 and won 11-straight games. During Southern’s five-game winning streak, it out-scored opponents by an average margin of 20.2 points. The 24-point win at Western Illinois was the team’s largest road margin in school history.

True Scholar-Athletes

Saluki Athletics leads the Missouri Valley Conference with 101 Academic All-Americans all-time. C Jacob Marnin was the most recent Academic All-American in 2018, 2019.

Quick Facts

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis...Many of SIU’s alums are concentrated in those two cities...The Southern Illinois region is informally known as “Little Egypt,” hence the adoption of the Saluki (an Egyptian hunting dog) as the school mascot.

Jerry Kill legacy

Jerry Kill coached Nick Hill at SIU. Kill was the head football coach at SIU from 2001 to 2007, leading the Salukis to five-straight appearances in the Football Championship Subdivision and winning three straight Gateway Football Conference Championships. While at SIU he also received the prestigious Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year Award in 2004 and the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year Award in 2007.

He left SIU to serve as head coach at Northern Illinois from 2008 to 2010, delivering three bowl-eligible teams. Kill went on to become head coach at Minnesota from 2011 to 2015. While there, he was named 2014 Big Ten Coach of the Year, sent three teams to bowl games and produced six NFL draft picks.

Kill inherited a program at SIU that had two winning seasons in

its previous 15 years. His 2007 team, quarterbacked by Nick Hill, advanced to the semifinals in the playoffs, where SIU lost to Joe Flacco and Delaware. Hill played for Kill from 2005-07.

Coach Kill connections

Five assistant coaches on Southern’s staff have direct ties to Coach Kill.

- Safeties coach Marty Rodgers played for Kill at SIU in his first two seasons, 2006 and 2007.
- Offensive line coach Trevor Olson played for Kill at Northern Illinois.
- Olson and running backs coach Nate Griffin were on the quality control staff under Kill at Minnesota before Hill hired them at SIU.
- Tight ends coach and co-special teams coordinator Pat Poore was an assistant coach under Kill at SIU, Northern Illinois and Minnesota.

intercollegiate athletics began in 1913. The name "Salukis" became official on March 19, 1951, when the student body overwhelmingly approved the dog as the new symbol of SIU athletics, easily besting "Rebels," "Knights," "Flyers," "Marauders," and "Maroons."

The oldest purebred dogs in the world with records dating back to 3600 B.C., the Saluki is an ancient Egyptian hunting dog known for its speed and hunting prowess.

So why is the name Salukis relevant to Southern Illinois? Natives of southern Illinois know that the region is frequently referred to as "Egypt." Historian Baker Brownell, in his book "The Other Illinois," explained how the region came to be known as Egypt.

He wrote, "There was a drought in the northern counties (of Illinois) in the early 1800s...the wheat fields dried up, the streams died in their beds. But in Southern Illinois, rain fell and there were good crops, and from the north came people seeking corn and wheat as to Egypt of old. Thus, the name, Egypt."

The 19th century drought in Illinois parallels the Biblical account of the country of Egypt.

"There was famine in all lands; but in all the land of Egypt there was bread. All the earth came to Egypt to Joseph to buy grain, because the famine was so severe. And (Jacob) said, 'Behold, I have heard that there is grain in Egypt; go down and buy grain for us there, that we may live, and not die.' So 10 of Joseph's brothers went down to buy grain in Egypt." (Genesis 41:54b, 57, 42:2-3).

In Egypt at that time, Salukis were accepted as the finest animal a family could possess. Adopting such a well-respected dog as its mascot fit perfectly for a school in a region known as "Little Egypt."

King Tut's Tomb

King Tut was the school's first live Saluki mascot after the nickname change from Maroons to Salukis in 1951. King Tut died in 1954 after being struck by a car, and a concrete pyramid marked his burial at McAndrew Stadium. The marker was moved to its current spot outside Saluki Stadium in 2010. Before each home game, the Salukis walk from their locker room and pat Tut's Tomb for good luck.

Live pure-bred Saluki mascots continue to lead the team onto the field prior to each home game.

Walt Frazier — The Rest of the Story

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season.

Basketball powerhouse, 2002-07

SIU's most successful run in college basketball took place from 2002-07 when it made six-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including Sweet 16s in 2002 and 2007. Head coaches during that span were Bruce Weber, Matt Painter and Chris Lowery.

Heading into his fifth season at the helm of Saluki Football, and coming off a seven-win season and Top-25 ranking in 2019, 35-year-old Nick Hill has brought the perfect balance of energy, passion and creativity needed to re-energize the program.

A native son of southern Illinois, Hill's journey to the top job at SIU started 16 years ago and just 20 miles north of campus, where he was a football and basketball icon at DuQuoin High School.

During his senior year of high school in 2002-03, Hill was the area's Player of the Year in both sports and guided the Indians to the Illinois High School Association 3A state championship football game.

The legend continued on the hardwood where Hill averaged 23 points as a senior at DuQuoin and chose Western Kentucky from a host of Division I offers. A broken hand prematurely ended his freshman season at Western but ultimately led him home.

In the spring of 2004, Hill transferred to SIU to switch sports and play football under head coach Jerry Kill, just as the program was beginning its rapid rise to the top of the league standings.

Nick Hill was selected to attend the American Football Coaches Association's 35 Under 35 Coaches Leadership Institute in 2019.

"I took a leap of faith with Coach Kill," Hill recalled. "Everyone needs someone who believes in him and for me, that someone was Coach Kill."

Hill initially sat behind league Player of the Year Joel Sambursky, before taking over the starting job in 2006. In two seasons as the starter, he went 21-6 and set the school record for passing yards in 2007. He still holds the best completion percentage (68.3) in school history.

Highlights of Hill's playing career include guiding Southern to a win at Indiana in 2006, in which he passed for four touchdowns as SIU became the league's first team to defeat a Big Ten opponent. Hill capped off his career in 2007 by leading the team to the Final Four of the playoffs, where the Salukis ultimately lost a 20-17 heartbreaker to Joe Flacco and Delaware. He was also a finalist for the Peyton Award in '07.

Hill played six seasons of professional football, mostly in the Arena Football League, where he played for head coach Jay Gruden, now the offensive coordinator of the Jacksonville Jaguars. Hill also had brief free-agent stints with the Chicago Bears in 2008 and Green Bay Packers in 2012.

Playing for Gruden, one of the game's top offensive minds, helped shape Hill's offensive philosophy. First as

Southern's offensive coordinator and now as head coach, Hill has refined his own unique style of offense that combines elements of Air Raid, spread and up-tempo.

In his first season at SIU, Saluki quarterbacks broke a school record for single-season touchdown passes with 29. The following year in 2015, Southern's offense averaged 498 yards per game -- the second most in conference history. Quarterback Mark Iannotti led the nation in total offense per game.

In 2016, the Salukis set program records for passing completions, attempts and yards while only throwing seven interceptions. Southern Illinois ranked in the top-10 nationally for passing offense, total offense and scoring offense for nearly the entire year.

In 2018, the offense ranked third in the MVFC in total offense, first downs and time of possession, and ranked in the top half of the league in several more offensive categories. In 2019, the Saluki offense produced a pair of 1,000-yard rushers and ranked 12th in the nation in rushing.

Hill has assembled a talented mix of veteran assistant coaches and young, up-and-comers. First-year defensive coordinator Jason Petrino has both head coaching experience, plus spent four years in the MVFC as defensive coordinator at South Dakota. Tight ends and special teams coach Pat Poore is a former Kill assistant who was a key figure in Southern's initial rebuild.

"I know what the blueprint looks like for our program to be successful, going back to my playing days for Coach Kill, and I know we can get there," Hill said. "Coaching my alma mater is a dream come true. I love everything about this region and what it stands for, that blue-collar mentality. This is not my team. This is our team. Our program is going to invest in the community and make us proud on and off the field."

Hill and wife, Alicia, a former volleyball player at SIU, reside in Carbondale and have two daughters, Skylar and Charley. His brother, former Saluki quarterback A.J. Hill, coaches football at Rochester (Ill.) High School.
