Opening Tip

- In SIU's last game at Carver Arena (2-7-21), Lance Jones hit a free throw with 2.3 seconds left to give the Salukis a 69-68 win. Southern won the rematch at Arch Madness (3-4-21), when Ben Harvey scored 24 points in a 73-63 victory.
- The Salukis are 2-1 in Valley road games this season with wins at Evansville and Valparaiso.
- SIU has held all but one opponent under 70 points, including its first 14 opponents — the longest streak since 2006-07 (17) and longest streak to start a season since 1946-47 (20).

Trending

- Dalton Banks is 23-of-35 (.657) from the field in his last eight games, reversing a 5-for-31 start to the season. He's averaging 7.5 points and 3.0 assists during the stretch. He is also fifth in the MVC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.56).
- Southern has out-scored each of its last three opponents in the second half by a total of 20 points.
- SIU is 47-for-110 (.427) from 3-point range in its last four games.
- SIU's bench has scored 51 points in the last two games.
- Steven Verplancken Jr. is 3rd in the MVC in 3-point shooting (.461)

Marcus Domask

- Scored 20+ points in four-straight games (Dec. 28-Jan. 15).
- Is third in the league in assists (4.06). No forward in SIU history has averaged 4.00+ apg in a season.
- Leads the conference and ranks 25th in the nation in minutes played (36.07).
- Enters the game with 883 career points, 298 rebounds, 184 assists.
- Made 32-straight free throws during a nine-game stretch (11/22-12/28) — the second-longest streak in school history.

The Salukis...

- Allow 60.9 points per game, which leads the MVC and ranks 23rd nationally.
- Lead the MVC in 3-point field goal percentage defense (30.5).
- Are 20-1 in their last 21 games when out-rebounding an opponent. They are 7-1 this season.
- Are 21-5 in the Bryan Mullins era with 15+ assists and 23-7 when they have more assists than their opponent.
- Are 23-4 under Mullins when they win the points in the paint (8-1 this year).
- Did not allow any fast-break points in two games this season (at Evansville, Southern Miss)

Lance Jones

- Leads the league in steals (1.88).
- Is the team's second-leading scorer and has scored double figures in all but three games.
- Missed the Evansville and Maryville games with a foot injury.
- Stands at 852 career points, 232 rebounds and 178 assists.

Ben Coupet

- Was SIU's top scorer during the month of December, averaging 15.9 points in seven games.
- Recorded double figures in all seven December games, including a career-high 27 at Tulsa.
- Averaged 7.5 points in six games in November.

Season Milestones

- The win over Colorado was the program's first win over a Power 5 program since 2008.
- The win vs. Southern Miss marked two milestones — fewest points allowed since Jan. 29, 2008 (SIU beat Evansville that day, 59-39. Mullins was a junior on that SIU team and had 5 points, 4 rebounds, and 7 assists.) and largest margin of victory versus a Division I opponent in the Mullins era.

2021-22 (THIRD SEASON)

- » Beat Colorado for SIU's first win against a Power 5 school since 2008.
- » For the 2021 fall semester, Saluki Basketball earned a 3.526 team grade point average — the top GPA within the athletic department and the best term GPA in program history.
- » Named one of The Athletic's '40 under 40' — nation's top coaches under 40 years old. (Was also named one of ESPN's 40 under 40 in 2019>)

2020-21 (SECOND SEASON)

- » Snapped Butler's 59-game non-conference home court winning streak, which was the longest in the nation. Butler had not lost a non-conference home game since March 2012.
- » Started 7-0, the program's best start since 1947-48.
- » Seven-game winning streaks in back-to-back seasons (2019-20 and 2020-21) for the first time at SIU since 2005-06 and 2006-07.
- » HoopDirt's National Coach of the Week after SIU snapped Butler's 59-game non-conference home court winning streak.

2019-20 (FIRST SEASON)

- » Named one of ESPN's '40 under 40' — nation's top coaches under 40 years old.
- » Runner-up for 2020 Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year
- » Most MVC wins ever for team picked 10th preseason
- » Finalist for Joe B. Hall Award, given to the nation's top first-year head coach.
- » Team was picked last in the MVC preseason poll, and star guard Aaron Cook suffered a season-ending broken hand six games into the season. But SIU went 16-16 and finished 10-8 in the MVC — a league record for wins by a team that was picked last.
- » SIU ranked top-15 nationally and led the MVC in scoring defense.
- » SIU had a 10-game home court winning streak and a seven-game MVC winning streak, both of which were the longest for the program since Mullins was a player in 2008.

COACHING CAREER

- » After playing professionally in Europe, Mullins began his coaching career by joining Porter Moser's staff at Loyola in 2013.
- » He was an assistant on Loyola's Final Four team in 2018 and was promoted to Associate Head Coach after the season.
- » Loyola won back-to-back MVC titles in 2018 and 2019.
- » Conference Players of the Year under Mullins:
 - » 2020 MVC Freshman and Newcomer of the Year Marcus Domask
 - » 2019 MVC Player of the Year Marques Townes
 - » 2018 MVC Player of the Year Clayton Custer
 - » 2018 MVC Defensive Player of the Year Ben Richardson
 - » 2018 MVC Freshman of the Year Cameron Krutwig
 - » 2017 MVC Sixth Man of the Year Aundre Jackson
 - » 2014 MVC Newcomer and Freshman of the Year Milton Doyle

AS A PLAYER AT SIU

- » An SIU alum (2009), Mullins was the point guard on the 2007 "Floorburn U" Salukis that reached the Sweet Sixteen. That team finished the season ranked No. 11 nationally, SIU's highest ever national ranking.
- » Holds SIU's career record for assists, and ranks second in steals.
- » Two-time MVC Defensive Player of the Year (2008, 09)
- » A two-time Academic All-American, he graduated with a perfect 4.0 GPA in finance.
- » Inducted into the SIU Hall of Fame in 2018

2021-22 SALUKIS: THE BASICS

SIU is in its 108th season of basketball. The 2021-22 SIU team returns 97% of its scoring from last season and seven players who started 10+ games last season.

OUTSIDE EXPECTATIONS: The Salukis were picked fifth in the preseason Missouri Valley Conference poll of coaches, media and sports information directors. KenPom and Bart Torvik also rank SIU fifth, while Norlander ranks SIU sixth in the MVC.

WHAT WAS LOST: Not much. SIU returns its top-eight scorers from last season. SIU only lost three players who scored last season: Sekou Dembele (39 points in 19 games), Jakolby Long (15 points in 14 games), and Eric Butler (4 points in 8 games).

WHAT'S BACK: SIU returns 97% of its scoring and 96% of minutes played from last season's team. Seven players started at least 10 games last season. Marcus Domask was the 2020 MVC Newcomer and Freshman of the Year but missed the final 16 games of last season with a foot injury (he was averaging 16 points in 10 games before the injury last year). Domask (Second Team) and Lance Jones (Third Team) were named preseason All-MVC in 2021-22. Jones averaged 13.4 ppg last season and was named All-MVC Third Team.

Last season, seven of SIU's top-eight scorers were freshmen or sophomores (Domask, Jones, Harvey, Verplancken and Brown were sophomores; Filewich and Banks were freshmen).

WHAT'S NEW: SIU brought in a heralded recruiting class, led by Little Rock grad transfer Ben Coupet, who averaged in double-figures each of the last two seasons at Little Rock. Each of SIU's incoming freshmen (Troy D'Amico, Scottie Ebube, and Foster Wonders) was ranked among the top-10 players in his state (D'Amico and Ebube in Illinois; Wonders in Michigan).

Additionally, SIU center J.D. Muila is a newcomer to the court. Muila was on the team last year but missed the season with a knee injury. Muila was ranked the No. 24 junior college player in the nation in the 2019-20 class.

INJURY REPORT: Marcus Domask missed the final 16 games of last season with a foot injury but is fully healthy for the 2021-22 season ... Trent Brown has not played this season with a back injury ... Ben Harvey has not played since November 12 due to injury ... Dalton Banks broke his nose the day before the Alcorn State game but played through it with a mask ... Lance Jones dressed but did not play at Evansville due to an injury.

LATE-GAME MAGIC

- » Marcus Domask hit a game-winning 15-foot fadeaway with 0.6 seconds left in SIU's 54-52 win at Evansville (Dec. 1, 2021).
- » Domask hit a buzzer-beating game-winning 18-foot jumper to beat Missouri State as a freshman in the 2019-20 season.
- » SIU overcame a 17-point deficit to beat Alcorn State. Lance Jones made the game-winner in the final five seconds on an offensive rebound.
- » SIU is two games over .500 in games decided by five points or fewer under head coach Bryan Mullins (14-12).
- » SIU is 12-8 in its last 20 games decided by one possession or overtime.

DAWG BITES

- » SIU had seven-game winning streaks in each of Bryan Mullins first two seasons as head coach, the first time SIU had a seven-game winning streak in back-to-back seasons since 2005-06 and 2006-07, when Mullins played at SIU.
- » Bryan Mullins is one of 35 head coaches in Division I who is coaching at his alma mater.
- » Bryan Mullins is the third-youngest head coach in college basketball.
- » Trent Brown is wearing #24 because his dad, his two uncles, and his grandfather all wore #24.
- » Lance Jones never played point guard before arriving at SIU. He took over as SIU's starting point guard when Aaron Cook Jr. broke his hand at Murray State in his freshman season.
- » J.D. Muila and Kyler Filewich are the first Canadians to play for SIU men's basketball.
- » Steven Verplancken Jr. grew up in the Dominican Republic and moved to Belgium when he was 9 years old. His first language is Spanish.
- » Will Keller grew up in nearby Marion, Ill. (17 miles from Carbondale) and played junior college basketball at John A. Logan in even closer Carterville, Ill. (9 miles from Carbondale). He grew up coming to SIU games.
- » Chris Cross is the nephew of Joshua Cross, who played for Bruce Weber at SIU (1998-01). Cross's paternal grandparents are from Carbondale. His father, Joe, played basketball at Illinois.
- » Head coach Bryan Mullins and assistant coach Brendan Mullins are brothers. They are the only brothers coaching together in Division I basketball.

DOMASK, JONES — PRESEASON ALL-MVC

- » Marcus Domask and Lance Jones were named to the preseason All-MVC teams. Domask was named to the Second Team and Jones was named to the third team.
- » Domask was the 2020 MVC Freshman of the Year and Newcomer of the Year, along with Second Team All-MVC. Last year, Domask was limited to 10 games due to a foot injury.
- » Jones was named Third Team All-MVC last season after averaging 13.4 points per game. Jones led the MVC in 3-point field goal percentage.

SALUKI BASKETBALL LINGO

- » **THREE RULES:** (1) Bring your best every day, (2) Trust the work, and (3) Own the moments.
 - » **"KEEP YOUR CHIP":** The chip on your shoulder. No matter how much success a team or an individual has, keep your chip.
 - » **FLOORBURN U:** SIU's defensive-minded teams in the mid-2000s earned six-straight NCAA Tournament appearances (5 by at-large bid), earning SIU the moniker "Floorburn U."
 - » **LEAVE A LEGACY:** Head coach Bryan Mullins honored every member of every SIU team that has made an NCAA Tournament, and NIT, or won a conference championship on a graphic that players walk past on their way from the locker room to the court.
 - » **CHARLES HELLENY TIP-OFF CLASSIC:** SIU's first Division I game each year is denoted the "Charles Helleny Tip-Off Classic," in memory of "Mr. Southern Illinois" Charles Helleny, the long-time SIU fan and supporter who passed away in August 2019. Charles (a 1957 SIU alum) donated the fourth-largest gift in Saluki Athletics history
 - » **SALUKI STRIP:** About 2-3 times per season, the SIU swimming and diving team leads the Dawg Pound (SIU's student section) by showing up to home games in their competition Speedos and swimsuits.
- ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE**
- » For the 2021 fall semester, Saluki Basketball earned a 3.526 team grade point average — the top GPA within the athletic department and the best term GPA in program history.
 - » All three program term GPA records (Fall, Spring, and Summer) have been set since Bryan Mullins became head coach.
 - » SIU earned the NABC Academic Excellence Award for the 2019-20 season.
 - » Last year, SIU senior center Barret Benson was named Academic All-District.
 - » SIU has produced 101 Academic All-Americans across all its sports, which is the most of any MVC school and among the national leaders.

RESPECT THE VALLEY

- » The Missouri Valley Conference is one of the most underrated basketball conferences in the country. The MVC has 20 NCAA Tournament wins since 2012. Two MVC teams have advanced to the Final Four in that span.
- » The MVC is 11-1 in first-round NCAA Tournament games since 2012.
- » The MVC vs. Power Six conference opponents has been nearly a toss-up in the NCAA Tournament since 1994 (MVC has won 44% of the games (31-39)).
- » The MVC has produced nine Sweet Sixteen teams since 2002. Years: 2002, 06 (2), 07, 10, 13, 15, 18, 21.



PROGRAM HISTORY

- » SIU has a rich basketball tradition. SIU has won more MVC championships and been to more NCAA Tournaments than any other member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- » Walt Frazier, named one of the NBA's 50 Greatest Players, played at SIU. With Frazier leading the way, SIU won the NIT in 1967. Frazier and his teammates came back to Carbondale in 2017 for a 50-year celebration of the achievement.
- » Most recently, SIU is known for advancing to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07 (Five at-large bids). In that stretch, the Salukis made the Sweet Sixteen twice (2002, 07).
- » Bruce Weber started the run and was SIU's head coach for the first two of those NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 2002 Sweet Sixteen team. Weber went on to coach at Illinois and is the current head coach at Kansas State.
- » Matt Painter coached SIU in 2004 before leaving for Purdue, where he is still the head coach. Chris Lowery took over for Painter and guided SIU to three more NCAA Tournaments, including the 2007 Sweet Sixteen. Lowery was inducted into the SIU Hall of Fame in 2019.
- » SIU's current head coach, Bryan Mullins, was a point guard on the 2006 and 2007 NCAA Tournament teams.
- » Prior to the run in the 2000s, Rich Herrin led the Salukis to three-straight NCAA Tournaments in the mid-1990s (1993-95). The Salukis won the MVC Tournament ("Arch Madness") in all three seasons, which remains the MVC's only three-peat at Arch Madness. Lowery was the point guard on the 1993 and 94 NCAA Tournament teams.

MIKE REIS – RADIO "DEAN OF THE VALLEY"

Mike Reis enters his 43rd year as the radio play-by-play Voice of the Salukis. He is tied with Bradley's Dave Snell for longest active tenure in the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks seventh overall.

FAMILIAR FACE JOINS REIS ON RADIO

Rodney Watson joined Hall of Famer Mike Reis on the radio in 2020-21. Coach Watson was a 21-year assistant at SIU, during which time SIU went to nine NCAA Tournaments, two Sweet Sixteens, and 430 wins. He went on to become the head coach at Southern Indiana, where he retired as that program's all-time winningest head coach. Watson will divide games as analyst with Hall of Famer Greg Starrick, who is in his 38th year calling games with Reis.

WALT FRAZIER – THE REST OF THE STORY

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season and was named one of the 50 greatest basketball players of all-time by the NBA in 1996.

ABOUT SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis. Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities. Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.

WHAT'S A SALUKI?

Salukis are the oldest purebred dogs in the world, with records dating back to 3600 BC. The Saluki is an ancient Egyptian hunting dog, and has been known to outrun Greyhounds as the fastest dogs in the world, reaching 43 mph. So why is it SIU's mascot? The southern Illinois region is nicknamed "Little Egypt." The "Little Egypt" moniker came from a 19th century drought in northern Illinois led citizens to travel to southern Illinois seeking corn and wheat, a parallel of the biblical story Jacob's brothers flocking to Egypt during a famine. The names of several southern Illinois towns have Egyptian roots: Cairo, Metropolis, Thebes, Dongola, Palestine, Lebanon, New Athens, Sparta, and Karnak.

» Prior to Domask's injury, SIU started the 2020-21 season 7-0, the program's best start to a season since 1947-48. The Salukis beat Butler 76-73 at Hinkle Fieldhouse, ending Butler's 59-game nonconference home court winning streak that stretched back to 2012. Domask scored 26 points in that win.

HEAD COACHES WHO GOT THEIR START AT SIU

Bryan Mullins is the latest in a long line of young head coaches who got their first Division I head coaching job at SIU. (Age at hiring in parentheses.)

Harry Gallatin (31), 1959-62 Went 79-35 in four years at SIU (three conference titles) ... Left SIU to coach in the NBA (St. Louis Hawks, and then the New York Knicks for two seasons) ... Member of the Basketball Hall of Fame and College Basketball Hall of Fame.

Jack Hartman (37), 1963-70: Coached Walt Frazier at SIU and won 1967 NIT ... Went on to coach at Kansas State for 16 years (K-State has a "Jack Hartman Drive" near its arena) ... Went 589-279 overall (142-64 at SIU) ... Won 1981 NABC National Coach of the Year.

Rich Herrin (53), 1986-98: Before SIU, had coached at a local high school (Benton HS) ... Won 225 games at SIU, two regular-season MVC titles, and 3 MVC tournament titles ... Took SIU to 3 NCAA Tournaments and 4 NITs.

Bruce Weber (42), 1999-03: Had been an 18-year assistant under Gene Keady at Purdue ... Took SIU to two MVC titles and two NCAA Tournaments (2002 Sweet Sixteen) before leaving for Illinois, and now at Kansas State ... 2005 National Coach of the Year (led Illini to 37-2, national runner-up) ... Nearing his 500th career win as a head coach.

Matt Painter (33), 2004: Coached at SIU for one season (took over for Bruce Weber) and led SIU to at-large berth to NCAA Tournament before becoming coach-in-waiting at Purdue ... In Painter's only season at SIU, the Salukis went 25-5 overall, 17-1 in the MVC (won conference title), and were ranked as high as #15 nationally.

Chris Lowery (32), 2005-12: Two-time MVC Coach of the Year ... Led SIU to three NCAA Tournaments (2 at-large selections, 2007 Sweet Sixteen) ... His 2007 team finished the season ranked #11 nationally (AP) ... Now associate head coach at K-State with Bruce Weber.

Bryan Mullins (32), 2020-pres. Runner-up for 2020 MVC Coach of the Year in his first season ... Finalist for Joe B. Hall Award in 2020 (best first-year head coach in the nation) ... Named one of ESPN's '40 under 40' coaches.
