OPENING TIP

Southern Illinois celebrates its 112th year of basketball. The Salukis are participating in the Jacksonville Classic MTE and face off with the Delaware Blue Hens. The second game is Monday against the UAB Blazers.

QUICK HITS

- The Salukis are led by second-year head coach Scott Nagy. Nagy brings 31 years of head coaching experience to Carbondale and had recorded 14 straight winning seasons while at the helm of both South Dakota State and Wright State before a 14-19 first season at SIU.
- The Salukis return six players from last year's squad in Rolyns Aligbe, Damien Mayo Jr., Jorge Moreno, Drew Steffe, Davion Sykes, and Jaheem Webber. SIU added eight players this offseason, including Prince Aligbe, Caden Hawkins, Jalen Haynes, Quel'Ron House, Daniel Pauliukonis, Max Pikaar, Isaiah Stafford, and Luke Walsh.
- Quel'Ron House and Isaiah Stafford were included on the MVC's Players to Watch List.

LAST TIME OUT

The Salukis fell to North Dakota State, 92-85, in Fargo. The Bison made nine of their first 12 shots from 3-point range, and finished going 16-for-35 from the beyond the arc. It was both the second-most 3-pointers made and attempted against the Salukis in SIU history. For Southern Illinois, Quel'Ron House led the team in scoring for the fourth-straight game, notching 23 points. Davion Sykes put in 14 and grabbed seven rebounds. Rolyns Aligbe and Isaiah Stafford each scored 12, while Aligbe added seven boards of his own. Damari Wheeler-Thomas led the Bison with 24 points.

FAMILY MATTERS

- Prince and Rolyns Aligbe are brothers from Minneapolis, Minnesota. Rolyns, the younger brother, came to SIU in 2024-25 as a true freshman. Prince joins this season after averaging 7.8 points while playing 32 games, including 29 starts, at Seton Hall. Rolyns is a sophomore, and Prince is a senior.
- Caden Hawkins is the son of former SIU sharpshooter and coach, Shane Hawkins. Caden, a Carverville High School graduate, joins SIU after helping John A. Logan College to a 24-10 record last season. He made 22 starts for JALC, averaging 7.9 points and 4.1 assists while shooting 42 percent from beyond the arc. Shane, a Pinckneyville High School graduate, is the Salukis' all-time leader in 3-point shooting.

NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Quel'Ron House was named the MVC Newcomer of the Week on Monday, Nov. 17, before the game at North Dakota State. The 6-foot sophomore point guard transferred to SIU from Jacksonville State this offseason. The award was recognition for his 44-minute, 22-point effort in an overtime loss against the Nevada Wolf Pack on Nov. 12.

NEW DAWGS ON THE BLOCK

Although eight new players is a far cry from the 12 that Coach Scott Nagy had to bring in before his first season at SIU, the Salukis do have new faces in key places. Isaiah Stafford (Valparaiso) Quel'Ron House (Jacksonville State), Prince Aligbe (Seton Hall), Max Pikaar (Saint Louis University), and Caden Hawkins (John A. Logan) are all transfers, while, Jalen Haynes, Daniel Pauliukonis, and Luke Walsh are true freshmen. Pauliukonis and Walsh will spend the 2025-26 season redshirting.

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH FOR THE SALUKIS

One thing that Southern Illinois does not lack on the bench is experience within the coaching staff. SIU boasts over 100 years of total coaching experience between six coaches, as well as 60 years of head coaching experience between Scott Nagy (31) and Steve Hawkins (29). Nagy (593) and Hawkins (453) have won a combined 1,046 games while at the help of their programs respectively.

LOOKING AT DELAWARE

- Delaware earned its first win Tuesday night, beating Saint Peter's 81-70. The Blue Hens (1-3) got 18 points from 6-foot-5 guard Justyn Fernandez in his season debut. Forwards Macon Emory (6-8) and Tyler Houser (6-9) scored 17 each, while guard Christian Bliss added 15 points, seven rebounds and five assists. Emory also grabbed 11 boards.
- Delaware shot 11-of-21 from 3-point range, including 8-of-13 in the first half, and outrebounded Saint Peter's 38-26.
- The Blue Hens have a KenPom rating of 219; SIU ranks No. 131.

NCAA NAGY, THE PLAYER

As a player at NCAA Division II Delta State, Scott Nagy was a part of two Regional Championships with the Statesmen in 1987 and 1988. A guard from 1985-1988, Nagy started 122 straight games and is Delta State's career assist leader (549) and the program leader for most assists in a season (234, 1986-87). The Gulf South Conference Freshman of the Year in 1985, he was the Gulf South's Athlete of the Year in 1988, and a three-time member of the Gulf South All-Academic Team (1986, 1987, 1988).

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

SIU head coach Scott Nagy has made five trips to the NCAA Tournament, a place his father was very familiar with. Dick Nagy spent 33 years in coaching, mostly as a top assistant. He worked for the legendary Lou Henson at Illinois for 17 years, helping the Illini reach the NCAA tourney 14 times and advance to the Final Four in 1989. He also was on the bench for Wright State's Horizon League foe UIC when it won the Midwestern Collegiate Conference in 1998.

RESPECT THE VALLEY

- » Notably, MVC teams are 13-4 in their first game in the NCAA Tournament dating back to 2012. The league has now combined for 21 wins in the NCAA Tournament in the past 11 NCAA championships and has earned multiple bids 16 times since 1994.
- » From 2012 to 2019, MVC teams won 10-straight, first-round games in the NCAA Tournament, tying a league record that was set from 1941-55.
- » MVC teams have 43 total wins in the NCAA Tournament since 1994 with 12 Sweet 16 trips and two Final Four appearances. Notably, 32 of 43 victories have been against Power conferences, and the league has a winning record in that span against Big 12 and SEC schools.
- » During the last decade, the MVC has ranked in the Top 10 nine times for all conferences in average home attendance.

PROGRAM HISTORY

- » SIU has a rich basketball tradition. SIU has won more MVC championships and been to more NCAA Tournaments than any other member of the Missouri Valley Conference.
- » Walt Frazier, named one of the NBA's 50 Greatest Players, played at SIU. With Frazier leading the way, SIU won the NIT in 1967. Frazier and his teammates came back to Carbondale in 2017 for a 50-year celebration of the achievement.
- » Most recently, SIU is known for advancing to six-straight NCAA Tournaments from 2002-07 (Five at-large bids). In that stretch, the Salukis made the Sweet Sixteen twice (2002, 07).

- » Bruce Weber started the run and was SIU's head coach for the first two of those NCAA Tournament appearances, including the 2002 Sweet Sixteen team. Weber went on to coach at Illinois and Kansas State.
- » Matt Painter coached SIU in 2004 before leaving for Purdue, where he is still the head coach. Chris Lowery took over for Painter and guided SIU to three more NCAA Tournaments, including the 2007 Sweet Sixteen. Lowery was inducted into the SIU Hall of Fame in 2019.
- » Before the run in the 2000s, Rich Herrin led the Salukis to three-straight NCAA Tournaments in the mid-1990s (1993-95). The Salukis won the MVC Tournament in all three seasons, which remains the MVC's only three-peat at Arch Madness. Lowery was the point guard on the 1993 and 94 NCAA Tournament teams.

WALT FRAZIER — THE REST OF THE STORY

Most people know that Southern's most famous basketball alum is Walt Frazier (1964-67). What they don't know is the story of how the Atlanta native ended up in Carbondale.

Basketball was Frazier's second-best sport in high school. He was offered a scholarship to play quarterback at Georgia Tech, but he didn't want to play football. Frazier went on a recruiting visit to SIU in 1963 and met with AD Donald Boydston, who was progressive about recruiting minorities during a time when southern schools rarely recruited them. According to Boydston, Frazier didn't say one word the whole trip, but called shortly after he took the train back to Atlanta to say he was enrolling at SIU.

Frazier was dismissed from the team for academic issues after his sophomore year. He went back to Atlanta and got a job doing manual labor. Frazier called in August of 1965 and asked if he could come back. He was not eligible for a scholarship, so he paid his own way and sat out his junior year, making the Dean's List. He played on the practice team, and sometimes they would beat the varsity. The 1966-67 storybook season saw Frazier lead the team to the NIT National Championship, beating Marquette in the finals. He turned pro after the season and was named one of the 50 greatest basketball players of all-time by the NBA in 1996.

ABOUT SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY

Carbondale is located in the southern tip of the state — about a five-hour drive south of Chicago and two hours southeast of St. Louis. Many of SIU's alums are concentrated in those two cities. Since moving to Division I in 1968, SIU has been to the NCAA Tournament 10 times, including Sweet 16 appearances in 1977, 2002 and 2007. The Salukis have made nine NIT appearances.

WHAT'S A SALUKI?

Salukis are the oldest purebred dogs in the world, with records dating back to 3600 BC. The Saluki is an ancient Egyptian hunting dog, and has been known to outrun Greyhounds as the fastest dogs in the world, reaching 43 mph. So why is it SIU's mascot? The southern Illinois region is nicknamed "Little Egypt." The "Little Egypt" moniker came from a 19th century drought in northern Illinois led citizens to travel to southern Illinois seeking corn and wheat, a parallel of the biblical story Jacob's brothers flocking to Egypt during a famine. The names of several southern Illinois towns have Egyptian roots: Cairo, Metropolis, Thebes, Dongola,

Palestine, Lebanon, New Athens, Sparta, and Karnak.

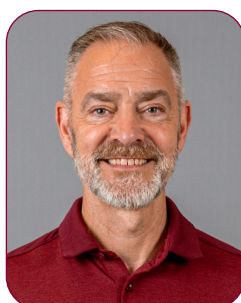

SCOTT NAGY

HEAD COACH // SECOND SEASON

Southern Illinois University has named Scott Nagy (Pronounced NAY-gee) the 15th men's basketball coach in the program's history on March 28, 2024.

With three decades of head coaching experience at Wright State and South Dakota State, Nagy has a career 593-353 (.627) record, has led his teams to 14 consecutive winning seasons, and ranks in the top 20 in wins among active Division I head coaches.

In eight years at Wright State, Nagy was named Horizon League Coach of the Year three times, led the Raiders to 20-plus wins in five seasons, and tallied 18 wins in the shortened 2021 campaign. He guided WSU to three Horizon League regular-season championships, two Horizon League tournament championships, a pair of NCAA Tournament berths, and one NIT bid.

In his first season at Wright State in 2017, he led the program to its first 20-win season since 2008. Building on that success in his second season, Nagy took the Raiders to their first NCAA Tournament in a decade and earned his first Horizon League Coach of the Year Honor.

Nagy repeated as Coach of the Year in year three, taking the Raiders to the NIT after tying for the league's regular season title.

In 2019, he won a school-record 25 games on his way to WSU's first outright League title in program history, while earning his third-consecutive Horizon League Coach of the Year award.

He led Wright State to a Horizon League tournament championship in 2022 – with wins over No. 1-seeded Cleveland State and No. 3 Northern Kentucky. The Raiders won their First Four game in Dayton over Bryan before falling to No. 1 Arizona. The win over Bryant marked the first NCAA Tournament win for WSU in the history of the program.

Nagy spent 21 seasons at South Dakota State and guided the program's transition to Division I. He led the SDSU to 20-win seasons in eight of nine seasons while at the Division II level, including eight postseason appearances.

During that time, Nagy recorded an overall record of 410-240 (.631). After SDSU moved to the Summit League in 2007, Nagy's teams went 175-119 (.595), earning berths in the NCAA tournament in 2012, 2013 and 2016, and an NIT berth in 2015.

In his final season at SDSU, he led the Jackrabbits to a 26-8 record, winning the Summit League regular-season and post-season tournament championships.

NAGY RECORD VS OPPONENTS
