SAN JOSÉ STATE UNIVERSITY FOOTBALL FACT SHEET (GAME #8 - Colorado State)

Upcoming game: San José State vs. Colorado State

Saturday, November 1, 2014, Spartan Stadium, San José, Calif. 4:00 p.m. (PT), CBS Sports Network

San José State record: 3-4, 2-1 Mountain West. The Spartans' two-game winning streak ended with a 41-31 loss at Navy on October 25.

Colorado State record: 7-1, 3-1 Mountain West. The Rams extended their winning streak to six in a row after hosting a 45-31 win over Wyoming in the 105th Border War. Colorado State's six-game winning streak is the longest among conference teams heading into games on November 1.

San José State head coach Ron Caragher: In his second season as the San José State head coach. Has a record of 9-10 with the Spartans. Overall, he is in his eighth season as a major college head coach with a 53-32 record. He is 1-0 as a head coach against Colorado State. Caragher's first six seasons as a head coach were at the University of San Diego.

Colorado State head coach Jim McElwain: In his third season at Colorado State. Has a major college head coaching record of 18-15, all with the Rams. He is 0-2 as a head coach against San José State.

San José State-Colorado State series: The Spartans lead the series, 4-3. San José State has wins in the last three meetings between these teams including a 34-27 triumph at Colorado State last year. The Rams' last win in the series was a 55-20 victory on October 11, 1996 in Spartan Stadium - the only time in three visits to San Jose Colorado State left with the victory.

Frontrunners in the Mountain West: San José State and Colorado State are among the top two teams in their respective divisions within the Mountain West. The Spartans enter the weekend's play in second place with a 2-1 record and 0.5 games behind San Diego State in the West Division. San José State presently is in control of its destiny for a West Division championship and a berth in the Mountain West Championship game on Saturday, December 6.

Colorado State is tied with Boise State for first in the Mountain Division with a 3-1 mark. The Rams lost at Boise State, 37-24, on September 6.

Former Spartans returning to Spartan Stadium: Three Colorado State assistant coaches once were members of the San José State coaching staff. Colorado State offensive coordinator Dave Baldwin is the most notable. Baldwin was a Spartan assistant coach for four seasons (1980-83) and the San José State head coach for four seasons (1997-2000). Baldwin was the only Spartan head coach to direct the program to a winning season from 1993 through 2005 when San José State posted a 7-5 win-loss record in 2000. As a head coach, he had an 18-27 win-loss record.

Colorado State co-defensive coordinator Al Simmons was a graduate assistant in charge of the cornerbacks during the 2005 season. Special teams coordinator Jeff Hammerschmidt had a similar role with the Spartans in 2007. Both Simmons and Hammerschmidt were hired by Dick Tomey.

For the first time, San José State has four network affiliates.

Game Presentation

Forty-three San Jose State studentathletes from 2013-14 will be recognized as recipients of a Mountain West Scholar-Athlete Award for maintaining a cumulative grade-point average of at least 3.50 and being an active member of an intercollegiate team. Wide receiver **Tim Crawley** is the first Spartan football player to earn the academic award.

Ron Caragher Radio Show:

The weekly one-hour Ron Caragher Radio Show airs on KLIV (1590 AM, San José), Wednesdays, at 8:00 p.m. The 60-minute show is taped Wednesday, 5:00 p.m., at Willow Street Pizza in San José's Willow Glen district.

Ron Caragher on KRTY FM:

San José State head coach Ron Caragher also is heard weekly on KRTY (95.3, San José), Tuesdays at 6:30 a.m. Morning show hosts Gary Scott Thomas and Julie Stevens host the Spartans' coach. **Top-20 nationally-ranked in seven defensive categories:** San José State begins the week nationally-ranked in the top-25 in six defensive categories. For the fourth week in a row, the Spartans are the national leaders in passing yards allowed and fewest passing touchdowns. Then #5-Auburn was the first team to pass for a touchdown against the Spartans this season.

National leader in fewest passing yards allowed: In games played through October 25, San José State is the national leader in passing yards allowed (89.0). The Spartans are the only Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) team yielding less than 100 passing yards a game. In the last four games, San Jose State opponents combined to pass for 362 yards - an average of 72.4 yards per game.

One pass completion allowed - a 2014 FBS least: In games played through October 18, Minnesota's one pass completion in its win over San José State was the fewest by a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) team this season.

In the Spartans' last five games, opponents completed 41.6 percent of their passes.

Defensive highlights: San José State heads into the Colorado State game ranked 22nd nationally in total defense yielding 336.7 yards per game. In their first three Mountain West games, the Spartans limited Nevada (256), UNLV (221) and Wyoming (277) to their season low total offense figures. UNLV gained its fewest yards in a game since a November 24, 2012 loss at Hawai'i when the Rebels gained 203 yards in a 48-10 loss.

Gray moves into top-five: Joe Gray is one of five Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) quarter-backs to complete at least 70 percent of his passes in games played through October 25.

Since taking over as the Spartans' starting quarterback for the September 27 game vs. Nevada, Gray completed 70.7 percent of his passes (118-of-167).

Total offense high: San José State's 542 yards of total offense in the UNLV game were a season high and the first time in 2014 the Spartans gained at least 500 yards. The previous team total offense season high was 446 yards against Nevada (9/27).

In the last four games, San Jose State is averaging 470.2 yards per contest compared to 326.3 yards per outing the first three games of the season.

Spartans 11-3 when rushing for 150: San José State rushed for a season-high 277 yards in the October 4 UNLV win. It was the third time in 2014 the Spartans ran for at least 150 yards. In the opener, San José State gained 150 yards rushing in the North Dakota win. Since 2011, the Spartans are 11-3 in games in which they rushed for 150 or more yards.

Tyler Winston becomes #26: Wide receiver **Tyler Winston** became the 26th San Jose State player to catch at least 100 passes in a career.

Presently with 106 career receptions, Winston reached the milestone in his 16th major college football game on the first play in the overtime win at Wyoming. His 101st reception turned out to be the game-winning touchdown in the 27-20 overtime victory.

The late **Guy Liggins** (1986-87) is the only other San José State player to reach the 100 mark in as few as 16 games. Liggins, a community college transfer played two seasons for the Spartans and finished with 149 career receptions.

Unconventional: San José State has a 2-5 record in overtime games. Both overtime wins came on the road and involved the Spartans losing the cion toss, being assigned the ball first in the first overtime, scoring and holding off the opposition on downs.

BYU, Boise State, New Mexico State also are playing road games in the four continental U.S. time zones. Utah State and Wyoming have road contests in four different time zones with a road game at Hawai'i.

Ending a spell: The 27-20 overtime win at Wyoming marked the first time since 1993 a San José State squad won on the road following a bye week. The Spartans were 0-11 in road games following a bye before topping Wyoming.

Austin Lopez Mountain West Special Teams Player of the Week: Placekicker **Austin Lopez** was the first San Jose State player to receive Mountain West Player of the Week recognition in 2014 for four field goals and three PAT's in the 33-10 win over UNLV.

Lopez tied one San José State single-game and set three University career records in the UNLV game. Lopez matched the school record of four field goals in a game for the second time in his career. He broke the San José State career records for most field goals (43), most kick-scoring points (238) and overall scoring (238).

Tyler Ervin ties school record: Tyler Ervin tied a San José State career record for special teams touchdowns by returns when he scored a touchdown on a 40-yard punt return against North Dakota. Ervin is the Spartans' career leader for kickoff returned for a touchdown with three and now has a punt return for a six-pointer giving him four.

At San José State, he scored touchdowns four different ways - rushing (3), pass receiving (2), kickoff returns (3) and punt returns (1).

Trestin George (2000-03), who played in the Arena Football League, and Walt Roberts (1962-64), who played six seasons with three NFL teams, share the school record scoring a touchdown five of the six ways (rushing, pass receiving, fumble, interception, punt return and kickoff return).

Ervin is the second Spartan with four career punt and kickoff returns for a touchdown. Jimmie Lassiter (1970-72) was the first with two punt and two kickoff returns for TDs.

San José State sets team passing record in opener: San José State tied its single-game team record for passing accuracy in the North Dakota win completing 23-of-26 passes. Starter Blake Jurich was 22-of-25 and Joe Gray was 1-of-1 for the Spartans. In 2008, San José State also completed 23-of-26 passes in a 23-10 loss at Stanford.

Tyler Winston sets school mark: Wide receiver Tyler Winston caught 10 passes for 96 yards and two TDs in the 42-10 win over North Dakota. Including the last two games of 2013 against Navy and Fresno State, respectively, Winston became the first San José State player to catch 10 or more passes in three consecutive games. The 2013 Mountain West Freshman of the Year caught 10 passes each against Navy and Fresno State.

A first since 2007 in the offensive line: Redshirt freshmen Jeremiah Kolone and Nate **Velichko** became the first pair of freshmen to start at the two offensive guard positions since the 2007 season when they were the starting guards in the North Dakota win.

13 first time starters in 2014: After seven games, 13 Spartans made their first career starts on either offense or defense this season. Freshman Michael Carrizosa also took over the punting chores for San José State in 2014
