HAWK HEADLINES

- Saint Joseph's will compete in the Atlantic 10 Men's Soccer Championship for the first time since 1994 and for the third time in program history, starting play on Thursday morning.
- The seventh-seeded Hawks will face second-seeded George Mason at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday. The Patriots defeated SJU in overtime, 1-0, at Sweeney Field earlier this season.
- Saint Joseph's reached the A-10 title game in 1993, led by All-Championship Team selection and current head coach Don D'Ambra.
- With three A-10 wins this season, the Hawks notched more than two league wins in the same season for the first time since 2007.

LAST TIME OUT...

...Saint Joseph's clinched its first postseason birth since 1994 with a 1-0 win at Fordham on Sunday. Sophomore midfielder **Tim Lazorko** scored his fourth goal of the season in the 23rd minute. Redshirt senior goalkeeper **Andrew D'Ottavi** and junior forward **Alex Critzos** were both credited with assists on the play, and D'Ottavi made four saves to post his sixth blank sheet of the season.

The Hawks also won their must-win match on Friday at George Washington as Saint Joseph's rallied for the match's first three goals in a 3-1 victory over the Colonials. Senior midfielder **Jimmy Reilly**, Critzos, and Lazorko scored one goal apiece while Lazorko assisted on Reilly's tally and Critzos and junior forward **Mike Glazer** assisted on Lazorko's goal. D'Ottavi made two saves in the win.

For their efforts, Lazorko and D'Ottavi earned weekly accolades. Lazorko was named both the Atlantic 10 and Philadelphia Soccer Six Player of the Week while D'Ottavi nabbed Philadelphia Soccer Six Defender of the Week distinction.



HIGH-FLYING HAWKS: Saint Joseph's will compete in the Atlantic 10 Men's Soccer Championship for the first time since 1994 and for the third time in program history, starting play on Thursday morning. Having not made the postseason in 19 years, Thursday's A-10 Championship Tournament match will be a first for all 30 members of the squad.

"DONNING" A FAMILIAR FACE: Current head coach **Don D'Ambra** is no stranger to the A-10 postseason, having led the Hawks to their first program appearance in 1993. That year, the Hawks concluded the season ranked second in the conference with a 12-6-1 overall record and 4-3-0 league record and, after defeating third-seeded Temple, 2-1, in the semifinals, advanced to the final match against top-seeded Rutgers. Unfortunately for the Hawks, Rutgers took the match, 3-0. D'Ambra was named to the All-Championship Team en route to being named the 1993 A-10 Performer of the Year. In 1994, a year after D'Ambra's graduation, third-seeded Saint Joseph's (10-7-2, 5-1-1 A-10) fell to second-seeded Rutgers, 4-2, in double-overtime of the semifinals.

LAZORKO ON THE LOOSE: Sophomore midfielder **Tim Lazorko** has been phenomenal in conference play, averaging 2.0 points per game in A-10 matches that the Hawks have won. From two goals and two assists, Lazorko owns six of the squad's 19 points in A-10 action and boasts a .417 SOG percentage in league play, landing five of his 12 shots on net. In a pair of must-win games this past weekend, Lazorko exploded for five points (2G, 1A) en route to being named the Atlantic 10 and Philadelphia Soccer Six Player of the Week.

ALL ABOUT ALEX: Junior forward **Alex Critzos** notched the match-winner in Saint Joseph's 3-1 victory over George Washington on Friday and one of two match-winning assists in SJU's 1-0 win over Fordham on Sunday, leading the Hawks to their first Atlantic 10 Championship Tournament appearance in 19 years.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: On October 27, Saint Joseph's downed #24 VCU, 1-0, to earn its first win over a nationally-ranked team in recent history. Senior forward **Ryan McFadden** tallied the goal in the 85th minute and redshirt senior goalkeeper **Andrew D'Ottavi** made four saves between the pipes as the Hawks picked up their first A-10 win of the season.

COACH'S CORNER: Head coach **Don D'Ambra** understands the feeling of heading to the A-10 postseason, having been a senior on the 1994 squad that made the program's most recent appearance 19 years ago.

"Seeing them have some success is the best part," said D'Ambra on Monday afternoon. "The program hasn't been there in a long time. They're excited to be a part of the group that got there for the first time in a long time."

STANDOUT SENIORS: Eight of SJU's 10 seniors have seen time in more than half of the Hawks' 18 regular-season matches this season, and goalkeeper **Andrew D'Ottavi**, defenders **Brendan Reilly** and **Brian Reynolds** and midfielders **Pat McGlynn** and **Jimmy Reilly** have been consistent starters. B. Reilly and Reynolds played full matches on the back line in SJU's 1-0 wins over #24 VCU and Fordham and 3-1 victory over George Washington while D'Ottavi sports a 1.61 GAA and .698 saves percentage against A-10 teams. D'Ottavi, McGlynn, J. Reilly, Reynolds, and senior forward **Ryan McFadden** have combined for 13 of SJU's points on the season, including seven of the squad's 16 assists.

MARYLAND MAGIC: The junior attacking trio of **Alex Critzos** (Annapolis), **Mike Glazer** (Ellicott City), and **Jake Nelson** (Jessup) hail from the Old Line State. Combined, they own 19 of SJU's points, including eight of the Hawks' 19 goals. The trio dominated in SJU's 3-3 draw at Howard, each recording one goal apiece in the tie.

DOMINANT DEFENDER: Redshirt senior goalkeeper **Andrew D'Ottavi** has put together a phenomenal senior season and currently sports a 1.45 GAA and .716 saves percentage off of 68 saves and just 27 goals allowed in 1679:40. The veteran netminder ranks fourth all-time in career saves on Hawk Hill with 361 and ties for third in all-time career shutouts with 11. D'Ottavi boasts six shutouts on the season, including crucial wins over Temple and #24 VCU, and has been named the Philadelphia Soccer Six Defender of the Week three times this year.

HAWK HONOREES

A number of Saint Joseph's men's soccer players have earned awards during the 2013 season. Atlantic 10 weekly award winners are selected by the conference office, while Philadelphia Soccer Six weekly award winners are chosen by the Soccer Six office.

HOME SWEET HOME: Sweeney Field serves as the home of Saint Joseph's men's soccer. Previously named Finnesey Field, the venue has served as the home of Hawk Athletic teams for more than 80 years and is in the process of significantly increasing the seating capacity for SJU's varsity lacrosse and soccer programs. The new name recognizes the contributions of Sean S. Sweeney '94 (MBA), a member of the University's Board of Trustees and the lead benefactor to the renovation project. The current expansion includes the addition of 1,200 permanent seats to the hillside nearest to the University's iconic Barbelin Hall as well as the addition of 1,100 portable seats on the opposite side of the field, increasing total seating capacity to 3,000. In addition, the facility will include a new state of the art press box and enhanced sound system.

CALLING ALL HAWKS: 30 Hawks from eight different states comprise the 2013 roster. A majority of the squad hails from New Jersey (12) and Pennsylvania (11), while the junior offensive trio of **Alex Critzos**, **Mike Glazer**, and **Jake Nelson** come from Maryland and freshmen **Sam Irvin**, **Cameron Kadkhodai**, **Coupar Lipp**, and **Mori Diane** represent Alabama, Louisiana, Massachusetts, and Virginia, respectively.

(T)WINNING!: Senior twins **Brendan and Colin Reilly** have both had sensational years in their final seasons on Hawk Hill. A defensive captain who averages 95 minutes per match, Brendan has anchored a back line that has posted six clean sheets, including 1-0 wins over Temple and #24 VCU. Colin owns a .500 SOG percentage and has been consistently strong on the attacking half of the field in 12 matches this season, earning the starting nods against Cornell and #24 VCU. The Reillys hail from Cinnaminson, N.J. and are products of Holy Cross High School.

CAPTAINS OF THE SHIP: This season's trio of captains exemplifies the definitions of both commitment and consistency. Redshirt senior goalkeeper Andrew D'Ottavi and senior midfielder Pat McGlynn are serving their second years as captains of the squad. Joining them in 2013 is senior defender Brendan Reilly.

FAMILY AFFAIR: Six Hawks have relatives who either played for or attended Saint Joseph's. Senior midfielder Jimmy Reilly's parents both graduated from Saint Joseph's while senior goalkeeper Sam Pozzessere's older brothers Nick and Rocco were Hawks stars in the late 2000s. Senior midfielder Pat McGlynn's older brother played for the men's soccer squad and junior defender Brandon Stevis' older sister played for the women's team. Sophomore midfielder Tim Lazorko and senior forward Ryan McFadden are both related to former SJU men's basketball alum. Currently, Brendan and Colin Reilly are senior twins who have both competed for the Hawks for all four years of their collegiate careers.
