
## **LANGSTON GALLOWAY**



## Senior • Guard • 6-2 • 200 Baton Rouge, La. **Christian Life Academy**

2012-13: All-Big 5 Second Team selection... Team captain... Ranked second on the Hawks in scoring with 13.8 ppg... Averaged 11.6 ppg in A-10 games... Topped team in three-pointers made (80) and three-point percentage (39.4)... Ranked fourth in the league in minutes played (35.5 per game), sixth in three-point field goals (2.5) and 15th in scoring... Started all 32 games... Named to the inaugural Allstate NABC Good Works Team for his community involvement and traveled to the 2013 NCAA Final Four with that team...

Posted 23rd double-figure game with 16 pts (4-of-8 3FG) in NIT Opening Round against St. John's... Registered seventh 20-plus point game (8-of-12 FG, 5-of-8 3FG) with 25 in A-10 Quarterfinals against #25 VCU... Netted 14 points in A-10 win over Xavier... Shot 10-of-17 from the field and 6-of-9 from three-point range to hit season-high 26 points in win over George Washington... Went 5-of-10 from behind the arc to hit 15 points in win over Xavier... Hit game-best 20 points (6-of-10 3FG) and season-best nine rebounds in win over Penn... Recorded team-best 22 points (8-of-19 FG) at #22 VCU... Had 16 points and two blocks at Morgan State... Recorded 23 points (7-of-14 FG) against Iona... Posted 22 points (6-of-10 3FG) at Villanova... Shot 5-of-10 from the floor en route to posting 14 points at Coppin State... Scored 18 points vs. American to eclipse the 1,000 career-point mark, becoming the 50th Hawk to do so and the 21st to achieve it in his third season ... Tallied 13 points in win over #20 Notre Dame... Scored game-high 20 points against Yale on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor... Chosen to the A-10 Preseason All-Conference Second Team.

2011-12: Named to the Atlantic 10 All-Conference Second Team... All-Big 5 First Team selection... Received the John P. Hilferty Award as SJU's MVP for the second year in a row... Hawks' second leading scorer with 15.5 ppg... Ranked as the top three-point shooter in the A-10, and fourth in the nation, with 46.6 percent... Made team-high 90 three-pointers... Had a game-high 22 points against Temple... Scored career-high 32 points in loss at Penn... Tallied 30 points against Fordham, hitting 7-of-9 three-pointers... Chosen the Atlantic 10 Co-Player and Big 5 Player of the Week (12/19) after scoring 20 pts in win over Villanova... Scored career-high 30 points against Boston University, making 6-of-8 from three-point range... Scored 23 points vs. Tulsa, shooting 9-for-11 from the floor.

2010-11: Atlantic 10 All-Rookie Team selection... Philadelphia Big 5 Rookie of the Year... Named the Hawks' Co-MVP as he shared the award with Carl Jones... Team's second leading scorer (12.8) and top rebounder (5.5)... Led the Atlantic 10 in free throw percentage (88.7)... Led the Hawks in three-point percentage (39.2) and three-pointers made (65)... Scored in double figures 20 times and had eight games with 20-plus points... Named the A-10 Rookie of the Week five times and the Big 5 Player of the Week twice... Tallied a career-high 27 points twice, against St. Bonaventure and Charlotte... Went 6-for-7 from three-point range, and had the game-winning free throw with 4.1 seconds left at Charlotte to give the Hawks a spot in the A-

10 Tournament... Shot 6-for-6 from three-point range to score 25 points in win over UMass... Had a team-high 20 points against Duquesne... Scored 24 points at Boston University... Posted 21 points and seven steals vs. Minnesota.

High School/Personal: Class 1A All-State First Team selection while at Christian Life Academy... Two-time District 7 1-A Player of the Year... Averaged 26.2 points, 5.0 assists and 5.0 steals as a senior... Team won the Class 1A title in 2010... Mother, Jeralyn, is the sister of Hawks' assistant coach Geoff Arnold... Majoring in sports marketing.
