Declared eligibility for the NBA Draft... Invited to the 2016 NBA Draft Combine.

Career/Records: Finished career with 1,590 points to rank 15th on the Hawks' all-time list... Ranks 25th in career rebounds with 672... Had 88 double-figure games, 26 games of 20-plus points and 15 double-doubles in 101 career contests... Scored 627 points in 2015-16 for the seventh-best single-season total in SJU history... Had 161 assists, which is tied as the 11th best single-season total in program history... Tied as record-holder for most double-figure games in a season with 35 in 2015-16... Member of two Atlantic 10 champion teams (2014, 2016)... Helped Hawks go 65-36 in his three years, with two Atlantic 10 titles and two NCAA Tournament appearances.

2015-16: The Player of the Year in both the Atlantic 10 and the Big 5... All-Atlantic 10 First Team and All-Big 5 First Team honoree for second straight year... Team's second leading scorer (17.4) and rebounder (7.8)... Led team in assists (4.4) and steals (1.4)... Averaged 20 points per game, six rebounds and five assists in the A-10 Tournament as SJU won its second A-10 championship in three years... Named to the A-10 All-Championship Team... All-District selection by both the USBWA and the NABC... Saint Joseph's Co-MVP with Isaiah Miles... Helped SJU to a 28-8 record for second-most wins in school history... Recorded double-figures in 35 games, which is tied as the school record... Ranked third in the nation in total minutes (1,341)... Had 16 points and 12 rebounds in NCAA Second Round vs. 5th-ranked Oregon... Team-high 23 points in NCAA First Round win over Cincinnati... Poured in season-high 30 points by hitting a personal best 13-of-16 from the field in A-10 Finals vs. VCU... Turned in nine points, season-high eight assists, and seven rebounds in A-10 Semifinals vs. Dayton... Scored game-high 21 points in A-10 Quarterfinals vs. GW... Scored 27 points to go along with eight rebounds and six assists vs. Saint Louis... Notched 18 points by converting 8-for-12 from the field, to go with nine rebounds at UMass... Recorded 16 points and season-high 13 rebounds vs. #15/13 Dayton... Had 16 points and 10 rebounds at Fordham... Netted 22 points by shooting 7-of-11 vs. St. Bonaventure... Posted 15 points and 10 rebounds at Rhode Island... Had 16 points, six assists, and season-high four steals at La Salle... Tallied 17 points, eight rebounds, four assists, and four steals at Penn... Recorded 26 points and 12 rebounds vs. Fordham... Posted 16 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists at George Mason... Recorded 20 points, seven rebounds, five assists, and three steals vs. Rhode Island... Had 17 points and eight assists vs. VCU... Recorded 22 points vs. Virginia Tech... Shot 6-for-9 from the field, with 4-of-6 three-pointers, to record 16 points, nine rebounds, and seven assists vs. Illinois State... Had 17 points and 13 rebounds at Temple... Posted 27 points, 10 rebounds and four steals vs. Princeton... Recorded 12 points, nine rebounds, and eight assists at Columbia... Scored 17 points against #8 Villanova... Posted 15 points and 10 rebounds vs. Old Dominion at the Hall of Fame Tip-Off... Scored 1,000th career point vs. Buffalo... Netted game-high 23 points and four steals vs. Drexel... Two-time A-10 Player of the Week and six-time Philadelphia Big 5 Player of the Week... Team captain for second year... Named to Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 List and the Naismith Trophy Early-Season Watch List... One of five finalists for the Julius Erving Small Forward Award.

2014-15: The Atlantic 10's leading scorer in both overall (17.7 ppg) and conference games (19.0), becoming the first SJU player to win the league's scoring title... Was the fifth player in Hawk history to receive All-Atlantic 10 First Team honors as a sophomore... Named to the USBWA District 2 Team and to the NABC All-District 4 First Team... All-Big Five First Team selection... Led the nation in minutes played with 38.6 per game... Ranked seventh in the A-10 with 7.7 rebounds in overall games... Topped the Hawks with 3.6 assists and 1.9 steals... Ranked among the top 15 in the conference in seven categories... Recorded 13 20-plus point games, 28 double-figure games and six double-doubles... Had game-high 21 points, six rebounds and six assists at Rhode Island... Tallied 14 points and 13 rebounds, and added career-high nine assists, against La Salle... Recorded a career-high 33 points and added 14 rebounds in win at UMass, shooting a career-best 10-for-11 from the foul line... Scored 23 points at Dayton... Notched 19 points and added nine rebounds vs. Rhode Island... Had three consecutive double-doubles with 21 points and career-high 17 rebounds against Davidson, 19 points and 12 rebounds at Saint Louis and 14 points, 11 rebounds vs. George Mason... Scored 20 points at La Salle... Recorded 25 points against Penn... Hit for 25 points while added eight rebounds, seven assists, five steals, and three blocks vs. UMass... Posted career-high 27 points with a career-high 6-of-9 from beyond the arc at St. Bonaventure... Made 7-of-12 field goals to tally 16 points, eight rebounds, and three blocks at #20 VCU... Scored 22 points vs. George Washington... Scored 20 points on 8-of-13 from the field at Denver... Had 16 points and seven assists vs. Marist... Made 8-of-11 field goals en route to 21 points vs. Loyola Maryland... Posted 23 points and added four steals against Western Kentucky... Had first career double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds vs. LIU Brooklyn... Recorded 22 points and nine rebounds vs. Vermont... Elected as team co-captain, becoming the second sophomore in school history to serve as captain, and the first since with 1936-37... Named Atlantic 10 Co-Player of the Week once and Big 5 Player of the Week three times... One of 20 collegiate players invited to the Nike Basketball Academy in June 2015.

2013-14: Named the Atlantic 10 Co-Rookie of the Year and All-Rookie Team selection for A-10 Champion Hawks... Chosen as the Big 5 Rookie of the Year... Chosen to the Kyle Macy Freshman All-America squad... Team's third leading scorer with 12.1 points per game... Averaged 4.5 rebounds and 2.7 assists... Started all 34 games and set the school's freshman record for games played... Scored double figures in 11 of the final 12 games... Had 13 points in championship game win over VCU... Scored 15 points in A-10 Quarterfinal win over Dayton... Led team with career-high 22 points while dishing out eight assists at George Washington... Had 18 points at St. Bonaventure... Scored all 16 of his points in second half in win at La Salle... Registered 18 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the floor in win over VCU and earned Atlantic 10 Co-Rookie of the Week honors (2/10)... Scored 13 points on 5-of-6 from the floor in win at Penn... Posted 17 points of 7-of-11 shooting at George Mason... Hit 7-of-11 shots for 16 points at #19 Massachusetts... Handed out career-high eight assists against Binghamton... Registered 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting against Drexel... Posted 17 points against Villanova... Scored 12 points and pulled down season-high nine rebounds at Temple... Named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week after scoring 20 points against Creighton... Scored 11 points in collegiate debut at Vermont.

High School/Personal: New Jersey All-State First Team selection in 2013... Named the 2013 Union County Player of the Year... Averaged 21.8 points per game while grabbing 9.0 rebounds... Tallied over 1,000 points in his career... All-Union County First Team honoree... Averaged 18.2 points as a junior... 2013 McDonald's All-American nominee... Participated in the 2013 Jordan Brand Classic... Originally from Charlotte, N.C. and attended Rocky River High School there before transferring to The Patrick School in New Jersey... Sports marketing major.
