GAME STORIES...

- Saint Joseph's is making its 11th appearance in the Postseason Women's National Invitation Tournament as the Hawks head to Seton Hall for a First Round matchup on Wednesday.
- The Hawks earned their second-straight Postseason WNIT berth and 10th overall under head coach **Cindy Griffin**.
- Over her 17 seasons, Griffin has led SJU to 12 postseason appearances, including the NCAA Tournament in 2013 and 20014, and has posted a 7-11 mark.
- Saint Joseph's is 7-10 all-time in Postseason WNIT play.
- SJU has earned a postseason berth in 28 of its 45 seasons as a Division I program.
- Wednesday's contest marks the 33rd game for the Hawks this season, matching the program's single-season mark for games played. SJU has previously played 33 games in 2003-04, 2006-07, 2011-12 and 2013-14.
- Graduate student **Amanda Fioravanti** and senior **Adashia Franklyn** enter Wednesday having played in all 32 games this season, and would become the 25th and 26th players in team history to play 33 games in a single-season.
- Wednesday marks the 13th meeting between the Hawks and the Pirates. Seton Hall owns an 8-4 edge in the all-time series and has won four-straight over SJU (series history on page two).

FOR STARTERS...

- Sixth seed Saint Joseph's advanced to the title game of the 2018 Atlantic 10 Championship before falling to fifth seed George Washington, 65-49.
- The 2018 A-10 Championship marked the 12th time the Hawks advanced to the title game, with SJU going 3-9 in those contests.
- Senior guard/forward **Chelsea Woods** was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Championship Team.
- Senior **Chelsea Woods** scored a career-high 33 points versus VCU, the most points by a Hawk since Ayahna Cornish's 35 at Dayton on February 17, 2007, and the most by a SJU player in an A-10 Championship game since Dale Hodges' 35 against West Virginia on March 9, 1990 in a semifinal contest.
- Junior **Alyssa Monaghan** went 12-for-12 from the foul line against VCU on February 27, matching a program record for proficiency held by Mary Sue Garrity, Angela Zampella and current assistant coach Stephanie McCaffrey.

WOODS NAMED TO ALL-CONFERENCE THIRD TEAM

Saint Joseph's senior **Chelsea Woods** was named to the Atlantic 10 All-Conference Third Team. An A-10 Second Team honoree a season ago, Woods has bounced back from missing five games during A-10 play to lead SJU in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg).

FIORAVANTI AND VEILLEUX ALL-ACADEMIC

Saint Joseph's graduate student **Amanda Fioravanti** and junior **Sarah Veilleux** were named to the Atlantic 10 All-Academic Team. A special education major, Fioravanti is having a career year in her final season on Hawk Hill averaging 10.2 points, 5.8 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game. A business intelligence and analytics major, Veilleux ranks among the conference leaders in field goal percentage (.498) and three-point percentage (.380), while ranking second on the team in scoring (12.8 ppg).

ZERO FOR 60 NO MORE

Saint Joseph's entered the final weekend of the regular season going 0-10 in games in which the Hawks scored under 60 points. That changed though at Rose Hill Gym as SJU earned a 52-50 win over Fordham on a last-second layup by senior **Chelsea Woods**, followed by SJU's 52-49 win over the Rams in the A-10 quarterfinals and 58-59 victory over Saint Louis in the A-10 semifinals.

MONAGHAN ETCHING HER NAME

Junior **Alyssa Monaghan** is among the career top-10 for three-pointers made and attempted at SJU. Having hit 150 of 448 field goals from behind the arc, she currently ranks ninth in makes and attempts.

WOODS AMONG ELITE

Senior **Chelsea Woods** has moved into the top-10 for career rebounds as she currently ranks eighth all-time in SJU history with 754 career. Next on the list is Trish Brown '85 at 769. Woods additionally is tied for 14th all-time in scoring with 1,193 points, matching the mark of assistant coach Stephanie McCaffrey '04.

FRANKLYN SECOND ALL-TIME IN BLOCKS

With a pair of blocks against George Washington, senior **Adashia Franklyn** moved into second place all-time for career blocks. Currently with 124 rejections, Franklyn trails only assistant coach Stephanie McCaffrey (nee Graff) at 175.

HAWKS AMONG TOP SHOOTER IN A-10

MARZ HONORED AS MOST COURAGEOUS

Saint Joseph's senior guard **Avery Marz** has been recognized twice this season for her courageous spirit in recovering from a stroke her freshman season to returning to the court for the first time this season, scoring three points in her debut at Niagara. Marz was selected as the U.S. Basketball Writers Association's 2018 Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award recipient in December and was named the Philadelphia Sports Writers Association's Most Courageous Athlete on January 15 at the organization's 114th Annual Awards Banquet. Marz will be presented Pat Summitt Most Courageous Award at the NCAA Women's Final Four in Columbus, Ohio, as part of the organization's annual press conference March 30 in Nationwide Arena several hours in front of the national semifinals. The PSWA's signature award, the Most Courageous Athlete, has been presented annually since 1936 to an athlete who exemplifies courage in the face of adversity. Marz joins a list of honored athletes that includes, Mickey Mantle, Ben Hogan, Dizzy Dean, Tom Dempsey, Babe Zaharias, Roy Campanella and Jim Abbott.

FIORAVANTI REACHES TOP-25

Graduate student **Amanda Fioravanti** has climbed into the Hawks' top-25 for career rebounds. Playing just three seasons in a SJU uniform after transferring from Virginia, Fioravanti currently stands 23rd with 498, 17 shy of Erica Pollock '07 in 21st (515).

CHARITY STRIPE CONSISTENCY

Junior **Sarah Veilleux** has proven to be one of the most accurate free throw shooters in program history as she currently ranks second all-time at .874 percent (97-of-111), trailing only Erin Shields '14 record of .905.

FRANKLYN ADDING TO LEGACY

While cleaning up on the defensive end with rejections, senior **Adashia Franklyn** has also climbed among the SJU elite rebounders. Currently she ranks ninth all-time rebounds with 721.

VEILLEUX CONNECTING FROM DEEP

Junior **Sarah Veilleux** enters the Postseason WNit with a career .376 shooting percentage from three-point range. Hitting 102-of-271 from behind the arc, Veilleux currently is tied for fifth all-time in three-point accuracy alongside Erin Shields '14.

GRiffin HITS 300TH WIN AT SJU

Cindy Griffin earned her 300th win with the Hawks victory at La Salle. Over 17 seasons at Saint Joseph's, Griffin has posted a 308-227 record and has amassed a 356-260 record as a head coach over 20 seasons at SJU and Loyola-Maryland.

MONAGHAN MATCHES MARK

Junior guard **Alyssa Monaghan** opened the season matching a 20-year record going 7-of-7 from behind the arc at Niagara for a perfect 1.000 field goal percentage. Finishing 8-for-8 overall on the day, Monaghan matched Mégan Compain's record of 7-of-7 from three-point range set versus Rhode Island on January 25, 1997.

TURNOVER TROUBLES

Saint Joseph's has turned the ball over more than its opponent in 22 contests. Of those 22, the Hawks have won just nine in which they have more turnovers than the other team.

HAWK CLASSIC CHAMPS

Saint Joseph's captured the 24th Annual Hawk Classic with wins over Eastern Illinois (80-62) and Saint Peter's (87-58). This year marked the 11th Hawk Classic title for SJU as it has captured the title in 1993, 1997, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2012, and 2015.

HAWKS EARN ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM HONORS

Saint Joseph's junior guard/forward **Sarah Veilleux** was named Hawk Classic MVP, while senior guard/forward **Chelsea Woods** and senior forward **Adashia Franklyn** were named to the Hawk Classic All-Tournament Team. Junior guard **Alyssa Monaghan** was named to the Gator Holiday Classic All-Tournament Team.

17th Season

The all-time leader in wins at Saint Joseph's, **Cindy Griffin** is in her 17th season as head coach of the Hawks. A 1991 and 1993 graduate of SJU, Griffin (nee Anderson) has compiled an overall record of 356-260 in 20 seasons as a head coach, and a 308-227 record over 17 years at Hawk Hill that has included 10 postseason appearances.

The eighth coach in NCAA Division I history to lead her alma mater to the NCAA Tournament as a player and a coach, Griffin's squads have posted six 20-win seasons and six victories over nationally-ranked teams, while her players have been honored as Atlantic 10 All-Conference performers 20 times and 15 have gone on to play professionally.

Behind a resilient team, the 2016-17 Hawks battled back from a slow start to become one of the top teams in the Atlantic 10. Finishing third in the conference standings, the Hawks advanced to the semifinals of the A-10 Championship and earned the program's 10th Postseason WNIT berth. Individually, Chelsea Woods was named an A-10 All-Conference honoree and was selected to the All-Big 5 Second Team. Joining Woods on the All-Big 5 Second Team, Adashia Franklyn also garnered Big 5 most Improved Player accolades, while Sarah Veilleux was recognized as the Big 5 Scholar Athlete.

Behind a pair of 1,000-point scorers in seniors Sarah Fairbanks and Ciara Andrews in 2015-16, Saint Joseph's finished tied for sixth in the A-10 behind a strong finish to the regular season. Finishing among the attendance leaders in the conference, the Hawks added to their mantle as they claimed the Hawk Classic title. Additionally, Fairbanks was named the Big 5's Scholar-Athlete, while sophomore Chelsea Woods was selected the Big 5's Most Improved Player.

Backed by First Team All-Big 5 selection Natasha Cloud, the Hawks earned a share of the Big 5 title in 2014-15. Cloud, who garnered A-10 All-Conference First Team and All-Defensive Team accolades, also became just the third SJU player to be selected in the WNBA Draft as she was picked by the Washington Mystics in the second round in 2015.

Following up their A-10 Championship the season prior, the 2013-14 Hawks continued to prove themselves as one of the top programs nationally as they earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament and advanced to the Second Round for just the seventh time in team history. Led by Erin Shields and Cloud, Saint Joseph's earned its fifth straight postseason bid and claimed its first outright Philadelphia Big 5 title since 2000-01.

Under Griffin's leadership, Saint Joseph's posted one of its most memorable seasons in team history in 2012-13 as the Hawks claimed the Atlantic 10 Championship for just the third time and earned the automatic NCAA Tournament bid. Led by a senior class that had advanced to the postseason every year, the Hawks finished with a 23-9 record that included wins over #5 Maryland and #11 Dayton.

In addition to the team's success, a trio of Hawks were singled out for their performances, led by NCAA Woman of the Year nominee Chatilla van Grinsven. With Griffin's guidance, van Grinsven turned in one of the more dominant seasons in recent SJU history, becoming just the fifth player in SJU history to average a double-double for the year en route to being named to the A-10 All-Conference First Team and as the Big 5 Player of the Year. The duo of backcourt mates Shields and Cloud helped propel SJU to new heights, with Shields garnering A-10 and Big 5 Most Improved Player honors and I-AAA distinction, while Cloud was named the Most Outstanding Player of the 2013 A-10 Championship.

Led by a veteran-laden team in 2011-12, the Hawks earned their third-straight WNIT berth and posted their most wins (22) since the 2003-04 season. Moving into second place in career victories at her alma mater, Griffin picked up her 200th win as the Hawks topped Boston University in the opening game of the WNIT on March 15, 2012. Leading the Hawks to a 15-4 mark at home, she helped Saint Joseph's become one of the more efficient teams in the nation, ranking fourth in fewest turnovers per game (12.5), 26th in three-point percentage (.348) and 39th in field goal percentage (.423).

Individually, senior Michelle Baker and Kelly Cavallo had breakout years, both garnering All-Big 5 honors. Behind Griffin's teaching, Baker went on to be named to the A-10 All-Conference Second Team and capped her career as SJU's then all-time leader in games played (127) while ranking in the top 20 for scoring and field goals made. After seeing limited time as a freshman, Cavallo developed into one of the top post players in the A-10, leading SJU and finishing in the top five of the conference in rebounding, blocked shots and field goal percentage. With Griffin's aid, Cavallo finished her career second all-time in blocks and 11th in rebounding at SJU. Returning just one starter for the 2010-11 season, the Hawks quickly jelled under Griffin's guid-

ance as they went on to win 20 games, earned the program's 700th victory, and advanced to the second round of the WNIT. Led by All-Big 5 honorees Baker and Katie Kuester, Saint Joseph's had its most efficient offensive showing since 2002-03, as the Hawks finished 60th in the nation in field goal percentage (42.1).

Additionally, several Hawks were honored for outstanding seasons in 2010-11, headlined by sophomore Ashley Prim becoming the first SJU player to be named Atlantic 10 Sixth Player of the Year. Baker became just the second Hawk to be named to the A-10 All-Defensive Team, while freshman Erin Shields became the sixth player Griffin has coached to A-10 All-Rookie Team honors.

Earning a postseason berth for the first time in two years, the Hawks surpassed predictions in 2009-10 as they finished tied for fourth in the Atlantic 10 after being picked to finish ninth. After opening the season with a 3-7 mark, Griffin saw her team begin to click at the end of the non-conference schedule as SJU claimed the 19th Annual Hawk Classic title and worked its way to .500 by the second week of the Atlantic 10 slate. Posting a 9-5 mark against conference opponents, Griffin hit two milestones during A-10 play, earning her 150th win at Saint Joseph's in a victory against Dayton and earning her 200th coaching win against George Washington. The Hawks would go on to earn the program's seventh WNIT bid, and play the first postseason game at Hagan Arena.

In 2008-09, Griffin undertook arguably her toughest season to date as Saint Joseph's played every contest away from Hawk Hill for the first time in program history. And in typical SJU fashion, Griffin got her team to respond as Saint Joseph's went on to post an 8-5 record at home venues and earn its first Big 5 title since 2000-01. Individually five Hawks posted career bests in scoring, with Brittany Ford and Mariame Djouara both earning All-Big 5 Second Team honors.

Relying heavily on underclassmen in 2007-08, Griffin guided her Hawks to another winning season, including crowns at the Brown Basketball Classic and the Hilton Philadelphia Hawk Classic. Among the wins, Saint Joseph's posted its biggest win over a non-conference ranked opponent since the 1984-85, topping #15 Auburn for the Hawk Classic title.

Despite losing several experienced players prior to the 2006-07 season, Griffin had her team peaking at the right time. Playing Griffin's style of hard-nosed defense and persistent offense, the Hawks advanced to the Atlantic 10 Championship game, including the program's first win over a top 10 opponent (#8 George Washington) since 1992 along the way. Saint Joseph's capped the season with its fifth WNIT appearance in six years and tied the SJU record for games played in a season with 33.

Fueled by a collection of newcomers and a developed core of upperclassmen, Griffin led the Hawks back to national prominence in 2005-06. The Crimson and Gray engineered the nation's best turnaround (13 games) and received votes in the national polls for the first time since 2003-04. The Hawks advanced to the semifinals of the A-10 Championship and earned a berth in the WNIT.

With the loss of four 1,000-point scorers, the 2004-05 Hawks showed their true colors down the stretch, earning a hard-fought victory over La Salle in the opening round of the Atlantic 10 Championship and coming within 10 points of 16th-ranked, and eventual A-10 Champion, Temple. Led by six seniors, the 2004 team went 22-11 and advanced to the WNIT Elite Eight. Saint Joseph's finished second in the A-10 East and dropped a heartbreaker in the Atlantic 10 Championship to Temple. Four Hawk seniors reached the 1,000-point plateau, marking just the eighth time in NCAA history that a quartet of players had reached the milestone in the same season. Erin Brady, Irina Krasnoshik, Stephanie (Graff) McCaffrey and Amra Mehmedic went on to sign professional contracts.

Following a memorable first year at the helm of her alma mater, Griffin upped the ante in her second season by capturing 2003 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors after guiding the Hawks to a 19-11 record. The team sprinted to the conference's Eastern Division title and earned a berth in the WNIT for the second straight season, despite the departure of SJU's all-time leading scorer and a non-conference schedule that ranked fourth nationally.

Griffin helped to reinvigorate the SJU program in her first season, leading the squad to a 24-8 record and the second round of the WNIT. She capitalized on the team's tradition of scrappy play and rugged defense, while releasing the reins and allowing the team to play a more up-tempo style on the offensive end of the floor. The Hawks finished the year among the national leaders in nine different categories and paced the nation in free throw percentage for the second straight year.

Following her playing career, Griffin spent the 1992-93 season as a graduate assistant at her alma mater. She then accepted an assistant's spot at Vanderbilt University from 1993-95 under former Saint Joseph's head coach Jim Foster. Foster recruited Griffin to SJU and coached her during her playing career on Hawk Hill.

In her two years as an assistant at Vanderbilt, the Commodores finished 53-15 overall, won the 1995 SEC championship and reached the NCAA Sweet 16 both seasons. In addition to coaching responsibilities, she was the co-director of the Vanderbilt Basketball Camp and the director of the Black & Gold Club.

Griffin left Vanderbilt after the 1995 season to become an assistant coach at Loyola Maryland. She spent three seasons as an assistant under Patty Coyle before being promoted to associate head coach in 1998. Griffin was promoted to the position of head women's basketball coach at Loyola Maryland midway through the 1998-99 season. She was the seventh-youngest head coach in Division I at the time. Griffin – who was named head coach five games into the season as Coyle left for an assistant coach position with the WNBA's New York Liberty – kept the Greyhounds' momentum going as Loyola Maryland won a team-record 21 games that year. Overall she compiled a record of 48-33 during her tenure at the Baltimore school, guiding the squad to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference semifinals all three years.

One of the top playmakers in Saint Joseph's history, Griffin starred for the Hawks from 1987-88 through 1991-92 (missing the 1988-89 season due to injury). A three-time team captain, Griffin finished her career with 662 points, 278 rebounds, 510 assists and 197 steals. She currently ranks fourth on SJU's all-time assist list.

As a junior in 1990-91, she played in 1,178 out of a possible 1,200 minutes to set the school record for minutes played in a single season. The Hawks made three NCAA Tournament appearances and posted three straight 20-win seasons during her playing career. A two-time Second Team All-Big 5 choice, as well as a Third Team All-Atlantic 10 pick as a senior, she was inducted into the Saint Joseph's Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in 1998.

A native of Maple Glen, Pa., Griffin played her high school basketball for Bishop McDevitt, winning two Philadelphia Catholic League titles. A 1987 graduate of McDevitt, she was inducted into its Athletic Hall of Fame in 1997, and in 2002, received the Philadelphia Catholic League's alumni achievement award. She earned a bachelor's degree in accounting from Saint Joseph's in 1991 and completed her M.B.A. from SJU in 1993. She resides in Conshohocken, Pa., with her husband, Curtis, and children, Kaylie, Hannah and Curtis, Jr.

Game 1 • November 12, 2017 • Gallagher Center Saint Joseph's - 93, Niagara - 69

Shooting 61.4 percent from the floor, including 75 percent from three-point range, Saint Joseph's opened the 2017-18 season with a 93-69 victory at Niagara at the Gallagher Center.

Alyssa Monaghan led four Hawks in double figures with a career-best 23 points and matched a program record for three-point proficiency as she finished 7-of-7 from behind the arc and 8-8 overall from the field.

Behind 11 points from Monaghan, SJU took control from the tip as it ran out to a 14-6 lead.

Down 19-12 after the first quarter, Niagara used a 7-3 run to start the second period and rally to within three, 22-19.

That would be as close as the Purple Eagles would get on the day though as the Hawks answered with a 14-0 run to open a 36-19 lead on a layup by Amanda Fioravanti.

Taking a 49-32 advantage into the second half, Saint Joseph's went on to outscore Niagara 44-37 in the second half to set a new program record for points in a season opener with 93.

For the game, the Hawks went 35-of-57 from the field, 15-of-20 from behind the arc and finished with a 38-23 edge in rebounding.

Game 2 • November 15, 2017 • Sojka Pavilion Saint Joseph's - 77, Bucknell - 53

Behind a strong second half performance, Saint Joseph's snapped Bucknell's 29-game home win streak with a 77-53 victory.

Led by 10 of **Chelsea Woods'** game-high 21 points, the Hawks outscored the Bison 43-23 in the second half after leading by four at halftime.

Ahead 34-30 at intermission, Saint Joseph's held Bucknell to just 25 percent shooting (4-of-16) in the third quarter and used a 15-9 scoring advantage to open a 49-39 advantage.

Up by 10, the Hawks' lead would shrink to no less than eight as they closed out the game going 11-of-17 from the field (64.7 percent) in the fourth quarter to improve to 2-0 on the season.

For the game, SJU shot 47.7 percent from the floor (31-of-65), hit 4-of-8 from three-point range and shot 68.8 percent from the foul line (11-of-16).

Saint Joseph's improved to 3-0 to start the season for the first time since 2010-11 as the Hawks topped James Madison.

James Madison opened the game scoring on its first two possessions, but the Hawks quickly battled back. Down 4-0, Saint Joseph's used a 13-2 run to open a seven-point advantage on a layup by **Amanda Fioravanti** at 4:44.

The Dukes strung together a 9-2 run of their own to tie the game at 15, but a pair of free throws by **Kristalyn Baisden** and a layup by **Adashia Franklin** pushed SJU back ahead, 19-15.

Up four to start the second half, Saint Joseph's saw its lead erased just over three minutes in as a three-pointer by Hailee Barron gave JMU a 44-43 advantage.

Fighting back to a 48-48 tie, the Hawks closed the third quarter on a 7-2 run to take a 55-50 lead.

Saint Joseph's advanced to title game of the 2018 Atlantic 10 Championship as the sixth seeded Hawks downed seventh seed Saint Louis, 58-49, in a semifinal matchup.

Leading from the start and never falling behind, the Hawks sprinted out to a 14-4 lead as a jumpshot by **Amanda Fioravanti** capped a 9-0 run at 4:56 of the first quarter.

Ahead by 10 early in the second, Saint Joseph's saw its advantage cut to two, 18-16, as the Billikens scored eight-straight points in a 90-second span early in the quarter.

The Hawks would take a 24-18 advantage into the third quarter and opened a nine-point lead, 33-24, on a three-pointer by **Sarah Veilleux** at the 6:31 mark.

Again Saint Louis responded, as a layup by Jackie Kemph brought the Billikens back within three, 33-30, with 3:47 left in the third.

Once again the Hawks' resolve came through as a three-pointer by **Kristalyn Baisden** capped an 8-0 spurt that gave SJU a 41-30 lead.

Up 49-39 with under three minutes to play in the fourth quarter, Saint Joseph's used the clock and got key buckets and free throws to secure its first A-10 title game appearance since 2013 and 12th overall.


