- Saint Joseph's returns to action for the first time in nearly three weeks as the Hawks travel to Drexel.
- Thursday's matchup marks the first meeting between the Hawks and Dragons since a 72-71 Saint Joseph's victory on December 11, 2016.
- Saint Joseph's is looking to pick up its first win of the season after opening the year with hard-fought matchups against Auburn and #6 Kansas at the Rocket Mortgage Fort Myers Tip-Off.
- The Hawks fell to #6 Kansas, 94-72, in their previous contest on November 27.
- Sophomore **Jack Forrest** came off the bench to score a team-best 18 points against the Jayhawks, knocking down 7-14 from the field, including 4-8 from three-point range.
- Classmate **Dahmir Bishop**, who has scored 14 points in each of his first two games with the Hawks, has posted a team-best 53.3 shooting percentage from three-point range (8-15).
- Redshirt junior **Taylor Funk** enters Thursday averaging a team and career-best 17.5 points per game.
- Redshirt senior **Ryan Daly**, who led the Hawks in rebounds and assists a season ago, currently leads SJU with 7.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game this year, to go with 16.0 points a contest.

## SJU VERSUS DREXEL

Thursday marks the 58th meeting between Saint Joseph's and Drexel with the Hawks entering the game holding a 48-9 edge in the series and having won the past six contests. Below are series highlights and notes.

- Shavar Newkirk converted the game-winning three-point play with 6.7 seconds to go, and scored Saint Joseph's final 11 points, as the Hawks rallied to defeat Drexel, 72-71, on December 11, 2016.
- Saint Joseph's is 14-2 in away games in the series.
- Rap Curry matched SJU's single-game assist mark (14) in a 106-98 win over Drexel on November 28, 1990.
- SJU Head Coach Billy Lange has faced the Dragons once, as his Navy squad fell at Drexel, 86-70, on November 11, 2007.

## DALY NAMED TO A-10 PRESEASON TEAM

Redshirt senior **Ryan Daly** was named to the Atlantic 10 Men's Basketball Preseason All-Conference Second Team. Daly earned A-10 All-Conference Third Team honors in 2019-20 and was twice named to the All-CAA Third Team at Delaware.

## RETURNING FIREPOWER

Saint Joseph's entered the 2020-21 season in good shape on the offensive side as it returns 74 percent of its scoring from a season ago, including its top five scorers in **Ryan Daly** (20.6 ppg), **Cameron Brown** (10.1 ppg), **Taylor Funk** (9.4 ppg), **Myles Douglas** (7.6 ppg) and **Rahmir Moore** (7.3 ppg). All told, the Hawks' returning letterwinners scored 1,633 of their 2,208 points in 2019-20.

## FUNK BACK AND READY FOR ACTION

After missing the final 25 games of last season due to a right hand injury, **Taylor Funk** returned to the Hawks' lineup, scoring a career-best 28 points versus Auburn. Along with a fully healed hand, Funk improved his conditioning and strength in the down time and enters the season weighing 215 pounds, down 15 from last season thanks in part to working out with head strength and condition coach **Eric Lang**.

## HAWKS PICKED 12TH IN A-10 POLL

Saint Joseph's was picked to finish 12th in the Atlantic 10 Conference's Preseason Poll of head coaches and media. The Hawks finished 13th in the A-10 standings in 2019-20.

## BISHOP MAKES DEBUT

Sophomore **Dahmir Bishop** scored 14 points and added seven assists in his Hawk debut against Auburn, and has already surpassed his 28 points to date have already surpassed his previous season output (16). Transferring from Xavier to Hawk Hill last winter, Bishop received his eligibility waiver from the NCAA this fall for this season. Appearing in 10 games for the Musketeers, Bishop averaged 1.6 points, 2.5 rebounds and 12.0 minutes per game. A two-time Pennsylvania Sports Writers Class AAAA First Team All-State selection, he helped lead the Panthers to three-straight PIAA Class 4A State titles and Philadelphia Public League championships.

## DALY BACK ON HAWK HILL

Redshirt senior **Ryan Daly** originally entered the 2020 NBA Draft, but removed his name this summer to return back to Hawk Hill. The Atlantic 10 leading scorer a season ago, Daly has tallied 1,651 career points (17.9 ppg) over his collegiate career at Saint Joseph's and Delaware.

## CHALLENGING START

Saint Joseph's is facing a challenging open to its 2020-21 schedule as the Hawks will face three Power 5 teams, including two nationally-ranked squads, in its non-conference schedule. The Hawks opened the year with matchups against Auburn and #6 Kansas, and will take on #10 Tennessee on December 21. Additionally, the Hawks still have the potential to reschedule their contest against #7 Villanova. Should the Hawks face Villanova, or another nationally ranked team in non-conference play, it would mark the first time since 1996-97 that SJU has faced three ranked opponents prior to the A-10 slate:

## FORREST TRANSFERS HOME

A native of nearby Bala Cynwyd, Pennsylvania, **Jack Forrest** is back home after transferring from Columbia. A four-year standout at Lower Merion High School, he appeared in 25 games with seven starts for the Lions, the 6-5 guard ranked third on the team in scoring (8.9 ppg) and shot a team-best 35.2 percent from three-point range. The former All-State Third Team honoree has been stellar in a reserve role so far for the Hawks, averaging 16.5 points a game and shooting 52.2 percent from the field and 50 percent from behind the arc.

## FOSTER, JR. DONS CRIMSON AND GRAY

Like Dahmir Bishop, Redshirt sophomore **Greg Foster, Jr.** scored 11 points in a starting role against Auburn. A transfer from Gonzaga, Foster, Jr. spent last season practicing with the Hawks as he sat out per NCAA transfer rules. Scoring 19 points in 28 games at Gonzaga, Foster, Jr., Foster's relationship with Saint Joseph's head coach Billy Lange goes deep as he previously spent Thanksgiving with the Lange family during his eighth grade year as his father, Greg Foster, Sr. and Lange were member of the 76ers coaching staff.

### HAWKS VERSUS RANKED TEAMS

November 27 marked the 184th time Saint Joseph's has faced a nationally ranked opponent, this time in #6 Kansas. With the loss, the Hawks moved to 45-139 all-time versus ranked squads, but have a chance to snap their five-game skid on Monday at #10 Tennessee. Saint Joseph's last win over a ranked team came on February 27, 2018, as the Hawks topped #17 Rhode Island, 78-48.

### THREE-POINT FRENZY

The 2019-20 season ushered in a new offensive focus for Saint Joseph's basketball as the Hawks' put added emphasis on three pointers. Leading the Atlantic 10 in threes last year (287), the Hawks also set a new program record for attempts (965) and finished the year third in the nation in attempts and 28th in three pointers made. Additionally, Saint Joseph's 43 three-point attempts against William & Mary matched the program record that was set on March 15, 1997 versus Boston College. The Hawks have picked up where they left off as they enter Thursday averaging 38.5 three-point attempts per game.

### PROMISING SOPHOMORE YEARS

Two keys members of last year's team - sophomores **Cameron Brown** and **Rahmir Moore** -are looking to build off their playing time as rookies. Leading all newcomers in scoring (10.1 ppg), Brown appeared in all 32 games and hit several big buckets for the Hawks, including a game-winning three pointer in the final seconds against Davidson. An explosive, slashing guard, Moore split time between starting and sixth man as a freshman and should build on his 7.3 points per game.

### CENTER OF ATTENTION

The Hawks' added **Anton Jansson** last winter, and after serving as a member of the practice squad, the 6-foot-11 center is made collegiate debut against #6 Kansas scoring two points. Jansson competed for Sweden at the U20 European Championship in 2019 and most recently was a member of the Golden State Prep in Napa, California.

### HAWKS IN THE FAMILY

Saint Joseph's **Billy Lange's** family tree is checkered with Hawk Hill ties. His parents, his parents, Bill and Kathy, are both SJU alumni, while his brother, Mark, was a four-year manager for the Hawks. Additionally, Lange's wife Alicia worked in the athletic department as the coordinator of academic services for student athletes from 1999-2004.

### LONGPRÉ'S STRONG PLAY

Senior **Anthony Longpré** is coming off his best year on Hawk Hill as the forward averaged a career-best 5.6 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.

### DALY'S OFFENSIVE PROWESS

**Ryan Daly** had an offensive season for the record books in 2019-20 as his 619 points ranked eighth most in a single-season in Saint Joseph's history, and became just the 14th Hawk since 1941-42 to average 20 or more points per game. His 20.6 ppg were the highest by a Hawk since Jameer Nelson's 20.6 ppg in 2003-04 and he finished the year 21st nationally in scoring. Daly also became the second consecutive Hawk to lead the A-10 in scoring, following Charlie Brown (19.0 ppg) in 2018-19.

### MOORE SJU TIES

Sophomore **Rahmir Moore**. is the brother of former women's basketball standout Ayahna Cornish '07, and brother-in-law to current Toronto Raptors All-Star - and former Villanova standout - Kyle Lowry.

### DALY AND HAWK HILL

For **Ryan Daly**, Saint Joseph's has been in his DNA. His father, Brian, played for the Hawks from 1989-92, while Ryan is also the cousin of Saint Joseph's Director of Scouting and Analytics Thomas Boyle. Additionally, Daly's late grandfather, Jim Boyle, played for the Hawks and coached them from 1981-89.

### NEXT UP

The Hawks travel to #10 Tennessee for a 6 p.m. tip with the Volunteers on December 21. The game will be televised on the SEC Network.

### THE HAWK

One of the most famous mascots in college sports, the Saint Joseph's Hawk is in its 66th year in 2020-21.

The Hawk is best known for staying in constant motion by flapping its wings throughout every basketball game and representing the Saint Joseph's motto, "The Hawk Will Never Die".

The idea for the Hawk as a mascot was originated by Jim Brennan during the 1954-55 season. Brennan, an ex-Marine and SJU cheerleader, at first wanted to secure an actual hawk, but later switched to the costume idea. The student government raised the 120 dollars needed to buy the initial costume, which Brennan donned for three years. He made his debut as the Hawk on December 3, 1955, a 84-72 win over Rhode Island at the Palestra. The Hawk has not missed a men's basketball game since that first season.

In addition to the constant flapping, the Hawk is also recognized by its "flying" in figure eights around the court during timeouts. The constant motion, coupled with the scrappy play of the University's athletic teams, helped to spawn the school's familiar slogan "The Hawk Will Never Die!" A few years ago, ESPN used a "flap-o-meter" on the national telecast of a Saint Joseph's game to estimate that the Hawk flaps its wings 3,500 times during a regulation game.

**Alec Kerr** will serve as the Hawk for his second season in 2020-21, and is the 40th student to don the feathers. There have been three women who have served in the role, with Mikaela Bakey being the most recent in 2017-18, following Sara Brennan (2000-01) and Brienne Ryan (2009-10).



# BILLY LANGE

## Head Coach - 2nd Season

The 15th head coach in the storied history of Saint Joseph’s men’s basketball program, **Billy Lange** returns for his second season at Hawk Hill in 2020-21.

Named Saint Joseph’s head coach on March 28, 2019, Lange brought more than 23 years of sideline experience to the Hawks, most recently as assistant coach of the Philadelphia 76ers. Since he joined the Sixers in 2013, the team has rebuilt its culture, emphasized player development and implemented a process that has led to their current success.

Lange’s college head coaching experience spans nine years with stints at the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy and the U.S. Naval Academy. As Navy’s head coach from 2004 to 2011, the Midshipmen showed a marked improvement under Lange, as he led the squad to its first winning season in seven years during the 2007-08 campaign with a 16-14 record. Helped by a six-game winning streak, that squad went 9-5 in league play and finished second in the regular season. Lange was named the 2008 Patriot League Coach of the Year for his efforts, which also saw Greg Sprink earn Player of the Year honors, marking the only time a Midshipman has received that league’s award.

He served as head coach at the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy from 2000 through 2001, where he compiled a 39-19 record and led the Mariners to the Skyline Conference regular-season title in each of his two seasons. In 2001, the USMMA also won the conference tournament title to secure a bid to the Division III NCAA Tournament and reach the Sweet 16, becoming the first team in program history to advance past the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Lange was named the New York Metropolitan Basketball Writers Division III Coach of the Year following that season.

A native of Haddon Heights, N.J., Lange began his coaching career with one season at his alma mater, Bishop Eustace Prep, succeeding his father, Bill Lange, Sr., in the role. He then moved on to the collegiate level as an assistant coach under Naismith Hall of Fame coach Herb Magee at Philadelphia (now Jefferson) University. After two seasons with the Rams, he served as an assistant coach at La Salle University under Speedy Morris for one season before taking over at the USMMA.

Lange joined Jay Wright’s staff at Villanova as an assistant coach and coordinator of basketball operations for three seasons before taking the head job in Annapolis. He returned to Villanova as the Wildcats’ associate head coach in 2011 before joining the 76ers in 2013.

Lange’s connection to Saint Joseph’s runs deep as his parents, Bill and Kathy, are both alumni, as is his brother, Mark. Lange’s wife, Alicia, served as the Hawks’ coordinator of academic services for student-athletes for five years in the early 2000’s.

A 1994 graduate of Rowan, he and Alicia are the parents of four sons – Will, Matt, Jake and Marc.

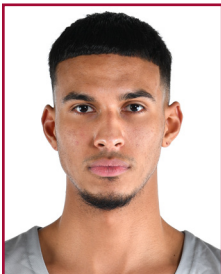

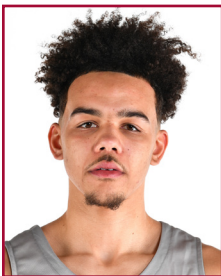

- Jaylin Williams answered with a dunk for the Tigers to tie the game with :13 to play.
- Daly got a clean look for the win at the buzzer, but the ball missed its mark, sending the game to extra time.
- Saint Joseph's scored the opening basket of the extra frame on a Funk jumper and held a 91-90 edge at the 2:02, but Auburn scored the final six points of the contest to pull away with the win.
