NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: Villanova returns to action for the first time in eight days when the Wildcats visit Saint Joseph's on Saturday afternoon. In the team's last outing on Nov. 12, Villanova fell at No. 4 Maryland by a score of 88-67. In the setback, Brianna Herlihy led the Wildcats with 16 points, while Lior Garzon tallied 15 points and Maddy Siegrist chipped in with 11 points. Maryland was paced by Angel Reese who had a game-high 23 points. She was one of six Terrapins to reach double figures. For the game, Villanova was 24-of-55 from the field (43.6%), 13-of-27 from three-point range (48.1%) and 6-of-6 from the foul line (100.0%), while Maryland shot 56.7 percent from the floor (34-of-60), 50.0 percent from long distance (5-of-10) and 83.3 percent from the foul line (15-of-18). Maryland owned a 38-21 advantage on the backboards.

ROAD TRIP: Villanova is in the midst of playing three straight games away from home. The road stretch began with an 88-67 loss at Maryland on Nov. 12 and will continue on Saturday at Saint Joseph's and conclude on Monday at The Palestra versus Penn. The Wildcats next home game is set for Saturday, Nov. 27, against the Temple Owls.

BIG 5 STRETCH: Starting with Saturday's game at Saint Joseph's, Villanova will play three consecutive Philadelphia Big 5 games. Following the trip to Hawk Hill on Saturday, the Wildcats will visit The Palestra on Monday to take on the Penn Quakers. The third game in the stretch will take place on Nov. 27 with a home date versus the Temple Owls. The fourth and final City Series game will be on Dec. 21 at La Salle.

PHILLY FLAVOR: Entering play against Saint Joseph's on Saturday, Nov. 20, Villanova is 33-6 in its last 39 games versus Philadelphia Big Five competition.

WINNING WAYS: Villanova enters play versus Saint Joseph's on Saturday having won five in a row against the Hawks. Saint Joseph's last win in the series came during the 2014-15 season. In the last meeting between the schools on Dec. 7, 2019, Villanova tallied a 60-44 win over the Hawks.

BIG FIVE HISTORY: The Wildcats enter play against Saint Joseph's on Saturday afternoon with an all-time Big Five record of 122-40 (.753). The 122 wins are the most victories by any Big Five women's program. Saint Joseph's is second with 111 Big Five wins.

FAMILY INFLUENCE: Villanova junior guard Kenzie Gardler is no stranger to Saint Joseph's Basketball. Both of Gardler's parents played basketball at Saint Joe's, including her mom Katie Curry Gardler from 1989-93 and her father Chris who played on Hawk Hill from 1989-91. A Big 5 Hall of Famer, Katie currently ranks fourth on the St. Joe's all-time scoring list with 1,663 points and she owns the school record for three-point field goals made with 216. She was a three-time first team All-Atlantic 10 honoree and was the conference player of the year in 1993. This will be the first time that Kenzie has played against the Hawks in her collegiate career. She missed the game her freshman year due to illness and the two teams did not play one another last season.

COSTLY MISCUES: The Wildcats have struggled in the early going this season in the turnover department. After two games, Villanova has committed 36 turnovers, including 20 in the season opener versus Princeton and 16 at Maryland in game two. In 24 games last season, the Wildcats averaged 14.1 turnovers per contest.

BIG EAST HONORS: For the second straight year, Villanova junior forward Maddy Siegrist was a unanimous selection to the preseason All-BIG EAST team. Siegrist started all 24 games last season and averaged 22.8 points per game and 9.8 rebounds per contest, while shooting .483 from the field (208-of-431) and .364 from three-point range (43-of-118). She finished the regular season by leading the BIG EAST in both scoring at 23.1 points per game and rebounding at 10.1 rebounds per contest, becoming just the third player in league history to lead the conference in both categories. In the 24 games played in 2020-21, Siegrist tallied 20 points or more in 16 games, including six games of 30 points or more. She also registered a BIG EAST best 13 double-doubles. In 54 career games, Siegrist has scored 20 points or more in 31 of the 54 contests. She also has 24 career double-doubles to her credit. For her efforts last season, Siegrist garnered first team All-BIG EAST honors and Honorable Mention All-American distinction.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION: The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association announced the 20 player watch list for the 2021 Katrina McClain Award with Wildcat sophomore forward Maddy Siegrist being one of the 20 student-athletes to earn recognition. This is the second straight year that Siegrist has been named to the Watch List. For her efforts as a sophomore in 2020-21, she was one of the five finalists for the McClain Award. In late January, the watch list of 20 players for the 2022 Katrina McClain Power Forward of the Year Award will be narrowed to 10 and then in late February to just five. In March the five finalists will be presented to Ms. McClain and the Hall of Fame's selection committee where a winner will be selected.

NOTES

MORE ON MADDY: Junior Maddy Siegrist received another national honor on Nov. 9 when she was named to the Wade Trophy Watch List. The Wade Trophy, now in its 45th year, is the oldest and most prestigious national player of the year award in college women's basketball. Siegrist is one of 30 players named to the List. Villanova has had one Wade Trophy winner in its program history. For her efforts during the 1986-87 season, Shelly Pennefather won the honor as the top player in the country.

1,000 POINT HISTORY: Junior forward **Maddy Siegrist** became just the third player in Villanova women's basketball history to score 1,000 points in two seasons when she sank two free throws at the 9:04 mark of the first quarter against Seton Hall on Feb. 27, 2021. Siegrist becomes the fastest to reach the milestone in Villanova women's basketball history. Shelly Pennefather (1983-87) scored 1,000 points in 52 career games, while Laura Kurz (2007- 09) did it in 60 career contests. Siegrist currently ranks 20th on the program's all-time scoring list with 1,152 points.

A LOOK BACK: Sophomore forward Maddy Siegrist is coming off a sensational sophomore season for the Wildcats. For her efforts in 2020-21, she was a unanimous first team All-BIG EAST selection, an Honorable Mention All-American honoree and a finalist for the Katrina McClain Award.

MADDY AS A SOPHOMORE IN 2020-21

- ** Averaged 22.8 points per game and 9.8 rebounds per contest
- ** Became the third player in the history of the BIG EAST Conference to lead the league in both scoring and rebounding
- ** 20+ points in 16 of the 24 games
- ** 30+ points in six of the 24 games
- ** Registered a BIG EAST leading 13 double-doubles

EXPERIENCED PERFORMER: Villanova's most experienced performer is grad student forward **Brianna Herlihy.** As a senior in 2020-21, Herlihy averaged 13.8 points per game and 7.1 rebounds per contest which both ranked second on the team. She also shot .488 from the field (122-of-250). For her efforts last season, she was a second team All-BIG EAST selection. In 24 games last year, Herlihy tallied 18 double figure scoring games and four 20-point efforts. Herlihy has been the team's leading scorer in the first two games of the season with 12 points versus Princeton and 16 against Maryland.

550 IN A ROW: Entering play at Saint Joseph's on Saturday afternoon, Villanova has made at least one three-point field goal in 550 consecutive games. The last time Villanova failed to connect on a triple was against Boston College on Jan. 2, 2004, when the Wildcats were 0-for-10 from long distance in a 61-48 loss.

ROSTER ADDITIONS: Villanova has added five freshmen to the 2021-22 roster. The five rookies include guards **Zanai Jones**, **Kaitlyn Orihel**, **Lucy Olsen**, **Anahi-Lee Cauley** and forward **Christina Dalce**. The Villanova roster breakdown includes one graduate student, three juniors, three sophomores and five freshmen.

WILDCATS PICKED FIFTH: In the BIG EAST preseason predicted order of finish, Villanova was picked to finish fifth in the league standings with 62 points. Connecticut was selected to win the conference championship with 100 points and 10 first place votes.
