2012 Season Outlook with Coach Nelson

Q- Do you feel that your club has gotten off to a good start this year?

I'm very pleased with how we've started. The strengths of this team are going to be our pitchers competing in the strike zone, and our defense playing catch. We're really athletic all across the baseball field. With that athleticism, we will hit and be a very good offensive team.

Q- How do you follow up last year's #1 ranking for six weeks, a #6-ranked finish and 49-16 overall record?

We've shown that we've got a program that should be a perennial top five team every year. It's just a matter of getting out there and getting our guys to play the way they should.

Q – Is the Scenic West Athletic Conference as competitive in baseball as it is in other sports?

Personally, I think it's tougher. Our conference has been in the championship game, or won the national championship, for five of the last eight years. The top four teams in our league are extremely good--Western Nevada has always been one of the top teams in our conference, and Southern Nevada has always been really good as well. They had a bit of a down year last season, but they're off to a good start and their new coach is doing a great job. Southern Idaho is always competitive and well-coached, and they do a very good job up in Twin Falls.

Q- What will make this SLCC team tough to contend with?

Our strength is our team speed. We're big and strong, we work hard and we can really run. On scout day, where we had all the major league scouts here to evaluate our team, the comment was that they hadn't seen a team this fast as a whole in quite some time, if ever. That was a great compliment to us.

Q- Tell us a bit about the guys you have returning this year.

We expect big things out of our sophomores this year. Dominique Taylor and Braden Anderson started as freshmen, and they're two of the best outfielders and complete baseball players that I've seen. Both of them are above major league average speed, which we will definitely use this season. On the mound, Tanner Banks, AJ Carmen and Ruddy Acosta anchor a very deep pitching staff.

Q- What would you say are the 'set goals' that you've got for your Bruins in 2012?

Our set goal is to play every pitch, take every at bat and make every play as well as we can. We are a very process oriented group. The harder we work at the small things, in the weight room and the batting cages, the better we will be for it. If we focus and take seriously every opportunity that we have to make a play, it will add up to success in the end. Working hard on the process equals success—the awards and championships are just rewards for how hard we worked that year.

Head Coach DG Nelson

In his eight years of heading the SLCC baseball program, Coach DG Nelson has won a SWAC Championship, recorded the schools' best record and best ever winning percentage, while sending players to top institutions and one to even a MLB World Series team.

Last season (2011) marked the first time in eight years a SLCC Baseball team reached the District Playoffs. The 2011 team set a record for most wins in a season (49) highest NJCAA rank (1) and won the Region 18 Championship for the first time since 2003.

Coach Nelson has compiled a 282-176 overall record and 186-126 SWAC record as head coach and developed Salt Lake into one of the premier juco baseball programs in the country.

Prior to joining SLCC as an assistant in 2000, Nelson was an assistant at Dixie State College on their SWAC Championship and National Runner-up team. He also served as a hitting coach for the St. George Pioneerzz in 2002 and worked as a graduate assistant at BYU from 1998-1999.

As a player, Nelson helped BYU win the WAC in 1994 and was an All-WAC player in 1997. He then played in the Western Baseball League making stops with the Bend Bandits and St. George Pioneerzz. He was a member of the league-winning Pioneerzz in 2000.

Coach Nelson earned a bachelor's degree from BYU in Sociology and English. He and his wife Jodi are the proud parents of four daughters.



Assistant Coach Derek Waddoups



Coach Derek Waddoups enters his fifth season as assistant baseball coach for Salt Lake Community College. In 2011 the SLCC team finished with a record of 49-16(28-12 SWAC) and the Region 18 title for the first time since 2003.

Coach Waddoups teaches the Know Greater Heroes program with softball head coach Mary Kay Amicone.

Under Waddoups guidance as hitting coach, the Bruins lead the SWAC in batting average of .308, and lead in most all other offensive categories.

Along with the outstanding team accomplishments SLCC Baseball received many individual awards with 5 first-team All Region selections and 4 second- team selections. Adam Gunn was also

named SWAC Pitcher of the Year in 2011.

The Bruins have moved numerous players to 4 year institutions. Currently playing at 4-year institutions are: Adam Gunn (UVU), Sean Moysh (UVU), Mitch Manning (BYU), Kyle Bilbry (ASU), Josh Mooney (DSC) and Tyson Memmott (Sterling). There have been 20 Bruins that have been drafted into the MLB since 1997.

Prior to SLCC Waddoups spent the 2007 season at The University of Texas at Brownsville as the pitching coach and the '05-'06 seasons at Bellevue University (NE) as the hitting and catching coach. He spent the summer of 2006 with the Wisconsin Woodchucks of the Northwoods Collegiate League as an assistant coach.

A graduate of Roy High School in Roy, Utah, Waddoups lettered in football, basketball, and baseball and was named Athlete of the Year as a senior. He served a mission for the LDS church in Mexico Torreon.

Waddoups received his Masters Degree in Leadership from Bellevue University in 2006. Derek is happily married to Carly Waddoups and they have a daughter, Paisley (18 m) with son Paxon due to arrive in June.



Assistant Coach Sam Swenson

Sam Swenson begins his third year with the Bruins. His responsibilities will include outfielders and hitting. Coach Swenson graduated from Bingham high School in 1996 where he was a three sport letter winner and was named All-State in baseball two years in a row. He went on to play for the University of Utah and graduated in 2000. Sam was drafted by the Angels in 2001 and went on to play in the Pioneer League and earned all-star honors in 2001. He retired from pro baseball in 2003.

Sam is married to Mindy and they have four children; Brooks, Taeler, Daxon and Cash.



Assistant Coach Kevin Gust

Kevin Gust joins the Bruins for his third year. He will put his valuable knowledge to work in the infield.

Coach Gust is a Salt Lake native with a big time baseball background. His dad was a Cincinnati Reds scout and the former head coach at Hillcrest High for more than 30 years.

Kevin graduated from Bingham High School and played college baseball at UVU, where he was an all-conference shortstop. He owns a successful construction company and is married to Joan. They have three children; Brynn, Brandon and Camron.

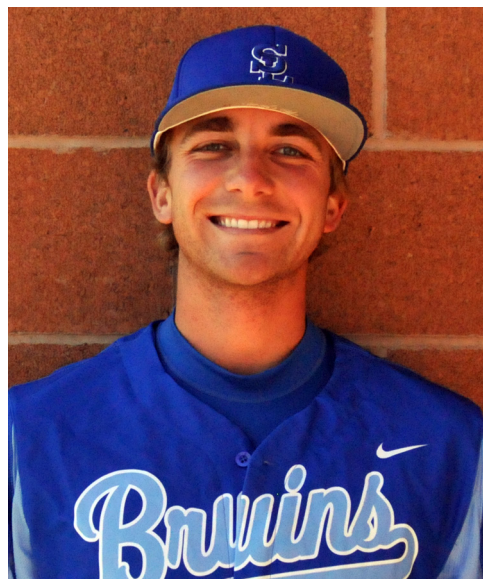

Dr. Cynthia A. Bioteau is the seventh president of Salt Lake Community College, an urban multi-campus college of 60,000 students located throughout the Salt Lake Valley.

She has over 30 years of experience as an educator and administrator, serving in educational and mental health institutions throughout the East, and most recently in North Carolina.

Dr. Bioteau earned her Bachelor's Degree at the University of New Hampshire, her Master's Degree at Assumption College in Worcester, Massachusetts, and her Doctor of Philosophy Degree at Lesley University, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Dr. Bioteau received the 2002 Boston Public Schools Higher Education Partnership Service Award and the 2001 Outstanding Developmental Program in New England Award. Contemporary research includes *Critical Transformations: Essays of Voice for Nontraditional Adult Learners*. Other publications include *Beyond the Open Gate: Influences on Student Success* and *The Community College as a Catalyst for Change*.

She is also responsible for creating and implementing the first associate degree in Nanotechnology for the state of North Carolina, as well as the five-college National Initiative recently funded through the United States Department of Labor – The National Center for the Biotechnology Workforce.

She is known for her passion for positioning the community college as the core and engine of economic and workforce development.

Perhaps her most important accomplishments, however, are the two wonderful adult children she shares with her husband of 32 years. Together they enjoy family, fly-fishing, kayaking, hiking and gardening.

Dr. Huftalin serves as Vice President for Student Services at Salt Lake Community College and has worked in the student affairs field for twenty-three years. In addition to working with student services, she has been very involved in student leadership development, learning communities on campus, and strategic planning and assessment initiatives. Deneece earned a Bachelor's degree at the University of Utah, a Master's degree at University of California, Los Angeles and a doctorate at the University of Utah.

Norma Carr
Athletic Director

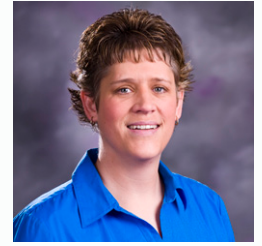
Norma Carr is a sports icon in the state of Utah. She was the only woman considered in the top 25 Most Influential People in Utah Sports. As the first woman in Utah to serve as athletic director for both men and women's programs and the first to officiate in boy's high school basketball games, she has been recognized as a standard bearer among Utah sports figures.

Norma graduated as a five sport athlete from BYU in 1969 and went on to receive her Master's Degree at the University of Utah. She started her coaching career at Davis High School and in 1975 went on to coach at the University of Utah. During her 14 years at Utah, she was head Volleyball Coach for five years, assisted with Women's Basketball and Softball for one season. She was named "Coach of the Year" for either Region or Conference in 1976, '78,'80, '85 and '87. She also served as the assistant women's athletic director for two years.

Since joining the Bruins in 1989, Norma has been at the helm of building both the athletic program and its facilities. Norma took a struggling athletic program that consisted of only two sports (Men's and Women's Basketball) and turned it into a successful five-sport program. She oversaw the construction of the Lifetime Activities Center and Bruin Arena, Cate Field and the softball diamond. Her teams have always finished among the very top in the conference, having won numerous titles in the past 15 years. In 2009 the Men's Basketball team won the NJCAA National Championship. Norma was inducted into the Utah Softball Hall of Fame; the Utah Coaches of Merit Hall of Fame; and the UHSSA Officials Hall of Fame. In 2007 she was named to the UHSSA "Circle of Fame". Finally in 2009 she was awarded the National Administrator of the Year. She coordinated Volleyball officials for the Western Athletic and Mountain West Conferences and is the current Region Director of the NJCAA Region 18. She is also Chairperson for NJCAA Softball.

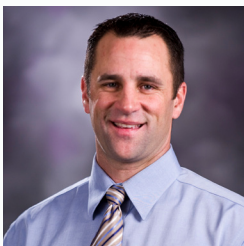

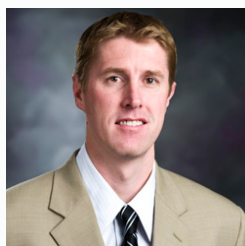

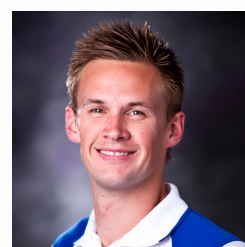
