PREVIEW

Saint Louis will finish up the 2012 regular season with a mid-week game against Southern Illinois. They get a quick day off before traveling to Evanston, Ill. to take on Northwestern for the final series of 2012. The Bills will then head to the A-10 conference tournament in the Bronx, hosted by Fordham.

LAST WEEK

The Billikens wrapped up their 2012 A-10 schedule with a series sweep over preseason favorite Charlotte. The three wins locked up the top seed in the Atlantic 10 tournament for the first time in school history. The Bills also slammed three home runs in a mid-week game against Eastern Illinois. It is the most round-trippers SLU has hit in a game this season.

BILLIKEN RECORD BOOK:

- Senior **Travis Parker** holds SLU's all-time mark in career saves with 21. He also broke his own single season save record with his 11th save on May 13.
- Junior **Mike Levine** is second all-time in career assists with 526. Nick Steiner holds the all-time mark at 562.
- Junior **Alex Alemann** is second all-time in career wins with 21. Dave Sever holds the all-time mark with 22.
- Freshman **Alec Solé** is second in single season assists with 177, Levine is third with 175. Levine holds the single season record with 187 in 2010.
- **Alemann** is tied for eighth in single season wins with 7.
- Parker is second in single season appearances with 25. One more appearance matches the SLU standard of 26 set by Joe Buehler in 2004.
- On March 6, 2012 against Southeast Missouri State, the Billikens set a school record for runs scored in a contest with 22. They also set the standard for HBP with 7.
- From March 4 through March 25, Saint Louis recorded 13 straight victories, a program-best win streak.
- The 1-0 victory over St. Bonaventure on May 6 was Saint Louis' 33rd win of the season, matching the school's all-time win mark.

ACROSS THE DIAMOND

Southern Illinois

The Salukis have been a thorn in the side of the Billikens, with a 51-10 series advantage. This year, SIU is led by Chris Serritella, a dangerous .393 hitter. He has a .672 slugging percentage with a .459 on-base percentage, both team bests. On the hill, RHP Aaron Snyder will get the start. Snyder has been the top bullpen option for the Salukis, making 23 appearances with a 4.00 ERA, 27 SO and 13 BB. This will be his first start of the season.

Northwestern

Northwestern will host the Billikens after a mid-week game against Notre Dame. The Wildcats are powered by Kyle Ruchim, who hits .271 with a .388 slugging percentage and a .364 on-base percentage. RHP Francis Brooke is the staff ace in Evanston. He touts a 2.66 ERA with 60 SO to 12 BB.

A-10 PLAYOFF PICTURE

The Billikens have locked up the top seed in the postseason tournament at Fordham. As the top seed, they receive a first-round bye and will take on the winner of the No. 4 vs. No. 5 seed game. Seeding is still TBA.

COMMANDING THE ZONE

The Billikens pitching staff has the fewest walks allowed (120) in the A-10 and is second in strikeouts (352). In 84 innings pitched, **Alex Alemann** has allowed 19 free passes, fifth in the A-10 among starting pitchers.

SHUTTING THE DOOR

At the end of the game, **Travis Parker** has thrown 34.2 innings over 25 appearances, notching 11 saves. He has also struck out 30 and has not allowed an earned run this season. Parker has now gone 37.1 innings without allowing an earned run, dating back to last season.

AK LEADS THE WAY

Alex Kelly has had a terrific junior year for Saint Louis. The left fielder leads the team in batting average, slugging percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs and home runs. He and fellow transfer **Grant Nelson** are the only Bills to start all 52 contests this season.

WALK LIKE A BILLIKEN

The Billikens own a .385 on-base percentage this season, best in the A-10. Their 240 walks also leads the A-10. Senior **Marco DiRoma** leads the team with 35 free passes, third in the conference. Junior **Mike Levine** is second in the A-10 with 17 hit by pitches. The Billikens have finished in the A-10 top three in walks in every season of head coach **Darin Hendrickson's** tenure

SEASON OF THE STREAK

Saint Louis has had streaks of all varieties this season. Senior **Marco DiRoma**, junior **Alex Kelly** and junior **Mike Levine** have had the longest hitting streaks of the year at eight games. **Grant Nelson** is in the midst of a 25-game on base streak. Earlier this season, the Bills rattled off 13 consecutive wins, a SLU record winning streak. Junior **Alex Alemann** had a 32.1 inning streak without allowing an earned run to start the season. Senior **Travis Parker** is currently on a similar streak of 37.1 innings.

NATIONAL RESPECT

The Billikens were ranked 30th in the Mar. 26 Collegiate Baseball Newspaper to earn the first national ranking in school history. The Bills have made the NCAA postseason tournament three times, but have never earned a spot in any of the national polls.

VIGLIAROLO EARNS A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Vigliarolo powered the Billikens to a conference sweep of St. Bonaventure to put Saint Louis in a tie for first place in the A-10. TAgainst the Bonnies, the Smithtown, N.Y., native hit .500 (5-10) with a .600 slugging percentage and .545 on-base percentage. In addition to his balanced production at the plate, he showed prowess in the field, going error-free in 26 chances on the week.

ALEMANN NAMED A-10 PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Junior RHP **Alex Alemann** earned Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Week honors for his efforts in the series opener against Northern Illinois. It is the second time he has been honored. Alemann also received accolades on Mar. 5 for his game against St. Mary's College.

KELLY EARNS CONFERENCE HONOR

Junior **Alex Kelly** won Atlantic 10 Player of the Week on Feb. 27 for his series against Mount St. Mary's. In the four-game series, the Fort Collins, Colo., native ripped his second home run of the season, while maintaining a .583 average. He also crossed the plate eight times, while adding a double and a RBI.

SAINT LOUIS PROBABLE STARTERS

C Connor Gandossy

Gandossy is hitting .264 this season with a .392 on-base percentage and a .397 slugging percentage. He is one of the top defensive catchers in the A-10 and only 16 runners have attempted to steal on him over 52 games, with 10 being caught stealing. He has recorded only one error in 281 chances.

1B Mike Vigliarolo

Vigliarolo has been a spark for the Billikens this season. He is hitting .302 with a .370 on-base percentage and a .446 slugging percentage. Against Temple on Mar. 24, his double in the ninth inning broke up a no-hitter and propelled the Bills to a ninth-inning comeback victory.

2B Mike Levine

Levine is a defensive specialist at second base. He is hitting .264 with a .385 on-base percentage and a .355 slugging percentage in the leadoff slot. The junior leads the team in assists and is among the school's all-time leaders in the category. He is also the team's leader in doubles with 13.

3B Grant Nelson

The transfer from Skyline College has made his mark on the 2012 season. He is one of three Billikens to have started every game this season. He is hitting .323 with a .413 on-base percentage and slugging .441. He is second on the team with 82 total bags this season.

SS Alec Solé

Solé is an impact freshman from Holbrook, N.Y. On the season, he is hitting .280 with a .357 on-base percentage over 51 games. Solé has been in numerous clutch situations in his young career and delivered more often than not. He drew a sixth-inning walk against Temple on Mar. 24, breaking up a perfect game, and later scored the game-winning run in the contest.

LF Alex Kelly

The former high school football star has excelled on the diamond as a Billiken. Kelly has started in every contest for SLU and has hit .335 with a .412 on-base percentage and a .498 slugging percentage. He is one of the top offensive contributors for Saint Louis, leading the team in average, slugging percentage, HR, runs scored and RBIs.

CF Jerry Mancuso

Mancuso is one of the senior leaders on the Billikens. He has done it all in his four-year career: infield, outfield and pitcher. Mancuso is hitting .262 and belted two home runs in the month of April. He boasts a .369 slugging percentage to go with a .364 on-base mark.

RF Steve Fernandez

Fernandez is the cleanup man for the Bills. While starting in 51 games, Fernandez is hitting .303 with a .404 on-base percentage and a .404 slugging percentage. He has driven in 31 runs this season.

DH Marco DiRoma

DiRoma has been having a stellar senior campaign. He is hitting .286 with a .461 on-base percentage and a .406 slugging percentage. Additionally, DiRoma has stolen 10 bags, a career best. DiRoma is second in the conference in on-base percentage.

SP Clay Smith

Smith has been one of the top pitchers in the A-10 all season, notching a 6-2 record with a 2.71 ERA over 83 innings. He has not allowed a home run all season. Smith is third all-time in wins by a sophomore and third in strikeouts by a sophomore.

SP Alex Alemann

Alemann has been a reliable option for Saint Louis this season. He is 7-0 with a 2.36 ERA, 65 strikeouts and 19 walks. He has also held opposing hitters to a .225 average. Earlier this season, Alemann had a 32.1 inning streak where he did not allow an earned run. He has only given up nine extra-base hits this year.

RP Travis Parker

Parker has been one of the top closers in the nation as a senior. He has a 3-1 record without allowing an earned run this season. Parker has struck out 30 batters in 34.2 innings, and has held opposing batters to a .157 average. He is currently on a 37.1 inning streak without allowing an earned run.
