PREVIEW

The Billikens will wrap up their 2012 home schedule as well as the A-10 regular season by hosting Eastern Illinois on Tuesday and traveling to Charlotte, N.C. over the weekend. Eastern Illinois was the squad that snapped the Billikens' historic 13 game win streak. Charlotte was named the preseason favorite to win the A-10.

LAST WEEK

Saint Louis defeated a hard-hitting SEMO squad before dropping a tough contest to SIUE. However, the Bills responded with a conference sweep of St. Bonaventure. The sweep gave SLU a 14-7 conference mark, netting first place for the Billikens. The sweep also helped Saint Louis achieve their 33rd victory of the season, tying the all-time school record.

BILLIKEN RECORD BOOK:

- Senior **Travis Parker** holds SLU's all-time mark in career saves with 19.
- Junior **Mike Levine** is second all-time in career assists with 508. Nick Steiner holds the all-time mark at 562.
- Junior **Alex Alemann** is third all-time in career wins with 20. John Marcum is second all-time with 21.
- On March 6, 2012 against Southeast Missouri State, the Billikens set a school record for runs scored in a contest with 22. They also set the standard for HBP with 7.
- From March 4 through March 25, Saint Louis recorded 13 straight victories, a program-best win streak.
- The 1-0 victory over St. Bonaventure on May 6 was Saint Louis' 33rd win of the season, matching the school's all-time win mark.

ACROSS THE DIAMOND

Eastern Illinois

The last time the Billikens played the Eastern Illinois, the Bills were in the midst of a 13-game winning streak. However, that streak ended in Charleston on a 6-13 loss to the Panthers. T.J. McManus leads EIU with a .359 batting average, a .641 slugging percentage and a .414 on-base percentage. He has also hit nine round-trippers on the season.

Charlotte

The 49ers sit in ninth place in the A-10 with a 8-9 conference mark. They are led offensively by speedster Shane Brown. He leads the A-10 with a .374 batting average and 29 stolen bases. On the hill, preseason All-American Andrew Smith is the power arm for Charlotte. Last season, Smith was named the A-10 Pitcher of the Year.

A-10 PLAYOFF PICTURE

The Billikens sit in first in the A-10 with an 14-7 conference record. The top six teams will make the conference tournament at Fordham. Saint Louis has one conference series remaining against defending champion Charlotte (ninth, 8-9). Last season, the final team to make the conference tournament had 13 wins.

COMMANDING THE ZONE

The Billikens pitching staff has the fewest walks allowed (113) in the A-10 and is second in strikeouts (327). Among pitchers who have at least 40 innings pitched, LHP Damian Rivera has the fewest walks allowed with eight over 49 innings.

SHUTTING THE DOOR

At the end of the game, **Travis Parker** has thrown 31.2 innings over 23 appearances, notching nine saves. He has also struck out 28 and has not allowed an earned run this season. Parker has now gone 34.1 innings without allowing an earned run, dating back to last season.

JUNIORS LEAD THE WAY

The junior quad of **Alex Kelly**, **Steve Fernandez**, and **Grant Nelson** have started in all 48 games for Saint Louis this season. The trio forms the heart of the SLU lineup and are among the leaders in every category for the Bills. Kelly leads the team in average, slugging percentage, runs scored and home runs. Fernandez is the team leader in RBIs. Nelson has a team-best 12 doubles. Kelly (.333), Nelson (.320) and Fernandez (.314) are 1-2-3, respectively on the Saint Louis batting average leaderboard.

WALK LIKE A BILLIKEN

The Billikens own a .383 on-base percentage this season, best in the A-10. Their 217 walks also leads the A-10. Senior **Marco DiRoma** leads the team with 28 free passes, eighth in the conference. Junior **Mike Levine** is second in the A-10 with 16 hit by pitches. The Billikens have finished in the A-10 top three in walks in every season of head coach **Darin Hendrickson's** tenure

SEASON OF THE STREAK

Saint Louis has had streaks of all varieties this season. Senior **Marco DiRoma** and junior **Mike Levine** have had the longest hitting streaks of the year at eight games. **Grant Nelson** is in the midst of a 21-game on base streak. Earlier this season, the Bills rattled off 13 consecutive wins, a SLU record winning streak. Junior **Alex Alemann** had a 27.2 inning streak without allowing an earned run. Senior **Travis Parker** is currently on a similar streak of 30.1 innings.

NATIONAL RESPECT

The Billikens were ranked 30th in the Mar. 26 Collegiate Baseball Newspaper to earn the first national ranking in school history. The Bills have made the NCAA postseason tournament three times, but have never earned a spot in any of the national polls.

VIGLIAROLO EARNS A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Vigliarolo powered the Billikens to a conference sweep of St. Bonaventure to put Saint Louis in a tie for first place in the A-10. TAgainst the Bonnies, the Smithtown, N.Y., native hit .500 (5-10) with a .600 slugging percentage and .545 on-base percentage. In addition to his balanced production at the plate, he showed prowess in the field, going error-free in 26 chances on the week.

ALEMANN NAMED A-10 PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Junior RHP **Alex Alemann** earned Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Week honors for his efforts in the series opener against Northern Illinois. It is the second time he has been honored. Alemann also received accolades on Mar. 5 for his game against St. Mary's College.

KELLY EARNS CONFERENCE HONOR

Junior **Alex Kelly** won Atlantic 10 Player of the Week on Feb. 27 for his series against Mount St. Mary's. In the four-game series, the Fort Collins, Colo., native ripped his second home run of the season, while maintaining a .583 average. He also crossed the plate eight times, while adding a double and a RBI.

SAINT LOUIS PROBABLE STARTERS

C Connor Gandossy

Gandossy is hitting .20 this season with a .376 on-base percentage and a .357 slugging percentage. He is one of the top defensive catchers in the A-10 and only 15 runners have attempted to steal on him over 48 games, with 10 being caught stealing. He has recorded only one error in 261 chances.

1B Mike Vigliarolo

Vigliarolo has been a spark for the Billikens this season. He is hitting .304 with a .372 on-base percentage and a .464 slugging percentage. Against Temple on Mar. 24, his double in the ninth inning broke up a no-hitter and propelled the Bills to a ninth-inning comeback victory.

2B Mike Levine

Levine is a defensive specialist at second base. He is hitting .256 with a .376 on-base percentage and a .344 slugging percentage in the leadoff slot. The junior leads the team in assists and is among the school's all-time leaders in the category. He is second on the squad with 11 doubles.

3B Grant Nelson

The transfer from Skyline College has made his mark on the 2012 season. He is one of three Billikens to have started every game this season. He is hitting .320 with a .415 on-base percentage and slugging .414. He has amassed a team-best 12 doubles this season.

SS Alec Solé

Solé is an impact freshman from Holbrook, N.Y. On the season, he is hitting .279 with a .355 on-base percentage over 47 games. Solé has been in numerous clutch situations in his young career and delivered more often than not. He drew a sixth-inning walk against Temple on Mar. 24, breaking up a perfect game, and later scored the game-winning run in the contest.

LF Alex Kelly

The former high school football star has excelled on the diamond as a Billiken. Kelly has started in every contest for SLU and has hit .333 with a .408 on-base percentage and a .473 slugging percentage. He is one of the top offensive contributors for Saint Louis, leading the team in average, slugging percentage, HR and runs scored.

CF Jerry Mancuso

Mancuso is one of the senior leaders on the Billikens. He has done it all in his four-year career: infield, outfield and pitcher. Mancuso is hitting .261 and belted two home runs in the month of April. He boasts a .377 slugging percentage to go with a .350 on-base mark.

RF Steve Fernandez

Fernandez is the cleanup man for the Bills. While starting in all 48 games, Fernandez is hitting .314 with a .408 on-base percentage and a .420 slugging percentage. He has driven in a team-best 31 runs this season.

DH Marco DiRoma

DiRoma has been having a stellar senior campaign. He is hitting .298 with a .453 on-base percentage and a .427 slugging percentage. Additionally, DiRoma has stolen 10 bags, a career best. DiRoma is fourth in the conference in on-base percentage.

SP Clay Smith

Smith has been one of the top pitchers in the A-10 all season, notching a 6-2 record with a 2.45 ERA over 77 innings. He has not allowed a home run all season. Smith is third all-time in wins by a sophomore and fourth in strikeouts by a sophomore.

SP Alex Alemann

Alemann has been a reliable option for Saint Louis this season. He is 6-0 with a 2.57 ERA, 61 strikeouts and 19 walks. He has also held opposing hitters to a .222 average. Earlier this season, Alemann had a 27.2 inning streak where he did not allow an earned run. He has only given up eight extra-base hits this year.

RP Travis Parker

Parker has been the team's closer this season. He has a 3-1 record without allowing an earned run this season. Parker has struck out 28 batters in 31.2 innings, and has held opposing batters to a .172 average. He is currently on a 34.1 inning streak without allowing an earned run.
