## THE OPENING TIP...

- Saint Louis is in the midst of a season-opening six-game homestand. The Billikens enter Sunday's showdown with No. 12 Seton Hall with a 3-0 record after picking up victories against Florida Gulf Coast (89-67), Valparaiso (81-70) and Eastern Washington (82-60) to start the year.
- The Billikens have scored 80 or more points in each of the first three games of a season for the first time since the 1993-94 season, as well as 80 or more in three straight games at any point during a season since 2000-01.
- Sunday's game against No. 12 Seton Hall will be the ninth game the Billikens have played against a ranked opponent at Chaifetz Arena. SLU is 4-4 in those games. The Billikens' last win against a ranked foe at Chaifetz came during the 2012-13 season, a 76-62 win against No. 24 VCU on Feb. 19, 2013.
- Saint Louis junior forward **Hasahn French** is second in the SLU record book in blocked shots for a career. He now has 130 career blocks and needs six more to surpass **Ian Vouyoukas'** school record of 135 blocks.
- Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** leads the Billikens in scoring (16.0 ppg), rebounding (8.3 rpg) and steals (3.0 spg).
- Freshman guard **Yuri Collins** is fifth in the NCAA in assists per game (8.3 apg), first among freshmen (through games of Nov. 14). He is coming off an 11-assist outing against Eastern Washington.
- Seton Hall is 2-1 on the season. The Pirates are coming off a 76-73 home loss on Thursday to No. 3 Michigan State. Guard **Myles Powell** dropped an impressive 37 points in the game.
- Up next, SLU hosts High Point at Chaifetz Arena on Wednesday.

## ABOUT SUNDAY'S GAME

► The Billikens continue their season-opening six-game homestand on Sunday afternoon when they welcome No. 12 Seton Hall. Game time is 3 p.m.  
 ► Sunday's game will be televised on ESPNU, with **Jordan Bernfield** and **Kevin Lehman** on the call.  
 ► Sunday's radio broadcast airs on 101 ESPN (101.1 FM). As always, Billiken Hall of Famers **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action.

## LAST TIME OUT

► Saint Louis shot 69.6 percent from the field in the second half and ran away with an 82-60 victory over Eastern Washington Wednesday night at Chaifetz Arena.  
 ► **Hasahn French** scored a game-high 19 points on 9-of-11 shooting and added six rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals. **Fred Thatch Jr.** tossed in 11 points and tied **Jordan Goodwin** for team-high rebounding honors with seven boards.  
 ► **Yuri Collins** dished out a game- and career-high 11 assists while committing just two turnovers. **Tay Weaver** tallied nine points on 3-of-3 shooting from beyond the arc.  
 ► SLU finished 31-of-54 (57.4 percent) from the field following its torrid second-half performance. The Billikens were 8-of-21 (38.1 percent) from 3-point distance.

## SHOTS ARE FALLING

► The Billikens have scored 80 or more points in the first three games of the season for the first time since 1993-94. The 2000-01 team was the last Billiken squad to score 80 or more points in three straight games at any point during the season.  
 ► Saint Louis has a chance on Sunday do something that hasn't happened at SLU since 1955 - score 80 or more points in the first four games of a season. That 1955-56 team, led by legendary head coach **Eddie Hickey**, surpassed 80 or more points in each of the first nine games of the season.  
 ► The Billikens' 89 points against Florida Gulf Coast in the season opener were the most points scored by SLU in the **Travis Ford** era. Also, they were the most points scored in a season opener since the 1982-83 season.

## BILLIKENS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

► Sunday's game against Seton Hall will be the ninth game against a ranked foe in the 12-year history of Chaifetz Arena.  
 ► The Billikens are 4-4 against ranked opponents at Chaifetz Arena. The last ranked opponent to visit Chaifetz Arena was No. 16 VCU on Jan. 23, 2015. SLU dropped that game 63-61 after VCU scored the game-winning basket with 0.9 seconds remaining.  
 ► SLU's last win against a ranked opponent at Chaifetz Arena was Feb. 19, 2013, a 76-62 win over No. 24 VCU.  
 ► SLU won three consecutive games against ranked opponents in that magical 2012-13 season, starting with a 60-46 win over No. 20 New Mexico on New Year's Eve.  
 ► The Billikens' best win against a ranked opponent at Chaifetz Arena came against No. 9 Butler on Jan. 31, 2013, a 76-62 victory.  
 ► Saint Louis twice played a ranked opponent last year - falling 68-64 at No. 24 Houston and 81-59 on a neutral floor against No. 11 Florida State.

## BLOCK PARTY

► Junior forward **Hasahn French**, who is second on the Billikens in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (6.7 rpg), is on the verge of becoming SLU's all-time leader in blocked shots.  
 ► French enters the Seton Hall game second in school history with 130 blocked shots. He needs six more to surpass **Ian Vouyoukas'** school record of 135 blocks.  
 ► French registered 66 blocked shots a year ago, tied for third most in a single season in school history. He posted a SLU freshman-record 59 blocked shots as a freshman.  
 ► French posted 10 double-doubles last season, joining Billiken great **Anthony Bonner** as the only Billikens who have recorded 10 or more double-doubles in a season. His 15 career double-doubles leads all active Billikens.

## GOODWIN DOES IT ALL

► Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** has picked up where he left off last season, stuffing the stat sheet as one of the Billikens' leaders in scoring, rebounding,

steals, etc.

► Goodwin is averaging team bests of 16.0 ppg, 8.3 rpg and 3.0 spg.

► His 3.0 steals per game rank tied for 37th in the nation (through games of Nov. 14).

► Goodwin's 66 steals last year were the fifth-most in school history in a single season. He is already in the top 20 in school history with 127 career steals, five away from cracking the top 10.

► Last season, Goodwin led all NCAA guards in offensive rebounding with a 3.5 orpg average. His 127 offensive rebounds last season are the most by a Billiken since offensive rebounds began being tracked in the mid 1980s.

#### COLLINS PUTTING ON A SHOW

► Freshman point guard **Yuri Collins** is quickly turning into a fan-favorite among the Billiken faithful, prompting the term **Yurimania** to be used when discussing his exciting and creative pass-making ability.

► A true "pass-first" point guard who routinely mentions in interviews that all he wants to do is set up his teammates to score, Collins ranks fifth in the NCAA in assists per game (8.3 apg) and is first among freshmen (through Nov. 14).

► He dished out a game-high 11 assists in the Billikens' last game against Eastern Washington. One of them was a running, no-look, bounce-pass behind the run of play that **Hasahn French** slammed home. The play was No. 9 on SportsCenter's Top 10 Plays the next day.

► Collins' game hasn't been unexpected. He led St. Mary's High School (St. Louis) to its first ever state semifinal appearance last year. He is widely considered one of the top point guards ever from the St. Louis area prep scene.

#### THATCH LOCKING DOWN ON D

► Sophomore guard **Fred Thatch Jr.** is expected to make a big jump his sophomore year after playing in all 36 games as a freshman.

► One of the big reasons why is his defending. Last year, head coach **Travis Ford** had no second thoughts about putting Thatch on the opposing team's top scoring guard when A-10 Defensive Player of the Year **Javon Bess** needed a spell.

► Offensively, Thatch is scoring at a 8.3 ppg clip and is shooting 47.1 percent from the field.

#### JACOBS HAS BREAKOUT GAME

► Sophomore guard **Demarius Jacobs** had a breakout game against Valparaiso on Nov. 9, scoring 20 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the field.

► He scored eight points in all of 2018-19 as he appeared in just 19 games after suffering through injuries.

#### EVERYONE CONTRIBUTES

► The Billikens have 10 players who are playing more than 10 minutes per game.

► All 15 Billikens saw playing time in the Eastern Washington, and 13 of them scored.

#### BILLIKENS ON THE BOARDS

► The Billikens led the Atlantic 10 Conference and ranked in the top 20 nationally in rebounding margin (+6.5) last season.

► It's more of the same this year. The Billikens are a +7.0 in rebounding margin through their first two games this season.

► SLU's 1,427 rebounds were the most in school history in the modern era, surpassing the 1,375 rebounds brought down by the 1988-89 Billikens.

► The Billikens finished among the NCAA leaders in offensive rebounds per game. **Jordan Goodwin** led all guards in the NCAA and was in the top 10 overall in the country with 3.5 offensive rebounds per game.

#### RECAPPING LAST YEAR

► Saint Louis went 23-13 overall and 10-8 in the A-10 a season ago.

► SLU won the A-10 Championship in thrilling fashion, winning four games in four days as a six seed at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York.

► The Billikens made the NCAA Tournament, their fourth this decade, but lost to fourth-seed Virginia Tech in the First Round in San Jose.

#### MORE ON THE BILLIKENS' RUN TO THE A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP

► As a No. 6 seed at the 2019 A-10 Championship in Brooklyn, N.Y., the Billikens won four games in four days at Barclays Center to capture its second A-10 Championship crown.

► Billiken Hall of Fame radio analyst **Earl Austin Jr.** coined SLU's march through

the A-10 Championship "The Billiken Redemption Tour." All four opponents the Bills defeated (Richmond, Dayton, Davidson, St. Bonaventure) beat the Billikens the last time they met in the regular season.

►It was Saint Louis' second A-10 Championship title. The Billikens last won the A-10 crown in 2013, when they became the very first collegiate team to cut the nets down in a then brand-new Barclays Center.

### BACK IN THE NCAAS

►The Billikens made their 10th appearance overall and fourth this decade in the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship last season, earning the No. 13 seed and playing Virginia Tech in San Jose, California.

►Saint Louis last was in the NCAA Tournament in 2014, completing a stretch of three straight appearances. SLU won a game in each of them.

### PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

►SLU was predicted to finish seventh in the Atlantic 10 Conference race in the annual preseason poll of A-10 head coaches and media.

►Junior **Hasahn French** was named preseason second-team All-Conference and was voted to the league's preseason All-Defensive team. Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** was voted to the preseason third-team.

### BILLIKENS HAVE SEVEN NEWCOMERS

►The Billikens welcome seven newcomers in 2019-20.

►Senior guard **Tay Weaver** is a graduate transfer from Eastern Kentucky. Junior guard/forward **Javonte Perkins** is a JUCO transfer from SWIC.

►Five true freshmen join the Billikens, including local standouts **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** (East St. Louis HS) and **Yuri Collins** (St. Mary's HS).

►Also joining the squad are big men **Jimmy Bell Jr.** (Bella Vista Prep) and **Madani Diarra** (St. Benedict's Prep), as well as sharp-shooting guard **Gibson Jimerson** (Montverde Academy).

### FORD IN FOURTH SEASON

►**Travis Ford** is in his fourth season with the Billikens and his 23rd overall. He is 55-50 in four years at SLU, 391-316 in 23 seasons overall.

►The Billikens have improved their win total in all three seasons under Ford.

►Last season marked the 11th time that Ford guided his team to the postseason, and it was his seventh NCAA Tournament appearance.

### HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

►The Billikens are in their 12th season at the state-of-the-art Chaifetz Arena. SLU was 15-2 last year and has an all-time record of 142-55 on its current home floor.

►Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus and recent inductee into the Billiken Hall of Fame, **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**. Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded ComPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

►Chaifetz is also one of the Billikens' biggest fans. He is often seen courtside (next to the TV table) at Billikens games. He has graciously hosted the men's and women's basketball teams for team meals while on roadtrips in New York and Florida.

### HISTORY LESSON

►This is the 105th season of Saint Louis University men's basketball.

►The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by Easy **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Macauley's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

►The AP poll was first released the next season, and Saint Louis was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949. SLU was No. 1 again the next week until Kentucky claimed the top spot for the rest of the season.

►**Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).

►SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

►The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

# HeadCoach **TRAVIS FORD**



In three years as Saint Louis University's head men's basketball coach, **Travis Ford** has reinvigorated the program and reestablished its place on the national stage.

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total in each of his first three seasons, highlighted by last season's 23-13 record, an Atlantic 10 Conference Championship, and a bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Billikens entered the 2018-19 season with high expectations, being picked to win the league despite finishing in a tie for fifth in the league standings in 2017-18.

Ford had the Billikens playing their best basketball late in the season. Saint Louis entered the Atlantic 10 Conference Men's Basketball Championship as the No. 6 seed, and SLU would go on to win four games in four days for the conference title.

SLU was a No. 13 seed in the NCAA Tournament, Ford's seventh appearance as a head coach in the NAAs and 11th in a postseason in his career.

In 23 years as a collegiate head coach, Ford's career record stands at 391-316. In four years at Saint Louis, he holds a 55-50 record.

In addition to his four years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville University. Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and six who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Ford spent three years as head coach at the University of Massachusetts. He led the Minutemen to a pair of 20-win seasons in 2006-07 (A-10 regular-season co-champions, NIT second round) and 2007-08 (NIT finalist).

Over the span of five seasons at Eastern Kentucky, Ford engineered a turnaround that saw the Colonels post 22 victories his final year after they registered seven in each of his first two seasons. In 2004-05, ECU won the Ohio Valley Conference title to give the program its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 26 years.

Ford began his first foray into coaching in 1997 with a three-year stint at Campbellsville University, an NAIA school in Kentucky.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.

Ford, is a native of Madisonville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Heather, have three children: Brooks, Kyleigh and Shane. Ford earned a bachelor's degree in communications at the University of Kentucky in 1994.
