## OPENING TIP

- Saint Louis continues its six-game road stretch with a matchup at UT Martin Sunday.
- Tipoff from Martin, Tenn., is set for 2 p.m. on ESPN+, with an audio feed also available on SLUBillikens.com.
- The game will mark the fifth of 11 games away from Chaifetz Arena in a 12-contest stretch for the Billikens, including the first two Atlantic 10 Conference games at George Washington (Jan. 1) and Fordham (Jan. 5).
- Sunday will mark the 12th meeting between the Billikens and Skyhawks, with UTM leading the all-time series 7-4.
- In terms of opponent winning percentage, SLU has had the 17th toughest schedule across the NCAA entering the week. Its past opponents held a 25-8 record (.758). Prior to this weekend, in their last four games, the Billikens have faced three Power Five teams and a 25th-ranked Florida Gulf Coast.
- Cijaja Harbison and Brooke Flowers continue to move up the Billikens' career charts. On SLU's all-time lists, Harbison is sixth in assists (363), seventh in made free throws (306) and scoring (1,382 points) and 10th in steals (185). Flowers ranks second in blocked shots (200) and sixth in rebounds (726).
- Flowers entered the weekend eighth nationally with 3.0 blocks per game, while her average of 11.2 rebounds ranked 12th.
- Flowers' 200 career blocked shots rank 10th among active players in the NCAA.
- Harbison's career .810 free throw percentage is 11th among active players in the NCAA.
- The Billikens will look to build off Friday's win at SEMO where Flowers posted her 20th career double-double, Harbison had her second straight 20-point performance and Kiley Bess poured in a career-best 18 points.
- Head coach Lisa Stone is in her 10th season at the helm of the Billikens and 36th overall as a collegiate head coach. She ranks 14th among active Division I head coaches and 32nd all-time with 660 career wins.

## DOUBLE-DIGIT HARBISON

- Cijia Harbison ranks fifth in the A-10 with 16.4 points per game.
- The guard has scored in double figures in 78-of-89 career games. She is riding a streak of 21 such contests. Dating back to her sophomore season, Harbison has scored 10+ points in all but one of her last 35 games.
- Harbison already ranks top 10 in Saint Louis history in assists (sixth, 363), made free throws (seventh, 306), points (seventh, 1,382) and steals (10th, 135).
- Her career average of 15.5 points is third best all-time at Saint Louis.
- Harbison's career .810 free throw percentage ranks 11th among active players in the NCAA.
- The senior has been tabbed to an All-Conference team in each of her first three seasons: first team (2019-20, 2020-21) and second team (2018-19). She was also named the A-10 Rookie of the Year as a freshman in the 2018-19 season.

## FORCE IN THE POST

- St. Louis native Brooke Flowers ranks second all-time at SLU with 200 blocked shots and is sixth all-time with 726 boards.
- After averaging a double-double of 10.2 points and 10.2 rebounds last season, Flowers was named to her first All-Conference team (third).
- The center has a team-leading 20 career double-doubles, including a 19-point, 18-rebound performance at SEMO. She also added five blocks and a career-best five assists in the contest.
- Flowers entered the weekend eighth nationally with 3.0 blocks per game, while her average of 11.2 rebounds ranked 12th.
- Flowers' 23 total blocks are top nine in the NCAA, while her 85 boards are top 25.
- Her 200 career blocked shots rank 10th among active players in the NCAA.

## HOME COOKIN'

- Just 60 miles away from her hometown, sophomore Kiley Bess posted the best game of her career Friday at SEMO.
- The Poplar Bluff, Mo., native made six field goals, including three treys, on her way to 18 points and six rebounds. All were career bests.
- Bess is second on the team with six 3-pointers, despite missing three games due to injury. She was pulled in her first minute of action against Kansas and was unable to suit up in the following two contests.
- Bess' 6.6 points and 2.8 rebounds on the season.

## MCNEAL HEATING UP

- Natalie McNeal has averaged 11.3 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists over the team's three games leading up to the weekend.
- She entered the starting lineup for the first time in her career last weekend against Florida and Florida Gulf Coast.
- McNeal is fourth on the team in scoring this season, with 6.7 points per game.
- McNeal collected career highs of 18 points, eight field goals, seven rebounds and 39 minutes against No. 25 FGCU.
- The guard had four points, four rebounds and four steals against SEMO Friday.

## LOCAL STANDOUT

- Marisa Warren, the 2019 St. Louis Post-Dispatch All-Metro Player of the Year, is in her second season with the Billikens.
- She's third on the team with 7.3 points per game, while also leading the squad with 20 assists and 14 steals.
- The transfer from DePaul played in 17 games in her first year at SLU, averaging 2.3 points in 9.5 minutes per game.
- She's one-of-three Billikens from the metro St. Louis area, joining Brooke Flowers and Kiley Bess.

## GUL STEPPING UP

- Sevval Gul is playing in her first games at SLU since her transfer from Arizona.
- The forward is averaging 6.3 points and 4.3 rebounds per game.
- She netted a career-high 14 points in the win over Indiana State.
- Gul will be seeing increased playing time, following senior forward Myriama Smith Traore's season-ending injury in October.
- The sophomore played in 16 games for Arizona in her freshman season.
- Gul has multiple years of experience on the Turkish national team, including this past summer of 2021.

## SHOOTERS BE READY!

- Junior Julia Martinez finished last season ranked fourth in the A-10 with a 2.3 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- Joining Cijia Harbison (4.0) in the top 10, she was also seventh in the conference with 3.6 assists per game.
- The guard dished out 767 career assists at Loyola Academy in Chicago, Ill., eighth most in Illinois history.
- After grabbing six rebounds in five of the first six games, Martinez is second on the Billikens in with 5.5 rebounds per game.
- Martinez did not suit up for the matchup at SEMO.
- Her 13 total assists rank fourth on the squad.
- Martinez has four multi-assist contests on the season and is third on the team with eight total steals.
- The sophomore has earned a start in every game she's played in this season.

## STIFF NON-CON COMPETITION

- Saint Louis' 13-game nonconference slate features six 2020-21 postseason teams, two contests in Puerto Rico and eight games against programs that finished in the top 100 of the NCAA NET rankings a season ago.
- In terms of opponent winning percentage, SLU entered the week with the 17th toughest schedule across the NCAA. Its past opponents held a 25-8 record (.758). In their four games leading up to this weekend, SLU has faced three Power Five teams and a 25th-ranked Florida Gulf Coast.
- The Billikens (No. 86 in the NET rankings last season) will take on Florida Gulf Coast (43), Missouri (47), Northern Iowa (61), Illinois State (69), Florida (76), UT Martin (78), Bradley (79) and Kansas (92) this year.
- FGCU and Bradley made the NCAA Tournament last season, while Missouri, UNI, UT Martin and Illinois State all made the WNIT with the Billikens.

## SOPHOMORES POISED FOR BIG SEASON

- Sophomores make up five of the 11 Billiken roster spots this season.
- Joining Natalie McNeal, Sevval Gul and Kiley Bess are Peyton Kennedy and Ny Toang.
- Toang grabbed a career- and team-best seven rebounds against Florida. She connected on her first two collegiate field goals at SEMO on Friday.
- Peyton Kennedy earned the first start of her collegiate career at SEMO Friday. She burst onto the collegiate scene, nailing four 3-pointers and recording 15 points and nine rebounds in the season opener last season.
- Sevval Gul transferred to the Billikens from Arizona in January 2021.

## ROAD WARRIORS

- Saint Louis was one of just seven teams across the NCAA to go undefeated on the road last season (6-0).
- After three home games to open the season, the Billikens are on the road for 11 of the next 12 games, including two neutral-site contests in San Juan, Puerto Rico (Nov. 26-27), and the first two Atlantic 10 Conference matchups at George Washington (Jan. 1) and Fordham (Jan. 5).

## BASKETBALL RUNS IN BESS' BLOOD

- Billiken sophomore Kiley Bess is the granddaughter of legendary head coach Gene Bess.
- The former coach of the men's basketball team at Three Rivers Community College in Poplar Bluff, Mo., retired in 2020 with a career record of 1,300-416, making him the all-time winningest college basketball coach.
- He won two national junior college basketball titles, in 1979 and 1992 and was the first college coach to reach 1,000 and 1,200 wins.

- Harbison has earned All-Conference accolades in each of her three seasons, including two first-team nods. She led the league in scoring a year ago with 16.9 points per game, and she also averaged a team-high 4.0 assists.
- Flowers was picked to the All-Conference third team last season after averaging a double-double of 10.2 points and 10.2 rebounds. Along with leading the conference in rebounding, she ranked third in the A-10 with 2.2 blocks per game.

- The Billikens' lone freshman this season is Sarah Lazar, a native of Madison, Wis., who attended high school at Edgewood.
- She was a four-year varsity starter who shot over 50 percent from the floor.

•Formally introduced as Saint Louis' seventh head women's basketball coach on May 4, 2012.

•Career record also includes eight seasons at Wisconsin (128-119), three seasons at Drake (64-27), 12 seasons at Wisconsin-Eau Claire (277-59) and three seasons at Cornell (Iowa) (34-32).

•Named A-10 Coach of the Year and College Sports Madness High Major National Coach of the Year in 2016. Has earned eight conference Coach of the Year awards during her career.

•Twenty-two of her teams have competed in postseason play (14 NCAA tournaments, eight WNIT appearances). Guided the 1996-97 and 1993-94 Wisconsin-Eau Claire teams to second place and third place, respectively, in the NCAA Division III Championship. Led Drake to the NCAA round of 16 in 2001-02 and Wisconsin to a WNIT runner-up finish in 2006-07.

Lisa Stone arrived at Saint Louis University in May 2012 with a vision to build Billiken women's basketball into a championship-caliber program.

Stone's vision has come into clear focus in recent seasons. Saint Louis captured 116 victories – third most among Atlantic 10 Conference women's basketball programs – tied for the 2015-16 A-10 regular-season championship and made four Women's National Invitation Tournament appearances during the past six seasons.

Despite a season unlike any other, due to COVID-19, the 2020-21 Billikens finished with a 14-5 record and made the deepest postseason run in school history. The team won two games in the WNIT and earned a trip to the quarterfinals. The Billikens went 9-3 in Atlantic 10 Conference play and, at one point, held an eight game winning streak. Junior guard Ciaja Harbison was named to the All-Conference first team and All-Defensive team, while junior center Brooke Flowers was named All-Conference third team and All-Defensive team.

The 2019-20 Billikens reached the semifinals of the Atlantic 10 Women's Basketball Championship, finishing just one win shy of 20 on the season. Harbison was named to the All-Conference first team, while Kendra Wilken was selected the A-10 Most Improved Player, in addition to garnering third-team honors. Freshman Rachel Kent earned spot on the All-Rookie team.

Under Stone's watch, the Billikens collected an impressive array of individual honors in 2018-19. Harbison was selected A-10 Rookie of the Year and, along with Jordyn Frantz, landed on the All-Conference second team. Kerri McMahan was named the league's Defensive Player of the Year and earned a spot on the All-Academic list, while Flowers joined Harbison on the All-Rookie team and McMahan on the All-Defensive squad.

Harbison was the first Billiken to be named A-10 Rookie of the Year, while McMahan was Saint Louis' first Defensive Player of the Year in any of the four conferences in which the program has held membership. SLU placed two players on the All-Rookie team for the first time and two players on the All-Defensive team for the first time. McMahan's selection to the All-Academic team marked a fourth consecutive year a Billiken has earned inclusion in the five-player group.

A demanding schedule in 2018-19 saw Saint Louis take on 11-time national champion Connecticut and nationally ranked Missouri at Chaifetz Arena. The Billikens posted impressive victories over A-10 regular-season co-champion VCU; archrival Dayton in the first triple-overtime game in SLU women's basketball history; Duquesne, in the Bills' first triumph over the Dukes in Pittsburgh; and Virginia in Charlottesville.
