NOTABLES

- Saint Louis is home for its next two games - Wednesday night against Tennessee State at 8 p.m. and Southern Illinois Saturday afternoon at 3 p.m. Both games will be televised on Bally Sports Midwest.
- The Billikens are 5-2 on the season. SLU has quality KenPom wins against Memphis (No. 27) and Providence (No. 75) this year. The Bills' lone losses came against teams ranked in this week's AP Top 25 - #15 Auburn and #22 Maryland.
- The Billikens have won seven in a row at Chaifetz Arena dating back to last season.
- With his next win, SLU head coach **Travis Ford** will tie **John Benington** for fourth in school history with 118 wins as head coach of the Billikens.
- **Yuri Collins** leads the NCAA in total assists (73) and assists per game (10.4). He leads the A-10 and is 33rd nationally in assist/turnover ratio (3.32). The Cousy Award candidate led the country in assists and assists per game last year as well.
- **Gibson Jimerson** is the team's leading scorer with 14.3 ppg. His 25 3-pointers made this season leads the A-10 and ranks fourth nationally. He needs 59 more points to reach 1,000 for his career.
- Collins (14.3 ppg), **Javonte Perkins** (12.3 ppg) and **Javon Pickett** (10.9 ppg) also score in double figures for the Bills. **Francis Okoro** leads the team in rebounding (9.3 per game).
- Saint Louis leads the Atlantic 10 in scoring offense (80.4 ppg), rebounding (41.7 per game), free-throw percentage (.759) and fastbreak points (14.9 per game).

BILLIKENS OPEN TWO-GAME HOMESTAND

- Saint Louis, which has played three of its last four away from Chaifetz Arena, are back home for a pair of games against Tennessee State (Wednesday) and Southern Illinois (Saturday).
- The Billikens face Tennessee State on Wednesday in an 8 p.m. tipoff. The Tigers are 4-2 on the season.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- Wednesday's game will be televised on Bally Sports Midwest. **Dan McLaughlin** and **Scott Highmark** are on the call.
- KMOX 1120 AM serves as the Home for Billiken Basketball on the radio. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action for every Billikens men's basketball game.

ABOUT TENNESSEE STATE

- The Tigers are coming off the SoCal Challenge last week in San Juan Capistrano, Calif. Tennessee State defeated Cal State Northridge in its first game before falling to High Point in the championship game of the MTE.
- **Jr. Clay** leads the Tigers in scoring (16.0 ppg), 3-pointers (15) and assists (27). Clay transferred to TSU from Tennessee Tech, where he earned All-Ohio Valley Conference honors all four years. He has the opportunity to be the first player to receive All-OVC honors five times.
- **Christian Brown**, who had his season cut short last year due to injury, is second on the Tigers with 13.8 ppg. He scored 20 points on 4-of-5 shooting from 3-point range in his season debut against Alabama A&M.
- Tennessee State was picked second in the OVC preseason poll. Last year, Tennessee State went 14-18 overall and 8-10 in OVC play.
- TSU head coach **Brian "Penny" Collins** is in his fifth season at the helm of the Tigers. Collins was a four-year starter at Belmont and graduated in 2006 as the Bruins' all-time leader in assists and steals.

THE SAINT LOUIS-TENNESSEE STATE SERIES

- Saint Louis leads the all-time series against the Tigers 4-0. All four games in the series were played in St. Louis, with two of them being played at Chaifetz Arena in 2010-11 and 2011-12.
- The last game in the series, played in 2011-12, was a 71-37 win for the Billikens in their season opener. SLU went on to post a 26-8 record that season under **Rick Majerus** and reach the second round of the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

CHALLENGING NONCON SCHEDULE

- The Billikens are in the midst of a challenging nonconference schedule. SLU will be facing eight teams that played in the postseason a year ago during the nonconference slate.
- Saint Louis has eight games against KenPom top 100 teams. Murray State, which SLU defeated in the season opener, is close to cracking the top 100 after it beat nationally ranked Texas A&M earlier this year.
- Saint Louis has the 19th-toughest nonconference schedule in the NCAA according to KenPom.

ASSISTS KING

- Point guard **Yuri Collins** has lived up to the preseason hype in the early going this season. He leads the NCAA in total assists (73) and assists per game (10.4).
- Last year, Collins led the NCAA in total assists (267) and assists per game (7.9).
- Collins is on the 2023 **Bob Cousy Award** Preseason Watch List. The Cousy Award, which is sponsored by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame, recognizes the top point guard in men's NCAA Division I basketball.
- Collins has the three of the four highest assists games in the NCAA this season – 15 vs. Paul Quinn (Nov. 23), 14 vs. Murray State (Nov. 7) and 13 vs. Evansville (Nov. 13). **Darius Brown II** of Montana State had a 16-assist game against Middle Tennessee to lead all Division I players.
- Collins is the Billikens' career assist leader with 627 and counting. He surpassed the previous record of 436 – which was held by **Josh Fisher** (2004-08) – last year in just his third season with the Bills.
- Collins' 627 career assists rank fourth among active players in NCAA Division I, and first in the NCAA among players who have played in 100 or less games. His 6.89 career assists per game average is tops all-time in the A-10 and second among active players in DI, trailing only **Jalen Moore** at Oakland (7.87).
- In addition to his assists totals, Collins is among the top defenders in school history. He is ninth in school history with 142 career steals, four away from surpassing **Erwin Claggett** for eighth.

JIMERSON LEADS BILLIKENS IN SCORING

► **Gibson Jimerson** leads the Billikens in scoring with 14.3 ppg after he led SLU and ranked among the A-10's top scorers a season ago.

► He has drilled multiple 3-pointers in each of the first seven games. His 3.57 3-pointers made per game leads the Atlantic 10 and ranks ninth in the NCAA. His 25 total treys are fourth overall in the country.

► Jimerson is among the SLU program's top shooters of all-time. He is second in school history in 3-point FG percentage and fourth in FT percentage.

► Jimerson is seventh all-time at SLU with 173 3-pointers made in a career. The next former Billiken for Jimerson to catch is **Cody Ellis**, who drained 194 triples from 2009-13.

► Last season, Jimerson knocked in 87 3-pointers, tied for the second-most by a Billiken in school history.

► While this is Jimerson's fourth season with the Billikens, he is technically a sophomore eligibility wise. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games, the maximum amount of games allowed for him to play in and still receive the waiver. The 2020-21 season did not count against a players' eligibility due to the pandemic.

PERKINS IS BACK AND SCORING

► Guard **Javonte Perkins** is back after he missed all of last season with a torn ACL.

► Perkins has led SLU in scoring twice this season. He scored a team-leading 17 points against Maryland, with all of the scoring coming in the second half.

► He has taken the second-most shots on the Billikens (73) and is shooting 39.7 percent from the field, 36.1 percent from 3-point range and 78.9 percent from the stripe.

► The senior led the Billikens with 21 points in the season opener against Murray State and added 13 points the next game against Evansville.

► In 2020-21, Perkins earned second-team All-Conference honors after leading the Billikens in scoring with 17.1 ppg. He shot .456 from the field, .367 from 3-point range and an A-10 leading .866 from the FT line.

► As a junior in 2019-20, Perkins was voted the A-10 Sixth Man of the Year after leading the Billikens with 18.2 ppg in A-10 play.

► Perkins announced on March 28, 2022, that he would return for another season. That came after fans chanted "One More Year" while Perkins was being honored on Senior Day at Chaifetz Arena last year.

OKORO LEADING THE BILLIKENS IN REBOUNDING

► Senior forward **Francis Okoro** leads the Billikens in rebounding with 9.3 rpg. He has posted double-digit rebounds in four of the seven games this season.

► Okoro had a 10-point, 10-rebound double-double against Providence. He posted is first double-double of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds against Evansville. He also dished out three assists.

► Okoro was the team leader in rebounds last year with 8.1 per game. In A-10 play, he was the Billikens' second-leading scorer with 12.0 ppg.

► He is an efficient shooter as well. His career FG percentage of .581 (169-291) is currently good for second in school history.

► Okoro also led the Billikens with 42 blocked shots and had nine double-doubles last season, tied for the third-most in the A-10.

PICKETT LED BILLIKENS AT AUBURN

► Graduate transfer **Javon Pickett** turned in a solid all-around effort, leading the Billikens with 16 points, including 10 in the first half.

► The Missouri transfer scored his 1,000th career point in the Providence game. He scored 950 points in four years at Missouri and 76 points so far this year.

► Pickett registered double-doubles in each of his first two games as a Billiken. They were also the first double-doubles of his long career.

► Pickett scored 13 points and grabbed a career-best 13 rebounds in the season opener against Murray State. Pickett followed that up by matching his career-high with 13 boards and added 11 points on 4-of-5 shooting versus Evansville.

► Pickett is the Billikens active leader in game played with 125 in his five-year career. He came to SLU after a four-year career at Missouri where he started in 85 of 119 in which he played.

ADDITIONAL VETERANS CONTRIBUTING

► Also providing plenty of experience to the Billikens' rotation is **Fred Thatch Jr.** and **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** They have combined to play in 185 games so far during their careers.

► Thatch returned from missing two games with a knee injury to score four points and post three steals against

Auburn. Last season, he was second only to **Yuri Collins** on the team in assists (56) and steals (37).

► Hargrove, who scored a season-high 10 points against Paul Quinn, turned in 6.7 ppg and 4.2 rpg a year ago. He registered back-to-back double-doubles against Memphis and Mercer.

FIVE TRUE FRESHMAN ON THE BILLIKENS' ROSTER

► SLU's roster features five true freshmen – center **Mouhamadou Cissé**, guard **Larry Hughes Jr.**, guard **Phil Jones**, guard **Nick Kramer** and guard **Kellen Thames**.

► Cissé is an athletic big from Dakar, Senegal. Last year, he helped Putnam Science Academy to an undefeated season (38-0) and the National Prep Championship.

► Hughes Jr. joins the Billikens as a preferred walk-on after helping his CBC team in St. Louis capture the 2022 Class 6 state championship.

► Jones is another preferred walk-on from Mount Carmel High School in Chicago. His senior year was cut short after he suffered a knee injury prior to the season.

► Kramer is a SLU High School product where he was a 1,000-point scorer and two-time Missouri Class 6 All-State selection. He will be redshirting this season.

► Thames is a local product who was named the Conference Player of the Year following his senior season at Pattonville High School where he averaged 22 ppg. He was also a two-time Missouri Class 6 All-State selection.

FOUR BILLIKENS TABBED PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

► A league-high four Billikens were featured on the Atlantic 10 Conference preseason All-Conference teams, which were released in conjunction with Media Day in Brooklyn, N.Y. The teams and the poll are voted upon by each A-10 head men's basketball coach and one media member covering each team.

► **Yuri Collins** was tabbed to the first team, while **Gibson Jimerson** and **Javonte Perkins** landed on the second team. **Francis Okoro** was named to the third team.

► Additionally, Collins and Okoro were voted to the All-Defensive team.

► The Bills were selected to finish second in the A-10 race behind Dayton. SLU received seven first-place votes, with the rest going to the Flyers.

BASKETBALL BLOODLINES

► The Billikens' three local true freshmen are all sons of former NCAA Division I players.

► **Larry Hughes Jr.** is the son of Billiken great **Larry Hughes**. Larry Hughes played one season at SLU in 1997-98 before enjoying a long and successful career in the NBA. In his lone season with the Bills, Larry Hughes scored a school record 670 points and led the Bills to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Additionally, Larry Hughes Jr.'s sister, Lauryn, graduated from SLU in 2021 and played for SLU's women's basketball team.

► **Nick Kramer's** father, **Jack Kramer**, played basketball for one year at the University of Michigan before transferring to UAB where he was a three-year starter from 1988-91.

► **Kellen Thames** is the son of **Kelly Thames**, who from 1993-98 started at the University of Missouri and scored more than 1,600 points for the Tigers.

FORD CLIMBING SLU COACHING LISTS

► With 117 wins in his SLU career thus far, **Travis Ford** is one away from tying two wins away from surpassing **John Benington** (118 wins from 1958-65) for fourth in SLU history. Ford is six wins away from passing the legendary **Charlie Spoonhour** for third on the Bills' career wins list.

► Last year, Ford became the fifth head coach in SLU history to reach 100 wins at the school, and the first since Spoonhour.

► Ford also reached 100 wins while at Oklahoma State, posting 155 victories in eight seasons with the Cowboys.

► The Billikens reached 20 wins last year for the third time in Ford's tenure. He is one of four head coaches in school history with three or more 20+ win seasons.

REMEMBERING FORD STUEN

► The Billikens remember and honor assistant coach **Ford Stuen**, who passed away May 11, 2021, at the age of 29. Stuen, the nephew of head coach **Travis Ford**, played at Oklahoma State for his uncle and served on the Billikens' staff for five years.

► The Billikens wear a patch on their jersey with the "FS" script. That is how Ford would sign his name on the many hand-written notes and letters that he would send to family, friends, and coaching colleagues.



► The program has taken up one of Ford's favorite quotes: **"The Journey is the Reward"**

► On opening night last season, Nov. 9, 2021, a banner was unveiled honoring **Ford Stuen** that will forever hang in the Chaifetz Arena rafters.

MASTER CLASS

► The Billikens are experienced this season both on the court and in the classroom.

► Five players have already received undergraduate degrees and are enrolled in graduate school. **Francis Okoro** (B.A. Environmental Studies) and **Javonte Perkins** (B.A. Sociology) graduated last spring. **Jake Forrester** and **Javon Pickett** earned undergrad degrees from Temple and Missouri, respectively.

► **Fred Thatch Jr.** has already earned two degrees from SLU and is working on another. Thatch graduated last spring with an MBA after earning a B.S. in Marketing

in 2021. He is now working toward a Master's in Supply Chain Management from SLU.

► While this is Thatch's fifth year with the Bills, he is technically just a junior eligibility wise. He received a medical hardship waiver after playing in just six games in his second year (2019-20), and the 2020-21 season did not count against a players' eligibility due to the pandemic.

QUICK HISTORY LESSON

► The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.

► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424). In 2018-19, Bonner was in Brooklyn for the Billikens' run to the title and cut down a piece of the net.

► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

In seven years as Saint Louis University's head men's basketball coach, Travis Ford has reinvigorated the program and reestablished its place on the national stage.

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total over the next four seasons.

Ford's tenure at SLU has been highlighted by three postseason appearances. Saint Louis captured the 2019 Atlantic 10 Conference Championship in dramatic fashion in Brooklyn and went to the NCAA Tournament. In a 2020-21 season that was derailed by COVID-19, the Billikens still managed to be in the conversation on Selection Sunday and ultimately was awarded a No. 1 seed in the NIT. The Billikens again went to the NIT in 2021-22. SLU was positioned for another postseason bid in 2019-20, but the season was canceled in March as SLU was preparing for the A-10 Championship.

The 2022-23 season is Ford's seventh year at SLU and his 26th season overall as a head coach. He has a 117-79 record at SLU and a 453-345 record overall.

Ford's 117 wins at SLU make him the fifth-winningest head coach in SLU men's basketball history, two away from surpassing John Benington for fourth. In 2022-23, he joined just five other SLU head coaches who have a tenure lasting seven or more seasons.

In addition to his six years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville (1997-2000). Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and eight who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances. He recruited three McDonald's All-Americans to Stillwater during his tenure.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.

Ford, is a native of Madisonville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Heather, have three children: Brooks, Kyleigh and Shane. Ford earned a bachelor's degree in communications at the University of Kentucky in 1994.
