THE MATCHUP

•Saint Louis was awarded a No. 2 seed for the 2022 NCAA Championship and hosts former Conference USA rival Memphis in a first-round game this afternoon.

•The Billikens earned an automatic bid by winning a fifth straight Atlantic 10 Championship title, topping Dayton 4-0 in the tournament final following victories of 3-0 over Loyola Chicago in the quarterfinals and 2-0 over Saint Joseph's in the semifinals.

•Defending champion and preseason favorite Memphis (9-5) finished fourth in the American Athletic Conference regular-season standings with a 3-2-3 league record but rallied to win the AAC tournament and claim an automatic bid. The Tigers defeated East Carolina 1-0 in overtime in the quarterfinals; tied top-seeded Central Florida 1-1 and advanced on penalty kicks in the semifinals; and edged SMU 1-0 in overtime in the championship match. Memphis has lost just twice in its last 13 games (6-2-5).

•Saint Louis leads the series with Memphis 7-3, including a 6-2 mark between 1996 and 2004 when the schools were members of Conference USA. In the teams' two non-conference matchups, the Billikens prevailed in 2009 and the Tigers won in 2010.

SLU IN THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

•Saint Louis is competing in its seventh NCAA Championship overall and fifth in succession. Its No. 2 seeding this year is the highest in program history.

•The Billikens are 3-5-1 in the national tournament, including 1-1 last season. SLU won 2-1 at Ole Miss in the opening round before falling 4-0 at Rutgers in the round of 32.

•Saint Louis' other two tournament victories were 2-0 over Stanford in the program's first NCAA Championship game in 2005, and 2-0 over Drake in 2006.

SAINT LOUIS IN THE NATIONAL PICTURE

•The Billikens are a unanimous top-10 team as they continue 2022 postseason play.

•SLU's No. 10 ranking by United Soccer Coaches matches its highest-ever ranking in the coaches' poll. The Bills are rated No. 4 by College Soccer News – the highest ranking in any poll in program history – and No. 8 by Top Drawer Soccer.

FOR THE RECORD

•SLU's 20 wins, .952 winning percentage and 18-game active winning streak lead NCAA Division I.

•With their 4-0 victory over Dayton in the A-10 Championship final, the Billikens extended their school records for longest winning streak, wins, longest unbeaten streak (18) and shutouts (15); equaled the A-10 women's soccer record for wins; and tied the school mark for home wins (11).

•SLU's nine road wins match the school record set in 2005.

•SLU's .944 winning percentage (17-1) in regular-season games is a school record.

BILLIKENS SET RECORD FOR ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS

•A program-record 10 Saint Louis players, including three major-award winners and seven first-team selections, collected 2022 Atlantic 10 All-Conference honors.

•**Abbie Miller** was tabbed Midfielder of the Year for a second time, defender **Brionna Halverson** was named Defensive Player of the Year, and **Caroline Kelly** claimed Offensive Player of the Year plaudits. **Katie Shields** won a third Coach of the Year award.

•SLU's seven first-team honorees matched the 2020 Billikens for the most in program history. Joining Miller, Halverson and Kelly on the top unit were **Emily Groark**, **Lyndsey Heckel**, **Sophia Stram** and **Emily Gaebe**.

•**Hannah Friedrich**, **Emily Puricelli** and **Anna Walsh** were selected to the All-Conference second team.

•Walsh and **Katie Houck** were voted to the All-Academic team.

SEVEN, LED BY MOP HECKEL, NAMED A-10 ALL-TOURNAMENT

•**Lyndsey Heckel** was named Most Outstanding Player of the Atlantic 10 Championship.

•Heckel was joined on the All-Tournament team by each of her teammates in the starting backfield – **Brionna Halverson**, **Katie Houck** and **Sophia Stram** – as well as **Emily Groark**, **Caroline Kelly** and **Hannah Larson**.

SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. MEMPHIS

FRIEDRICH BECOMES SLU'S ALL-TIME POINTS LEADER

- With her goal vs. Dayton in the A-10 Championship final, **Hannah Friedrich** broke **Jamie Perry's** school record for career points.

- Friedrich begins today's game with 105 points (31 goals, 43 assists). It is the sixth Saint Louis career record she owns, adding to her school marks of 43 assists, 15 game-winning goals, 104 games played, 103 games started and 261 shots (tied).

PURICELLI BREAKS, TIES BILLIKEN GOALKEEPING RECORDS

- Emily Puricelli** earned her 18th victory of the season in goal in the A-10 Championship quarterfinals vs. Loyola Chicago, breaking the previous record of 17 held by **Olivia Silverman**. Puricelli increased the record to 20 when SLU defeated Dayton 4-0 in the title game.

- Puricelli's shutout of Dayton was her 13th clean sheet of the year, breaking **Meghann Burke's** SLU single-season record.

- With 48 wins in goal, Puricelli is tied with Burke (1999-2002) for the Saint Louis career record.

KELLY SETS SINGLE-SEASON POINTS RECORD, TIES GOALS MARK

- Caroline Kelly's** goal vs. Dayton in the A-10 Championship final lifted her season points total to 32, breaking a tie with **Hannah Friedrich** for the Billikens' single-season record.

- The goal was Kelly's 13th of the season, tying **Maddie Pokorny** (2018) and **Jamie Perry** (2002) for the Saint Louis record.

- Kelly also is approaching Friedrich's (2019) single-season record of seven game-winning goals. She has five game-winners this year.

MILLER NOW ON FOUR BILLIKEN CAREER TOP-10 LISTS

- Abbie Miller** has moved into the top 10 on four Saint Louis career statistical lists.

- Miller has nine game-winning goals, good for a sixth-place tie; 83 games played, tying for eighth; 55 points, tying for ninth; and 20 goals, tying for 10th.

WALSH HIGH AMONG NATIONAL ASSISTS LEADERS

- Anna Walsh** recorded six assists over the last five regular-season matches to rise to the top of the A-10, and tied for 16th nationally, with nine.

- That production has increased Walsh's career total to 19 assists, tied for seventh on Saint Louis' all-time list. Her six game-winning assists are tied for eighth on the SLU career chart.

- Walsh's nine assists are tied for seventh on SLU's season list.

BILLIKEN OFFENSE MOST PROLIFIC IN PROGRAM HISTORY

- Several facts point to the 2022 Saint Louis offensive attack as the most explosive in the history of the Billiken program.

- SLU holds the national lead in goals per game (3.10) and points per game (9.10) and is second in assists per game (2.90).

- Saint Louis has tallied 65 goals, 61 assists and 191 points, all school records. The Billikens broke the previous marks before playing their 20th game; the teams who held the previous records set them in either 21 or 23 games.

- Saint Louis has scored its 65 goals on 190 shots on goal. It took the previous record-holding team, the 2018 Billikens, 222 shots on frame to register 52 goals.

- The Billikens have three 20-point scorers – **Caroline Kelly** (32, first in the A-10), **Emily Gaebe** (24, third) and **Emily Groark** (22, fourth) – for the first time since 2006.

- Nine Billikens have collected 10 or more points, the most double-digit totals in program history.

- SLU has scored five or more goals in four games this year, the most in program history.

... AND DON'T FORGET THE DEFENSE

- Saint Louis traditionally has played smothering defense, and this year is no exception.

- Entering the NCAA Championship, SLU has shut out five straight and nine of its last 10 opponents.

- The Billikens are third in the nation in shutout percentage (.714, 15 shutouts in 21 games) and goals against average (0.43).

- SLU's 15 shutouts are a school record.

- Saint Louis has allowed just nine goals, tied for second fewest in the nation. The Bills yielded only four goals in A-10 regular-season play.

- Coupling the nine goals allowed with the team's 65 goals scored, the Billikens' plus-56 goal differential will be a school record – 18 goals better than the previous mark of plus-38 set by the 2018 team.

- SLU allowed averages of 6.2 total shots, 2.8 shots on goal and 2.3 corner kicks in its first 21 games.

REGULAR-SEASON CROWN FOURTH IN FIVE SEASONS FOR SLU

- The 2022 A-10 regular-season championship is the fourth in five seasons for Saint Louis.

- The Billikens posted a third unbeaten, untied A-10 record as well as a fourth unbeaten league slate in that five-year stretch. Their regular-season A-10 record during that period is 44-3-1.

- Saint Louis has captured seven regular-season conference titles in all (five A-10, two Conference USA).

BILLIKEN ATTACK SPREADING THE WEALTH

- The Billikens have displayed their customary scoring balance through the first 21 games this season.

- Fourteen different players have tallied at least one goal, and 16 different players have at least one point.

- In three A-10 Championship games, seven players combined to score the Billikens' nine goals, and 10 different players had at least one point.

- Twelve different players scored SLU's 29 goals in A-10 play, and 15 different players had a point in league action.

- SLU players have scored 64 goals this season (there has been one own goal); 53 of those goals have been assisted. A different player combination has produced 46 of the 53 assisted goals.

BILLS MAKE HERMANN STADIUM A SOCCER FORTRESS

- Saint Louis is 62-6-6 (.878) in its last 74 games on the home pitch of Robert R. Hermann Stadium, a stretch that dates to the final home game of the 2015 campaign.

- In those 74 games, SLU outscored opponents 164-29, posted 47 shutouts, and allowed more than one goal just twice.

KELLY SETS SLU SEASON RECORD

- Caroline Kelly's** game-winning goal vs. VCU was her team-leading fifth game-winner of the season, setting a record for game-winning goals by a Billiken junior.

- Kelly's five game-winners also tie her with **Kelly Massman** for fourth place on SLU's overall season chart.

- Sophia Stram** – Three goals (tied), two assists (tied), eight points (tied), two game-winning goals, seven shots on goal, 15 shots.
- Anna Walsh** – Nine assists, four game-winning assists, 11 points.

BILLIKENS' COMEBACK AT XAVIER MAKES PROGRAM HISTORY

- After trailing 1-0 and 2-1 at Xavier Sept. 8, SLU came back for a 3-2 win. It marked the first time in program history that the Billikens overcame two separate deficits en route to a victory.

QUICK STARTS BECOMING COMMON FOR SAINT LOUIS

- The Billikens have scored a goal within the first seven minutes in seven games this season, including twice in the first minute.
- SLU's quickest goal came just 50 seconds into the SIUE game, and the Billikens scored 55 seconds into the Missouri State match. They grabbed a 1-0 lead at the 3:30 mark vs. Nebraska, at 5:04 vs. Saint Joseph's (A-10 semifinals), at 5:14 vs. Drake and at 6:13 vs. George Mason.
- The Bills scored twice within the first seven minutes vs. Saint Joseph's (regular season), striking at 2:28 and again at 4:22.

TWO BILLIKENS BREAK OR TIE PREVIOUS GAMES RECORDS

- Not surprisingly, fifth-year player **Hannah Friedrich** and sixth-year player **Brionna Halverson** will conclude their careers having played in and started more games than any other players in SLU women's soccer history.
- Earlier this season, Friedrich broke school records for games played (she now has 104) and games started (she now has 103).
- With 100 games played and 99 starts, Halverson also eclipsed the previous school marks in both categories.

BILLIKENS HIGH ON NCAA ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS LISTS

- Hannah Friedrich**, **Emily Puricelli** and **Brionna Halverson** appear on several NCAA Division I active career leader lists.

- Friedrich is the only active Division I player with at least 30 goals and at least 40 assists. Her 43 assists are the most among active players.

- Friedrich also is fourth in games played (104), 10th in points (105) and 28th in goals (31).

- Puricelli stands third in goals against average (0.64) and tied for third in shutouts (29).

- Halverson is 15th in games played (100).

SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. MEMPHIS

SLU BREAKS, TIES HERMANN STADIUM RECORDS VS. RHODY

•In their 6-0 win over Rhode Island Oct. 13, the Billikens set Hermann Stadium records for first-half points (14) and first-half assists (six) and tied the stadium mark for first-half goals (four).

LAST TIME OUT: BILLS DOMINATE DAYTON IN A-10 FINAL

•Top-seeded SLU captured an unprecedented fifth straight A-10 Championship title with a dominant 4-0 win over No. 2 seed Dayton in the tournament final Sunday at Hermann Stadium.

•**Hannah Larson**, with the first of two **Emily Groark** assists, put the Billikens on top in the 20th minute. **Emily Gaebe** (**Hannah Sawyer** assist) scored in the 42nd minute to give SLU a 2-0 halftime lead.

•**Hannah Friedrich** (Groark) made it 3-0 in the 53rd minute, and **Caroline Kelly** (Larson) concluded the scoring in the 86th minute.

•SLU out-shot Dayton 19-8 overall and 10-2 in shots on goal.

SAINT LOUIS ONE OF NATION'S ELITE IN HOME ATTENDANCE

•With an average turnout of 1,449 at Hermann Stadium this season, SLU is 11th in Division I women's soccer attendance.

•Saint Louis has drawn three of the top 32 crowds in Division I this year – vs. Notre Dame (4,273, fifth), vs. Arkansas (3,102, 24th) and vs. Dayton (2,876, 32nd).

•The Notre Dame, Arkansas and Dayton crowds rank second, third and fourth, respectively, on the Hermann Stadium list for SLU women's soccer. The women's record of 5,205 – also a state of Missouri women's college mark – was set vs. Kansas in 2017.

HEAD COACH KATIE SHIELDS

•Now in her 10th season leading the Billikens, 2018, 2019 and 2022 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year **Katie Shields** owns a 134-55-14 (.695) career record (all at Saint Louis).

•Shields, who spent one year as a SLU assistant before becoming head coach, has guided the Bills to a league-best 112-26-9 (.793) mark since the start of the 2016 season. That record includes a 72-8-4 (.881) ledger vs. A-10 opponents (including conference tournament games).

•Shields' Billikens are playing in a fifth straight NCAA Tournament after extending the A-10 women's soccer record for consecutive conference tournament championships to five.

•The Billikens also made history two seasons ago when they became the first A-10 women's soccer team to capture both regular-season and tournament titles in three consecutive years. Shields and her staff were selected East Region Coaching Staff of the Year by United Soccer Coaches.

•Shields' players have earned All-America honors twice, All-Region plaudits 20 times and Atlantic 10 accolades (first team, second team, All-Rookie) 63 times. In addition, Billikens have been selected A-10 Defensive Player of the Year six times (six of the past seven seasons), Midfielder of the Year three times, and Offensive Player of the Year and Rookie of the Year twice each.

•Shields began the 2022 campaign ranked 27th in winning percentage among active NCAA Division I head coaches.

GOING THE DISTANCE

•**Emily Puricelli** has played all 90 minutes in 19 of 21 games this season, most on the team.

•**Lyndsey Heckel** and **Sophia Stram** have played the full 90 minutes 15 times, and **Abbie Miller** has logged all 90 in nine games.

SAINT LOUIS IN 27TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S SOCCER

•The 2022 season is the 27th in SLU women's soccer history.

•The Billikens are 315-171-57 for a .633 winning percentage.

•In conference play (Conference USA 1996-2004, Atlantic 10 since 2005), SLU is 165-71-26 (.679).

•Saint Louis has captured 14 conference championships (seven regular-season, seven tournament) and has made seven NCAA Championship appearances (2005, 2006, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022). The 2005, 2006 and 2021 teams reached the second round with first-round wins; the 2020 Billikens were seeded into the second round in an abbreviated 48-team tournament field.

•This year, Saint Louis is assured of being the 11th SLU team to have a .700 or higher winning percentage and has produced an 18th winning season.

FRIEDRICH REWRITING BILLIKEN RECORD BOOK

•**Hannah Friedrich** owns Saint Louis career records for points (105), assists (43), game-winning goals (15), games played (103) and starts (102), and she is tied for the school record for shots (261).

•Six of Friedrich's 15 game-winning goals have come in the 84th minute or later, including two golden goals.

•She ranks second in goals (31), trailing only **Jamie Perry** (41), and game-winning assists (18), trailing only **Courtney Hulcer** (21).

•Friedrich's game-winning goals and game-winning assists total of 33 is the highest in Billiken women's soccer history.

•Two seasons ago, Friedrich's 14 assists tied for the national lead and were just one shy of matching the school record.

•In her freshman season (2018), Friedrich scored what were then a school-record 30 points (11G, 8A).

•Friedrich tallied a school-record seven game-winning goals in 2019, including a pair of golden goals.

PURICELLI CLIMBING SAINT LOUIS GOALKEEPING LISTS

•**Emily Puricelli** has established herself as one of the most prolific goalkeepers in Billiken history.

•Puricelli is tied for first in career wins (48), ranks second in goals against average (0.64), and is third in shutouts (29) and minutes (5,475).

•Puricelli's 168 career saves rank seventh.

•In SLU's NCAA Championship second-round game vs. Rutgers last year, Puricelli tied the Billiken single-game record of 14 saves.

HALVERSON MAKES IT A HALF-DOZEN

•Defender **Brionna Halverson** returned in 2022 for a sixth year as a member of the Billiken women's soccer program.

•On SLU's career lists, Halverson is second in games played (100) and games started (99).

•The combination of a medical redshirt after missing her second year (2018) due to injury and the extra year of eligibility granted student-athletes due to COVID-19 led Halverson to become the second Billiken in recent years to spend six seasons at SLU. Goalkeeper **Mary Niehaus** spent the 2014 through 2019 seasons in the Saint Louis program.

•Halverson holds a bachelor's degree in public health and is pursuing a graduate certificate in organizational leadership. She was SLU's 2022 NCAA Woman of the Year nominee and was voted to the Billikens' 25th Anniversary Team in 2021.

SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. MEMPHIS

BILLIKENS' VETERAN PLAYERS HEAVILY DECORATED

•Postseason accolades have been plentiful for Saint Louis in recent seasons, and players on this year's team have collected their fair share.

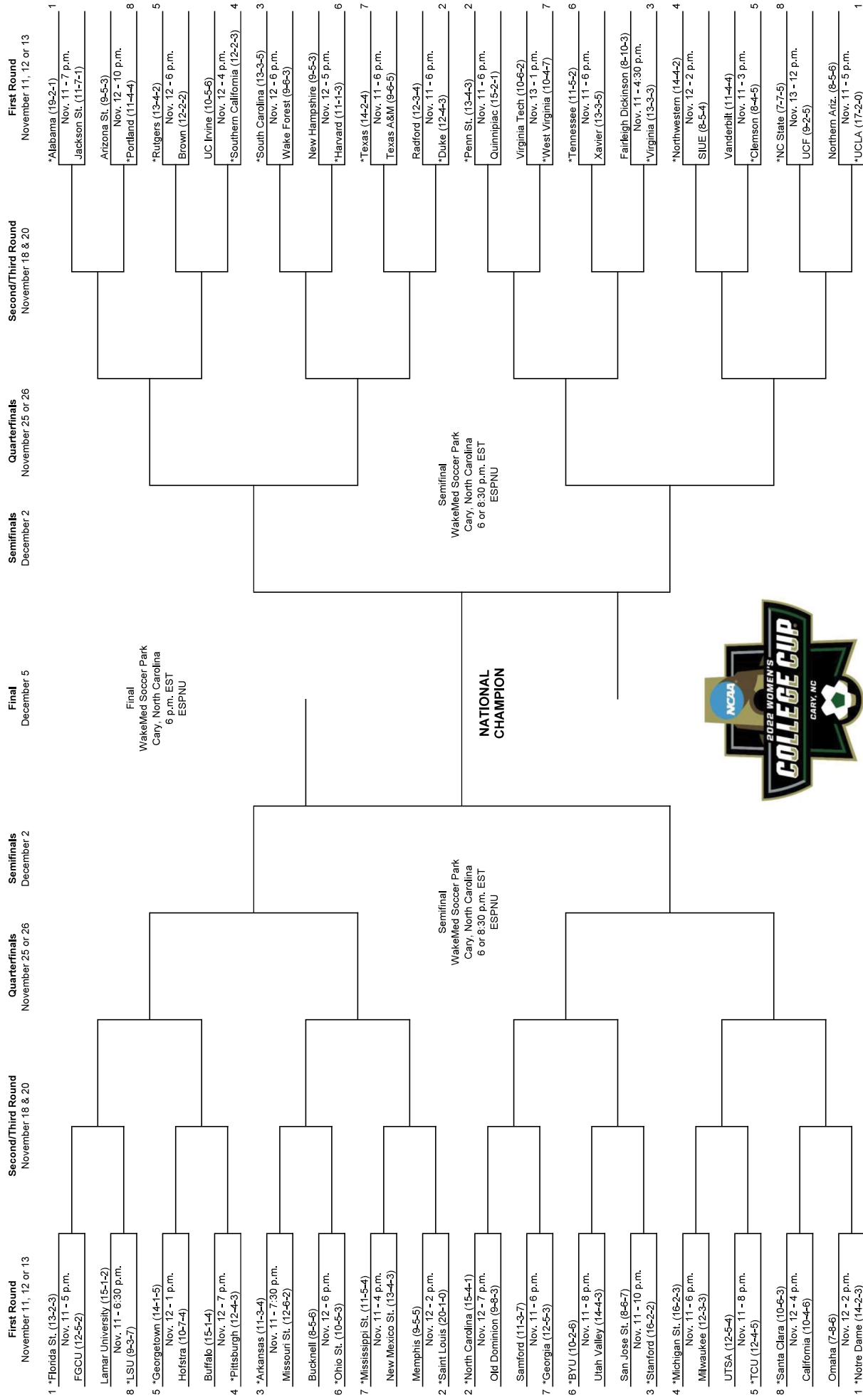

WHAT'S A BILLIKEN?

The Billiken was born Oct. 8, 1908, when Kansas City art teacher and illustrator Florence Pretz patented a design for an elflike creature with pixie ears, a mischievous smile and a tuft of hair on his pointed head. Reportedly, the image came to her in a dream.

Although it didn't appear on the actual patent, some believe Pretz found the Billiken name in a fanciful work entitled, "Mr. Moon: A Song of the Little People," by Canadian poets Bliss Carman and Richard Hovey.

Within a short time, Pretz sold her patented image to the Billiken Company of Chicago. Initially manufactured as a bank and statuette, and later as a doll, this good luck charm soon became a national craze. By 1911, the Billiken's likeness adorned everything from marshmallow candies to hood ornaments.

In his heyday, the Billiken enjoyed worldwide fame. Artisans in Alaska began carving his image into ivory, and in Japan, he appeared in shrines, amusement parks and even a movie.

Like many other fads, the Billiken might have faded into obscurity if it were not for Saint Louis University law student John Bender, who also happened to be the coach of SLU's football team during the height of Billikenmania.

One story claims that nearby drugstore owner Billy Gunn called Bender a Billiken when the coach walked into his establishment one day. Supposedly, legendary sportswriter William O'Connor

was within earshot of the remark and took up the moniker not only for Bender but also for SLU's sports teams.

Another tale claims O'Connor himself dubbed the coach a Billiken after a particularly good practice left Bender beaming with a big smile. After practice, Bender's fellow law student Charles Z. McNamara, a local cartoonist, sketched Bender as a Billiken, posted it in Gunn's drugstore window and tabbed the football team "Bender's Billikens."

Yet another yarn reports that the druggist asked McNamara to decorate his store window the night before a homecoming game. Supposedly, McNamara drew a Billiken, a popular good luck charm, causing one of his fellow students to exclaim, "That looks like coach Bender!"

Whatever the case, O'Connor is generally credited for popularizing the name throughout the city, but one fact flies in the face of this legend and lore. O'Connor did not join the St. Louis Post-Dispatch until Nov. 26, 1911, one full month after the newspaper first mentioned "Bender's Billikens."

Regardless of how the story is told or whether his mysterious origins are ever finally resolved, the Billiken remains a good luck charm for Saint Louis University's sports teams and always brings smiles to the faces of SLU fans.

Legend has it that the Billiken has three kinds of luck – good, better and best. Buying a Billiken gives the buyer good luck. To have one given to you is better luck. The best luck comes if the Billiken is stolen.
