#### RHODE ISLAND VS. SAINT LOUIS - SERIES NOTES

- The Rams make the trip to Saint Louis Thursday for the 19th meeting all-time with the Billikens.
- It's the first trip to Saint Louis since the Rams beat the Billikens 68-56 on Jan. 16, 2019. The win was the first in Chaifetz Arena in program history.
- SLU has a 12-6 advantage in the all-time series.
- Head coach **Tammi Reiss** is 2-0 against Saint Louis.
- The Rams have won the last three games in the series against the Billikens. Rhody was 2-8 in the 10 meetings before that.
- The last time the teams faced was a season ago on Feb. 7. The Rams defeated the Billikens 60-52 at The Ryan Center.
- The game will be the fourth A-10 matchup for Saint Louis. The Billikens are 1-2 to start league play, picking up a win over VCU. Rhody is 3-0 in the A-10 after beating La Salle last time out.

#### TOURÉ NAMED ATLANTIC 10 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Rhode Island junior **Mayé Touré** was named the Atlantic 10 Player of the Week, the conference announced Monday.
- It's the first career weekly conference honor for Touré.
- Touré led the Rams to two wins last week, as Rhody improved to 3-0 in conference play defeating Massachusetts (75-68) and La Salle (70-59).
- She averaged a double-double on the winning week, pouring in 22.0 points per game and grabbing 10.5 boards.
- Touré had two straight 20-point performances while shooting an impressive 77.3 percent, missing just five shots from the floor (17-of-22).
- She collected a game-high 11 boards with 24 points for her fourth straight double-double in Rhody's win over La Salle.
- Touré was 10-of-13 at the charity stripe, including 8-for-11 against La Salle to help the Rams remain undefeated at home.
- The honor was the first for Rhode Island this season. The last Ram to earn a weekly honor was **Emmanuelle Tahane** a season ago.

#### COMING SOON: TAMMI REISS COACHES SHOW

- The first-ever **Tammi Reiss** Coaches Show is set to broadcast live from the East Greenwich Tavern in the Square at 7 p.m. on Jan. 19.
- The show will feature guests including players and assistant coaches.

### CAIRNS COMES BACK

- Rhode Island junior **Dolly Cairns** made her return last time out in the win over La Salle last time out.
- The guard posted nine points in 15 minutes off the bench.
- Cairns, a Saratoga Springs, N.Y. native, missed four games due to concussion protocol.

### REISS NOW THIRD PLACE ALL-TIME IN WINS

- Rhode Island head coach **Tammi Reiss** picked up her 58th career win against La Salle.
- The win pushed her past **Tom Garrick** (2003-09) who was third all-time with 56 wins at the helm.
- There are just two coaches in program history with more wins than Reiss, now in her fourth season leading the Rams.
- **Nancy Langham** (1977-85) sits at the top of the all-time list, collecting 122 wins, while **Linda Ziemke** is second all-time recording 106 wins in 10 seasons (1989-99).

### NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Rhode Island has not lost at the Ryan Center this season.
- The Rams are 8-0 in Kingston.
- Over the last four seasons, head coach **Tammi Reiss** has led Rhody to a 37-8 record at the Ryan Center, building a true home court advantage.
- In the four years before Reiss arrived in Kingston, the Rams were 15-39 at home.
- The eight wins at the Ryan Center have already cracked the top-10 all-time.

### CAIRNS CLIMBS TOP 10 3-POINTERS LIST

- Junior **Dolly Cairns** has connected on 121 career 3-pointers, tying her for seventh place all-time.
- Cairns is knotted with **Ashley Rivera**, who also had 121 in 2009-12.
- The guard has the chance to pass former teammate **Marta Vargas** (2016-22) who connected on 122 treys. Vargas is sixth all-time.
- Associate head coach **Megan Shoniker** sits fourth all-time with 158 career 3-pointers during her time in Keaney Blue (2007-11).
- Shoniker was the lead recruiter to bring Cairns to Kingston.
- Last season, Cairns made 57 3-pointers for seventh place all-time in program history.
- She's connected on one trey in every game she's played in this season. She missed four games due to concussion protocol.
- A junior, her career 3-point percentage sits second best all-time in program history at .392 (121-309).

### LIGHTS, CAMERA...

- The game last time out on Sunday was the first of three nationally televised games for Rhody this season.
- Both the La Salle and Loyola Chicago (Jan. 15) games will be broadcast on CBS Sports Network.
- Rhody's trip to VCU on Feb. 12 will be aired nationally on ESPNU.

### TOURÉ TAKING OVER THE PAINT

- Rhode Island junior **Mayé Touré** posted her fourth straight double-double against La Salle, scoring 24 points to go with 11 rebounds.
- In Atlantic 10 play, Touré is averaging 19.3 points and 11.3 rebounds.
- She had a career-best 13 rebounds to go with 14 points, all while playing in foul trouble against Duquesne.
- Touré recorded her third career 20-point performance last time out against La Salle. It was her second straight 20-point performance after scoring 20 points at Massachusetts.
- Touré poured in 27 points for the Rams in the season-opener at Harvard.
- The double-double against La Salle was the seventh of Touré's career, and the sixth this season.
- Touré leads the Rams in both scoring and rebounding, at 14.7 points and 7.5 boards per game.

### STINGY DEFENSE STRIKES AGAIN

- Rhode Island plays its best offense off of its best defense.
- In the road win over Quinnipiac, the Rams had 22 fast break points.
- In Rhody's loss at Wake Forest, URI had zero points off the fast break.
- In six of the last seven games, the Rams have held the opponent to 40 percent or lower from the floor.
- Rhody forced Maine to shoot 29.6 percent (16-of-54) and Hartford to 23.5 percent (12-of-51).
- In the A-10 opener, the Rams limited Duquesne to 32.8 percent (21-of-64).
- Grad transfer **Sayawni Lassiter** leads the team with 2.33 steals per game.

### PHILLIPS FINDS HERSELF IN THE STARTING FIVE

- With junior **Dolly Cairns** out on concussion protocol, sophomore **Sophie Phillips** stepped in as next one up in the starting five.
- Averaging just 3.9 minutes a game a season ago, Phillips had her first career start in Rhode Island's road game at Wake Forest, and has now started in four consecutive games for the Rams.
- Rhody is now 2-2 with Phillips in the starting five, winning the last two straight A-10 games.
- Her twin sister, **Lilly Phillips**, is a member of the women's basketball team at UAlbany.

### DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Rhode Island grad transfer **Madison Hattix-Covington** and junior **Mayé Touré** both recorded a double-double in the win over UMass.
- The VCU transfer paired 17 points with 10 rebounds for her first Rhody double-double, and the second of her career.
- Hattix-Covington recorded one double-double while with the Rams of VCU.
- Her rebounding effort has been a key contribution to Rhody's winning ways.
- The Rams are 9-2 when Hattix-Covington has grabbed at least five boards.
- It's the first time this season two Rams have collected a double-double.

### HIT ME WITH YOUR BEST SHOT

- Junior **Mayé Touré** leads the Rams and the Atlantic 10 shooting 55.7 percent from the floor.
- In the two wins for the Rams last week, Touré missed just five shots from the floor, shooting 77.3 percent (17-of-22)
- Touré has shot 70 percent or better four times this year.
- She's first on the team averaging 14.7 points per game.
- Touré missed just one shot from the floor in the win over Hartford, shooting a season-best 83.3 percent.
- In the win over the Hawks, Rhody connected on a season-high 37-of-66 (56.1 percent) from the floor.
- The Rams are third in the conference in field goal percentage, shooting 43.9 percent as a team.

### FORECAST CALLS FOR RAINING THREES

- Rhode Island shot the lights out against Massachusetts, scoring 24 points in fourth quarter to hand the Minutewomen a 75-68 loss.
- Rhody shot 14-of-30 from beyond the arc in the win.
- Three Rams connected on at least three 3-pointers, led by sophomore **Sophie Phillips** (5-of-7).
- Grad transfers **Madison Hattix-Covington** (4-of-8) and **Sayawni Lassiter** (3-of-7) also let it fly from long range, adding 17 and 13 points, respectively.

### RHODY PICKED THIRD IN A-10 PRESEASON POLL

- Rhode Island was selected to finish third in the Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll, released in October.
- Massachusetts was the unanimous pick to repeat as conference champions.
- La Salle was chosen second in the poll with 188 points, while the Rams checked in with 184 points, edging out Fordham (183) who was picked fourth.

### SOPHIE P FOR THREE!

- Sophomore **Sophie Phillips** has stepped up when the Rams need her most in the last five games that she's been in the starting lineup.
- In conference play, Phillips has connected on 12 3-pointers, and is averaging 14.3 points per game.
- In the win over UMass, Phillips shot 5-of-7 from deep, the third time this season she's hit five shots from beyond the arc.
- She dished out a career-best four assists in the win Duquesne, and matched her career-high in rebounds (3) and steals (2).
- In the win over Hartford, she had her first 20-point outing, scoring 21 points.
- Last season, Phillips averaged 3.9 minutes a game. She averages 18.6 minutes this year.

## SHOW NO QUIT

- The Rams have outscored their opponent in the fourth quarter in all but one game this season.
- The lone game the Rams were outscored in the final period was the two-point loss at Princeton.
- After shooting 33.3 percent in the third quarter against Buffalo, the Rams went 7-of-14 from the floor in the final period.
- In the loss at Wake Forest, Rhody held the Demon Deacons to just four points in the fourth quarter.

## MAGASSA, SQUIRES NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM

- Transfers **Tenin Magassa** and **Emma Squires** earned spots on the Preseason All-Conference Third Team.
- Magassa, a transfer from Dayton, was named the 2020-21 Atlantic 10 Sixth Woman of the Year.
- One of the A-10's most threatening posts, she finished fifth all-time at UD with 113 blocked shots.
- The Morsang-Sur-Orge, France native also earned a spot on the A-10 All-Rookie team after her freshman campaign with the Flyers.
- Squires, last year's A-10 Sixth Woman of the Year, joins the Rams as a transfer from Richmond.
- Squires has started every game for the Rams this year, while Magassa has been sidelined due to injury.

## HAVE A GAME HATTIX-COVINGTON

- In Rhody's win over Quinnipiac, grad transfer **Madison Hattix-Covington** had her best game in Keaneey Blue.
- She poured in a game-high 19 points, and had seven rebounds, two assists, and two steals.
- The VCU transfer sealed the game with her performance from the charity stripe. She hit a perfect 8-of-8 down the stretch to push the Rams past the Bobcats for the first time in program history.
- In her fifth year of college hoops, the Killeen, Texas product has over 800 points and 500 rebounds.

## REISS REACHES 50 WINS

- Rhode Island's win over SEMO in the opening game of the UCF Thanksgiving Classic was the 50th win for head coach **Tammi Reiss**.
- Reiss becomes just the fourth head coach in program history to reach 50 victories at the helm.
- The last coach to reach 50 wins was **Tom Garrick**, who led Rhody to 56 victories from 2003-09.
- **Nancy Langham** sits at the top of the all-time list, leading the Rams to 122-105 from 1977-85.
- Reiss is the fastest coach in program history to hit 50 wins, doing so in 82 games.
- Reiss' winning percentage is currently the best all-time, at .630 (58-34).
- Last season, Reiss led the Rams to 12-2 at the Ryan Center, and 12-2 in Atlantic 10 play.
- Reiss was named the 2021 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year after her second year leading the Rams.
- Under Reiss, six Rams have gone on to sign professional contracts overseas.

## REISS' PIECES

- In her fourth season leading the program, head coach **Tammi Reiss** is 58-34.
- Historically, Rhode Island has not had a coach with above even a .400 winning percentage since **Nancy Langham** left after the 1984-85 season.
- Reiss is third all-time in wins at Rhode Island. Only two coaches have more career wins than Reiss: Langham (122) and **Linda Ziemke** (106).
- To show how far the team has come in a short time, Rhode Island was 17-71 in the three years before Reiss arrived.
- Last season, the Rams were undefeated through the first seven games for the first time in program history.
- Reiss is 32-16 in Atlantic 10 contests.
- In the four years before she arrived, Rhode Island was 16-48 in league games.
- In the 10 seasons before she arrived, Rhode Island was 24-126 in conference games.
- Rhody had its second straight winning season in the Atlantic 10 in 2021-22 for the first time in program history.
- Last year, the team was 12-2 in Atlantic 10 play, just the fourth time in 38 seasons the Rams have had a winning league record.
- The 12 league wins were the second most in program history behind the 1995-96 team that won 13 A-10 games and made the first and only NCAA Championship appearance.
- Reiss is only the third coach with a winning career record at Rhode Island. The others were **Beth Bricker** and Langham, both of whom coached the majority of their career before women's basketball was recognized by the NCAA and before the Atlantic 10 was formed.
- She has turned the Ryan Center into a true homecourt advantage, going 37-8 at home in four seasons. The Rams were 15-39 at home in the previous four years.
- Rhody was 12-2 at the Ryan Center last year, breaking the previous record of home wins in one season. Rhody's 10-3 home stint in 2019-20 was the previous record.
- In three years, six players signed professional contracts.
- The team has nine international players among its 14-player roster.

#### **Quentin Hillsman - Former Head Coach at Syracuse**

"In terms of what stands out for her strengths, it's her ability to connect with everyone around her. All of our players feel a close connection with her, and all of the people around our program feel it - because Tammi is genuine. She brings it every day, and everyone around her can see and feel the energy she has for life, not just for the game."

#### **Dawn Staley - Head Coach at South Carolina and Former Teammate at Virginia**

"It was going to take a special situation for Tammi to leave Syracuse, and she believes Rhode Island is that situation. She understands how she sees herself as a coach, and she is ready for this opportunity. She wants to build a brand, and it says a lot about what she sees in Rhode Island. She is putting her whole heart into this, and the people there will appreciate every bit of it."

#### **Paul Tylawski - Former School Teacher and Lifelong Mentor**

"Nobody will ever outwork Tammi. She attains the goals she sets. She has always been mature far beyond her years. When she was in eighth grade, she was the No. 2 cross country runner in the state of New York. I told her she was going to have to choose one sport or the other. The next day she came to me and said, 'Basketball is my ticket for the things I want to accomplish in life. Running is something I'll be able to do for the rest of my life, but basketball will give me the chance to achieve my goals.' And look where she is now. From the time she was a young kid, she's always been able to make decisions based on the bigger picture."

#### **Beth Burns - Former Head Coach at San Diego State**

"When Tammi joined our staff, she had to learn the scouting aspect of the college game. She had the quickest one-year improvement of any coach I've worked with. She understands how to do more with less. The kids she works with, they all love her. She's not soft on them by any means, and she knows how to keep them in line. She's able to communicate with them, they respect her, they believe in her, and they want to be her."

#### **Debbie Ryan - Women's Basketball Hall of Famer and Former Head Coach at Virginia**

"Rhode Island just got a gem of a head coach for its women's basketball program. Tammi was a great student-athlete here at UVA and I always felt that one day she would make an outstanding head coach. She understands the game and has a vision for how it needs to be played. More importantly, though, Tammi will be a leader of young women as she helps each player develop to her potential, both on and off the court."

The Rams had a historically written season under Reiss in 2021-22, reaching 22 wins for the first time in program history. It was the first 20-win season since 1996 and just the third all-time. For the first time ever, Rhody started off 7-0, and then strung together the program's longest win streak (13).

To add to the season of firsts, the Rams received the first-ever WNIT bid in history, and just the second postseason appearance all-time. Rhode Island had national recognition all season, earning votes from both the AP Top 25 Poll and six straight weeks of receiving votes in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches Poll. Reiss, named ESPNW National Coach of the Week, led Rhode Island to their second straight winning A-10 slate, another program first.

Reiss led the Rams to 29-16 in conference play, while also establishing the Ryan Center as a true home court advantage (30-8).

Under Reiss' leadership, eight Rams have earned All-Conference accolades. Emmanuelle Tahane was named Co-Player of the Year as the first Ram to earn the honor since 1985. Reiss also collected the 2020-21 Coach of the Year - just the second in program history.

Reiss has increased alumni engagement as well as fundraising for the program. On the annual URI Day of Giving, Reiss announced the team helped raised over \$150,000 to fund a new locker room.

Reiss led the Rams to new heights during her first year in 2019-20. Rhody had a program-record 10 wins in the Ryan Center, the best since the building opened its doors in 2002-03. Under Reiss, the Rams doubled their conference win total (6) from a year prior.

With a strong reputation as a communicator, Reiss has a history of recruiting and player development. She comes to URI after spending four years as an assistant coach at Syracuse. During her time with the Orange, she worked closely with the guards and helped Syracuse to three straight NCAA Tournament second round appearances. She mentored the only players in program history to earn WBCA Division I Coaches All-America Honors in Alexis Peterson, Brittney Sykes, and Tiana Mangakahia. Peterson and Mangakahia also earned Associated Press All-America Honors. Both Peterson and Sykes were selected in the 2017 WNBA Draft and Sykes went on to earn 2017 WNBA All-Rookie Team honors.

Reiss helped Syracuse to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances, owning a 7-4 record at the big dance. The Orange had 99 wins during her four-year span, including 45 conference victories. Following its run to the national championship game in 2016, the team was ranked No. 3 nationally in the final USA Today Coaches poll, its highest rank in program history.

Before Syracuse, Reiss spent time at Cal State Fullerton as the associate head coach. She served as the Titans' recruiting coordinator and was responsible for game and practice preparation, player development with emphasis on guard play, and conducted the offseason conditioning program.

From 2011-13, Reiss was an assistant coach at San Diego State, where she helped guide the Aztecs to two conference regular-season titles, the 2012 Mountain West Tournament crown, and one NCAA Tournament appearance. She mentored Courtney Clements, the 2012 Mountain West Player of the Year, and Chelsea Hopkins, who was named the 2012 Mountain West Newcomer of the Year and Mountain West Player of the Year in 2013.

Prior to working at San Diego State, Reiss served as an assistant coach for the WNBA's San Antonio Silver Stars and Utah Starzz. During her time in Utah, the Starzz advanced to the Western Conference final in 2002.

Reiss was an assistant coach at her alma mater, Virginia, from 1993-96. She helped guide the Cavaliers to two ACC regular-season titles and three NCAA Tournament appearances, including two trips to the Elite Eight.

She was a four-year starter for the Cavaliers, earning All-American honors in 1992. She led UVA to three ACC regular-season titles, two league tournament championships, and three Final Four appearances. Reiss earned All-Conference honors three times in her career and was named to the All-ACC Tournament Team twice. She ended her collegiate career ranked first in school history in 3-point field goals made (139) and 3-point field goal percentage (.416) and was second in points (1,842) and free throws made (437).

Reiss was the fifth overall pick in the 1997 WNBA Draft by the Starzz. She played two seasons for Utah, serving as team captain.

To add to her impressive athletic career, Reiss is also credited with multiple roles as an actress in movies *Juwanna Mann* and *Double Teamed*, as well as the TV series *Sister, Sister*.
