NOTABLES

- Saint Louis faces its highest ranked opponent this year (according to KenPom) on Tuesday as Utah State (5-1) visits Chaifetz Arena.
- The Billikens are 5-2 on the season and are coming off a 66-65 victory against Dartmouth on Saturday night.
- Saturday's win against the Big Green was the 200th in Chaifetz Arena history. The Bills are 200-68 in 16 seasons on their home court, including 4-0 this year and 19-3 the last two seasons.
- Terrence Hargrove Jr.** is second on the team in scoring (15.7 ppg) and tops in rebounding (6.1 rpg). He scored 17 points in the win against Dartmouth.
- Gibson Jimerson** scored a season-high 23 points in the win over Dartmouth, which moved him just three points away from passing Billiken great **Ed Macauley** for 13th on SLU's all-time scoring list.
- Michael Meadows Jr.** ranks 16th nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio (4.8).
- Kellen Thamess** has recorded at least one steal in every game and ranks fourth in the A-10 with 12 on the year.
- As a team, the Billikens rank 19th in the NCAA in free-throws made per game (19.0). They are also tops in the A-10 in 3-point percentage (.380) and fastbreak points (16.0 per game).
- After Tuesday's game, the Billikens hit the road for two straight at Southern Illinois (Dec. 2) and Drake (Dec. 6). SLU's next home game is Dec. 9 against Hofstra.

WHAT'S ON TAP?

- Saint Louis (5-2) concludes a busy November on Tuesday night when it hosts the Utah State Aggies (5-1) at Chaifetz Arena. Game time is set for 7 p.m.
- It's the final game of a quick two-game homestand for the Billikens. SLU hits the road for two straight beginning Saturday at Southern Illinois, then next Wednesday at Drake.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- Tuesday's game against Utah State will be televised on Bally Sports Midwest Extra, BSMW's alternate channel. **Scott Warmann** and **Scott Highmark** have the call.
- KMOX 1120 AM serves as the Home for Billiken Basketball on the radio. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will the call the action for all SLU games, both at home and on the road.

LAST TIME OUT

- Saint Louis survived a late rally by Dartmouth and defeated the Big Green 66-65 on Saturday night in nonconference men's basketball action at Chaifetz Arena.
- Saint Louis snapped a two-game skid and improved to 5-2 with the victory. Dartmouth fell to 1-3.
- **Gibson Jimerson** finished with a season-high 23 points thanks in part to 10-of-11 shooting from the stripe. Five of Jimerson's six field goals came in the second half.
- **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** scored 17 points and pulled down six rebounds. **Michael Meadows Jr.** scored 12 points, all in the first half. **Tim Dalger** was effective, scoring nine points and posting a team-high eight rebounds.
- The Billikens led by 11 at halftime but Dartmouth rallied and had a chance to win it in the end. The Big Green had a pair of shots at the basket and a wide-open look for 3 in the final seconds, but all attempts were off the mark and SLU escaped with the one-point win.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

- The Utah State game and the month of December usher in a challenging portion of the Billikens' schedule.
- Four of the remaining six opponents on the nonconference slate have KenPom rankings below 100, through games of Nov. 26. The other two, Southern Illinois and Hofstra, are close at 116 and 113, respectively.
- Utah State has the best KenPom ranking of an opponent that SLU has played this season at No. 64.

ABOUT UTAH STATE

- Utah State enters Tuesday's game with a 5-1 overall record. The Aggies' lone loss came in overtime at undefeated Bradley on Nov. 11.
- Last season, Utah State went 26-9 overall and earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament. In the offseason, head coach **Ryan Odom** was hired at VCU. Utah State hired **Danny Sprinkle** from Montana State after he took the Bobcats to two NCAA Tournament, and Sprinkle has constructed virtually an entirely new roster.
- Utah State is one of just three teams in the nation that returned zero points to its 2023-24 roster (New Mexico State and Northwestern).
- Despite the new look, the Aggies are still having success. They are coming off the Cayman Island Classic, which they won after defeating Marshall, Akron and Stephen F. Austin in consecutive games.
- **Great Osobor**, a 6-8 wing who played for Sprinkle at Montana State, averages a double-double of 20.5 ppg and 10.0 rpg. **Darius Brown II**, another Montana State transfer, scores 11.7 ppg and is among the nation's leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (6.71) and assists per game (7.8). Utah State features a seven-foot center in **Isaac Johnson**, a transfer from Oregon. He is averaging 6.2 ppg this season.
- Utah State ranks third in the NCAA in 3-point percentage defense as teams shoot just .222 against the Aggies from beyond the arc. Also, the Aggies are 11th in the NCAA in assists per game (19.2) and 11th in FG% (.520).

SERIES HISTORY

- Saint Louis and Utah State are meeting for just the second time.
- The only previous meeting between SLU and Utah State occurred during the 1967-68 season at UCLA's LA Classic in Los Angeles. The Billikens defeated the Aggies 97-78 on a neutral court in the opening round of the tournament to advance to face the host Bruins. UCLA would defeat the Billikens in the next game. The Bruins were led by **Lew Alcindor (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar)** and coached by **John Wooden** and went on to win the

► Utah State is the third Mountain West opponent the Billikens have played the last few years. SLU faced Wyoming earlier this season, and had a home-and-home with Boise State the last two seasons. SLU is 11-5 all-time against Mountain West opponents. It has played New Mexico the most of any Mountain West foe, having posted a 3-3 record against the Lobos.

TRACKING JIMERSON

► **Gibson Jimerson**, SLU's leading scorer each of the last two seasons, is working his way up several categories in the SLU record book. He is third in school history with 247 3-pointers made, third in career FT percentage (.843), fifth in career 3FG percentage (.406) and 14th in career points (1,400).

► Among all active NCAA Division players, Jimerson is 31st in career 3FG% and 28th in career 3FGs made.

► Jimerson's 1,400 career points is 14th in SLU history and 70th among all active NCAA Division players. He is three points away from surpassing Billiken great **Ed Macauley** in 13th.

► Last season, Jimerson led the Billikens with 14.0 ppg and was second in the A-10 in 3FG percentage (85-212, .401) and third in the league in 3-pointers made per game (2.58).

► Jimerson announced on March 29 his intention to return to the Billikens. In fact, while this is Jimerson's fifth season with the Billikens, he is technically a junior eligibility wise. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games, the maximum amount of games allowed for him to play in and still receive the waiver. The 2020-21 season did not count against a players' eligibility due to the pandemic.

► Dec. 17, 2022, was a special day for Jimerson. In the morning, he walked across the stage at Chaifetz Arena in a cap and gown during SLU's Midyear Commencements and received a B.S. in International Business. Later that night in a game against Drake in the same Chaifetz Arena, he registered his 1,000th career point. Jimerson was named an Academic All-American in 2021-22.

HARGROVE AMONG SLU'S TOP SCORERS

► **Terrence Hargrove Jr.** is averaging 15.7 ppg to lead SLU's active players (**Sincere Parker** is at 17.3 ppg but is out with a foot injury).

► Hargrove is averaging 17.7 ppg over his last three games. He averaged 15 points and 5.7 rebounds in the Myrtle Beach Invitational en route to All-Tournament team honors.

► Hargrove tied a career-high with 27 points in the season-opening win against Southern Indiana. He also pulled down a career-high 15 rebounds against USI for the third double-double of his career, and the first since he recorded two his freshman campaign.

► Back for his fifth season with the Bills, Hargrove has played in 119 games in his career and could surpass the school record for games played this year. That record is currently held by **Dwayne Evans** and **Jordair Jett**, who played in 134 games from 2010-14.

► Last year, Hargrove appeared in all 33 games and made 16 starts. He was third on the Billikens with 20 blocked shots. In A-10 play, Hargrove shot better than 50 percent and averaged 7.7 points and 4.2 rebounds.

► Hargrove was the recipient of the U.S. Basketball Writers Association 2023 Perry Wallace Most Courageous Award for coming forward to discuss his mental health and helping to remove any stigma still associated with that, and to also acknowledge the many issues college basketball players – and athletes in all sports – have faced before, during and after the pandemic.

PARKER OUT 4-6 WEEKS WITH FOOT INJURY

► Junior **Sincere Parker** suffered a fracture in his right foot Nov. 16 against Wyoming and is out 4-6 weeks.

► He had a career-best 22 points against the Cowboys and was leading the Billikens with eight boards before leaving with eight minutes left in the second half with the injury.

► Parker's 17.3 ppg this season leads the Billikens.

► Last season, Parker played in all 33 games and averaged 5.9 points and 3.7 rebounds. He shot 42.3 percent

from the field and was third on the team with 23 3-pointers made.

► Parker averaged 6.7 points and was a 42.2 percent shooter from 3-point range during A-10 play (19-45).

DALGER INTO STARTING ROLE

► Senior **Tim Dalger** came off the bench in the Billikens' first three games, but was inserted into the starting lineup against Wyoming in the Myrtle Beach Invitational and has been starting ever since.

► He was especially productive in the win against Wyoming, scoring 17 points and registering three steals.

► For the season, Dalger scores 10.9 ppg and hauls in 5.6 rpg. He is second on the team with eight steals.

THAMES CONTRIBUTING IN PARKER'S ABSENCE

► One of the players who figures to see more playing time for the injured Sincere Parker is sophomore **Kellen Thanes**.

► Thanes did not disappoint after playing the most substantial minutes of his career in the three games at the Myrtle Beach Invitational. He averaged 7.0 ppg and 4.7 rpg in the three games.

► Thanes has at least one steal in all seven games this season and leads the Billikens with 12. That total ranks third in the conference.

POINT GUARDS PROTECTING THE BALL

► Point guards **Michael Meadows Jr.** and **Cian Medley** combined to dish out 23 assists and commit just three turnovers in the three games of the Myrtle Beach Invitational.

► For the season, Meadows has a 4.8 assist-to-turnover ratio, which ranks 16th early on in the NCAA.

HUGHES II ON SCHOLARSHIP, IN STARTING LINEUP

► **Larry Hughes II** was technically a preferred walk-on last season and is on scholarship this season. He drilled three treys en route to 12 points in the opener against Southern Indiana. He has started every game this season and is averaging 5.9 ppg.

► He appeared in 27 games and made his first-career start in the win at George Washington for an ailing **Yuri Collins**. Hughes played a career-high 26 minutes in that game at GW.

► Hughes had a then career-high 12 points against VCU in the A-10 semifinals, going 3-of-5 from the field, 3-of-4 from downtown and 3-of-3 from the line.

BRUUUUUUUUCE ZHANG DEBUTS

► Seven-foot freshman center **Bruce Zhang** made his collegiate debut Nov. 11 against Illinois State. He converted a 3-point play for his first-collegiate points to bring the Chaifetz Arena crowd to its feet.

► Zhang matched his career high with five points against Wichita State. He has hit all six of his FTs this year.

► Billikens fans are quick to yell "Bruuuuuuuce" each time Zhang checks in or scores. It's familiar territory for St. Louis sports fans as they would do the same each time Super Bowl XXXIV champion and NFL Hall of Famer **Isaac Bruce** would catch a pass for St. Louis Rams from 1995-2007.

BASKETBALL BLOODLINES

► **Larry Hughes II** is the son of Billiken great **Larry Hughes**. Larry Hughes played one season at SLU in 1997-98 before enjoying a long and successful career in the NBA. In his lone season with the Bills, Larry Hughes scored a school record 670 points and led the Bills to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Additionally, Larry Hughes Jr.'s sister, Lauryn, graduated from SLU in 2021 after playing four seasons on the SLU women's basketball team.

► **Kellen Thanes** is the son of **Kelly Thanes**, who from 1993-98 started at the University of Missouri and scored more than 1,600 points for the Tigers.

CHANGING OF THE (POINT) GUARD

► For the first time in four years, **Yuri Collins** isn't manning the point guard spot at SLU as he has graduated and moved on to his professional career.

► Collins holds every assists record in SLU school history, and is the A-10 career assists leader as well.

► In his four-year Billiken career, he totaled 878 assists and finished with 1,002 career points. He is 22nd in NCAA history in career assists and ranks 16th in NCAA history in assists average.

GLOBAL BILLIKENS

► Saint Louis went international in its recruiting as the Billikens added four freshmen from overseas.

► **Djordje Curcic**, a 6-2 guard, hails from Serbia. He was one of the youngest players in the ABA League and was part of Serbia's youth national team setup including the 2023 FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup in Hungary

► **Bruce Zhang** is a 7-0 center from China who comes to SLU via The Skill Factory in Atlanta. His first name is Chenzhifeng, but was given his American name by his high school English teacher.

HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

► Saint Louis is in its 16th season playing inside the 10,600-seat Chaifetz Arena.

► SLU is 200-68 all-time at Chaifetz Arena, including 4-0 this year.

► Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**.

Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded ComPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

JIMERSON UP FOR ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

► **Gibson Jimerson**, who graduated with a degree in international business with a GPA above 3.9, was named an Academic All-American in 2021-22 and will be up for the award this year as well. It has been a stated goal by Jimerson to earn the prestigious honor this season.

► Other Academic All-Americans in school history are **Rich Niemann** (1968), **Ted Milmiltz** (1986), **Scott Highmark** (1994 & 1995), **Kevin Lisch** (2009) and **Brian Conklin** (2012).

REMEMBERING FORD STUEN

► The Billikens remember and honor assistant coach **Ford Stuen**, who passed away May 11, 2021, at the age of 29. Stuen, the nephew of head coach **Travis Ford**, played at Oklahoma State for his uncle and served on the Billikens' staff for five years.

► SLU players wear a patch on their jersey with the "FS" script. That is how Stuen would sign his name on the many hand-written notes and letters that he would send to family, friends, and coaching colleagues.

► On opening night, Nov. 9, 2021, a banner was unveiled honoring **Ford Stuen** that will forever hang in the Chaifetz Arena rafters.



QUICK HISTORY LESSON

► The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.

► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).

► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

Travis Ford is in his eighth season at the helm of the Billiken basketball program and his 27th season as a collegiate head coach.

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total over the next four seasons.

Ford's tenure at SLU has been highlighted by three postseason appearances. Saint Louis captured the 2019 Atlantic 10 Conference Championship in dramatic fashion in Brooklyn and went to the NCAA Tournament. In a 2020-21 season that was derailed by COVID-19, the Billikens still managed to be in the conversation on Selection Sunday and ultimately was awarded a No. 1 seed in the NIT. The Billikens again went to the NIT in 2021-22. SLU was positioned for another postseason bid in 2019-20, but the season was canceled in March as SLU was preparing for the A-10 Championship.

The 2022-23 season is Ford's eighth year at SLU and his 27th season overall as a head coach. Ford is the third-winningest head coach in SLU men's basketball history.

In addition to his six years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville (1997-2000). Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and eight who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances. He recruited three McDonald's All-Americans to Stillwater during his tenure.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.

Ford, is a native of Madisonville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Heather, have three children: Brooks, Kyleigh and Shane. Ford earned a bachelor's degree in communications at the University of Kentucky in 1994.


