#### LAST ONE-LOSS TEAMS LEFT MEET IN NCAA SECOND ROUND

•No. 8 seed Saint Louis and No. 1 seed Southern California square off for the first time ever this evening with a spot in the NCAA Championship round of 16 at stake.

•The Billikens and Trojans are the only two remaining one-loss teams in the tournament. Maine and Western Michigan lost and Utah State was eliminated in penalty kicks in round one.

•After claiming the Atlantic 10 regular-season crown for a sixth time in seven years, Saint Louis won a seventh straight A-10 Championship title to earn the league's automatic NCAA bid.

•The Billikens, seeking a second straight "Sweet 16" berth, advanced to round two by defeating Kansas 1-0. The win extended SLU's unbeaten streak to 17 games (13-0-4) since Penn State handed the Bills their only loss of the season, 2-1, Sept. 1.

•In its first Big Ten Conference campaign, USC captured the regular-season title with a 10-0-1 record. The Trojans were eliminated from the Big Ten Championship in the semifinals, losing a penalty-kick shootout to Rutgers, but received an NCAA at-large bid and blanketed Sacramento State 5-0 in round one.

•USC, which reached the second round of the 2023 NCAA Championship, is 12-0-2 since suffering its only defeat of the season, a 2-1 setback vs. then-No. 1 Stanford Sept. 8.

#### BILLIKENS' FIRST-ROUND NCAA ATTENDANCE SECOND BEST

•Saint Louis drew 3,136 fans to its game vs. Kansas, the second-largest attendance in this year's NCAA Championship first round. Southern at Mississippi State (3,461) drew the most spectators.

#### PENN STATE A COMMON OPPONENT FOR BILLIKENS, TROJANS

•Penn State was the only common opponent for Saint Louis and USC this season.

•The Billikens fell 2-1 to the Nittany Lions Sept. 1 in St. Louis, while the Trojans topped Penn State 2-1 at home Oct. 20.

#### BILLIKENS IN THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

•Saint Louis is competing in its ninth NCAA Championship overall and seventh in succession.

•The Billikens are 6-7-1 in NCAA competition with wins over Kansas (1-0, 2024), Georgetown (2-1, 2023), Indiana (2-0, 2023), Ole Miss (2-1, 2021), Drake (2-0, 2006) and Stanford (2-0, 2005, SLU's first NCAA tournament game).

•Last year's victories over Indiana and Georgetown sent SLU to the "Sweet 16" for the first time, where the Billikens fell 4-3 in double overtime to host team Penn State.

#### SAINT LOUIS PLAYS IN CALIFORNIA FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2005

•Saint Louis women's soccer is competing in California for the first time since 2005, when the Billikens played their only three previous games in the state, all at Santa Clara.

•SLU lost 2-1 to the Broncos in regular-season play, then returned for the first NCAA Championship games in program history. The Billikens defeated Stanford 2-0 before dropping a 4-0 decision to Santa Clara.

#### BILLIKENS NEARING SCHOOL UNBEATEN, SHUTOUT RECORDS

•Saint Louis brings a 17-game unbeaten streak (13-0-4) into tonight's game. That is just one game shy of the school record of 18 set in 2022 and matched in 2023.

•With shutouts in eight of their last 10 games, the Billikens now have 14 clean sheets this season. The school mark is 15, achieved in each of the past two seasons.

#### SEVEN BILLIKENS EARN A-10 POSTSEASON HONORS

•**Lyndsey Heckel** and **Emily Gaebe** repeated as the Defensive Player of the Year and Offensive Player of the Year, respectively, to headline Saint Louis' seven A-10 postseason honorees.

•Heckel and Gaebe were first-team All-Conference selections. **Sophia Stram** and **Julia Simon** were named to the second team, while **Hope Kim** earned a spot on the All-Rookie team.

•**Katie Houck** and **Emily Puricelli** made the All-Academic team.

#### HECKEL NAMED A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP MOST OUTSTANDING

•**Lyndsey Heckel** was named Most Outstanding Player of the 2024 A-10 Championship.

•Heckel scored two goals in the tournament, including the game-winning tally in the 74th minute of Saint Louis' 3-1 win over UMass in the final, and spearheaded a defense that allowed just one goal in three games.

•**Emily Puricelli**, **Emily Gaebe**, **Hannah Larson**, **Katie Houck** and **Lucie Schwartz** also made the All-Tournament team.

## SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. USC

### GAEBE JOINS ELITE COMPANY WITH POSTSEASON AWARDS

•**Emily Gaebe** became just the fourth Billiken to collect three conference postseason major awards. Gaebe was the 2021 A-10 Rookie of the Year in addition to her two Offensive Player of the Year honors.

•Gaebe joins **Alli Klug** (three-time A-10 Defensive POTY); **Courtney Hulcer** (twice A-10 and once Conference USA Defensive POTY); and **Meghann Burke** (C-USA Freshman of the Year and two-time Defensive POTY).

### GAEBE, LARSON COMING THROUGH IN POSTSEASON AGAIN

•Once again, **Emily Gaebe** and **Hannah Larson** are sparking the Saint Louis attack in postseason play.

•In four postseason games (three A-10 Championship, one NCAA Championship), Gaebe has four goals and Larson has four assists – notching a helper on each of Gaebe's goals.

•In six 2023 postseason games (three A-10 Championship, three NCAA Championship), Gaebe (3G, 3A) and Larson (3G, 2A) combined for six goals and five assists.

### SAINT LOUIS IN THE NATIONAL PICTURE

•Saint Louis landed at No. 21 in the final NCAA Division I Ratings Percentage Index.

•The Billikens moved up two spots to No. 19 in this week's Top Drawer Soccer rankings.

### SAINT LOUIS WINS SEVENTH A-10 REGULAR-SEASON CROWN

•Saint Louis is the A-10 regular-season champion for a sixth time in the past seven seasons and seventh time overall. The 2005 team accomplished the feat in SLU's first year in the league.

•SLU has gone unbeaten in A-10 play in each of its six championship campaigns since 2018. Its 2018 (10-0-0), 2020 (8-0-0) and 2022 (10-0-0) teams were unbeaten and untied. The Bills' combined conference record in those six seasons is 53-0-5.

•Including Conference USA titles in 1999 and 2004, the Billikens have nine regular-season championships to their credit.

### GAEBE SETS SLU CAREER GOALS, POINTS RECORDS

•**Emily Gaebe** recorded her first Saint Louis hat trick in a 5-0 win at Duquesne Oct. 6 and, in the process, set Billiken career records for goals and points. Gaebe has since increased her school-record totals to 48 goals and 118 points.

•Gaebe also owns the SLU career record for shots (304) and is second in game-winning goals (13), tied for fourth in game-winning assists (eight), tied for fifth in assists (22) and seventh in games (90).

### GAEBE TIES HER OWN SEASON GOALS RECORD, NEARS OTHERS

•**Emily Gaebe's** goal vs. Kansas lifted her season total to 16, matching the school record she registered last season.

•With 36 points, Gaebe also is within reach of the school-record 41 points she tallied a year ago. The 36 points – a Billiken senior-class record – rank second on the SLU single-season list.

•Gaebe has 90 shots, second most overall in Billiken history and most by a senior. She set the school mark of 93 a year ago.

### PURICELLI TO SET ANOTHER SCHOOL RECORD TONIGHT

•Goalkeeper **Emily Puricelli**, who has never missed a game during her collegiate career, tonight is making her school-record 109th appearance in the first 11. **Hannah Friedrich** (2018-22) held the previous mark of 104 starts.

•In addition, Puricelli enters tonight's game tied with **Abbie Miller** (2019-23) for the Billiken record of 108 games played.

•Puricelli also holds program records for wins (82), shutouts (51) and goalkeeper minutes (9,516) and is second in goals against average (0.61) and saves (331).

### OTHERS ON BILLIKEN CAREER LISTS

•**Lyndsey Heckel** is second in starts (107), third in games (107) and tied for third in game-winning goals (11).

•**Sophia Stram** is tied for third in starts (104) and tied for fourth in games (105).

•**Katie Houck** is sixth in starts (89) and eighth in games (89).

•**Hannah Larson** is eighth in assists (21).

•**Hannah Sawyer** is eighth in shots (189) and tied for ninth in games (86).

### BILLIKENS IN THE NCAA, A-10 PLAYER STATISTICAL RANKINGS

•**Emily Gaebe** is among the nation's top 25 in total shots per game (4.29, 14th, leads A-10), goals per game (0.76, 15th, leads A-10), points per game (1.71, 16th), game-winning goals (five, tied for 16th, leads A-10) and shots on goal per game (2.05, 22nd).

•**Emily Puricelli** is sixth in shutouts (11, leads A-10), eighth in save percentage (.868), 10th in goals against average (0.49, leads A-10) and 18th in GK minutes (1,844) in the national rankings.

•Puricelli's 11 shutouts this season are tied for third all-time at Saint Louis. She holds the record of 13 (2022).

### HECKEL DEADLY FROM THE SPOT

•**Lyndsey Heckel** has a career-high 14 points and a career-high-tying six goals this season, thanks in large part to her effectiveness from the penalty spot.

•Heckel has taken four of the Billikens' six penalty kicks and has converted all four. That ties her for the third-most successful attempts in the nation.

### KIM'S FIRST THREE BILLIKEN GOALS ARE GAME-WINNERS

•Freshman **Hope Kim** has scored four goals this season, and the first three were game-winning tallies.

•Kim's goals at Massachusetts and vs. VCU were the Billikens' only markers in 1-0 victories. She scored the first goal in a 2-0 victory at Richmond.

### STATISTICAL DOMINATION

•In addition to their 49-10 goals advantage, the Billikens have a significant edge over their opponents in three other categories.

•SLU has more than doubled its opponents' totals in total shots (400-187), shots on goal (186-84) and corner kicks (158-70).

## SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. USC

### FACING TOP TEAMS BECOMING ROUTINE FOR BILLIKENS

•Since the 2020 season, Saint Louis has played or will play, either during the regular season or in the NCAA Tournament, 14 opponents who are ranked among the top 50 in the final 2024 NCAA RPI.

•The 14 opponents are Arkansas, BYU, Georgetown, Iowa, Kansas, Massachusetts, Notre Dame, Oklahoma State, Penn State, Rutgers, USC, Utah State, Washington and Xavier.

### FIVE BILLIKENS RANK HIGH AMONG ACTIVE NCAA LEADERS

•**Emily Puricelli** leads active players across all three NCAA divisions in shutouts (51), goalkeeper minutes (9,516) and games (108). Among active Division I players, Puricelli is third in goals against average (0.61) and ninth in saves (331).

•**Emily Gaebe** is fourth in points (118) and fifth in goals (48) among active Division I players. Gaebe is one of only four active Division I players with at least 48 goals and 20 assists (22).

•On the games list for all divisions, **Lyndsey Heckel** is second (107), **Sophia Stram** is tied for third (105) and **Katie Houck** is tied for sixth (103).

### BILLS DISPLAY DEPTH, BALANCE IN THE ATTACK

•Through the first 22 games, 15 Billikens scored at least one goal, and 18 Billikens recorded at least one point.

•Thirty-seven of SLU's 49 goals have been assisted. A different player combination has accounted for 31 of the 37 assisted goals. The only combos who have collaborated more than once are **Emily Gaebe** from **Hannah Larson** (four times), Gaebe from **Julia Simon** (twice), Simon from Gaebe (twice) and **Lyndsey Heckel** from **Katie Houck** (twice).

•Gaebe leads Saint Louis with 16 goals and 36 points. Heckel is second with six goals, while Simon, **Hannah Sawyer**, **Hope Kim** and **Audrey Smith** have four goals each. Larson (seven), Houck (five) and Gaebe (four) are the Billikens' assists leaders.

### BILLIKENS CONTINUE IMPRESSIVE CONFERENCE STREAK

•Saint Louis' 3-1 win over Massachusetts Nov. 10 extended an Atlantic 10 Conference streak for the Billikens.

•Including regular-season and conference tournament competition, Saint Louis is unbeaten in 42 consecutive games vs. A-10 opponents.

### PURICELLI, GAEBE PILE UP ATLANTIC 10 WEEKLY HONORS

•**Emily Puricelli** earned three A-10 Defensive Player of the Week awards this season (Sept. 16-22, Sept. 9-15 and Aug. 19-25), giving her eight selections in her career.

•**Emily Gaebe** was named A-10 Offensive Player of the Week three times this year (Sept. 30-Oct. 6, Sept. 9-15 and Aug. 19-25), increasing her career total to seven.

•In addition, Gaebe was named to the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week for Sept. 30-Oct. 6 and Sept. 9-15 (honorable mention).

### HECKEL, HOUCK HONORED BY TOP DRAWER SOCCER

•**Lyndsey Heckel** and **Katie Houck** have been honored on Top Drawer Soccer's National Team of the Week this season.

•Heckel was recognized on the Nov. 4-10 team. She scored the game-winning goal in the 74th minute of the Billikens' 3-1 win over Massachusetts in the A-10 Championship final and was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

•Houck was honorable mention on the Oct. 14-20 team. She assisted on the game-winning goal and helped SLU hold Richmond without a shot in a 2-0 victory, and she recorded the game-winning goal and added an assist in a 4-1 win at La Salle.

### SLU HAS MOST ALL-AMERICANS, TIED FOR MOST HERMANN TROPHY SEMIFINALISTS ON 2024 DIVISION I TEAMS

•Saint Louis is the only NCAA Division I women's team in 2024 with three United Soccer Coaches All-Americans on its roster.

•The Billikens feature **Lyndsey Heckel**, a first-team selection in 2022 and a second-team choice in 2023, making her the second two-time All-American in program history (**Alli Klug**, 2017-18); **Emily Gaebe**, who collected first-team plaudits in 2023; and **Emily Puricelli**, a third-team pick in 2022.

•Heckel was the first Billiken women's soccer player to garner a place on an All-America first team, while Gaebe became the program's first forward to earn a first-team nod.

•Additionally, SLU is one of only two 2024 Division I women's teams with two former Hermann Trophy semifinalists on its roster, joining Texas (Trinity Byars, Lexi Missimo). Heckel and Gaebe made the 15-player list in 2022 and 2023, respectively.

### THE BILLIKENS IN 2023 ...

•Made a sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and advanced to the "Sweet 16" for the first time in program history, defeating Indiana and Georgetown in the first two rounds;

•Earned the program's highest end-of-season ranking in the United Soccer Coaches poll (No. 11) and matched its highest end-of-season standing in the NCAA Division I RPI (No. 10);

•Captured a sixth straight A-10 Tournament title;

•Won the A-10 regular-season title for a fifth time in six years;

•Went 19-3-2 overall and 9-0-1 in conference play, posting a fifth undefeated league slate in the past six years;

•Finished among the nation's top 10 in numerous categories, including second in goals per game (3.08) and goal differential (plus-59), fourth in shutout percentage (.625) and fifth in assists per game (2.92);

•Set SLU records for goals (74), assists (70), points (218), goal differential (plus-59), total shots (457), consecutive shutouts (11), consecutive shutout minutes (1099:09) and games (24), and tied SLU marks for longest unbeaten streak (18) and shutouts (15).

### 17 RETURN FROM 2023 TEAM

•Seven starters and 10 additional players return from the 2023 Billikens.

•Returning starters are goalkeeper **Emily Puricelli**; defenders **Lyndsey Heckel**, **Sophia Stram**, **Katie Houck** and **Izzy Luebbert**; forward **Emily Gaebe**; and midfielder/forward **Hannah Larson**.

•Also back are forwards **Hannah Sawyer** and **Jordan Gary**; forward/midfielders **Julia Simon** and **Lucie Schwartz**; midfielders **Ellie Paloucek** and **Nina Preusser**; midfielder/defender **Katelyn Brinkman**; defenders **Eva Schreiber** and **Autumn Jackson**; and goalkeeper **Becca Wolterman**.

## SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. USC

### SIX 2023 POSTSEASON HONOREES RETURN

•Six of the nine Billikens who earned postseason honors in 2023 return this season.

•The group includes three A-10 major-award winners – Offensive Player of the Year **Emily Gaebe**, Defensive Player of the Year **Lyndsey Heckel** and Goalkeeper of the Year **Emily Puricelli**. Since 2016, Saint Louis women's soccer players have earned 16 A-10 postseason major awards, including three in three of the past four seasons.

•Gaebe, Heckel and Puricelli went on to collect United Soccer Coaches first-team All-Region accolades. Gaebe and Heckel were named to the United Soccer Coaches All-America first and second teams, respectively.

•Also returning are second-team All-Conference selections **Hannah Larson**, **Sophia Stram** and **Katie Houck**.

•Heckel became one of the first two SLU women's soccer players to earn first-team All-Conference honors four times. She, Puricelli (first team three times, second team once) and Stram (twice each on the first and second teams) are three of nine players in team history with four All-Conference selections.

•Gaebe garnered first-team plaudits for a second time; with a prior second-team nod, she is a three-time All-Conference honoree. Larson is a two-time All-Conference choice (one first, one second).

### BILLIKENS WELCOME 13 NEWCOMERS

•Three transfers and 10 freshmen joined the SLU program this season.

•The transfers are midfielder/defender **Elise Le** (Xavier), forward **Rylee Howard** (Wisconsin) and defender **Camille Welker** (Iowa).

•The freshmen are forwards **Emily Fox**, **Hope Kim**, **Sarah Sarnowski** and **Audrey Smith**; midfielders **Addy Lang** and **Ashley Miller**; defender/midfielder **Isa Moreno**; defender **Ulla Sharp**; forward/defender **Caigan Leonard**; and goalkeeper **Nimu Karani**.

### THREE BILLIKENS LAND ON HERMANN TROPHY WATCH LIST

•**Lyndsey Heckel**, **Emily Gaebe** and **Emily Puricelli** were named to the 2024 Hermann Trophy Watch List.

•SLU tied 2023 national champion Florida State and Texas Tech for the most players on the Watch List.

•Gaebe was one of 15 semifinalists for last year's award, and Heckel was a 2022 semifinalist.

### THREE NAMED UNITED SOCCER COACHES "PLAYERS TO WATCH"

•The Billikens placed three players on the United Soccer Coaches "Players to Watch" lists.

•Goalkeeper **Emily Puricelli**, defender **Lyndsey Heckel** and forward **Emily Gaebe** comprise the Saint Louis trio.

### TOP DRAWER SOCCER RECOGNIZES FOUR BILLIKENS

•**Lyndsey Heckel**, **Emily Gaebe** and **Emily Puricelli** are included on Top Drawer Soccer's Preseason Best XI teams.

•Heckel was named to the first team, Gaebe landed on the second team, and Puricelli was selected to the third team.

•Heckel (No. 5), Gaebe (No. 17), Puricelli (No. 31) and **Hannah Larson** (No. 46) made the TDS Preseason Top 100.

•Top Drawer Soccer refers to Heckel as "the premier center back in college soccer."

### BIG PUNCH RETURNS FROM 2023 OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUT

•Five of SLU's top seven point-scorers from a year ago are back, part of a returning group who combined for 46 of the 2023 team's 74 goals (62 percent) and 48 of its 70 assists (69 percent).

•**Emily Gaebe** (school-record 41 points on a school-record 16 goals to go with nine assists), **Hannah Larson** (7-9-23) and **Hannah Sawyer** (10-2-22) are three of the players who gave Saint Louis four 20-point scorers for the first time in program history. Gaebe and Sawyer are two of the players who gave SLU three double-digit goal-scorers for the first time ever.

•**Lyndsey Heckel** (4-4-12) and **Julia Simon** (3-4-10) also finished among the top seven on the Billikens' points chart.

•**Izzy Luebbert** contributed eight assists, just one behind team leaders Gaebe and Larson.

•The 2023 Billikens broke school records for points, goals and assists in their 21st game. The 2022 team, which held the previous marks, set them in 22 games.

### ... AND DON'T FORGET THE DEFENSE

•SLU concluded the 2023 season by shutting out 13 of its last 16 opponents, part of a school-record-tying 15 clean sheets.

•The Bills set a school mark for consecutive shutout minutes (1099:09).

•The Billikens allowed just 15 goals overall. In 13 games vs. conference opponents (10 in the regular season, three in the A-10 Championship), Saint Louis yielded only one goal.

•The Billikens' plus-59 goal differential set a school record.

### BILLS MAKE HERMANN STADIUM A SOCCER FORTRESS

•Saint Louis is 79-9-11 (.854) in its last 99 games on the home pitch of Robert R. Hermann Stadium, a stretch that dates to the final home game of the 2015 campaign.

•In those 99 games, SLU outscored opponents 229-39, posted 63 shutouts, and allowed more than one goal just three times.

•Against A-10 opponents during the 99-game stretch, Saint Louis is 55-1-4 (40-0-4 regular season, 15-1-0 A-10 tournament) at Hermann Stadium.

•SLU's last home loss to a conference foe occurred Oct. 28, 2017, vs. Saint Joseph's in the A-10 Championship first round. The Bills' last A-10 regular-season home loss was Oct. 22, 2015, also vs. Saint Joseph's. SLU is unbeaten in 45 regular-season league matches at home since then.

### HOME-GROWN TALENT PROMINENT ON BILLIKEN ROSTER

•Seven different states – Missouri, Illinois, Kansas, Ohio, Tennessee, New York and Georgia – are represented on the 2024 Saint Louis roster, but the Billikens' team is composed largely of local and state-of-Missouri players.

•Of SLU's 30 players, 14 are from the St. Louis area (including three from just across the Mississippi River in Illinois), and 14 are from Missouri.

# SAINT LOUIS GAME NOTES vs. USC

## HEAD COACH KATIE SHIELDS

•Now in her 12th season leading the Billikens, 2018, 2019 and 2022 Atlantic 10 Conference Coach of the Year **Katie Shields** owns a 168-60-22 career record (all at Saint Louis). Shields' .716 career winning percentage ranks 21st among active NCAA Division I women's soccer coaches.

•In addition to the 2022 A-10 coaching honor, Shields and her staff were selected the 2022 East Region Coaching Staff of the Year by United Soccer Coaches, the second such honor for SLU in three seasons.

•Shields, who spent one year as a SLU assistant before becoming head coach, has guided the Bills to a league-best 146-31-17 mark since the start of the 2016 season. Her .796 winning percentage during that span ranks third among all active Division I women's soccer coaches and is the top mark among active female Division I women's soccer coaches.

•Shields' record since 2016 includes a 94-8-8 (.891) ledger vs. A-10 opponents (including conference tournament games).

•Shields' Billikens are playing in a seventh straight NCAA Championship this year after extending the A-10 women's soccer record for consecutive league tournament championships to seven.

•The Billikens also made history four seasons ago when they became the first A-10 women's soccer team to capture both regular-season and tournament titles in three consecutive years.

•Shields' players have earned All-America honors seven times, All-Region plaudits 29 times and Atlantic 10 accolades (first team, second team, All-Rookie) 77 times. In addition, Billikens have been selected A-10 Defensive Player of the Year eight times (eight of the past nine seasons), Midfielder of the Year three times, Offensive Player of the Year four times (including each of the past three seasons), Rookie of the Year twice and Goalkeeper of the Year once (award was initiated in 2023).

## SAINT LOUIS IN 29TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S SOCCER

•The 2024 season is the 29th in SLU women's soccer history.

•The Billikens are 349-176-65 for a .647 winning percentage.

•In conference play (Conference USA 1996-2004, Atlantic 10 since 2005), SLU is 181-71-30 (.695).

•Saint Louis has captured 18 conference championships (nine regular-season, nine tournament) and has made nine NCAA Championship appearances (2005, 2006, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024).

•The 2023 team became the first in program history to reach the round of 16. The 2005, 2006 and 2021 teams reached the second round with first-round wins; the 2020 Billikens (season played in spring 2021) were seeded into the second round in an abbreviated 48-team tournament field.

•This year's team has guaranteed a 20th winning season (ninth consecutive), a winning percentage of .750 or higher for an 11th time (including three straight and eight of the past nine years), and 15 or more victories for a 10th time (including three straight and seven of the past eight years).

## BILLIKENS' VETERAN PLAYERS HEAVILY DECORATED

•Postseason accolades have been plentiful for Saint Louis in recent seasons, and players on this year's team have collected their fair share.

•The 2024 Billiken squad includes 10 players who have combined to capture 71 postseason awards (A-10 conference and United Soccer Coaches All-America and All-Region recognition, plus Hermann Trophy consideration).

## WHAT'S A BILLIKEN?



The Billiken was born Oct. 8, 1908, when Kansas City art teacher and illustrator Florence Pretz patented a design for an elflike creature with pixie ears, a mischievous smile and a tuft of hair on his pointed head. Reportedly, the image came to her in a dream.

Although it didn't appear on the actual patent, some believe Pretz found the Billiken name in a fanciful work entitled, "Mr. Moon: A Song of the Little People," by Canadian poets Bliss Carman and Richard Hovey.

Within a short time, Pretz sold her patented image to

the Billiken Company of Chicago. Initially manufactured as a bank and statuette, and later as a doll, this good luck charm soon became a national craze. By 1911, the Billiken's likeness adorned everything from marshmallow candies to hood ornaments.

In his heyday, the Billiken enjoyed worldwide fame. Artisans in Alaska began carving his image into ivory, and in Japan, he appeared in shrines, amusement parks and even a movie.

Like many other fads, the Billiken might have faded into obscurity if it were not for Saint Louis University law student John Bender, who also happened to be the coach of SLU's football team during the height of Billikenmania.

One story claims that nearby drugstore owner Billy Gunn called Bender a Billiken when the coach walked into his establishment one day. Supposedly, legendary sportswriter William O'Connor was within earshot of the remark and took up the moniker not only for Bender but also for SLU's sports teams.

Another tale claims O'Connor himself dubbed the coach a Billiken after a particularly good practice left Bender beaming with a big smile. After practice, Bender's fellow law student Charles Z. McNamara, a local cartoonist, sketched Bender as a Billiken, posted it in Gunn's drugstore window and tabbed the football team "Bender's Billikens."

Yet another yarn reports that the druggist asked McNamara to decorate his store window the night before a homecoming game. Supposedly, McNamara drew a Billiken, a popular good luck charm, causing one of his fellow students to exclaim, "That looks like coach Bender!"

Whatever the case, O'Connor is generally credited for popularizing the name throughout the city, but one fact flies in the face of this legend and lore. O'Connor did not join the St. Louis Post-Dispatch until Nov. 26, 1911, one full month after the newspaper first mentioned "Bender's Billikens."

Regardless of how the story is told or whether his mysterious origins are ever finally resolved, the Billiken remains a good luck charm for Saint Louis University's sports teams and always brings smiles to the faces of SLU fans.

Legend has it that the Billiken has three kinds of luck – good, better and best. Buying a Billiken gives the buyer good luck. To have one given to you is better luck. The best luck comes if the Billiken is stolen.

**Emily Puricelli** made three saves and picked up her 11th shutout of the season. **Lyndsey Heckel** made a major contribution to the shutout, clearing a ball off the line in the 83rd minute.

### SAINT LOUIS 3, MASSACHUSETTS 1

**Sunday, Nov. 10 – Hermann Stadium**

A goal by tournament Most Outstanding Player **Lyndsey Heckel** in the 74th minute gave top-seeded Saint Louis the lead, and the Billikens went on to defeat third-seeded Massachusetts 3-1 in the Atlantic 10 Championship final.

Heckel's goal came on a corner-kick serve from **Katie Houck**.

**Emily Gaebe** scored Saint Louis' first (13th minute) and last (90th minute) goals. Both were assisted by **Hannah Larson**.

Bella Recinos, assisted by Chandler Pedolzky, netted an equalizer for UMass in the 37th minute, and the game was knotted 1-1 at intermission.

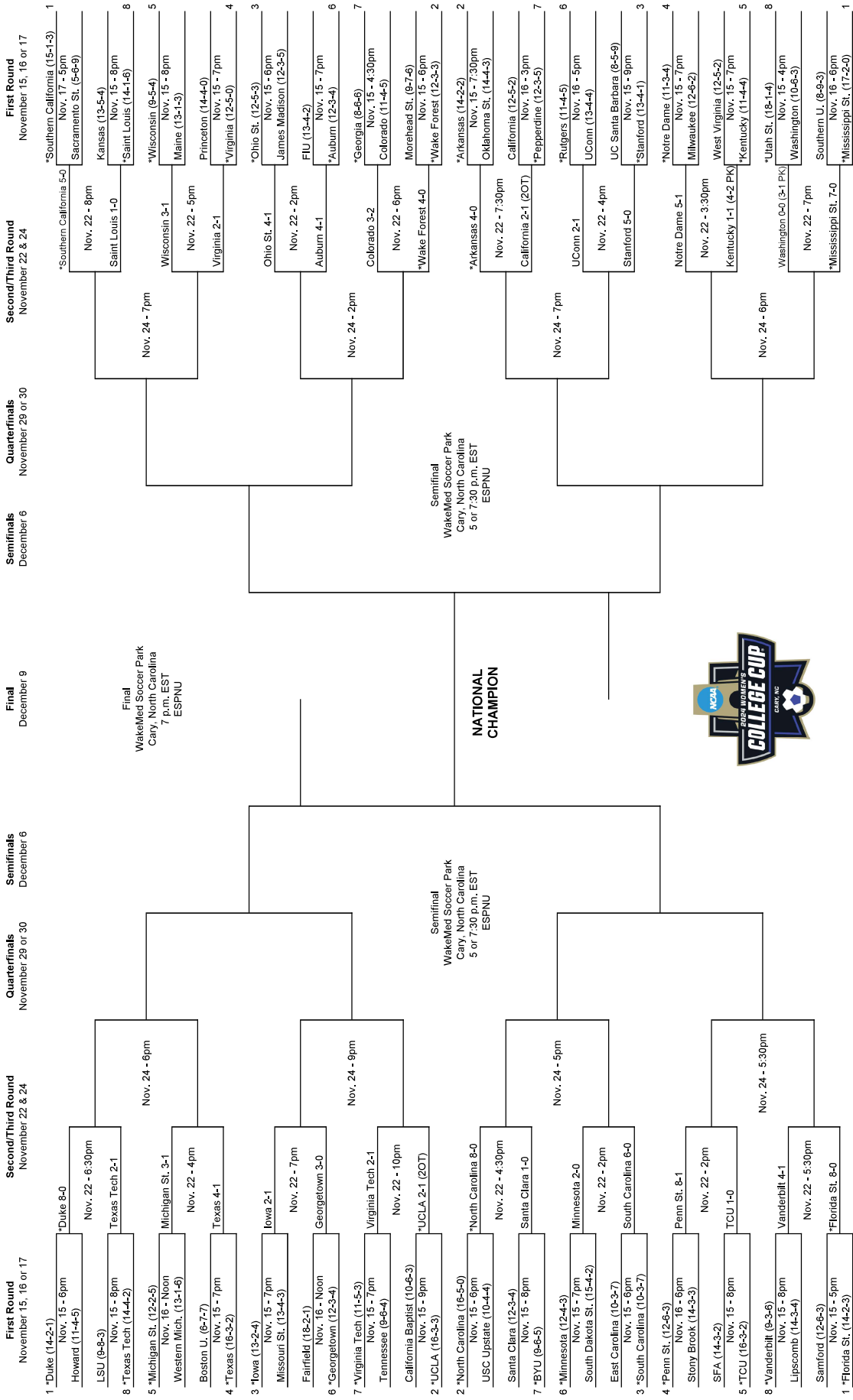
### #12 SAINT LOUIS 0, KANSAS CITY 0
