NOTABLES

- Saint Louis enters Tuesday's game in a three-way tie for fourth in the A-10 standings with an 8-6 conference mark. Davidson is in a group of three teams tied for ninth at 6-8.
- Saint Louis leads the A-10 in FG% (.471) and effective FG% (.556).
- The Billikens' 254 3-pointers are already third in a single season in school history, six away from second. SLU is on pace to break the school record of 284 set in 1994-95.
- **Gibson Jimerson**, SLU's leading scorer at 17.3 ppg (fourth in A-10), is coming off his first-career double-double in the URI game. The Bills' all-time leader in points and 3-pointers needs four FGs to surpass Anthony Bonner's school record (774).
- Jimerson needs seven more 3-pointers to reach 400 for his career. He would become just the 28th player in NCAA Division I history to reach that milestone.
- **Robbie Avila** is a finalist for the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award. He scores 17.0 ppg (fifth in A-10) and leads all centers in Division I in assists (4.1) and 3s made per game (1.7).
- **Isaiah Swope** turns in 15.8 points and is fourth in the A-10 with 4.6 assists per game.
- **Kalu Anya** is third in the A-10 in rebounds per game (8.7). His FG% of .600 is No. 5 in a season in school history.
- **Kobe Johnson** is averaging 9.5 ppg in conference play. He is leading the team in FG% (.600) and 3FG% (.444) during league play while hitting 13-of-14 from the stripe.
- Head coach **Josh Schertz** is in his first season at SLU. His .776 winning percentage ranks No. 8 among active coaches across all three NCAA divisions.

WHAT'S ON TAP?

- ▶ Saint Louis plays its second-to-last road game of the season on Tuesday when it travels to Davidson, North Carolina, to face the Davidson Wildcats. Game time is 6 p.m. (CT).
- ▶ The Billikens return home to take on Loyola Chicago on Saturday afternoon in a 3 p.m. tip at Chaifetz Arena. That game will be televised on CBS Sports Network.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION

- ▶ Tuesday's game at Davidson will be televised on FanDuel Sports Network Extra and also streamed on ESPN+.
- ▶ The game will air on KMOX 1120 AM. Billiken Hall of Famers and longtime SLU men's basketball radio partners **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action for all SLU games, both at home and on the road. Ramsey is in his 39th season calling SLU games, while Austin is in year No. 34.

LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ **Robbie Avila** scored a game-high 22 points, **Gibson Jimerson** posted his first career double-double, and Saint Louis sank a season-high 15 3-pointers in an 81-66 Atlantic 10 Conference victory over Rhode Island Saturday afternoon at Chaifetz Arena.
- ▶ The win put the Billikens (15-12, 8-6 A-10) in a three-way tie with Dayton and Saint Joseph's for fourth place in the A-10 with four games remaining. The top four teams in the final standings receive a double bye in the A-10 Championship.
- ▶ Jimerson's double-double was a 21-point, career- and game-high 11-rebound effort. He netted five 3-pointers as SLU shot 39.5 percent (15-of-38) from beyond the arc, and he added a season-high four assists.
- ▶ **Amari McCottry** also played a major role, scoring all of his career-high 13 points in the second half. McCottry's 4-of-4 second-half shooting including two treys, and he was 3-of-3 from the foul line. He also grabbed a career-high eight rebounds (six in the second half), helping Saint Louis register a 42-29 edge on the glass.
- ▶ **Isaiah Swope** had a game- and season-high four steals, a season-high-tying five rebounds and four assists.
- ▶ The Billikens did not allow an offensive rebound and outscored the Rams 12-0 in second-chance points. SLU also recorded a 21-10 advantage in bench points.

CARDIAC BILLIKENS

- ▶ One thing about this Billiken team is that they are rarely ever out of games and can put up points in a hurry.
- ▶ Against George Mason, SLU trailed by six with 41 seconds left and rallied to send the game into overtime. At UMass, the Billikens were down five in the final minute and scored seven points in the final 37 seconds to steal the win.
- ▶ Against Richmond, the Bills were down seven with approximately five minutes left and won by four. Even though it was a loss, SLU rallied from a 16-point second-half deficit at GW and got it to within a possession in the final seconds.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- ▶ The Davidson College Wildcats (Davidson, N.C.) enter Tuesday's game 16-11 overall and 6-8 in A-10 play.
- ▶ The Wildcats snapped a two-game skid in their last game at Fordham, winning 80-69 in the Bronx, N.Y. Davidson is 11-4 at Belk Arena, but it has lost its last two on its home court.
- ▶ **Reed Bailey** leads the A-10 in scoring with 19.7 ppg, which includes a league-best 21.4 ppg. The 6-foot-10 forward also ranks 10th in the A-10 in assists per game (3.8) and gets to the line more than anyone in the league. His 6.4 rpg leads the team.
- ▶ **Bobby Durkin** is second on the Wildcats in scoring (14.7 ppg) and rebounding (6.1 rpg). Durkin leads the A-10 in 3-pointers per game (3.04) and is second in 3-point field-goal percentage (.381).
- ▶ **Connor Kochera** is third on the squad with 13.6 ppg.
- ▶ Davidson leads the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.6). The Wildcats turn the ball over just 9.5 time per game, which ranks 14th in the NCAA.
- ▶ **Matt McKillop** is in his third year as head coach at Davidson. He has been on Davidson's staff since 2008 and took over for his father, **Bob McKillop**, who coached the Wildcats for 33 years.

SERIES HISTORY

- ▶ This is the 14th meeting all-time between the two teams. The series began when Davidson joined the A-10 in 2014-15. The Wildcats lead the all-time series 9-4.
- ▶ The Bills got their first win in Davidson the last time the teams met at Belk Arena in the 2022-23 season. **Gibson Jimerson** hit a pair of treys en route to 11 points in that game.

AVILA NCAA'S TOP PASSING CENTER, 3-POINT SHOOTER

► **Robbie Avila** is averaging 4.1 assists per game, which leads all centers in the NCAA this season and ranks seventh in the A-10. Wofford's Tyler Filewich is the next closest center in the NCAA ranks at 3.1 apg.

► Also, Avila's 1.7 3-pointers made per game leads all centers behind Illinois' Tomislav Ivisic (1.5).

► Avila has averaged 22.7 ppg over his last three games. This is coming off an uncharacteristic three-game stretch where averaged just 6.3 ppg.

► Avila is a finalist for the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award.

► Last season at Indiana State, Avila averaged 17.4 points, 6.6 rebounds and 4.1 assists while shooting 53.6 percent from the field and 39.4 percent from the arc. He led all NCAA Division I centers in assists a season ago.

► Avila has collected a number of preseason accolades. Just to name a few, Avila has been named a preseason AP honorable-mention All-American, first-team preseason All-Conference by the Atlantic 10, and named to preseason Watch Lists for the Naismith Trophy, and the Wooden Award

TRACKING JIMERSON

► **Gibson Jimerson** is the new scoring leader in SLU men's basketball history. He surpassed **Anthony Bonner's** school record that was set in 1990 with a layup in the San Francisco game. Jimerson is at 2,292 points, and counting.

► Jimerson is second among active NCAA Division I players in career 3-pointers (school-record 393). He ranks eighth in career points among active players.

► Jimerson broke the A-10 record for 3s made in a career by an A-10 player, surpassing Rhode Island's Jimmy Baron, who drained 361 3s from 2006-09. He is No. 3 all-time in the A-10 in career scoring, trailing Temple's Mark Macon (2,609 points from 1987-91) in first and UMass' Jim McCoy (2,374 from 1988-92) in second.

► For the year, Jimerson is fourth in the A-10 in scoring with 17.3 ppg.

► Jimerson's 81 treys are sixth on SLU's single-season chart. He occupies four spots in the top 10 at SLU. Jimerson's career season high in 3s is 87 back in 2021-22.

► This is Jimerson's sixth season with the Bills. He received a medical hardship waiver his first season (2019-20) after injuring his foot after playing in 10 games. The 2020-21 COVID season did not count against a players' eligibility. Jimerson is the school-record holder for games played (159) and minutes played (5,190).

► An Academic All-American, Jimerson holds a bachelor's degree in International Business and an MBA from SLU. He is currently pursuing a post-graduate certificate in Organizational Leadership from Saint Louis University.

SWOPE AMONG SCORING LEADER, TOP ASSISTS MAN

► **Isaiah Swope** scores 15.8 ppg (ninth in the A-10) and leads the Billikens with 4.6 assists per game (fourth in the A-10).

► Among active NCAA Division I players, Swope ranks 13th in the country in career 3s made per game (2.73). His career scoring average of 15.8 ppg (D1 seasons only) is 26th among all active players in Division I.

► Swope's scoring totals combined with his assists numbers is something that has rarely been seen in school history. Only David Burns some 45 years ago finished a season matching Swope's current averages of 15.8 points and 4.6 assists.

► Swope drilled 113 3-pointers last year at Indiana State to rank fourth in the NCAA. He averaged 15.9 points in 2023-24 despite playing the majority of the year with a knee injury.

CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD(S)

- **Kalu Anya** has stated in the media that it's a goal of his to lead the A-10 in rebounding.
- He enters Tuesday's game third in the A-10 with 8.7 rebounds per contest.
- Anya has a team-leading three double-doubles on the year. He also scores 7.3 ppg and leads the Billikens in FG% (.600).

DON'T FORGET ABOUT KOBE JOHNSON

- The Billikens have the big three scorers in Jimerson, Avila and Swope, as well as the top rebounder in Anya, but the fifth Billiken starter **Kobe Johnson** as come up strong as of late.
- In conference play, Johnson averages 9.5 ppg and leads the team in shooting from the field (.627), 3-point range (.444) and the stripe (.929).

IT'S RAINING 3s

- Saint Louis is on pace to drain the most 3-pointers ever in a single season in school history.
- SLU enters the Davidson game with 254 total 3-pointers, which already ranks third in a season in school history. It needs six more to surpass last year's squad for second. The 1994-95 team holds the school record for total 3s (284) and 3s per game (9.2).
- The Billikens' 9.4 3-pointers made per game ranks second in the A-10 behind only VCU (9.9).

- Saint Louis drained 15 3-pointers in the win over Rhode Island, the most ever in a home game in school history.
- Two single-game records to keep an eye on this year include the Billikens' team single-game record for 3s made (17, vs. Tulane, 12/8/19), and the individual single-game record for 3s made (8, **Tommie Liddell III** vs. Temple, 1/17/07).

EFFICIENT FROM THE FIELD

- A sure sign that the Billikens' offense is clicking is when they are finishing high percentage shots around the rim. For the season, the Billikens are fourth in the NCAA in 2-pt FG% (.600).
- The Bills' .730 2-pt FG% at Fordham is the second-best in school history in an A-10 game. In fact, SLU this season has posted four of the top seven 2-pt FG% marks all-time in A-10 play.
- Last season, **Josh Schertz's** Indiana State team led the nation in 2-point field-goal percentage at .627.

SCHERTZ AMONG NCAA'S ELITE

- SLU head coach **Josh Schertz** has a career .775 winning percentage, which ranks No. 8 among active coaches in the NCAA across all three divisions.
- Schertz was 337-69 (.830) in 13 seasons at Lincoln Memorial, 66-40 (.623) in three seasons at Indiana State, and is 15-12 (.556) in his first season at Saint Louis.

BLOCK PARTY

► **Max Pikaar** posted five blocked shots vs. William Woods, a SLU season-high.

► It was the most blocks by a SLU freshman since **Hasahn French** had six blocked shots his rookie year against La Salle.

► **Willie Reed** holds the freshman record for blocks in a game with seven against Dayton on 2/21/2009. The school record for blocks in a game is eight by **Kelvin Henderson** against Siena on 12/1/1979.

SHORT BENCH

► The Billikens have been short on personnel in recent games. SLU is at 10 scholarship players minimum as **AJ Casey** and **Josiah Dotzler** are out for the season with injuries. **Larry Hughes II** left the program.

► **Kellen Thames** has not played the last seven games.

► While SLU is second-to-last last in the NCAA in bench points per game (8.85), the bench as given SLU a lift in recent wins. In the win over URI, the bench provided 21 points, the most in an A-10 game this year. **Amari McCottry** provided the late-game heroics with rebounds, steals and assists to help the Billikens rally for the win against UMass.

► Guards **Gibson Jimerson** and **Isaiah Swope** rarely come out of games. They are No. 3 and No. 13, respectively, in the NCAA in percentage of minutes played according to KenPom. Jimerson has played in all 40 minutes in 11 games this season, including the two games after leaving the St. Joe's game with a sprained ankle.

BILLIKENS IN THE SHOW

► SLU currently has multiple former players on NBA rosters for the first time since the late 1960s.

► **Jordan Goodwin** (2017-21) was signed to a two-way contract by the Lakers in early February and has appeared in five games for them this season. He has appeared in more than 125 games across his four-year NBA career with the Wizards, Suns, Grizzlies and Lakers.

► **Yuri Collins** (2019-23) was signed to a 10-day contract by the Golden State Warriors and made his NBA debut on Sunday against Dallas. He played six minutes and scored his first NBA bucket.

► It is the first time since 1968-69 that the Billikens have had multiple former players on active NBA rosters. That year, **Bob Ferry** played in seven games for Baltimore; **Rich Nieman** played in 34 games for Detroit and Milwaukee; and **Barry Orms** played in 64 games for Baltimore.

► Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer Ed Macauley is the most decorated Billiken NBA player. He was a seven-time All-Star while scoring more than 11,000 points across 10 seasons in Boston and St. Louis. Macauley won the NBA title with the St. Louis Hawks in 1957-58, and he has his No. 22 retired by the Boston Celtics.

BASKETBALL BLOODLINES

► **Kellen Thames** is the son of **Kelly Thames**, who from 1993-98 started at the University of Missouri and scored more than 1,600 points for the Tigers.

► **Max Pikaar's** father, **Marco Pikaar**, played in 94 games over a four-year career at Dayton. He led the Flyers in blocked shots as a freshman in 1992-93.

► Walk-on **Nick Patton** is the son of **Peter Patton**, who played at DePaul from 1992-96. Patton is currently the Director of Player Development for the Chicago Bulls.

HOME SWEET CHAIFETZ

► Saint Louis is in its 17th season playing inside the 10,600-seat Chaifetz Arena.

► SLU is 216-79 all-time at Chaifetz Arena, including 12-3 this season.

► Chaifetz Arena is named after SLU alumnus **Dr. Richard A. Chaifetz**. Dr. Chaifetz is a world-renowned entrepreneur and business leader, who in 1984 founded ComPsych Corporation, which today is the world's largest provider of employee assistance programs, behavioral health and wellness services.

QUICK HISTORY LESSON

► The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Easy Ed's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

► The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.

► **Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) was the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) prior to Jimerson breaking the record this year. Bonner also has a school-record 1,424 rebounds.

► SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

► The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances, the last coming in 2019. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

JOSH SCHERTZ

Saint Louis University announced Josh Schertz as the head coach of the Billikens' men's basketball program on April 6, 2024.

Schertz comes to SLU after a three-year run at Indiana State. He led the Sycamores to a 32-7 record in 2023-24 and a magical run to the NIT championship game. Prior to his stint at ISU, Schertz spent 13 seasons at Lincoln Memorial, where he led the Railsplitters to 10 NCAA Division II national tournaments, including an appearance in the 2016 NCAA Division II national championship game. Schertz is 417-121 in 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach. His .776 career winning percentage ranks No. 8 among active head coaches across all three NCAA levels.

Schertz turned around the Indiana State program and led the Sycamores to their best season in several decades in 2023-24 as ISU captured its first Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title since 2000. Indiana State fell in the championship game of the 2024 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament and was selected as a No. 1 seed for the NIT after just missing out on an at-large bid to the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship.

Schertz was named the 2024 MVC Coach of the Year and was recently tabbed the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year, which is presented annually to the top mid-major head coach in college basketball. Five Sycamores earned All-Conference honors this season as Indiana State led the league and ranked among the top 10 in the country in scoring offense. ISU leads the nation in effective field goal percentage and was the league leader in assists per game (11th in the NCAA) and 3-point field goals made per game (fourth in the NCAA) as well.

Prior to his stint at Indiana State, Schertz guided one of the most successful NCAA Division II teams in the country, Lincoln Memorial University, for 13 seasons from 2008-21. The Railsplitters registered a remarkable 337-69 record during Schertz' tenure.

Schertz helped Lincoln Memorial (Harrogate, Tennessee) to 10 NCAA Tournaments. The Railsplitters went to the national semifinals three times (2016, 2017 and 2021) and were the national runner-up in 2016. Lincoln Memorial was 32-1 and poised for a national title run when the 2019-20 season was canceled due to the pandemic.

LMU earned 14 South Atlantic Conference championships during Schertz' tenure – nine regular-season crowns and five tournament titles.

Prior to becoming head coach at LMU, Schertz served as either an associate head coach or assistant coach at four different schools over a 10-year span – High Point University (2003-08), Queens University (2001-03), Lynn University (1999-2001) and Florida Atlantic University (GA, 1998-99).

Schertz is a 2000 graduate of Florida Atlantic. He also has a master's degree in education from Lynn. Schertz and his wife, Natalia, have two children, Jordan and Jaden.

Schertz on Swope

"The first thing that pops out to me with Isaiah is his toughness and courage. What he did for our team at Indiana State last year was one of the most selfless and remarkable displays of those traits I have ever witnessed. His quickness and shooting are at elite levels, and he is one of the best scorers in all of college basketball. On top of that, he is a savage competitor and a winner. We are incredibly lucky to have a player and person the caliber of Isaiah Swope in our program."
