SMSU vs. St. Cloud State Series Notes

Southwest Minnesota State and St. Cloud State meet for the 16th time on Saturday night with SCSU leading 14-1, including 5-1 in Marshall ... the first-ever meeting was on Oct. 3, 1970 in Marshall ... last season's game was the first meeting between the two schools since Sept. 8, 1984 ... SMSU's lone victory in the series was on Oct. 24, 1981, in Marshall, 13-6 ... that was also the last time SCSU played in Marshall ... the teams met 11 straight years from 1970-80 as members of the NIC ... the final three meetings (1981, 82, 84) were non-conference games.

The Last Time - SMSU vs. SCSU

St. Cloud State built an early 14-0 lead and went on to earn a 24-6 victory over SMSU on Oct. 16, 2010, in St. Cloud, Minn. The Huskies racked up 494 yards of offense, including 325 passing yards. Phillip Klaphake rushed for 134 yards and a touchdown, while completing 24 of 33 pass attempts for 320 yards and one touchdown to lead SCSU. SCSU also scored on a 78-yard fumble return for a touchdown by Josh Popanda. SMSU's lone score came late in the game on a Ryan Ratekin 80-yard pass to Gannon Moore. Moore finished the game with eight receptions for 150 yards and 21 yards rushing on 10 carries.

SETTING THE SCENE: Southwest Minnesota State University (2-4, 2-3 NSIC, 0-2 NSIC South) returns home to face No. 16 St. Cloud State University (5-1, 4-1 NSIC, 2-0 NSIC North) in a Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference match-up on Saturday night, Oct. 15, at the Regional Event Center. Kickoff is set for 6 p.m. The game will be SCSU's first in Marshall since Oct. 24, 1981.

SMSU, which snapped a three-game losing streak this past Saturday with a victory at MSU Moorhead, will be seeking its first win over St. Cloud State since Oct. 24, 1981, and just its second overall in 16 all-time games.

SCSU is coming off a 31-13 home victory over Minnesota State for its third straight win and moved up one spot to No. 16 in the latest AFCA Top 25 poll.

A VICTORY ON SATURDAY FOR SMSU WOULD...

- be just its second all-time vs. St. Cloud State in 16 games.
- be its first over SCSU since Oct. 24, 1981.
- be its first against one of the four teams that joined the NSIC in 2008 after leaving the NCC.
- lift the program's all-time record to 165-276-5.

LOOKING FOR A WIN VERSUS THE NEWCOMERS: Southwest Minnesota State is 0-10 versus the four schools, Augustana, Minnesota State, Minnesota Duluth and St. Cloud State, that moved from the North Central Conference to the Northern Sun Conference prior to the 2008 season. SMSU has beaten three of the four schools in the past, but not since the four joined the NSIC in 2008.

ON THIS DATE: Southwest Minnesota State is 0-5 all-time when playing on Oct. 15. The following are the scores of the previous five games: 1977: L, 49-7, Minnesota Duluth; 1983: L, 14-10, Winona State; 1988: L, 37-23 vs. Northern State; 1994: L, 31-6 vs. Wayne State; 2005: L, 38-13 vs. Wayne State.

THE COACHES: Southwest Minnesota State head coach **Cory Sauter** is in his second season and has an overall record of 6-11, including 5-10 in conference games. Sauter is 0-1 all-time versus St. Cloud State. Sauter was named head coach on March 29, 2010, after serving two seasons as an assistant coach at SMSU. In 2009, Sauter served as the team's offensive coordinator, while in 2008 he served as quarterbacks coach. A complete bio on coach Sauter can be found on page 21.

Scott Underwood is in his fourth season as head coach at St. Cloud State with a record of 29-12. Prior to taking over as head coach, Underwood, who led SCSU to the NCAA playoffs in 2010, served as an assistant coach at SCSU, the University of North Dakota, University of Sioux Falls and Augustana.

MUSTANGS SET SCHOOL RECORD: Southwest Minnesota State broke a 38-year-old team record with 397 yards rushing on 58 attempts in last week's 45-13 victory at MSU Moorhead. Warren Matthews set the record with a 38-yard rush midway through the fourth quarter. The previous record was 358 yards versus Dakota Wesleyan on Sept. 22, 1973.

MOORE NAMED NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: SMSU junior running back **Gannon Moore** was named the NSIC Offensive Player of the Week on Monday for his performance in SMSU's victory over MSU Moorhead on Saturday. Moore rushed for a career-high 159 yards and two touchdowns on 20 carries during SMSU's 45-13 victory over MSU Moorhead. He averaged 7.9 yards per carry, also caught two passes for 28 yards. Moore scored on touchdown runs of 45 and 12 yards and now has 21 rushing touchdowns in his career, tying for third all-time in school history.

LAST WEEK IN REVIEW: Southwest Minnesota State jumped to a 24-0 halftime lead and never looked back in earning a 45-13 victory over MSU Moorhead last Saturday in Moorhead, Minn. SMSU set a school record with 397 yards rushing and finished the game with 555 total yards of offense. **Warren Matthews** and **Gannon Moore** both rushed for career-highs with 172 and 159, respectively. The Mustang defense limited MSU to just 99 yards of offense through the first three quarters, including running just three plays on the SMSU side of the 50-yard line. **Mark Schollmeyer** led the SMSU defense with eight tackles and two sacks.

BACK-TO-BACK 400-YARD GAMES...AGAIN!: In week one and two and again in week five and six, SMSU has recorded over 400 yards of total offense in back-to-back games. Prior to this season, the last time SMSU had back-to-back 400-plus yard games, occurred on Oct. 11 and Oct. 18, 2008.

TWO 100-YARD RUSHING GAMES: **Warren Matthews** and **Gannon Moore** both rushed for over 100 yards in the victory over MSU Moorhead last Saturday. It was the first time the duo both rushed for over 100 yards in a single-game since Oct. 9, 2010, also versus MSU Moorhead.

MATTHEWS MOVES INTO 10TH ON RUSHING LIST: Junior running back **Warren Matthews** has now rushed for 1,223 career yards on 214 carries and has moved into 10th place on the school's all-time rushing list. He needs 68 yards to move into a tie for ninth all-time with Brent Miller (1996-97) at 1,291.

MUSTANG QUICK-HITTERS: Junior **Warren Matthews** had his fourth career 100-yard rushing game with a career-high 172 yards vs. MSU Moorhead ... The 172 yards rushing by Matthews vs. MSU Moorhead was the 16th highest total in school history ... Junior **Gannon Moore** finished with a career-high 159 yards rushing (his second career 100-yard rushing game) vs. MSU Moorhead ... Redshirt freshman **Jarred Carlson** caught his first career touchdown vs. MSU Moorhead ... Junior **Wes Anderson** made his first career start at cornerback vs. MSU Moorhead ... Sophomore **Mike Wenk** connected on a career-long 42-yard field goal vs. MSU Moorhead and is now 6 of 7 this season ... Wenk also booted a career-long 66-yard punt vs. Augustana ... **Tyler Pechong's** 70-yard touchdown pass to **Adam Olson** vs. Wayne State is the longest play from scrimmage for SMSU this season ... sophomore **Cody Condon** finished with a career-high five receptions vs. Wayne State ... Senior **John Kersbergen** recorded a career-high 13 tackles vs. Wayne State ... Sophomore **Britt Wickett** tied a career-high with seven catches for a career-high 91 yards vs. Augustana ... redshirt freshman defensive lineman **Jacob Levtzow** recorded his first career sack vs. Augustana and made his first career start vs. Wayne State ... senior safety **Levi Reiff** recorded a career-high 13 tackles vs. Bemidji State, while senior linebacker **Phil Bredidall** (12) and junior defensive end **Mark Schollmeyer** (12) also both recorded career-highs in tackles ... SMSU's 31 first downs vs. Mary was the team's highest total since earning 30 vs. Minnesota-Morris in 2002 ... **Tyler Pechong** passed for a career-high 334 yards and a career-high three touchdowns in the victory over Mary ... **Anthony Dean** had his first career 100-yard receiving game vs. Mary ... Senior defensive lineman **Randy Erickson** has started 22 consecutive games since week seven of the 2009 season ... Senior offensive tackle **Brian Rodas** has started 19 consecutive games since week 10 of the 2009 season ... Senior safety **Levi Reiff** has made 28 straight starts since the 2009 season ... Junior safety **Joe Stupka** has started all 28 games in his career.

NSIC WEEKLY STATISTICS (PAGES 18-19): In this week's NSIC statistics (conference games only), the SMSU offense ranks fourth in passing, sixth in scoring, sixth in total yards and 10th in rushing. The SMSU defense ranks 10th in passing, 12th in rushing, 12th in scoring and 13th in total yards.

Individually, **Tyler Pechong** ranks first in total offense and second in passing, **Warren Matthews** ranks fourth in all-purpose yardage and 10th in rushing, **Mike Wenk** ranks second in punting, while **Tyler Erickson** ranks 10th in receptions.

NCAA WEEKLY STATISTICS (PAGE 20): In this week's NCAA national statistics (Oct. 10), out of 152 teams, SMSU ranks 10th in net punting, 48th in total offense, 55th in kickoff returns, 58th in passing offense, 59th in scoring offense, 127th in scoring defense and 122nd in total defense.

Individually, **Tyler Pechong** ranks 24th in total offense, **Warren Matthews** ranks 18th in all-purpose yardage, **Mike Wenk** ranks tied for 32nd in field goals per game and **John Kersbergen** ranks tied for 50th in tackles per game.

WELCOME TO THE 300-100-100 CLUB: SMSU's week two victory over the University of Mary featured something that hasn't happened 15 years. **Tyler Pechong** (334, pass), **Warren Matthews** (101, rush) and **Anthony Dean** (102, rec.) are the first SMSU players since Nov. 17, 1996, to record over 300 yards passing, 100 yards rushing and 100 yards receiving in a single-game. It was also the first time SMSU had both a 100-yard rusher and 100-yard receiver in a single-game since Sept. 4, 2004.

BLOCK PARTY: Southwest Minnesota State has blocked two punts this season. Redshirt freshman **Tyler Tonderum** blocked a Northern State in week one setting up a Mustang touchdown drive, while junior **Dan Timm** partially blocked a Bemidji State punt in week three.

CONNECTING FOR 3: Sophomore **Mike Wenk's** 24-yard field in the opener versus Northern State not only was his first field goal made his career, but it was also SMSU's first made field goal since Nov. 7, 2009. Wenk has continued his strong season, connecting on 6-of-7 field goal attempts, including drilling

SPECIAL TEAMS TACKLE LEADERS: True freshman **Adam Olson**, senior **Phil Bredidall** and sophomore **Tate Bunkers** are tied for the team lead with five special team tackles.

MOORE IN THE RECORD BOOK: Junior running back **Gannon Moore** has rushed for three touchdowns this season and now has 21 in his career, which ranks tied for third in school history. Moore rushed for 13 touchdowns in 2009 tying **Robert Lipsey** (1990) for the school single-season record.

MORE ON MOORE: Junior running back **Gannon Moore** also ranks tied for eighth in program history with 24 career touchdowns (21 rush, 3 rev.) and is 10th all-time in points scored (132).

GET IN THE "ZONE": Southwest Minnesota State has scored on 19 of its 23 possessions inside the "red zone" this season with 15 touchdowns and four field goals.

HOLDING ONTO THE BALL: Winning the turnover margin each week is a major key to winning games at any level of football. Turnover margin has been a major issue for SMSU in the past seven-plus seasons. Since the start of the 2004 season (83 games), SMSU has been a "plus" in turnover margin in just 17 games (three in 2004, two in 2005, one in 2006, two in 2007, three in 2008, three in 2009, twice in 2010 and once in 2011).

In SMSU's last 61 conference games, which spans from late in the 2004 season through this season, SMSU is minus-46 in turnover margin. The Mustangs have been "even" or "minus" in turnover margin in 48 of their last 61 conference games.

BIG PLAY MUSTANGS: SMSU has recorded 42 offensive/defensive plays or kick/punt returns of 20 or more yards in 2011, including 26 by the Mustang offense (16 pass, 10 run). For a complete look at the "long" plays and SMSU's "money" plays for the season, go to pages 13-14.

PESCHONG EARNS NSIC HONOR ON SEPT. 12: Junior quarterback **Tyler Peschong** was named NSIC Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 12 for his performance versus the University of Mary. Peschong accounted for five touchdowns, completing 29 of 35 passes for a career-high 334 yards and three touchdowns, while also rushing for 89 yards and two more touchdowns in SMSU's 48-45 victory over the University of Mary. It was his first career 300-yard passing game.

ON THE ROAD: Southwest Minnesota State has six road games this season, its most since the 1994 season. SMSU, which is 1-3 on the road in 2011, finished 2-3 in road games last season and is 18-38 in road games since 2000.

THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS: The season opening game featured 19 Mustang players appearing in their first career games in SMSU uniforms. Wide receivers **Jordan Cross** and **Adam Olson**, along with defensive lineman **Nathan Werner** are the only true freshman to see action this season.

2011 season. The team captains were selected by a vote of the Mustang players. The offensive team captains selected were junior quarterback **Tyler Peschong** from Marshalltown, Iowa, and junior running back **Warren Matthews** from Minneapolis. The defensive team captains named were senior safety **Levi Reiff** from Dell Rapids, S.D., senior linebacker **John Kersbergen** from Marshalltown, Iowa and senior linebacker **Derek Klinkner** from Artesian, S.D. It's the second straight season Reiff has been named team captain.

NSIC PRESEASON POLL: Southwest Minnesota State was picked to finish sixth in the NSIC South Division and 11th overall in the annual NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll. SMSU received 58 points in the overall poll and 11 points in the division poll. Augustana (33 points) was picked to win the South Division, while Minnesota Duluth (167 points) was picked to win the North Division and overall championship.

ALL-NSIC RETURNERS: SMSU returns four players this fall who earned All-NSIC South Division honors in 2010. Sophomore punter **Mike Wenk** was named second team All-NSIC South, while senior offensive lineman **Brian Rodas**, senior linebacker **John Kersbergen** and senior safety **Levi Reiff** were all named to the honorable mention All-NSIC South.

THREE-YEAR STRETCH: SMSU amassed 15 combined victories in the past three seasons (2008-10), ranking as the best three-year stretch since the 1991-93 teams won 19 combined games.

WORKING OVERTIME: SMSU has played in eight overtime games in school history, including one last season, since the NCAA added the extra session in 1998. SMSU is 3-5 all-time in overtime games including 1-2 in multi-overtime games. SMSU's last overtime contest was an overtime win at Upper Iowa (40-34) on Oct. 23, 2010.

REGIONAL EVENT CENTER: The 2011 season marks the fourth season for SMSU football at Matkce Field at the Regional Event Center. The \$16 million facility was opened in the fall of 2008 with the first college football game played on Aug. 30, 2008. SMSU is 9-11 all-time at the REC, including 1-1 this season.

SOME MUSTANG HISTORY: 2011 marks the 44th season of college football at Southwest Minnesota State dating back to 1968. SMSU owns an all-time record of 164-276-5, including 102-183-5 in conference play. SMSU has recorded eight winning seasons and has made two NAIA playoff appearances (1987 and 1991). The program earned its lone conference championship in 1990.

MUSTANGS IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: SMSU has posted a 12-15 record in its last 27 non-conference games since the 2000 season.

FOR OPENERS: Southwest Minnesota State is now 20-24 all-time in season openers following this season's loss to Northern State, but has won eight of its last 10 lid-lifters. SMSU is also now 24-20 all-time in home openers after this season's victory over the University of Mary.

ALL-TIME RECORD ON HOMECOMING: SMSU is now 19-24 all-time in homecoming games including losing four straight and 10 of the last 11 games following this season's 37-24 loss to Augustana.

THE 2011 SMSU ROSTER: The Southwest Minnesota State football roster has a total of 106 players (as of Oct. 10) and features 10 seniors, 23 juniors, 17 sophomores, 16 redshirt freshmen and 40 true freshmen.

THE CORY SAUTER SHOW: *The Cory Sauter Show* airs weekly on Marshall's local cable access channel Studio 1. The show is scheduled to air Monday night at 10 p.m., Tuesday at 9:30 p.m., Wednesday at 10 p.m., Thursday at 9 p.m. and Friday at 10 p.m. The show can also be viewed at www.SMSUmustangs.com.

MUSTANGS ON RADIO: All SMSU football games during the 2011 season will be broadcast on KARL 105.1 FM with Aaron Ziemer handling the play-by-play for the ninth straight season.

ABOUT ST. CLOUD STATE: The Huskies, 5-1 overall, 4-1 NSIC, are coming off a 31-13 home victory over Minnesota State last Saturday. Dante Steward led the Huskies with 141 yards rushing and two touchdowns. Brad Meade started at quarterback for an injured Phillip Klaphake, and completed 7 of 12 passes for 77 yards and one touchdown.

Offensively, St. Cloud State is led by quarterback Phillip Klaphake (189.4 passing ypg, 6TD, 6INT, 153 yards rushing, 6TD), receiver Damon Treat (18 receptions, 193 yards, 3TD) and running back Dante Steward (421 yards, 70.2 rushing ypg, 3TD). SCSU's tackles leaders are Marvin Matthews (34, 2INT), Mark Martin (34, 4TFL) and Jack Moro (32, 1TFL).

St. Cloud State ranks 44th in the country in total offense, 42nd in total defense, 48th in scoring offense and 12th in scoring defense. The Huskies are averaging 31 points and 404.2 yards per game and are allowing 16 points and 320.5 yards per game.

Cory Sauter is in his second season as head coach at Southwest Minnesota State in 2011 and his fourth overall on the Mustang coaching staff.

Sauter was named the 10th head coach in program history on March 29, 2010, after serving a month as interim head coach. He brings six years of professional football playing experience in the National Football League and both collegiate and professional football coaching experience to the Mustang program.

During Sauter's first season as head coach, the Mustangs started the season 2-0 and were 4-4 after eight weeks, before suffering several injuries to key positions and finishing 4-7 overall. Seven Mustang players earned all-conference honors, including quarterback Ryan Ratekin, who became the first SMSU offensive player to earn first team All-NSIC honors since 2006.

Prior to becoming head coach, Sauter spent two seasons (2008-09) helping lead a high-powered Mustang offensive attack as quarterbacks coach and offensive coordinator.

During the 2009 season as offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator, SMSU averaged 36 points per game, the third highest in school history, and also scored 30 or more points in eight games tying a school single-season record.

SMSU quarterback Ryan Ratekin was named NSIC Offensive Newcomer of the Year in 2009, setting a school record with a 63.9 percent completion percentage, while passing for 2,963 yards and 33 touchdowns, the third highest in school history.

SMSU senior quarterback Josh Shudlick had a record breaking season during Sauter's first season on the sideline in 2008 setting a conference record for passing yards and tying the league record for touchdown passes in one season. The Mustang offense lead the NSIC in passing yards, while Shudlick finished first in the conference in passing yards per game and total offense.

Prior to SMSU, Sauter, a native of Hutchinson, Minn., spent several years coaching at both the collegiate and professional levels. In 2006 he served as quarterbacks/receivers coach for the Hamburg Sea Devils in NFL Europe and was also a graduate assistant at the University of Minnesota. In 2007 he was quarterbacks coach for the Berlin Thunder.

A 1997 graduate of the University of Minnesota, Sauter had a record-setting career at quarterback for the Golden Gophers and spent six seasons in the NFL from 1998-2004. He played four seasons for the University of Minnesota (1994-97), including starting the final 34 games of his collegiate career and playing in the Blue-Gray All-Star Football Classic following his senior season. He finished his career as the school's all-time career record holder for pass completions, pass attempts and passing yards. Sauter earned his master's degree from the University of Minnesota in 2003.

Following his collegiate career Sauter spent six seasons in the NFL from 1998-2004. He signed as a free agent with the Arizona Cardinals in 1998 before spending time with the Detroit Lions, Chicago Bears and Indianapolis Colts. He appeared in one regular season game in his career completing 6 of 9 passes for 59 yards in a 2002 game with the Chicago Bears. He also played one season for the Barcelona Dragons in NFL Europe.

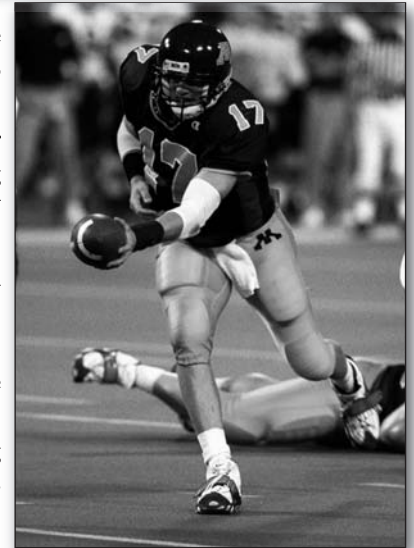

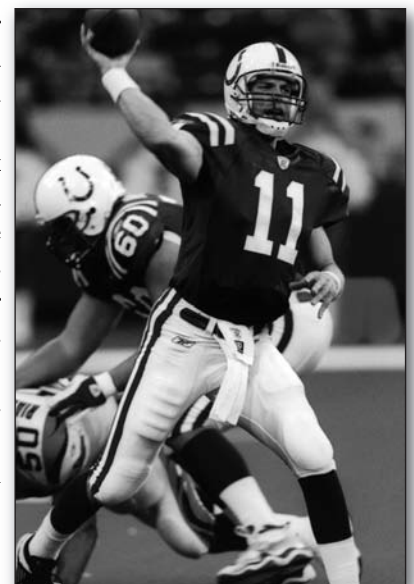
