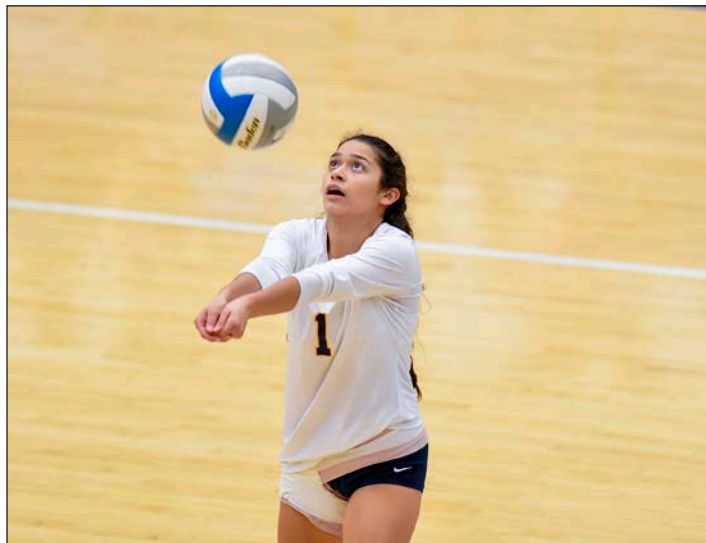

**UCO TO NATIONAL TOURNEY:** Central Oklahoma will make its sixth appearance in the NCAA Division II Volleyball Championships this week when the No. 15-ranked Bronchos head to Marshall, Minn. for the loaded Central Regional.

UCO, 29-5 on the season, earned the No. 7 seed for the regional and will take on third-ranked, No. 2 seed and defending national champion Concordia-St. Paul (28-3) at 12 p.m. Thursday.

Other first-round matches at the PE Gym on the campus of tournament host Southwest Minnesota have third-seeded Nebraska-Kearney (33-3) playing No. 6 seed Missouri Western (24-10) at 2:30 p.m., fourth-seeded Northern State (23-6) meeting No. 5 seed Minnesota-Duluth (24-6) at 5 p.m. and the top-seeded Mustangs (28-3) going against No. 8 seed Arkansas Tech (35-0) at 7:30 p.m.

Semifinal matches Friday will have the UNK/MWSU-UCO/CUSP winners playing at 5 p.m. and the NSU/UMD-SMSU-ATU winners meeting at 7:30.

The semifinal winners play for the regional title at 3 p.m. Saturday.

Seven of the eight teams are ranked in the top 15 by the American Volleyball Coaches Association – Southwest Minnesota (second), Concordia-St. Paul (third), Nebraska-Kearney (sixth), Minnesota-Duluth (seventh), Arkansas Tech (eighth), Northern State (11th) and UCO (15th).

**ABOUT THE NATIONAL TOURNEY:** Sixty-four teams earned bids into the single-elimination national tournament, with eight eight-team regionals to be held around the country this weekend.

The regional champions advance to Pensacola, Fla. Dec. 7-9 for the final three rounds, which will be hosted by the University of West Florida. Concordia-St. Paul beat Alaska-Anchorage in last year's finals.

**UCO IN NATIONAL MEET:** The Bronchos are 3-5 in five previous national tournament appearances, including 0-1 against first-round opponent Concordia-St. Paul.

UCO first qualified in 1994, beating West Texas A&M in the first round before losing to Central Missouri in the finals of the South Central Regional.

The Bronchos lost to Nebraska-Kearney in the first round of the Southwest Regional in 2002 and fell to Abilene Christian in the opening round of the 2005 Southwest Regional.

UCO swept Fort Lewis in the first round of the 2007 Southwest Regional before losing to UNK in four sets in the semifinals.

The Bronchos made their first Central Regional appearance in 2015, sweeping UNK in the opening round and losing to Concordia-St. Paul in the semifinals.

**UCO VS. REGIONAL FIELD:** UCO has played Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association rivals Nebraska-Kearney and Missouri Western a combined four times this season.

The Bronchos split two regular season meetings with the Lopers and lost twice to the Griffons, falling in five sets in the regular season and in the MIAA Tournament semifinals.

**SERIES RECORDS:** The Broncos have met five of the seven other teams in the Central Regional during their history.

UCO owns series leads of 10-5 over Missouri Western, 4-2 over Arkansas Tech and 1-0 over Southwest Minnesota while trailing first-round opponent Concordia-St. Paul 1-0 and Nebraska-Kearney 13-4. The Broncos have never played Minnesota-Duluth or Northern State.

**OFFENSIVE ATTACK:** Central features a potent offense and leads the MIAA with a .246 attack percentage that ranks 24th in NCAA Division II. The Broncos average 13.81 kills per set, which is 32nd-best nationally.

UCO has hit .275 or better in 10 matches, with a high of .434 coming in a road sweep of Missouri Southern.

Seven players have at least 113 kills on the season, including four with at least 150.

Junior Taylor Bevis leads the way with 514 kills, which ranks seventh nationally. Junior Jordan Spence has added 278 kills, senior Alexis Washington 177 and freshman Karyn Chrisman 157.

**LOCAL FLAVOR:** Six of the 15 players on UCO's roster are hometown products of Edmond high schools.

Junior Jordan Spence and freshman Ericka Scholl both went to Edmond Santa Fe, freshmen Callie Bangasser and Jordan Cramer attended Edmond North, freshman Malia Kaaiohelo went to Edmond Memorial and freshman Kadie Dewey is from Oklahoma Christian School.

**UCO ON THE ROAD:** The Broncos have played 19 of their 34 matches on the road this season, six at neutral sites and 13 in true road matches.

Central enters the Central Regional 5-1 in neutral-site matches, with the lone loss coming to Missouri Western in the MIAA Tournament semifinals in Kearney, Neb. on Nov. 17.

The Broncos are 10-3 in away matches, with the losses coming to national tournament participants Nebraska-Kearney and Tarleton State along with Central Missouri.

**ALL-MIAA TEAM:** Central Oklahoma had six players earn All-MIAA honors, highlighted by the selection of junior Taylor Bevis as Player of the Year.

Bevis was joined on the first-team unit by junior Jordan Spence. Junior McKenzie Fyfe and sophomore Dominique Lipari were second-team selections, while freshman Malia Kaaiohelo and senior Alexis Washington earned honorable mention recognition.

## TAYLOR BEVIS

**5-II • JUNIOR • OUTSIDE HITTER • WICHITA, KANSAS**

Returning All-American who ranks among the elite players in NCAA Division II . . . Is enjoying a sensational season and was named MIAA Player of the Year in addition to earning first-team All-MIAA honors for the third consecutive time . . . Enters the regional with 514 kills, ranking fourth nationally in kills per set (5.04) and seventh in total kills . . . Is also fourth in Division II in both total attacks (1,468) and attacks per set (14.39) while ranking fifth in points per set (5.45) . . . Has had double-digit kills in 26 of 32 matches played this fall with eight of 20-plus, capped by career-high 30 in five-set road win over Washburn . . . Averages 16.1 kills per match . . . Ranks eighth on UCO's single-season list for kills, needing just 15 more to move up to sixth . . . Is hitting a solid .216 and has hit .300 or better 11 times . . . Is second on the team in digs with 335 (3.28/set) in addition to having 49 total blocks and 14 service aces . . . Has had 17 matches with 10-plus digs, including career-best 22 against Missouri Western in the MIAA Tournament semifinals . . . Two-time MIAA Hitter of the Week winner this season . . . Was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District 7 team . . . MIAA Freshman of the Year and first-team All-MIAA pick in 2015 after collecting 396 kills, 110 digs and 58 blocks . . . Collected 415 kills, 326 digs and 54 blocks last year as a repeat first-team All-MIAA selection and third-team AVCA All-American choice . . . Has 1,325 career kills.

## JORDAN SPENCE

**6-0 • JUNIOR • MIDDLE BLOCKER • EDMOND, OKLAHOMA**

Junior standout and dominating force at the net for the Bronchos at middle blocker . . . First-team All-MIAA selection who enters the Central Regional second on the team in kills with 278 (2.53/set) and a .352 attack percentage that ranks second in the league and 34th in NCAA Division II . . . Has hit .400 or better 14 times . . . Has committed no errors while making at least 10 attacks in nine matches . . . Has had double-digit kills in seven matches, including a streak of four straight entering the regional . . . Has hit .392 with 53 kills and just six errors in 120 attacks in that four-match span . . . Hit .562 with season-high 18 kills and no errors in 32 attacks in four-set home win over Washburn . . . Named MIAA Hitter of the Week once this season . . . Also has 109 total blocks, ranking tied for seventh in the MIAA with 0.99 per set . . . Has had five matches with at least five blocks, including a season-high 10 in win over Henderson State . . . First-team All-MIAA as a freshman in 2015 after hitting .329 with 281 kills and 124 total blocks . . . Second-team All-MIAA selection last year, finishing with 210 kills and 108 blocks . . . Has a .332 career attack percentage with 769 kills and 162 errors in 1,830 attempts . . . Also has 341 career total blocks.

Junior setter who has shined in her first year of leading UCO's potent offensive attack . . . Is the only player on the team to have seen action in all 113 sets this season . . . Second-team All-MIAA selection who is fourth in the league in assists per set (10.27), with ranks 56th nationally . . . Has 1,160 assists for the year, averaging 34.1 per match . . . Has had nine matches with 40-plus assists, capped by 60-assist outings in five-set road win over Washburn and five-set loss to Missouri Western in the MIAA Tournament semifinals . . . Also has a pair of 56-assist matches to her credit . . . Ranks third on the team in digs with 307, averaging 2.72 per set . . . Has had 15 matches with double-digit

digs, including a season-high 17 in win over Henderson State . . . Is hitting .303 with 40 kills and just seven errors in 109 attacks . . . Sat out redshirt year last season after transferring to UCO following two years at Division I Wichita State . . . Lettered in back-up role both years with the Shockers.

Is averaging 16.7 digs a match and ranks fifth in the league in digs per set (5.05) . . . Has had 10-plus digs 29 times this season, including seven with at least 20 . . . Collected career-high 36 in five-set home loss to Missouri Western . . . Had 25 digs in just three sets during road sweep of Fort Hays State . . . Also has 17 service aces and 50 assists . . . Versatile veteran, team leader and UCO's lone senior . . . Honorable mention All-MIAA selection who is third on the team in kills (177) and second in total blocks (101) . . . Ranks seventh in the league in hitting percentage (.281) and tied for seventh with teammate Jordan Spence in blocks (0.99/set) . . . Has had 19 matches with five-plus kills, including a pair of double-digit outings . . . Knocked down career-high 14 kills while hitting .345 in win over Washburn and hit .417 with 11 kills in win over Southeastern Oklahoma . . . Has hit .300 or better 15 times this season . . . Has had five matches with no errors and at least 10 attacks, including dominating performance in first-round MIAA Tourna-

ment win over Lindenwood when hit .700 with seven kills and no errors in 10 attempts . . . Has made five-plus blocks in 10 matches . . .
