#### SMU NOTES

SMU Starting Five: Ben Moore (00), Shake Milton (1), Sterling Brown (3), Jarrey Foster (10), Semi Ojeleye (33)

Head Coach Tim Jankovich:

- 174-124 as NCAA head coach
- SMU is 17-3 under Tim Jankovich as head coach

SMU is 60-15 overall since the 2014-15 season

- The Mustangs are 27-6 in non-conference games during that span

21st straight non-conference home win (Streak started Nov. 26, 2014, against Texas Southern (W, 72-59))

- Third longest streak in program history (39, From Dec. 17, 1952 - Dec. 4, 1962; 30, Dec. 17, 1982 - Dec. 30, 1986.
- Last non-conference home loss was Nov. 25, 2014 ([25/rv] Arkansas, 78-72)

11th straight home win

- First 7 in 2016-17, last 4 of 2015-16

SMU is 3-0 all-time against McNeese (2-0 officially)

#### OFFENSIVE NOTES

Last time SMU scored 92 was at USF (2/7/2016; W, 92-58)

SMU had five score in double figures (Milton, 17; Ojelete, 16; Foster, 14; Moore, 14; Brown, 10)

- 2nd time with 5 scoring in double figures this season, 8th games this season with 4+

SMU outshot McNeese, 50.0 – 30.6%

- SMU has outshot 8-of-11 opponents this season

SMU had 40 points in the paint, compared to McNeese's, 14

- 10-of-11 games this season with more points in the paint

Registered 12 3FG Made; **Season high**

SMU held McNeese to 30.6 shooting.
