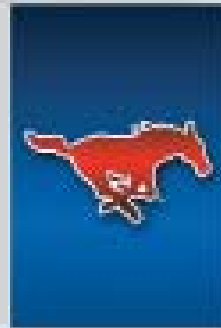

STORYLINES

SMU BEGINS SEASON AT HOME IN DOUBLETREE CLASSIC

The Mustangs begin the 2016 season at home in the DoubleTree Classic Friday and Saturday. SMU plays two matches Friday, taking on Montana at 12:30 p.m. before facing UTSA at 7 p.m. The Mustangs conclude the opening weekend tournament against Arkansas-Little Rock Saturday at 2 p.m.

The 2015 American Athletic Conference champions will celebrate the program's first championship with a banner reveal prior to Friday night's match, and hold a championship ring ceremony after Saturday's match.

SMU set a program record with 27 wins last season, losing just six matches, and posted a 17-3 record in conference play. The Mustangs hit .245, an SMU single-season record, and Avery Acker led the NCAA with 12.45 assists per set, setting a program-record with 1,482 assists last season, earning conference Player and Setter of the Year honors. SMU also lost all-conference award winners Cailin Bula and Abbey Bybel, but returns two-time defending Libero of the Year, Morgan Heise, who set a league and program record with 721 digs. Janelle Giordano was named to the all-region and all-conference teams after scoring 188 blocks, a single-season league and school record.

Montana went 8-20 last season, and lost four of its top five attackers. Silerolia Gaogao is a sophomore this season, and was third on last year's squad with 168 kills. Setter Raegan Lindsey had 840 assists in 2015, and libero Sadie Ahern had 410 digs. Both are seniors in 2016. SMU is 2-0 against Montana, winning 3-0 at home in 2008 and 3-2 on the road in 2009.

UTSA went 24-9 last season, finishing second in Conference USA, and returns four of its top five attackers, including senior Dajana Boskovic, who scored 430 kills last season. Setters Amanda Gonzales and Jessica Waldrup, who combined for 1,219 assists last year, are also among players returning. SMU is 7-3 all-time against the Roadrunners, including a 4-0 record in Moody Coliseum. SMU earned a 3-1 victory on Sept. 19 last season to claim the SMU DoubleTree Classic championship.

Little Rock went 14-14 last season, but lost just two of 10 letterwinners. The Trojans have four seniors on the 2016 roster who played in all 28 matches last year, including Edina Selimovic, who led the team with 320 kills. SMU is 2-0 all-time against the Trojans, winning five-set matches on neutral courts in 1997 and 2012.

**HEAD COACH
WINONA STATE, '83
20TH SEASON**

Lisa Seifert is the first and only volleyball coach in SMU history, in her 21st season (2016) with the Mustangs. Under her tutelage, the Mustangs have moved into the national spotlight with team and individual regional and national rankings. She has coached players to All-Conference honors 50 times and 10 All-America awards. Mustang athletes have not only excelled on the court under Seifert, but also in the classroom, where 80 student-athletes have been awarded Academic All-Conference honors.

She led the Mustangs to the American Athletic Conference championship in 2015 with a 17-3 mark and a program-record 27 wins overall with six losses. Avery Acker was named conference Player and Setter of the Year, as the Mustangs set a school record, hitting .245 as a team. Three players earned All-America status, with five being named to the all-conference team. Seifert won her second conference Coach of the Year honor, and was named region Coach of the Year.

Building a program from the ground up is an arduous process, but Seifert has put in the foundation for the Mustangs more recent successes. As the veritable architect of the SMU Volleyball program, coach Seifert has overseen the Mustangs rise from the beginning struggles to a team that is capable of competing with any team in the nation.

In 2005, SMU saw a transition into another conference. As the Mustangs joined Conference USA, they depended on the combination of a consistent returning class and strong newcomers to guide them through the season. The Mustangs went 13-16 overall and 8-7 in their inaugural season of C-USA. The team notched the nation's 23rd-highest number of digs per game while freshman Natalie Peters posted the 34th best number of blocks per game in the nation.

In 2006, the Seifert-led Mustangs compiled an overall record of 17-15. SMU hosted its first nationally-televised match and the first volleyball action televised from Moody Coliseum on Nov. 10, when the Mustangs hosted Houston. With a win over UTA on Sept. 1, the Mustangs and Seifert recorded the program's 150th win. Junior outside hitter Rachel Giubilato led the Mustangs and was ranked nationally in kills per game.

The 2007 season saw the best start in program history, with the Mustangs winning its first six matches, including SMU's first win over Texas Tech. The Ponies were 10-3 heading into the championship match at the New Hampshire Invitational, when outside hitter and team captain Giubilato went down with a career-ending knee injury. The Mustangs were forced to rely heavily on All-Freshman outside hitter Kathryn Wilkerson and senior co-captain Caitlin Rainbird, finishing with a 16-15 overall record.

The 2009 season saw a Seifert-led squad produce a 19-12 record behind the program's first All-American Honorable Mentions in sophomore Dana Powell and senior Kendra Kahanek. As a whole, the Mustangs' defense set a SMU single-season record with 317.5 blocks in just 121 games, while holding its opponents to 223.5 team blocks. The Mustangs were particularly tough at home winning 12 of 14 games in Moody Coliseum.

Seifert led the Mustangs to 25 wins in 2010, a school record at the time, with Powell repeating as an All-America Honorable Mention and highlighting a cast of five all-conference selections. Caroline Young became the program's third All-American in 2012, and in 2013, Avery Acker was an All-America Honorable Mention and earned Setter of the Year honors during the inaugural season of the American Athletic Conference. SMU finished 22-9 in 2013, winning at least 20 matches for the third time in program history.

The Mustangs won 26 matches in 2014, breaking the record of 25 set in 2010, and won a program-record 11 consecutive matches. SMU earned its first victory over an AVCA Top 25 team, beating then-No. 24 Oklahoma. Morgan Heise was named Libero of the Year, and Acker became the program's first Academic All-American. She was also an All-American Honorable Mention award winner for the second straight season.

Seifert joined SMU after six years as assistant coach at Texas Tech. The Lady Raiders compiled an overall record of 128-62 during Seifert's tenure, with NCAA tournament appearances from 1990-92 and regional semifinal berths in 1990 and 1991. A 1978 graduate of Saint Francis (Minn.) High School, Seifert held volleyball, softball, track and basketball coaching jobs at several different colleges and high schools in Colorado, Wisconsin and Minnesota from 1982-86.

Seifert earned her B.S. in physical education in 1983 from Winona State (Minn.) University, where she played volleyball and softball, and added a master's degree in P.E. from Wisconsin-LaCrosse in 1987.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Seniors Morgan Heise and Kristen Stehling were selected as 2016 team captains by their teammates. For Heise, this is the second year as a team captain.

"These two seniors have the traits necessary to guide our team through the highs and lows that can happen during a season," Seifert explained. "We have one of the largest freshmen classes we've ever had, and our captains have been very influential, providing guidance during summer and fall camp. I am confident this leadership will continue, and aid in our success during the season."

NATIONAL LEADERS

Morgan Heise and Janelle Giordano are both among the active career leaders in digs and blocks, respectively. Heise is second in the NCAA among active liberos with 1,753 digs after setting a conference and SMU record with 721 digs as a junior, finishing second in the NCAA last year behind North Dakota's McKenzie Hart, who recorded 787 digs. Heise was third in the NCAA last season, setting an SMU and conference record with 6.06 digs per set. In her career, she is second among 2015 juniors with a 4.97 average, trailing only Georgia Southern's Alex Beecher who records 5.02 digs per set.

Janelle Giordano was third in the NCAA with 188 total blocks last season, an SMU and conference record, and fifth in blocks per set, averaging 1.58, also a school and league record. In her career, Giordano has 461 total blocks, third among 2015 juniors.

COACH OF THE YEAR

Lisa Seifert was named AVCA Region Coach of the Year and American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Mustangs to a 27-6 record, a 17-3 mark in The American, the program's first conference championship and an NCAA appearance. She guided five players to all-conference honors, including Player and Setter of the Year, Avery Acker, and back-to-back Libero of the Year, Morgan Heise. Three players were named to the all-region team, and Avery Acker earned her third All-America Honorable Mention award, as well as CoSIDA Academic All-American of the Year accolades. Seifert was also named Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2003.



PROGRAM NOTES

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Janelle Giordano and Morgan Heise were each named to the American Athletic Conference All-Preseason team after earning first-team all-conference honors last season. Both seniors, Giordano and Heise are closing in on all-time records at SMU. Giordano has 461 total blocks, needing 139 to pass Courtney Manning, who blocked 579 attacks from 2009-12. Heise has 1,753 digs, needing 466 to pass Sidney Stewart, who had 2,218 digs from 2008-11.

FRESHMAN CLASS

SMU added five freshmen to its 2016 roster. The signing class includes a player at every position, including 6-3 middle blocker Meryn Kennedy, who finished with 135 blocks and 194 kills while hitting .464 as a senior at Allen High School.

The Mustangs also signed Ashley Homan, a 6-0 outside hitter from Brenham High School, the same program which produced All-American Caroline Young. Ashtyn Richey, a 6-1 right side from Prosper High School, gives SMU a third 6-footer in the class, which also includes Kendall Patterson, a setter from Hebron High School in Carrollton, Texas, and Montana Watts, a libero from Boyd High School in McKinney, Texas.

MOODY MAGIC

SMU set a program record with 15 home wins and just one loss in 2014, and went 14-2 at home last season. The Mustangs are 173-97 all-time in Moody Coliseum, and went 10-2 in 2013 while playing home matches in the Dedman Center on campus. SMU has won at least 10 matches at home in six of the last eight seasons, going 91-22 on the Hilltop during the stretch. Since joining the American Athletic Conference in 2013, SMU is 25-4 at home in conference matches.

RECENT SUCCESS

Over the last seven seasons, SMU is 153-70 overall and 98-36 in conference matches, including a 46-12 record in three seasons in the American Athletic Conference. Five players have combined for eight All-America Honorable Mention awards, and a Mustang has earned a conference Player of the Year award for their position each of the past three seasons, with Avery Acker earning the program's first conference Player of the Year award. Acker and Morgan Heise each have two player of the year awards at their positions.

NEW SETTER

Over the past three seasons, Avery Acker played in 347 of 353 sets at setter, posting an SMU single-season record 1,482 assists as a senior, earning three All-American Honorable Mention awards, two conference Setter of the Year accolades, and the 2015 conference Player of the Year award. She finished with 4,321 assists, second all-time at SMU and the most in a career during the rally-scoring era. With Acker now attending medical school, the Mustangs will look to sophomore Nastassja Bowman and freshman Kendall Patterson to take on the role of floor general. Bowman, who practiced with the Mustangs as a freshman in 2015, didn't see competitive action last season. In high school, she was a four-time all-league selection, twice earning MVP honors, and led her squad to three league championships. Patterson was a state championship at Hebron High School in Carrollton, Texas, earning all-state honors as a senior.

KRISTEN STEHLING

Splitting time at middle blocker with All-American Janelle Giordano, senior team captain Kristen Stehling finished with 100 blocks as a junior, reaching the century mark for the second straight season, and scored 264 kills with a .302 attack percentage, second on the team in 2015. She has 229 total blocks in her career, needing 40 to climb into the top 10 all-time at SMU.

KATIE HEGARTY

In her first full season as a starter, Katie Hegarty scored 273 kills, second among returning letterwinners, hitting .227 as an opposite hitter. In 111 sets, the junior also recorded 83 blocks and 44 digs.
