STORYLINES

MUSTANGS CONTINUE ROAD SWING AT NC STATE

The SMU volleyball team plays its second of three straight road tournaments Friday and Saturday at the NC State Invitational in Raleigh, N.C., taking on Delaware Friday at 3 p.m. ET/2 p.m. CT, and High Point and host N.C. State Saturday.

The Mustangs enter the tournament with a 3-3 record, hosting a tournament before playing at the Arizona Invitational. Katie Hegarty leads the team and ranks third in the American Athletic Conference with 3.85 kills per set, hitting .317. Lauren Mills is second on the team in kills with 50, posting her first career double-double with 10 kills and 14 digs against Alabama State. SMU is holding opponents to a .155 attack percentage, with Morgan Heise leading the league with 5.40 digs per set.

Delaware is 4-2, winning four straight with just one set lost before losing its last two matches. Maria Bellinger leads the Blue Hens with 51 kills, and Alexa Swann is hitting .363 with 45 kills. Taylor Hollingsworth leads the defense with 4.85 digs per set, helping Delaware hold opponents to a .154 attack percentage. This is the first meeting between the two programs.

High Point is 5-1 entering the tournament, winning its last four, including two five-set wins. Haley Barnes leads the team with 86 kills, averaging 3.58 per set, and Molly Livingston has 60 kills with a team-high .296 attack percentage, and also has 24 blocks. Amy Pilat is averaging 3.50 digs per set. As a team, the Panthers are hitting .248, while holding opponents to a .189 attack percentage. This is the first meeting between the two programs.

NC State is 4-3 after tournaments at TCU and at Ole Miss. Julia Brown leads the Wolfpack with 3.46 kills per set, and Teni Sopitan and Kaitlyn Kearney also have more than 50 kills each, hitting .294 and .293, respectively. Rachel Eppley has a team-high 94 digs, averaging 3.76 per set, and is one of four players with more than 50 digs. Opponents are hitting .187, while the Wolfpack is hitting .224. SMU has played NC State just once before, winning 3-0 in a neutralsite match in 1999.

LISA SEIFERT

HEAD COACH WINONA STATE, '83 21ST SEASON

Lisa Seifert is the first and only volleyball coach in SMU history, in her 21st season (2016) with the Mustangs. Under her tutelage, the Mustangs have moved into the national spotlight with team and individual regional and national rankings. She has coached players to All-Conference honors 50 times and 10 All-America awards. Mustang athletes have not only excelled on the court under Seifert, but also in the classroom, where 80 student-athletes have been awarded Academic All-Conference honors.

She led the Mustangs to the American Athletic Conference championship in 2015 with a 17-3 mark and a program-record 27 wins overall with six losses. Avery Acker was named conference Player and Setter of the Year, as the Mustangs set a school record, hitting .245 as a team. Three players earned All-America status, with five being named to the all-conference team. Seifert won her second conference Coach of the Year honor, and was named region Coach of the Year.

Building a program from the ground up is an arduous process, but Seifert has put in the foundation for the Mustangs more recent successes. As the veritable architect of the SMU Volleyball program, coach Seifert has overseen the Mustangs rise from the beginning struggles to a team that is capable of competing with any team in the nation.

In 2005, SMU saw a transition into another conference. As the Mustangs joined Conference USA, they depended on the combination of a consistent returning class and strong newcomers to guide them through the season. The Mustangs went 13-16 overall and 8-7 in their inaugural season of C-USA. The team notched the nation's 23rd-highest number of digs per game while freshman Natalie Peters posted the 34th best number of blocks per game in the nation.

In 2006, the Seifert-led Mustangs compiled an overall record of 17-15. SMU hosted its first nationally-televised match and the first volleyball action televised from Moody Coliseum on Nov. 10, when the Mustangs hosted Houston. With a win over UTA on Sept. 1, the Mustangs and Seifert recorded the program's 150th win. Junior outside hitter Rachel Giubilato led the Mustangs and was ranked nationally in kills per game.

The 2007 season saw the best start in program history, with the Mustangs winning its first six matches, including SMU's first win over Texas Tech. The Ponies were 10-3 heading into the championship match at the New Hampshire Invitational, when outside hitter and team captain Giubilato went down with a careerending knee injury. The Mustangs were forced to rely heavily on All-Freshman outside hitter Kathryn Wilkerson and senior co-captain Caitlin Rainbird, finishing with a 16-15 overall record.

The 2009 season saw a Seifert-led squad produce a 19-12 record behind the program's first All-American Honorable Mentions in sophomore Dana Powell and senior Kendra Kahanek. As a whole, the Mustangs' defense set a SMU single-season record with 317.5 blocks in just 121 games, while holding its opponents to 223.5 team blocks. The Mustangs were particularly tough at home winning 12 of 14 games in Moody Coliseum.

Seifert led the Mustangs to 25 wins in 2010, a school record at the time, with Powell repeating as an All-America Honorable Mention and highlighting a cast of five all-conference selections. Caroline Young became the program's third All-American in 2012, and in 2013, Avery Acker was an All-America Honorable Mention and earned Setter of the Year honors during the inaugural season of the American Athletic Conference. SMU finished 22-9 in 2013, winning at least 20 matches for the third time in program history.

The Mustangs won 26 matches in 2014, breaking the record of 25 set in 2010, and won a program-record 11 consecutive matches. SMU earned its first victory over an AVCA Top 25 team, beating then-No. 24 Oklahoma. Morgan Heise was named Libero of the Year, and Acker became the program's first Academic All-American. She was also an All-American Honorable Mention award winner for the second straight season.

Seifert joined SMU after six years as assistant coach at Texas Tech. The Lady Raiders compiled an overall record of 128-62 during Seifert's tenure, with NCAA tournament appearances from 1990-92 and regional semifinal berths in 1990 and 1991. A 1978 graduate of Saint Francis (Minn.) High School, Seifert held volleyball, softball, track and basketball coaching jobs at several different colleges and high schools in Colorado, Wisconsin and Minnesota from 1982-86.

Seifert earned her B.S. in physical education in 1983 from Winona State (Minn.) University, where she played volleyball and softball, and added a master's degree in P.E. from Wisconsin-LaCrosse in 1987.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Seniors Morgan Heise and Kristen Stehling were selected as 2016 team captains by their teammates. For Heise, this is the second year as a team captain. "These two seniors have the traits necessary to guide our team through the highs and lows that can happen during a season," Seifert explained. "We have one of the largest freshmen classes we've ever had, and our captains have been very influential, providing guidance during summer and fall camp. I am confident this leadership will continue, and aid in our success during the season."

NATIONAL LEADERS

Morgan Heise and Janelle Giordano are both among the active career leaders in digs and blocks, respectively. Heise is third in the NCAA among with 1,861 digs after setting a conference and SMU record with 721 digs as a junior, finishing second in the NCAA last year behind North Dakota's McKenzie Hart, who recorded 787 digs. Heise was third in the NCAA last season, setting an SMU and conference record with 6.06 digs per set. In her career, she is fifth among active players with a 4.99 average. Kent State's Challen Geraghty and Wright State's Jessie Thornton hold the active career lead with 5.15 digs per set. Heise has 108 digs as a senior, leading the league with 5.40 per set.

In her career, Giordano has 481 total blocks, tied for second among active career leaders. PROGRAM NOTES

COACH OF THE YEAR

Lisa Seifert was named AVCA Region Coach of the Year and American Athletic Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Mustangs to a 27-6 record, a 17-3 mark in The American, the program's first conference championship and an NCAA appearance. She guided five players to all-conference honors, including Player and Setter of the Year, Avery Acker, and back-to-back Libero of the Year, Morgan Heise. Three players were named to the all-region team, and Avery Acker earned her third All-America Honorable Mention award, as well as CoSIDA Academic All-American of the Year accolades. Seifert was also named Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2003.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE

Janelle Giordano and Morgan Heise were each named to the American Athletic Conference All-Preseason team after earning first-team all-conference honors last season. Both seniors, Giordano and Heise are closing in on all-time records at SMU. Giordano has 481 total blocks, needing 119 to pass Courtney Manning, who blocked 579 attacks from 2009-12. Heise has 1,861 digs, needing 358 to pass Sidney Stewart, who had 2,218 digs from 2008-11.

FRESHMAN CLASS

SMU added five freshmen to its 2016 roster. The signing class includes a player at every position, including 6-3 middle blocker Meryn Kennedy, who finished with 135 blocks and 194 kills while hitting .464 as a senior at Allen High School.

The Mustangs also signed Ashley Homan, a 6-0 outside hitter from Brenham High School, the same program which produced All-American Caroline Young. Ashtyn Richey, a 6-1 right side from Prosper High School, gives SMU a third 6-footer in the class, which also includes Kendall Patterson, a setter from Hebron High School in Carrollton, Texas, and Montana Watts, a libero from Boyd High School in McKinney, Texas.

MOODY MAGIC

SMU set a program record with 15 home wins and just one loss in 2014, and went 14-2 at home last season. The Mustangs are 177-99 all-time in Moody Coliseum, and went 10-2 in 2013 while playing home matches in the Dedman Center on campus. SMU has won at least 10 matches at home in six of the last eight seasons, going 91-22 on the Hilltop during the stretch. Since joining the American Athletic Conference in 2013, SMU is 25-4 at home in conference matches.

RECENT SUCCESS

Over the last seven seasons, SMU is 153-70 overall and 98-36 in conference matches, including a 46-12 record in three seasons in the American Athletic Conference. Five players have combined for eight All-America Honorable Mention awards, and a Mustang has earned a conference Player of the Year award for their position each of the past three seasons, with Avery Acker earning the program's first conference Player of the Year award. Acker and Morgan Heise each have two player of the year awards at their positions.

COLLEGIATE DEBUTS

Freshman setter Kendall Patterson started all three matches and played all 10 sets, recording 122 assists on SMU's 136 kills. Averaging 12.2 assists per set, Patterson was ninth in the NCAA in assists per set, with Wisconsin's Lauren Carlini leading the country with 13.3 assists per set, after the first weekend of matches. Avery Acker, a three-time All-America Honorable Mention award winner at SMU and the 2015 conference Player of the Year, posted 99 assists in eight sets in her first three starts in 2012, averaging 12.38 assists per set. Patterson recorded her first double-double with 46 assists and 10 digs against UTSA, and had 40 assists in three sets against Little Rock. Splitting time at setter in a 6-2 rotation in the first five sets at the Arizona Invitational, Patterson is now averaging 10.0 assists per set, fifth in the league. She also has 46 digs and eight blocks.

KRISTEN STEHLING

Splitting time at middle blocker with All-American Janelle Giordano, senior team captain Kristen Stehling finished with 100 blocks as a junior, reaching the century mark for the second straight season, and scored 264 kills with a .302 attack percentage, second on the team in 2015. She has 235 total blocks in her career, needing 34 to climb into the top 10 all-time at SMU. She scored 26 kills on opening weekend, hitting .327, second on the team in both categories. The senior also recorded six blocks and five digs. Stehling has 38 kills this season with 14 blocks and six service aces.

KATIF HEGARTY

In her first full season as a starter, Katie Hegarty scored 273 kills, second among returning letterwinners, hitting .227 as an opposite hitter. In 111 sets as a sophomore, Hegarty also recorded 83 blocks and 44 digs. Hegarty scored at least 10 kills in five of the first six matches, finishing with nine against [RV] Arizona. The junior is third in the conference, averaging 3.85 kills per set, and leads the team with a .317 attack percentage. She recorded a career-high 23 kills against Little Rock, and has 77 kills this season.

LAUREN MILLS

Lauren Mills is second on the team with 50 kills, averaging 2.5 per set. The junior recorded a career high with 20 digs against UTSA at home earlier this season. She is second on the team with 71 digs, averaging 3.55 per set.
