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MOODY COLISEUM POLICIES

WILL-CALL

The Mustang Will Call windows are located at Moody Coliseum's Main Ticket Office at 3009 Binkley Avenue. The Will Call windows will open one hour and 30 minutes prior to tipoff. Photo identification is required.

WHEELCHAIR SEATING

Wheelchair seating is available on the south side of the concourse level, between sections 209-215.

RE-ENTRY

No re-entry is allowed.

SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted in Moody Coliseum, including suites, club areas and terraces.

FIRST AID

A first aid station is located on the event level on the northeast corner of the arena. Please contact the nearest event staff for assistance.

BANNERS/SIGNS

Banners and signs may be displayed, but cannot be on poles or posted in a way that disrupts other patrons. A sign may be removed if it is offensive, violates NCAA rules, or violates the SMU or the American Athletic Conference sportsmanship policy.

LOST AND FOUND

During the event, please contact the nearest event staff member for information on lost and found items, or for post-event needs please call SMU PD at 214-768-3388.

CLEAR BAG POLICY

SMU has instituted a clear bag policy at Moody Coliseum. Permitted bags include those made of clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC which do not exceed 12 x 6 x 12 inches, one-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (Ziploc or similar), and small clutch bags (approximately the size of a hand), with or without a handle or strap. All bags except those approved under the clear bag policy are prohibited. All fans will also be subject to wandering prior to entering the stadium.

SECURITY AND SAFETY

The following items are prohibited from entering Moody Coliseum:

- Purses
- Coolers
- Briefcases
- Backpacks
- Fanny Packs
- Cinch Bags
- Computer Bags
- Camera Bags
- Luggage of any kind
- Seat cushions that have zippers, pockets or compartments

Uniformed personnel are stationed throughout the arena during all events. In the case of a security incident, notify a uniformed stadium employee and/or the nearest uniformed security officer.

PERMITTED

- Clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and do not exceed 12 x 6 x 12 inches
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags (Ziploc or similar)
- Small clutch bags approximately the size of a hand, with or without a handle or strap.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The NCAA and SMU promote good sportsmanship by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Spectators are reminded that they are prohibited from entering the playing area. Doing so may result in expulsion from the stadium and/or legal action. Negative comments directed at officials, student-athletes, coaches or team representatives are grounds for removal. The NCAA, the American Athletic Conference and SMU thank you for your cooperation.

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

In the event of an emergency, arena staff will utilize the public address system and video board to inform patrons of the situation and any instructions as applicable. All exits in the arena are clearly marked.

GATES AND GATE TIMES

Fan gates are located at the west end of Moody Coliseum. Premium entrances for the club and suite areas are located on the north side along Binkley Avenue.

Men's basketball - All gates will open 60 minutes before game time.

Women's basketball - All gates will open 60 minutes before game time.

PARKING

Parking lots are open on gameday 90 minutes prior to tip-off. Several cash lots are also available. For questions about parking, call 214-SMU-GAME (768-4263).

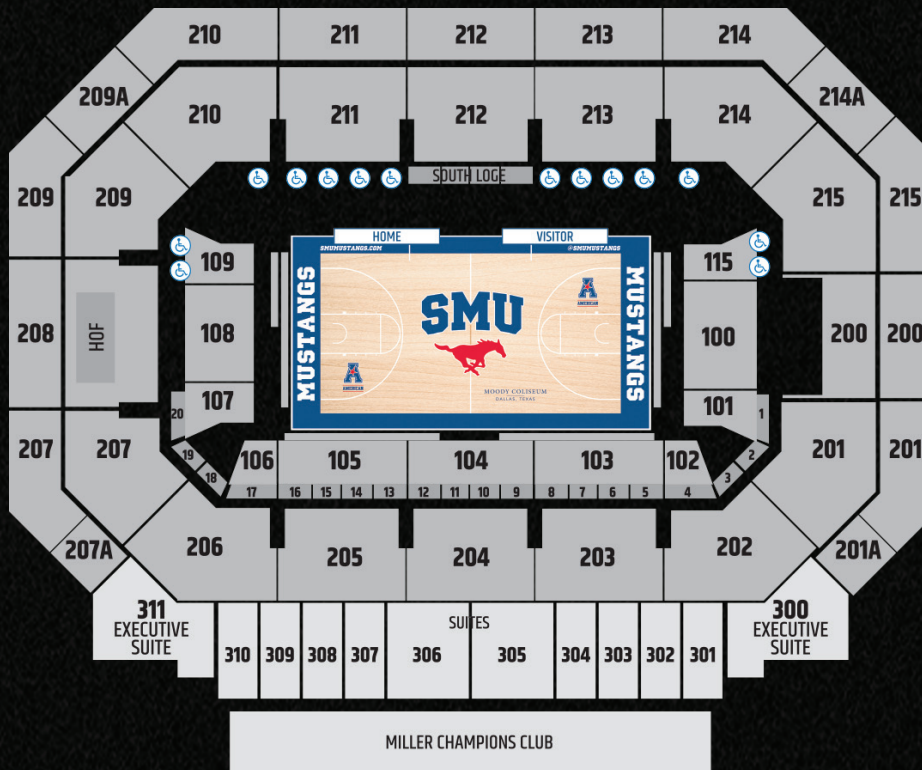
Handicap Accessible Parking: Handicap accessible parking is available in several reserved parking lots. A handicap parking permit is required to park in designated areas.

TRAFFIC - OPERATIONAL NOTES

The stretch of Binkley Avenue north of Moody Coliseum is westbound only prior to the game and eastbound-only after the game.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Outside food and drink
- Strollers
- Bags larger than 12" x 6" x 12": includes purses, backpacks, camera bags, large bags, luggage, and coolers. (Diaper bags and bags with medical supplies may be larger than restricted measurements but are subject to search.)
- Inflatables, nets, noise makers, brooms, weapons, or laser pointers
- Flag/sign poles are not allowed into the stadium. Flags and signs are permitted as long as they are not obscene or in bad taste. Flags/signs may not obstruct the view of other patrons or interfere with the game in any way.



COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

Q: WHAT IS A "REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS?"

A: According to NCAA rules, a representative of athletics interests is any individual, independent agency, corporate (e.g. apparel or equipment manufacturer), or other organization who is known (or who should have been known) by a member of the institution's executive or athletics administration to:

- (a) Have participated in or to be a member of any organization that promotes the institution's intercollegiate athletics program.
- (b) Have made financial contributions to the athletics department or to an athletics booster organization of that institution.
- (c) Be assisting or to have been requested (by the athletics department staff) to assist in the recruitment of prospects.
- (d) Be assisting or to have assisted in providing benefits to enrolled student-athletes or families; or
- (e) Have been involved otherwise in promoting the institution's athletics program.

Q: HOW LONG DO I REMAIN A REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS IF I MEET ONE OF THE CRITERIA ABOVE?

A: Under NCAA rules, once an individual, independent agency, corporate entity or other organization is identified as a representative, that person or group remains that identity indefinitely.

Q: CAN A REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS SIGN OR CO-SIGN A NOTE FOR A STUDENT-ATHLETE OR HIS/HER RELATIVE WITH AN OUTSIDE AGENCY TO ARRANGE A LOAN?

A: No, this is considered an extra benefit.

Q: IS IT PERMISSIBLE FOR A REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS TO BRING SMU'S ATTENTION TO OUTSTANDING PROSPECTS?

A: Yes. A representative of athletics interests may not, however, get involved in the actual evaluation of a prospect. In other words, a representative may not contact a prospect's coach, principal, or counselor, nor visit the prospect's educational institution to pick up film or transcripts pertaining to the evaluation of the prospect's athletic or academic abilities. In addition, an athletic representative cannot contact the prospect for purposes of soliciting the prospect's enrollment to SMU and participation in athletics.

Q: CAN A REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS BE INVOLVED WHEN A PROSPECT IS ON AN UNOFFICIAL OR OFFICIAL VISIT?

A: No. Representatives of athletics interests are precluded from all recruiting activities, including face-to-face contacts with a prospect or his/her relatives.

Q: IS IT PERMISSIBLE FOR AN SMU REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS TO PROVIDE SUMMER EMPLOYMENT FOR STUDENT-ATHLETES?

A: Yes, it is permissible. Please remember that compensation must be paid only for work actually performed and at a rate commensurate with the going rate in that locality. Student-athlete/prospect must complete and submit a Student-Athlete Employment Form to the Compliance Office prior to the first day of work.

Q: CAN AN SMU REPRESENTATIVE OF ATHLETICS INTERESTS ARRANGE FOR A PROSPECT TO WORK FOR THEM AFTER HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION?

A: Yes, once the prospect signs an NLI with SMU and graduates from high school, the prospect may work for an SMU representative of athletics interests. The prospect must complete and submit a Student-Athlete Employment Form to the Compliance Office prior to the first day of work.

Q: IS SMU'S ATHLETICS DEPARTMENT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTS OF ITS REPRESENTATIVES OR ATHLETICS INTERESTS, INCLUDING MUSTANG CLUB DONORS, AND BOOSTER SUPPORT GROUPS?

A: Yes. The athletic department is responsible for ensuring that its representatives of athletics interests follow NCAA regulations.

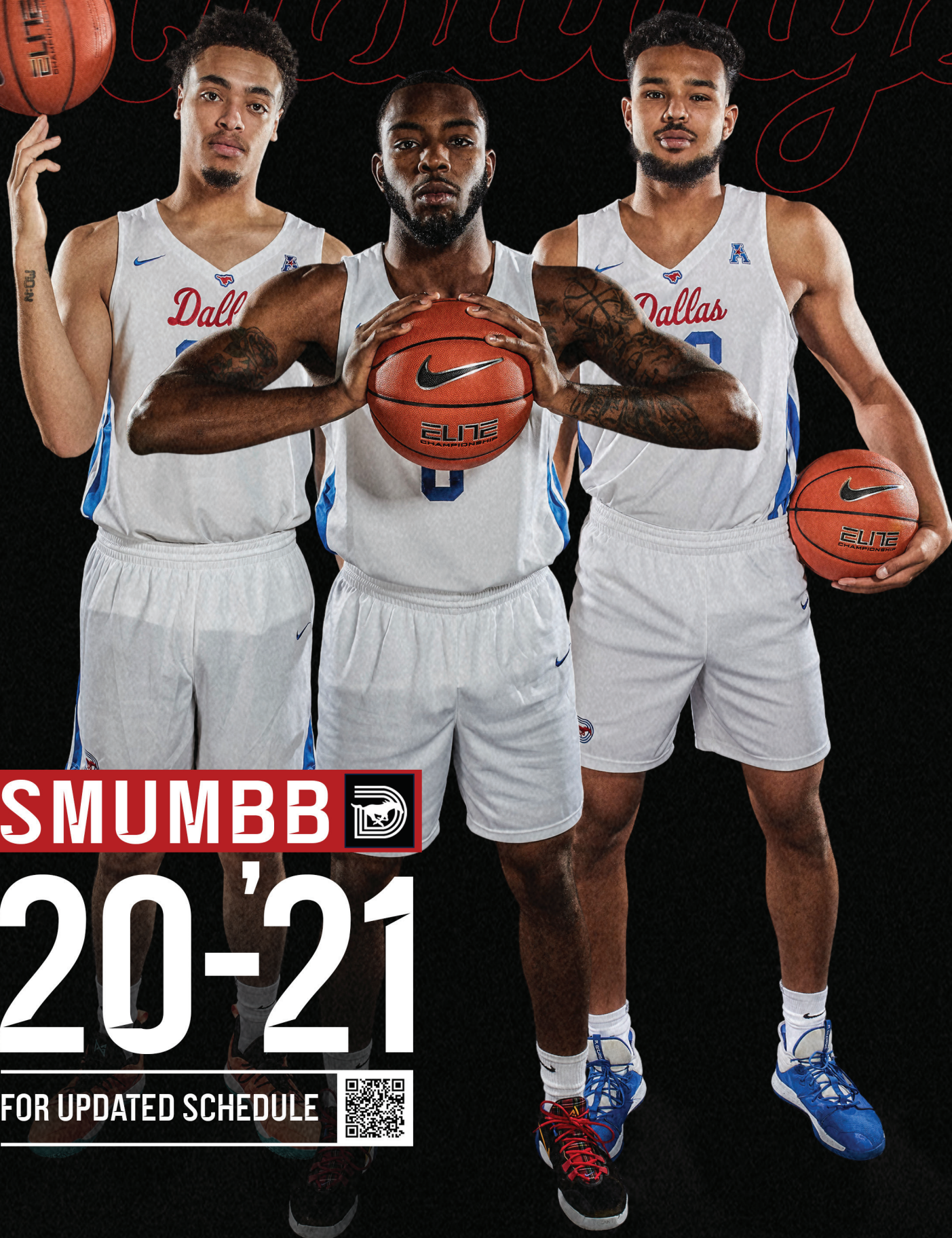
