Facility and Spike Rules

Washburne track surface is Beynon. **Athletes may only use 1/4" pyramid spikes**, except the high jump where 3/8" will be permitted. Spikes will be checked, and those not meeting the regulations must be replaced. No pin/needle/Christmas tree spikes will be allowed on the competition track. Spikes will be for sale: \$25 bag of 100

Washburne Track and Field

Washburne Stadium is the home and spirit hub for track and field. It features an updated track, conference room, and private team locker rooms. Beynon resurfaced the track during Summer 2024. The 2,577-capacity stadium offers Mustang fans a dynamic environment to cheer while supporting SMU's student-athletes. The throwing facility is in its own premier area for hammer, discus, and shot put.

SMU's cross-country and track and field teams have produced 10 NCAA Team Trophies, 61 NCAA Champions, 262 NCAA All-Americans, and 20 Conference Titles. Last year, women's cross-country had the highest team GPA (3.64) for all Mustang sports.

The use of 1/4" pyramid spikes will be strictly enforced. Absolutely NO Christmas tree, blunt or Needle spikes allowed. Shoes that have permanent spikes that do not meet the requirements will not be allowed. Athletes are required to check-in spikes for inspection at the clerk's area before competing. Approved spikes will be tagged. You may purchase spikes if you do not have the appropriate length and type. Javelin and High Jump are allowed 3/8"

Unattached/Post-Collegiate Entry Policy

Philosophy: SMU Track & Field program conducts its meets primarily for collegiate competitors. At the same time, the program seeks to accept a limited number of unattached or “open” competitors that will enhance the quality of the meet.

- Post-collegiate and unattached entries are permitted, but must have met the entry standards. No high school or high school club athletes are allowed to enter this meet.
- Acceptable marks must be from the 2024 or 2025 seasons only and must be verifiable via TFRRS or World Athletics. Meet management will review entries. The standards are from the 2024 NCAA 100th performance mark.
- Entries through DirectAthletics site (\$55 online fee). **DEADLINE** Wednesday, April 30 @ noon (CST).
- Submitted falsified marks to satisfy the event standards, will be subject to rejection from the event. Payment will NOT be refunded due to falsified marks and no-show meet day.

World Athletics and USA Track & Field policies require that marks to be considered for qualification to their championships may only come from competitions that are sanctioned through World Athletics / USATF and abide by their rulebook. While this meet will be conducted under NCAA rules, it is also sanctioned by World Athletics and USATF. Results will be reported both to TFRRS (the NCAA results reporting system) and to World Athletics / USATF, with notations of any rule violations from the World Athletics rulebook.
