PRIBBLE IS ENTERING HIS FOURTH SEASON WITH SMU AS HE WAS HIRED ON APRIL 2015. OVER THE COURSE OF FOUR YEARS, PRIBBLE HAS COMPILED A CAREER RECORD OF 57-35 (.620).

DURING THIS TIME AT SAINT MARTIN'S, ALEX PRIBBLE HAS COACHED ONE ALL-REGION PLAYER, ONE GNAC NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR, FIVE ALL-CONFERENCE SELECTIONS, AND NINE ALL-ACADEMIC SELECTIONS.

THE 2017 SEASON WAS ONE FOR THE AGES, AS THE SAINTS WON A SCHOOL RECORD NCAA-ERA 25 WINS, REACHED THE GNAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME FOR THE FIRST TIME IN SCHOOL HISTORY AND EARNED A BIRTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY. THE SAINTS DEFEATED CAL POLY POMONA IN THE FIRST ROUND AND ADVANCED TO THE ROUND OF 32. SAINT MARTIN'S EARNED THE GNAC TEAM OF THE WEEK IN NOVEMBER AFTER WINNING THREE ROAD IN CALIFORNIA, INCLUDING UPSETTING NO. 7 CAL BAPTIST. PRIBBLE COACHED NABC FIRST TEAM ALL-REGION, D2CCA SECOND TEAM ALL-REGION, GNAC FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE, AND GNAC NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR GUARD LUKE CHAVEZ AND GNAC ALL-CONFERENCE GUARD EJ BOYCE.

IN ONLY HIS SECOND SEASON AT THE HELM, PRIBBLE LED THE SAINTS TO THEIR FIRST EVER GNAC TOURNAMENT VICTORY WITH A WIN OVER CONCORDIA. THE SAINTS POSTED THEIR SECOND WINNING SEASON IN A ROW AFTER 17 WINS THAT INCLUDED TOUGH ROAD WINS AT ANCHORAGE (FIRST SINCE '05), CENTRAL WASHINGTON, AND SEATTLE PACIFIC (FIRST SINCE '84). AFTER FINISHING FOURTH OVERALL IN A COMPETITIVE GNAC FIELD, THE SAINTS PLAYED THEIR FINAL GAME AGAINST EVENTUAL CHAMPION WESTERN WASHINGTON IN FRONT OF OVER 3,000 PEOPLE, EVIDENCE OF THE RENEWED ENERGY SURROUNDING SAINT MARTIN'S BASKETBALL. NOT ONLY HAS THE TEAM FOUND SUCCESS ON THE COURT UNDER PRIBBLE, BUT ALSO OFF THE COURT WITH A TEAM GPA OF 3.00.

IN HIS FIRST SEASON AS A SAINT, HE LED HIS TEAM TO ITS FIRST WINNING SEASON SINCE 2009-10. THE SAINTS ENDED THE SEASON IN STRONG FORM, WINNING SEVEN OF THEIR FINAL EIGHT GAMES AND FINISHING WITH A 15-13 RECORD (9-11 IN THE GREAT NORTHWEST ATHLETIC CONFERENCE). DURING THAT STRETCH, THE SAINTS EARNED ROAD VICTORIES OVER ALASKA ANCHORAGE (FIRST TIME SINCE 2005) AND CENTRAL WASHINGTON, AS WELL AS KEY HOME VICTORIES OVER WESTERN WASHINGTON AND NATIONALLY RANKED SEATTLE PACIFIC. THE NINE-GAME IMPROVEMENT FROM THE PREVIOUS SEASON MADE THE SAINTS ONE OF THE MOST IMPROVED TEAMS IN THE WEST REGION, DESPITE NOT HAVING A SINGLE SENIOR ON THE ROSTER. AFTER THE SEASON, FRED JORG WAS NAMED TO THE GNAC ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM, AND BOTH JORG AND VICTOR IERONYMIDES WERE RECIPIENTS OF THE FAR SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD.

SAINTS' OFFENSE SPARKS IN SECOND HALF IN EXHIBITION LOSS TO BYU - PLAYING WITHOUT THE GNAC PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, LUKE CHAVEZ, THE SAINTS FELL BEHIND EARLY TO BYU, AS THE OFFENSE LOOKED TO FIND THEIR RHYTHM. BYU TOOK FULL ADVANTAGE OF THE SLOW START AND NEVER LOOKED BACK AS THEY CRUISED TO A 92-71 EXHIBITION WIN OVER SMU. "THIS WAS A VERY VALUABLE EXPERIENCE FOR US," SAID HEAD COACH ALEX PRIBBLE. "WE CAME INTO A TOUGH ENVIRONMENT, AGAINST A TOP TIER OPPONENT, AND IMPROVED THROUGHOUT THE GAME. WE FOUND SOME MOMENTUM IN THE SECOND HALF, AND WE'LL LOOK TO BUILD ON THAT THROUGHOUT THE REMAINDER OF OUR PRESEASON."

LAUNDRY LIST OF AWARDS – LUKE CHAVEZ WAS NAMED TO THE D2CCA ALL-WEST REGION, AND NABC WEST REGION TEAM, ALONG WITH THE GNAC NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR, FIRST TEAM ALL-CONFERENCE AND WAS A THREE TIME GNAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK LAST YEAR. HE WAS VOTED THE 2018 GNAC PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR TO BEGIN THE 2018-19 CAMPAIGN.

SAINTS RANKED IN TWO PRESEASON POLLS - AFTER COMING OFF A 25-8 SEASON, AND REACHING THE NCAA TOURNAMENT, AND ADVANCING TO THE ROUND OF 32, THE SAINTS HAVE CAUGHT ATTENTION OF THE NATIONAL STAGE. SAINT MARTIN'S RECEIVED 32 VOTES IN THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BASKETBALL COACHES' (NABC) PRESEASON POLL, AND 27 VOTES IN THE DIVISION II SPORTS INFORMATION DIRECTORS ASSOCIATION (D2SIDA) PRESEASON POLL.

SETTING RECORDS – THE SAINTS' 25 WINS LAST YEAR WAS MOST EVER IN THE NCAA-ERA IN PROGRAM HISTORY... AND THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE 1982-83 SEASON (28).

BOYCE ALL-CONFERENCE – EJ BOYCE WAS NAMED HONORABLE MENTION ALL-CONFERENCE LAST YEAR AFTER AVERAGING OVER 11 POINTS PER GAME AND SHOT ALMOST 44% FROM BEYOND THE ARC.

PLAYING IN THE SPOTLIGHT – THE SAINTS PLAYED IN THE FIRST EVER NATIONALLY TELEVISED GAME IN SCHOOL HISTORY. THE GNAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME WAS BROADCAST ON ESPN 3. THEIR SECOND NATIONALLY TELEVISED GAME CAME AGAINST BYU ON THE BYU.TV NETWORK.

PACK THE PAVILION – OVER 10,000 PEOPLE ATTENDED SMU BASKETBALL GAMES LAST SEASON... ONE OF ONLY FOUR PROGRAMS IN THE GNAC TO REACH THE 10,000 MARK.

CHAMPIONSHIP TIME – THE SAINTS REACHED THEIR FIRST EVER GNAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME IN SCHOOL HISTORY AFTER LUKE CHAVEZ HIT THE BUZZER BEATER OVER WESTERN WASHINGTON IN THE SEMIFINALS.

SAINTS GO DANCING – SMU WENT TO THE BIG DANCE FOR THE FIRST TIME IN PROGRAM HISTORY... BEING SELECTED AS AN AT-LARGE BID IN THE WEST REGION.

ADVANCING IN THE TOURNAMENT – ANOTHER FIRST IN SCHOOL HISTORY, THE SAINTS DEFEATED CAL POLY POMONA, 66-58, TO ADVANCE TO THE ROUND OF 32.

BRING ON THE D-I's – OVER THE COURSE OF THE LAST FOUR SEASONS, THE SAINTS HAVE FACED SOME OF THE PREMIER D-I BASKETBALL PROGRAMS TO BEGIN THE YEARS. DURING THAT STRETCH, SMU HAS TRAVELED TO GONZAGA, WASHINGTON, WASHINGTON STATE, AND MOST RECENTLY BYU.

POSITIONAL PREVIEW (GUARDS) – THE SAINTS RETURN ONE OF THE BEST BACKCOURTS NOT ONLY IN THE GNAC, BUT IN THE WEST REGION, HEADLINED BY ALL-REGION SELECTION LUKE CHAVEZ. WITH TWO TRANSFER GUARDS STARTING LAST SEASON, ALONG WITH SEASONED VETERAN RHETT BAERLOCHER, THERE WAS A LOT OF OPTIMISM, BUT ALSO A LOT OF QUESTION MARKS. CHAVEZ AND EJ BOYCE QUICKLY ERASED ANY QUESTIONS AND ESTABLISHED THEMSELVES AS ONE OF THE TOP BACKCOURTS IN THE NCAA WEST. THIS SEASON, THERE ARE NO QUESTION MARKS OR UNCERTAINTIES. THE SAINTS LOOK TO RELY ON THE SHARP SHOOTING AND QUICKNESS OF THEIR GUARDS IN ORDER TO RETURN TO THE NCAA TOURNAMENT.

POSITIONAL PREVIEW (FORWARDS) – THE SAINTS LONE LOSS FROM LAST YEAR'S SQUAD WAS CENTER MATT DAHLEN; HOWEVER, HEAD COACH ALEX PRIBBLE, RETURNS TWO SENIORS, JORDAN KITCHEN AND JARED MATHEWS, ALONG WITH SOPHOMORE TAVIAN HENDERSON, AND ADDS TRANSFER CENTER MARKY ADAMS TO THE MIX. DAHLEN PROVIDED LEADERSHIP AND IMPROVED HIS OFFENSIVE GAME AS THE SEASON WENT ON, AND WILL BE DIFFICULT TO REPLACE IN THE LINEUP. WITH THE LIKES OF KITCHEN, A FOUR YEAR STARTER, AND MATHEWS AND HENDERSON BEING AN INTEGRAL PART TO THE TEAM LAST YEAR, THE SAINTS LOOKED POISED TO STEP UP AND PRODUCE ONE OF THE MOST EFFICIENT FRONT COURTS IN THE REGION.

BYU 92 SAINT MARTIN'S 71 EXHIBITION

PROVO, UTAH – PLAYING WITHOUT THE GNAC PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR, LUKE CHAVEZ, THE SAINTS FELL BEHIND EARLY TO BYU, AS THE OFFENSE LOOKED TO FIND THEIR RHYTHM. BYU TOOK FULL ADVANTAGE OF THE SLOW START AND NEVER LOOKED BACK AS THEY CRUISED TO A 92-71 EXHIBITION WIN OVER SMU.

"THIS WAS A VERY VALUABLE EXPERIENCE FOR US," SAID HEAD COACH ALEX PRIBBLE. "WE CAME INTO A TOUGH ENVIRONMENT, AGAINST A TOP TIER OPPONENT, AND IMPROVED THROUGHOUT THE GAME. WE FOUND SOME MOMENTUM IN THE SECOND HALF, AND WE'LL LOOK TO BUILD ON THAT THROUGHOUT THE REMAINDER OF OUR PRESEASON."

BYU JUMPED TO AN EARLY LEAD, USING A 12-0 RUN TO ESTABLISHED THE TEMPO OF THE GAME. IN THE FIRST HALF, THE FRESHMAN ALEXIS ANGELES, GETTING HIS FIRST LOOK AT THE COLLEGIATE GAME, MAKE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT. ANGELES LED THE SAINTS WITH FIVE POINTS, INCLUDING KNOCKING DOWN ONE OF THE THREE 3-POINTERS. MARKY ADAMS AND BJ STANDLEY GRABBED A COMBINED NINE REBOUNDS AND STANDLEY AND CHANDLER REDIX BOTH HAD TWO ASSISTS.

BYU SHOT 50.0 PERCENT FROM THE FIELD IN THE OPENING HALF, WITH YOELI CHILDS LEADING THE WAY WITH 13 POINTS AND FOUR REBOUNDS DOWN LOW. THE COUGARS TOOK ADVANTAGE OF THE SMU TURNOVERS, SCORING 14 POINTS AND 14 FASTBREAK POINTS. THE LENGTH AND SIZE OF BYU PROVED TO BE THE DIFFERENCE MAKER IN THE FIRST HALF AND LED THEM TO A 45-23 LEAD AT THE BREAK.

OUT OF HALFTIME, THE SAINTS MANAGED TO TRIM THE LEAD DOWN TO 15 ON 3-POINTERS BY STANDLEY AND EJ BOYCE. RHETT BAERLOCHER AND JORDAN KITCHEN ADDED TO THE SCORING WITH A COUPLE OF BASKETS DOWN IN THE PAINT. HOWEVER, FOUL TROUBLE BY THE SAINTS STUNTED THEIR OFFENSIVE SURGE AND BYU USED ITS SIZE TO ATTACK DOWN LOW AND GET TO THE FREE THROW LINE. OVER THE COURSE OF THE GAME, THE COUGARS CONVERTED 21 TIMES AT THE LINE AND SHOT 54.7 PERCENT FROM THE FIELD. THE COUGARS PULLED AWAY DOWN THE STRETCH AND CRUISED TO A 92-71 EXHIBITION WIN TO OPEN THE SEASON.

"OUR FOCUS WAS REALLY ON COMMUNICATING THROUGHOUT THE GAME," SAID PRIBBLE. "I THINK OUR GUYS MADE SOME GREAT ADJUSTMENTS AFTER A SLOW START. WE GOT THE WAKE UP CALL WE NEEDED TO START THE GAME, AND NOW WE WILL GO BACK TO THE FILM AND IMPROVE."

STANDLEY COMPLETED AN ALL-AROUND GAME, FINISHING WITH 18 POINTS, SIX REBOUNDS, AND SEVEN ASSISTS. BAERLOCHER ADDED 11 POINTS AND THREE REBOUNDS, WHILE CADEN SMITH PROVIDED THREE 3-POINTERS OFF THE BENCH IN THE SECOND HALF. ADAMS AND JARED MATHEWS COMBINED FOR NINE POINTS AND NINE BOARDS DOWN LOW, AND KITCHEN ADDED FIVE POINTS AND THREE REBOUNDS.

AS A TEAM, THE SAINTS SHOT 24-FOR-55 (43.6 PERCENT) FROM THE FIELD, INCLUDING 61.5 PERCENT IN THE SECOND HALF. SMU HIT 12-OF-27 (44.4 PERCENT) FROM BEYOND THE ARC, AND WAS 11-FOR-19 (57.9 PERCENT) AT THE FREE THROW LINE. SAINT MARTIN'S COLLECTED 33 REBOUNDS, 14 ASSISTS, AND HAD 30 FOULS CALLED.

"I THOUGHT WE HAD SOME REALLY GOOD ENERGY FROM A FEW OF OUR GUYS OFF THE BENCH, INCLUDING MARKY ADAMS, ALEXIS ANGELES, CADEN SMITH, AND KAZUMA LANE," PRIBBLE STATED. "IT'S GREAT TO KNOW THAT WE HAVE SOME DEPTH WE CAN RELY ON."

THE SAINTS START THE SEASON NEXT MONTH ON NOVEMBER 9 DOWN IN SAN DIEGO FOR THE GNAC/PAC WEST CHALLENGE. SMU WILL FACE FRESNO PACIFIC, POINT LOMA, AND UC SAN DIEGO IN THE TOURNAMENT.
