# Directions

The Southern Nazarene University main campus is located at 6729 NW 39th Expressway, Bethany, OK 73008, on the western edge of Oklahoma City. Oklahoma City is at the crossroads of three interstate highways (I-40, I-44, and I-35) and is served by several national and regional airlines. SNU also maintains a campus center in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

## From the North

Traveling SOUTH on I-35 (Portions toll), proceed to OK-66. Merge onto OK-66 (exit 133, also marked I-44) and head WEST toward Lawton/Amarillo. OK-66 (I-44) will run straight into NW 39th Expressway (exit Bethany, Warr Acres). Proceed WEST down NW 39th Expressway until Peniel. The campus will be on your right.

## From the South

Traveling NORTH on I-35, proceed to I-240. Exit at I-240 (exit 121B, also marked OK-3 or US-62 W). Merge onto I-240 and travel WEST then NORTH (I-240 becomes I-44) 13.2 miles to OK-66. Exit OK-66 W (exit 123B) and travel WEST toward Warr Acres/Bethany. Proceed WEST down NW 39th Expressway until Peniel. SNU will be on your right.

## From the West

Traveling EAST on I-40, proceed to N. Rockwell Ave. Exit right at N. Rockwell Ave. (exit 143) and proceed NORTH to NW 39th Expressway. Turn right at the light at NW 39th Expressway and head EAST 0.5 miles to Peniel. The campus will be on your left.

## From the East

Traveling WEST on I-40, proceed towards Oklahoma City. Go through Oklahoma City and 2 miles past I-44. Exit right at N. MacArthur Ave. (exit 144) and travel NORTH to NW 39th Expressway. Turn left (WEST) at the light at NW 39th Expressway and head WEST 0.5 miles to Peniel. The campus will be on your right.

## From Will Rogers World Airport

(Est. time: 20 minutes / Est. distance: 13.67 miles)

Travel NORTH on Terminal Rd (which will become S. Meridian Ave.). Continue NORTH on Meridian (you will travel under I-40) until you reach NW 39th Expressway. At NW 39th Expressway, turn left and travel WEST approximately 1.5 miles towards Bethany/Warr Acres until Peniel. The campus will be on your right.

## From Downtown Oklahoma City

(Est. time: 18 minutes / Est. distance: 11.17 miles)

Traveling WEST on I-40, proceed towards Oklahoma City. Go through Oklahoma City and 2 miles past I-44. Exit right at N. MacArthur Ave. (exit 144) and travel NORTH to NW 39th Expressway. Turn left (WEST) at the light at NW 39th Expressway and head WEST 0.5 miles to Peniel. The campus will be on your right.

# Important Information

Here at Southern Nazarene University, we are committed to creating a positive game day experience for our student-athletes, coaches, fans, and visitors.

We will have a great number of SNU fans visit the SNU campus to watch the Crimson Storm compete against Great American Conference and NCAA Division II opponents.

We encourage fans to be aware of the information below to ensure that a positive and fun experience can occur during time spent on the SNU Campus.

## **PROHIBITED ITEMS:**

For the safety of student-athletes, coaches and fans, the following items are prohibited at athletics events held on the SNU campus.

All carried items and entrants are subject to search. Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's car or discarded. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation, and the person in possession of such items is subject to arrest. Items left at gate will be discarded. Prohibited items include:

- Outside food or drink
- Alcoholic beverages
- Tobacco products
- E-cigarettes/vapes
- Explosives, firearms or weapons of any kind
- Fireworks
- Banners and signs
- Beach balls
- Telephoto lenses, cameras with detachable lenses and/or lenses longer than 3", tripods, monopods or selfie sticks (with the exception of credentialed media)
- Backpacks, bags or oversized purses (with the exception of medically necessary or childcare-related items)\*
- Coolers, ice chests or containers
- Air horns, plastic horns, whistles, etc.
- Amplified power sound
- Personal heaters
- Stadium seats/chairbacks with armrests and/or wider than 17"
- Laser pointers
- Umbrellas (ponchos are allowed to protect fans from inclement weather)
- Animals (with the exception of registered service animals)

**\*All bags entering the facility will be subject to search by security staff**

# Weapons Policy

In accordance with Oklahoma state statutes, Southern Nazarene University (SNU or University) strictly prohibits the possession or use of a weapon on SNU Premises by anyone, including but not limited to employees, students, or guest, unless that possession or use falls within the exceptions section of this Policy. Students and employees also have a duty to report violations of this Policy to the SNU Department of Public Safety, Director of Human Resources, Dean of Students, or Office of Student Life.

**Weapon** is defined as any pistol, revolver, shotgun or rifle, whether loaded or unloaded, or any imitation or toy gun, airsoft or pellet gun, or any electronic control devices commonly known as Tasers, or any machete, dagger, bowie knife, dirk knife, switchblade knife, spring-type knife, sword cane, knife having a blade which opens automatically by hand pressure applied to a button, spring, or other device in the handle of the knife, blackjack, loaded cane, billy club, hand chain, metal knuckles, any knife with a blade measured greater than 4 inches, or any other offensive weapon, whether such weapon be concealed or unconcealed.

**Possession** includes, but is not limited to, carrying a weapon upon any person, whether concealed or unconcealed, and storage of a weapon in offices, classrooms, work areas, residential facilities, lockers, bags or backpacks, desks, briefcases, or any other similar manner.

**SNU Premises** includes all the lands, buildings, and facilities of Southern Nazarene University, whether owned or leased, and whether located in the United States or abroad, including designated university student and guest housing.

## Exceptions

Properties owned by SNU but that may be rented out or otherwise leased to non-SNU employees or students or for purposes not directly related to SNU's educational mission and business are exceptions to this policy.

SNU Department of Public Safety officers and other law enforcement officers authorized by the State of Oklahoma or any of its political subdivisions, or authorized by the federal government, to carry a firearm, if they are in uniform or carrying the firearm in compliance with law and the policies established by their employing departments will be exceptions to this policy.

A person may possess or carry personal protection chemical spray devices, which contain a small, limited amount of defensive spray, (e.g., key chain sprays, small containers) intended, reserved, and used solely for defensive purposes.

Tools possessed and used in accordance with direct job duties or departmental policies may be possessed, carried, and used in accordance with those duties or policies.

The use of disabled stage firearms and other stage weapons used in theatrical performances will be exceptions to this policy, provided they are inspected and approved in advance and in writing, by the SNU Department of Public Safety Director/Chief of Police or designee.

The use of firearms or other weapons used in a classroom or training environment for a specific teaching purpose will be exceptions to this policy, provided they are under the supervision of a qualified instructor, disabled, unloaded, and approved in advance and in writing, by the SNU Department of Public Safety Director/Chief of Police or designee.

## **Reporting Information About Weapons or Concerns of Violence**

SNU expects all members and visitors to SNU premises to help maintain safety and security at the University and at university-sponsored activities off campus.

All persons who have knowledge of weapons on SNU premises have an obligation to report that knowledge promptly to the SNU Department of Public Safety.

All persons concerned about a situation that is potentially violent have an obligation to report that concern promptly to the SNU Department of Public Safety, to the Dean of Students Office, or to a supervisor.

All persons concerned about an imminent threat of violence or about the imminent destruction of property have an obligation to report that concern immediately to the SNU Department of Public Safety or to other appropriate law enforcement agencies by dialing 911.

## **Disciplinary Actions Related to Unauthorized Possession or Use of Weapons**

Any violation of municipal, state, or federal statute or otherwise criminal act related to the possession or use of a weapon on SNU premises will be investigated by the law enforcement agency having appropriate jurisdiction and tried through the court system with appropriate authority.

Any employee or student found to be violating this policy in a way that does not rise to the level of a violation of municipal, state, or federal statute will be subject to SNU disciplinary or judicial processes through the SNU department of Human Resources, office of the Dean of Students/Student Life and subject to penalties up to and possibly including termination of employment or dismissal from the university.

Any guest or vendor found in violation of this policy will be required to remove the weapon from SNU premises and comply with the policy or be required to leave SNU premises themselves and possibly discontinue services and a business relationship with SNU.

**DOCTORS:** A medical doctor will be on call/in attendance and an ambulance is on site.

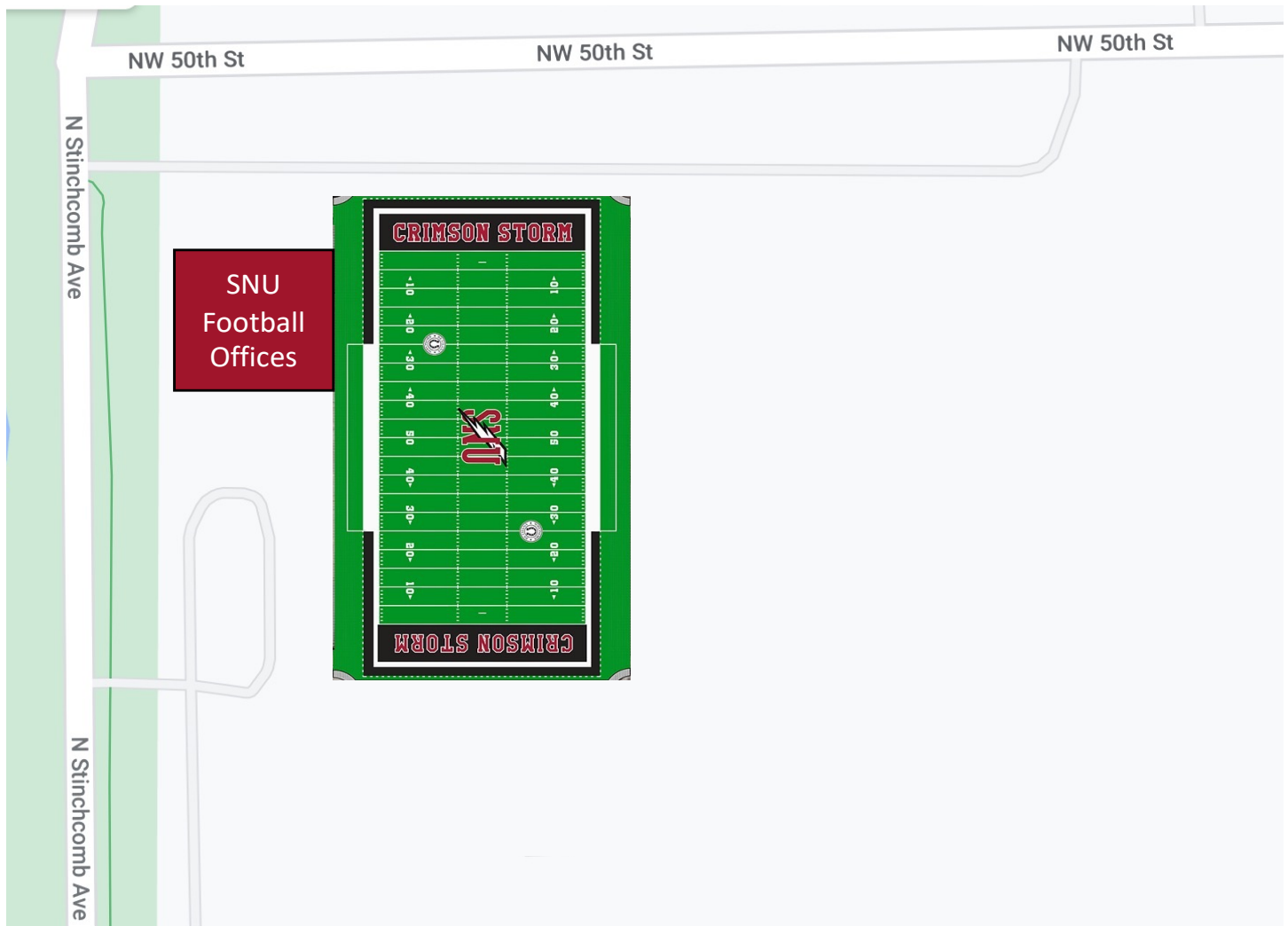
**COACHES BOX:** Visiting team coaches' booth is located on the second level on the south side of the press box.

**FILMING:** Filming for both teams is the room directly north of the visiting coaches' booth. Filming will be exchanged per Football Operations section of the GAC Handbook.

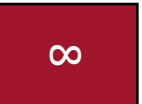
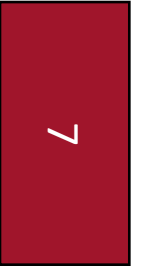
**WARM-UP:** The visiting team will warm up on the south end of the field and the east side to the south 30-yard line.

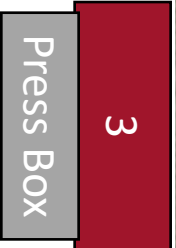
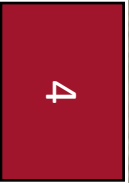

# Accessing the SNU Football Stadium

## General Public

E1 is for general public entry. An access management system is used for entry at all gates. The bar code on each ticket will be scanned by the gate attendant. Each individual is encouraged to hold their own ticket to assist in expediting the scanning process. Gates open to the public one hour prior to kickoff.

Visitors are encouraged to use E3 on the Northeast Side of the stadium for ease of access.

## SNU Students, Faculty & Staff

Students may enter the stadium by scanning their SNU ID at E1. Gates open one hour prior to kickoff.

SNU faculty and staff and their immediate families should show their SNU ID at the pass list located at E1 to receive general admission tickets.

## Re-Entry Policy

Patrons may re-enter the SNU Football Stadium with a ticket/ticket stub through the same gate they exited the stadium.

## Special Seating Requirements

SNU offers ADA seating on a season and single game basis in both general admission and reserved sections. Patrons wishing to purchase ADA seats prior to game day should contact SNU Athletics at (405) 491-8129 to reserve those seats. ADA seats are also available for purchase on game day at the Ticket Office located between. All ADA seating is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

## Parking

Reserved parking will be marked off and only those with parking passes will be allowed in the reserved lots located on the north end of the stadium. SNU administration, staff, visiting teams administration and staff will be presented with a pass prior to gameday.

## Disability Parking

All designated handicap parking spaces on campus are available on a first-come, first-served basis for patrons with a handicap parking permit.

## Busses

Visiting team buses will drop off on the northeast side of the stadium, near the visitor's locker room.

## Stadium Regulations

Unauthorized solicitation inside or outside the stadium is prohibited. Throwing objects onto the playing field is prohibited and punishable by state and local law. Violators are subject to immediate arrest, prosecution, and revocation of ticket(s).

Any person who enters the field area without the appropriate university-issued credential is trespassing and is subject to immediate arrest, prosecution, and revocation of ticket(s), credential(s), etc. All signs, banners, placards and leaflets are prohibited inside the stadium except as authorized in advance by SNU Athletics. Management reserves the right to eject, and revoke any ticket to future events without refund, any person who violates any of the terms of the license (see back of ticket) or any state, local, or federal laws. Violators are subject to immediate arrest, prosecution, and permanent revocation of ticket(s) or other credential(s).

## **Evacuation Procedures**

Your cooperation and assistance are major factors in SNU's security and emergency weather procedures. In the unlikely event of an emergency or severe weather, fans are asked to follow these procedures:

- Remain calm at all times.
- Listen to and follow all instructions that will be provided to you promptly over the public address system.
- Remain in your seat until you are promptly instructed to the safest exit. Please note that the exit nearest you may not be the safest exit.
- You may be directed to exit onto the field and out the field gates located on the field.
- Assist others and exit in a controlled and calm manner as instructed.
- If you see or become aware of any activity that is unusual, suspicious, or causes you concern, please reports that activity to the nearest uniformed officer or security staff.
- Usual exit locations are listed below. In case of an emergency or severe weather, please wait for and listen to instructions from the public address system.

Fans seated in sections 1-3 and the press box, please use southwest entry/exit - E1

Fans seated in sections 4-5, please use northwest entry/exit - E2

Fans seated in section 6, please use northeast entry/exit -E3

Fans in section 7-8, please use southeast entry/exit - E4

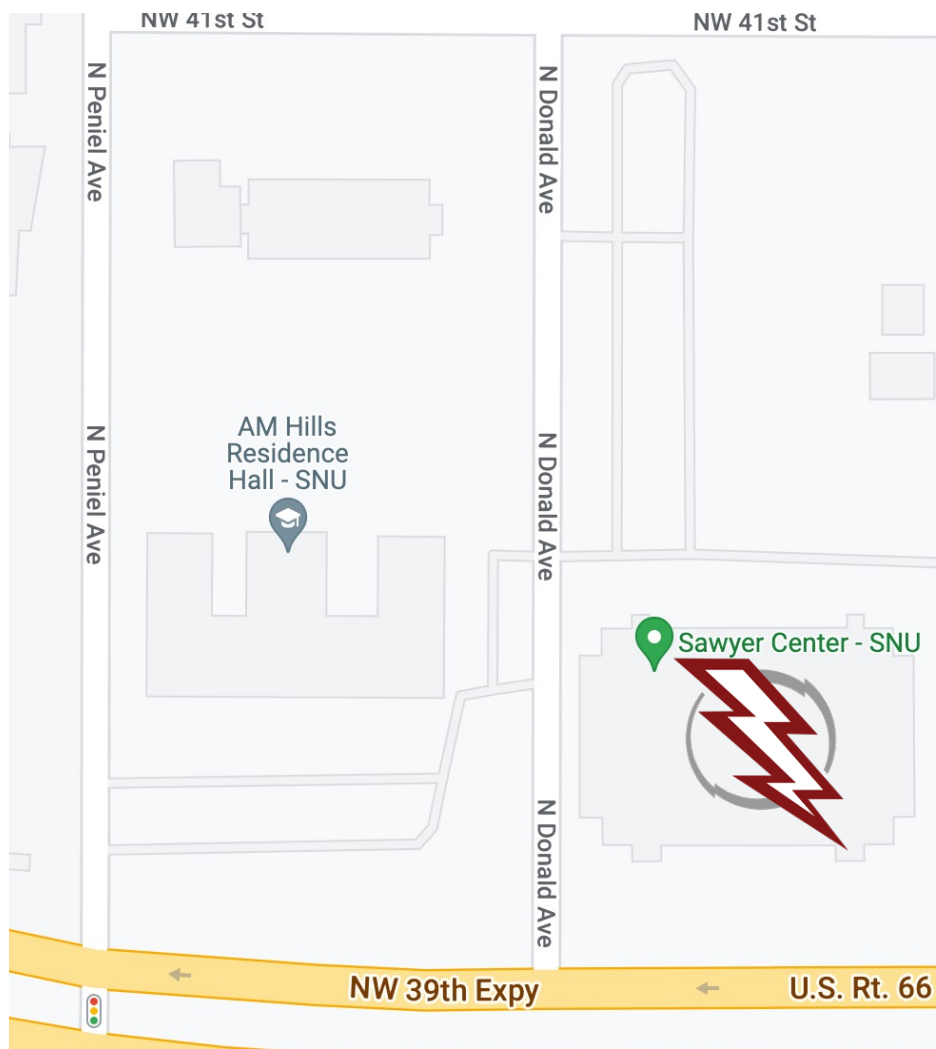
**MEDICAL:** We will have trained athletic training staff on site.

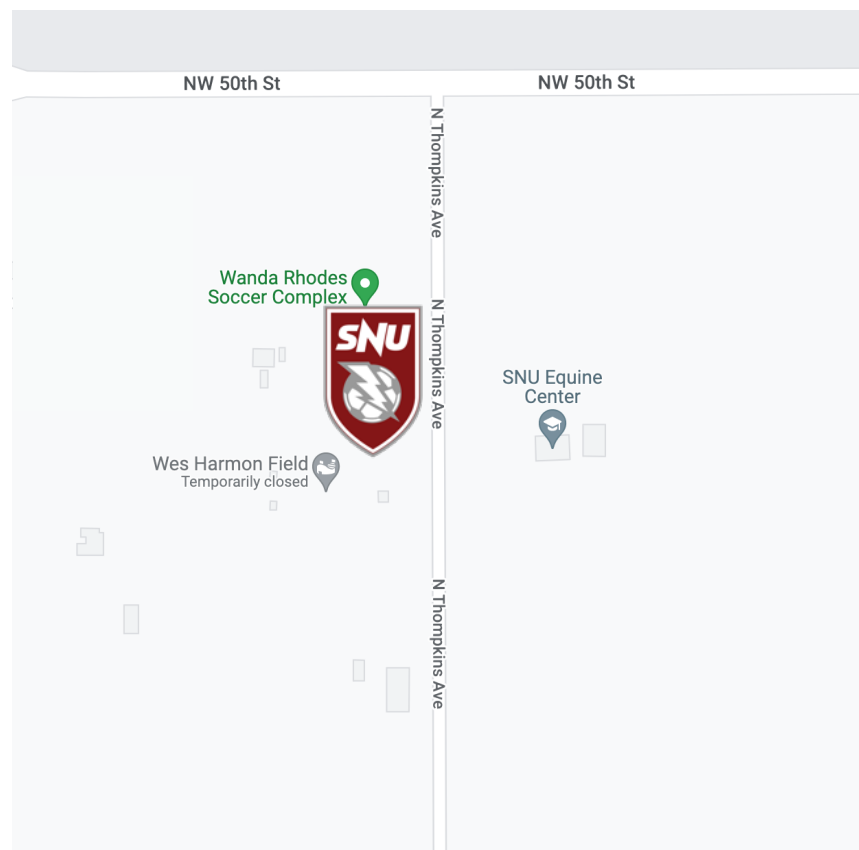

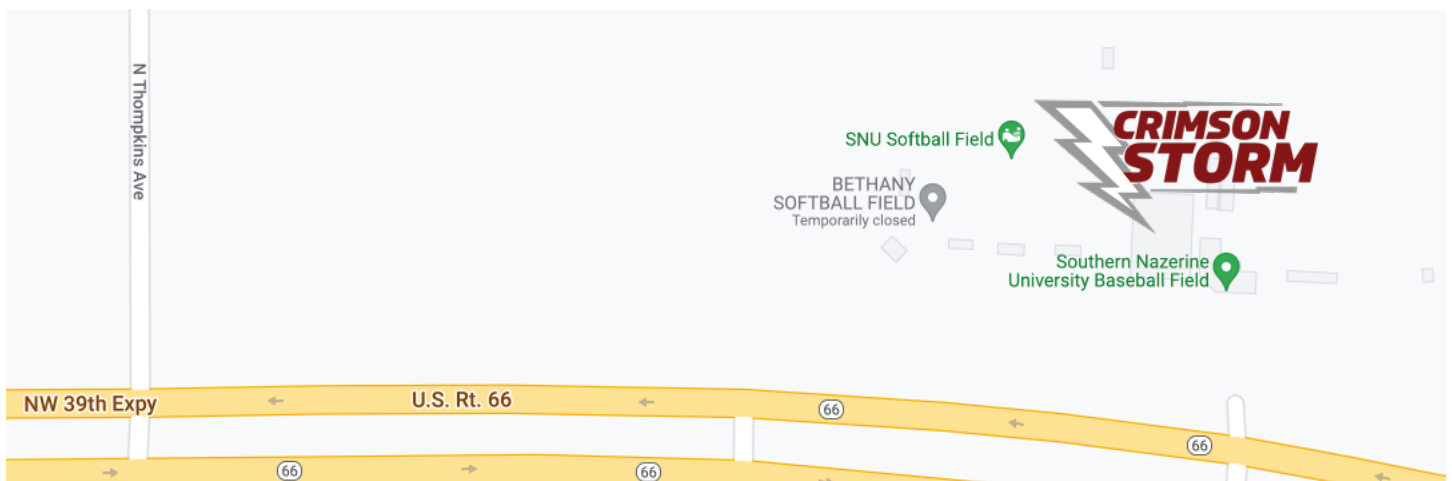

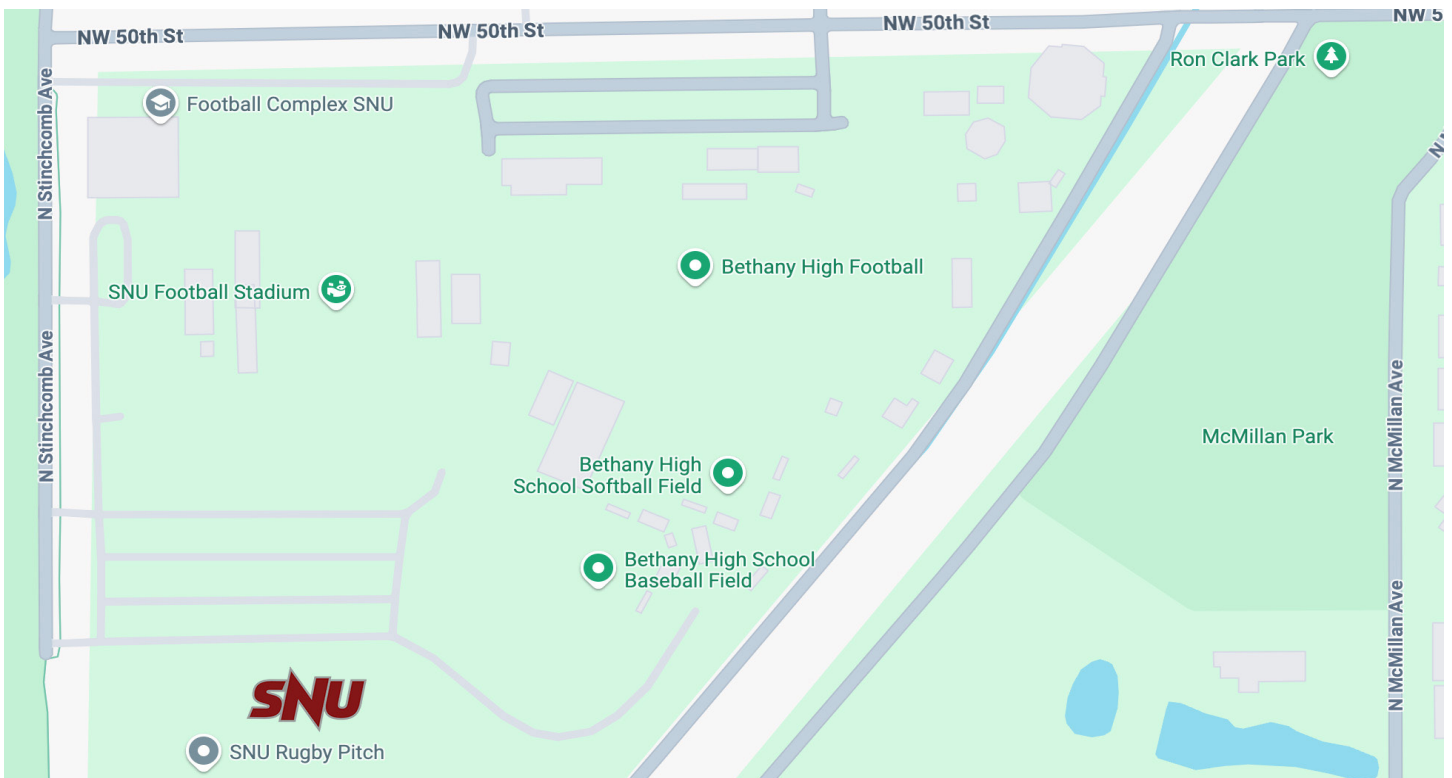
