FIRST PITCH

- ▶ Oklahoma (17-10, 3-3 Big 12) travels up to Stillwater this weekend for a Big 12 conference Bedlam series against No. 7 Oklahoma State (21-8, 5-1 Big 12) at O'Brate Stadium. Game times are 6 p.m. Friday, 8 p.m. Saturday and 3 p.m. Sunday.
- ▶ The Sooners and Cowboys met only 10 days ago (as of Friday night) at ONEOK Field in Tulsa, Okla. OU won that game 7-6 by scoring two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning.
- ▶ Saturday's game will be televised on ESPNU with Dari Nowkhah and Kyle Peterson on the call. The Friday and Sunday contests will be available via Big 12 Now on ESPN+, with Dave Hunziker and Tom Holliday on the call.
- ▶ All three games will be broadcast on the Sooner Radio Network (locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM KREF, Sportstalk1400.com and the Varsity Network app anywhere) with Toby Rowland on the call.
- ▶ Live stats will be available at OUStats.com.



▶ The Bedlam series continues a week of in-state games for the Sooners. OU defeated Oral Roberts 7-6 on Tuesday at L. Dale Mitchell Park. The Sooners also continue a stretch of 12 games against only Big 12 or in-state opponents: Baylor (March 25-27), OSU (March 29), Texas (April 1-3), ORU (April 5), at OSU (April 8-10) and Texas Tech (April 12). OU posted a 2-2 record last week (March 29-April 3) during its rivalry week against top 10-ranked rivals Oklahoma State and Texas.

LEADING OFF

- ▶ Through the first seven weeks of the season (27 games), the Sooners are 10-7 against the RPI top 100, including six top-50 wins (6-7) and three top-25 wins (3-4). OU's overall strength of schedule is ranked fourth in the country while its non-conference SOS is ranked sixth nationally.
- ▶ Oklahoma is hitting .284 as a team and averaging 6.0 runs, 9.0 hits and 2.7 extra base hits per game (47 doubles, 18 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 5.19 ERA, 243 strikeouts to 99 walks and 242 hits in 243.0 innings and has allowed a .257 opponent batting average.
- ▶ On the other side, Oklahoma State is hitting .266 as a team. The Cowboys average 6.5 runs, 9.0 hits and 3.0 extra base hits per game (55 doubles, 29 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 3.84 ERA, 319 strikeouts to 104 walks and 210 hits in 260.1 innings and has allowed a .221 opponent batting average.
- ▶ Oklahoma is in its fifth season under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson** (including the 2020 season that was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic). Johnson, who spent the 2017 season on staff as an assistant coach, has led the Sooners to a 129-90 record since taking over as head coach prior to the 2018 season.

SERIES HISTORY VS. OKLAHOMA STATE

- ▶ Oklahoma and Oklahoma State have met 308 times. OSU leads the series 163-145.
- ▶ The Sooners won a non-conference midweek contest over the Cowboys (7-6) on March 29 at ONEOK Field in Tulsa, Okla.
- ▶ The teams played each other six times last year; the Sooners won two of three games during the Big 12 conference series, but the Cowboys won both midweek games and the first-round matchup in the Big 12 Championship.
- ▶ OU is 1-1 vs. OSU at O'Brate Stadium. The Cowboys won a non-conference midweek game 5-4 in March of last year. The Sooners won the Big 12 series opener 16-2 in Stillwater.
- ▶ Oklahoma's Bedlam Big 12 series win last season was its first conference series win over OSU since 2016. The victory in Stillwater was its first since 2014.

▶ The #LaunchPad is back for 2022. For the second straight year, pledged donations to a customized dollar amount for every homer that OU baseball hits in 2022 will go towards the stadium renovation project. For more information, visit TheSoonerClub.com/LaunchPad.

▶ All donations from the Pledge Per Home Run Campaign will be treated as charitable donations supporting either the OU Softball Stadium Project or the OU Baseball Stadium Renovation Project and are tax-deductible.

BASE-SNATCHERS

- ▶ The Sooners have registered 62 stolen bases in 79 attempts through 27 games this season. OU surpassed its total from all of last year (46 steals) in the 18th game of this season. The last time Oklahoma completed a season with at least 62 steals was in 2013.
- ▶ Oklahoma ranks eighth nationally in stolen bases (62) and ninth in steals per game (2.3). Both figures rank second in the Big 12, only to West Virginia's 99 steals and average of 3.7 steals per game.
- ▶ **Kendall Pettis**, who led OU with seven steals in 2021, already has a team-high 12 stolen bases. **Tanner Tredaway** (six steals last year) and **Peyton Graham** each have 10 stolen bases, and **Blake Robertson** has seven steals so far this season. **Cade Horton** and catcher **Jimmy Crooks** each have five stolen bases.
- ▶ OU's most steals over the last 12 seasons was 98, in 2010. The Sooners registered 56 steals in 2016, 62 in 2013 and 79 steals in 2011.
- ▶ Oklahoma went off for 11 steals against Wichita State on Feb. 22. Three players — Graham, Pettis and Tredaway — each had three stolen bases in the game. Graham notched three steals again vs. Texas on April 2. It was the fourth time a single player has registered three steals in a single game this season.
- ▶ Prior to Feb. 22, no single Sooner had stolen three bases in a game since **Erik Ross** against Hartford in 2012. Oklahoma (3-1) finished the Wichita State game one steal shy of the school record of 12, set in 1937 against East Central (Okla.) University.

LAST TIME VS. OSU

- ▶ Oklahoma went 2-2 last week against two top-10 opponents and its biggest rivals in Oklahoma State and Texas. The Sooners won the initial Bedlam meeting over this season 7-6 on Tuesday at ONEOK Field in Tulsa, Okla., then took a game from Texas during the Big 12 series at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas.
- ▶ Against OSU, the Sooners scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning to erase a deficit for the second time in the game. Edmond, Okla., product **Blake Robertson**, who began his college career at Oklahoma State, hit an RBI single to score Peyton Graham and tie the game, and **Sebastian Orduno** drew a one-out, full-count bases-loaded walk to bring in the winning run in Mustang, Okla., product **Mason Lowe**.

▶ Additional freshmen and home state heroes contributed to the win. Redshirt freshman and Norman High School product **Cade Horton** doubled in OU's first run of the game, scored two runs and earned the victory in his collegiate pitching debut. He came in for the ninth inning and got a strikeout to end the frame. True freshman **Jackson Nicklaus** went 2 for 3 with three RBIs in his Bedlam debut. Vian, Okla., product **Javier Ramos** pitched 2.2 innings in relief of starter Braden Carmichael, striking out four batters.

RECAPPING THE LAST WEEK

- ▶ Oklahoma won one of three games in the Red River Rivalry against Texas at Globe Life Field, and nearly won the series. The Sooners rebounded from a 7-1 defeat on Friday night with a dramatic 4-2 victory on Saturday, and led 7-1 after six innings in the rubber game on Sunday, before Texas scored 11 straight to win 12-8. OU rebounded with an 8-2 win over Oral Roberts on Tuesday at L. Dale Mitchell Park.
- ▶ On Tuesday night, the Sooners jumped out in front of Oral Roberts with two runs in the first inning and another in the second, then tacked on two runs in the fifth and three more in the seventh inning. Five OU pitchers held the Golden Eagles to six hits and single runs in the seventh and ninth innings.

► The trio of **Peyton Graham** (3 for 4, 2 RBIs, home run), **Tanner Tredaway** (3 for 5, two RBIs, two runs) and **Blake Robertson** (2 for 4, RBI triple in first inning). **Jimmy Crooks** added a triple and two RBIs, as the second through fifth hitters in the OU lineup accounted for nine of the team's 10 hits and all seven runs batted in.

► **Braden Carmichael** allowed a hit and struck out two over his 4.0 innings, retiring nine straight to end his outing. **Carson Atwood** worked around two hits in his 2.0 frames, **Carter Campbell** struck out three of the five batters he faced in 1.1 innings and **Griffin Miller** closed it out in the ninth.

► On Saturday vs. Texas, **David Sandlin** struck out seven batters over 6.0 shutout innings and **Peyton Graham** gave Oklahoma the lead with a two-run single in the seventh inning.

► Sandlin allowed just two hits and one walk in his outing. He and UT starter Tristan Stevens allowed a combined six hits while dueling through six scoreless innings. Sandlin retired the first 11 batters of the ballgame. Trevin Michael struck out six batters over the final three frames to earn the victory.

► With the tying run on second and a full count in the bottom of the ninth, **Diego Muniz** laid out to catch a diving line drive in left field to end the game. In the eighth inning, **Kendall Pettis** scored on an error after he stole third, and Nicklaus followed with an RBI single to make it 4-1.

► **Chazz Martinez** turned in a stellar start on Sunday, taking a no-hitter into the fifth inning, and finishing with seven strikeouts and a run on four hits allowed in 5.2 innings.

► For the Texas series, Robertson led OU with a .500 batting average (5 for 10) with two walks and two runs scored. Graham hit .385 (5 for 13) with six RBIs, four stolen bases and three runs scored. **Wallace Clark** made two starts and hit .429 (3 for 7) with a pair of walks and two runs scored, and Horton hit .400 (4 for 10) with a triple, two walks and two runs scored. Pettis pinch ran once and stole two bases on his trip around.

NOTING THE SOONERS

► During the first 10 games of the season, Oklahoma scored a total of 35 runs (average of 3.5 per game). The Sooners have scored 128 runs during the last 17 games (7.5 per game). OU has scored at least seven runs in 13 of those 17 games.

► OU is 40 for 51 on stolen base attempts in the last 17 games (average of 2.4 steals per game). Thirteen different players registered at least one steal during that stretch, led by **Peyton Graham's** seven steals. **Tanner Tredaway** and **Kendall Pettis** have each registered six steals over the last 17 contests.

► **Blake Robertson** leads the Sooners with a .344 batting average (33 for 96), 25 walks and seven doubles (tied). **Peyton Graham** has team bests of seven home runs, 23 RBIs and 23 runs scored while batting .314 (32 for 102). **Tanner Tredaway** is batting .307 (31 for 101) with seven doubles, 21 RBIs and 20 runs scored.

► During its 12-game homestand (9-3 record at L. Dale Mitchell Park from March 8-27), Oklahoma turned up the offense.

The Sooners batted .336 with 40 extra base hits (average of 3.3 per game), 26 doubles, 12 home runs, 67 walks (5.6 per game) and 29 stolen bases. OU totaled 100 runs (8.3 per game) and registered 133 hits (11.1 per game).

► OU scored at least seven runs in eight straight games between March 8-19. The Sooners had a similar eight-game scoring run between March 9-21 of last season, but this was only the third occurrence in the last 11 years. Oklahoma opened the 2011 season by scoring at least seven runs in nine consecutive games.

THE "GRAHAM SLAM" VS. BAYLOR

► The Sooners called on a little "Sooner Magic" in the series-clinching victory vs. Baylor on April 26. **Peyton Graham** hit a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning, and that was after **Tanner Tredaway** hit a game-tying grand slam in the eighth inning. The home runs were the first hit of the game for either player, and Graham's first hit of the series to that point.

► The "Graham slam" is believed to be the first walk-off grand slam for Oklahoma in at least 25 years, and potentially longer. It was OU's first walk-off home run since **Renae Martinez** beat TCU in 2017.

► "That was probably the coolest thing I've ever experienced here at OU," Graham said of his game-winning grand slam.

MARTINEZ EARNED NATIONAL, BIG 12 HONORS

► **Chazz Martinez** fanned 14 batters over 7.0 innings, while allowing only three hits and one walk, in OU's series-clinching 5-1 victory over Northwestern State on Sunday. As a result, he was named the National Pitcher of the Week by the NCBWA, the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week and a national player of the week by Collegiate Baseball.

► Martinez struck out six consecutive batters across the second and third innings, then later retired nine in a row. The 14 strikeouts were the most by an OU pitcher since **Levi Prater** had 15 against Missouri State in 2019. It was also the first time a Sooner pitcher struck out six consecutive batters since **Jake Irvin** against Oklahoma State in 2018.

► Martinez was OU's first NCBWA national player of the week since **Dane Acker** on March 2, 2020, after his no-hitter vs. LSU. **Tyler Hardman** was one of Collegiate Baseball's national players of the week last season after hitting for the cycle in a game vs. Arkansas State.

BIG LEAGUE BALLPARKS

► This is the fourth straight season in which Oklahoma has played at least one game in a Major League Ballpark. OU has played nine games in big league ballparks this season — the State Farm College Baseball Showdown at the Texas Rangers' Globe Life Field (Feb. 18-20), a three-game set vs. Northwestern State at Globe Life Field (Feb. 25-27) and the Shriners Children's College Classic at the Houston Astros' Minute Maid Park (March 4-6). The Sooners played two games at Globe Life Field in 2021, three at Minute Maid Park in 2020 (Shriners College Classic) and one contest against Minnesota at Target Field in Minneapolis (2019).

► In addition to the Red River Rivalry series at Globe Life Field, the 2022 Big 12 Championship, which will include the league's top eight teams in the standings, will be held at Globe Life Field May 25-29.

► The Sooners are 5-7 in games played at Major League ballparks this season (5-4 at Globe Life Field, 0-3 at Minute Maid Park). Over the last four years, OU is a combined 9-9 in games played at MLB ballparks.



PRESEASON HONORS

► **Peyton Graham** was named on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, awarded by USA Baseball. He was also recognized as a first-team Preseason All-American by Baseball America and named to the Preseason All-Big 12 team by the league's coaches.

► **Jimmy Crooks** earned third-team preseason All-America honors from the NCBWA and Collegiate Baseball.

► Graham was ranked No. 23 on Baseball America's list of the top 150 overall players in the nation. Nine Sooners are ranked among the top 50 players in the Big 12, including seven in the top 20 and four in the top 10, according to D1Baseball: Graham at No. 3, Martinez at No. 5, Crooks at No. 7, **Cade Horton** at No. 8, Bennett at No. 16, Sandlin at No. 17, Miller at No. 20, **Creed Watkins** at No. 31 and **Tanner Tredaway** at No. 34.

OPENING DAY NOTES

► Since 1962, Oklahoma is 40-21 on opening day and is 10-4 in its last 14 season openers. The Sooners are 29-4 in home season openers since 1962, including a 25-3 mark at L. Dale Mitchell Park, which opened in 1982.

► Oklahoma opened the season at a neutral site for the third time in the last five seasons, sandwiching two wins around a loss at the State Farm College Baseball Showdown. OU began the 2020 season in Pensacola, Fla., with a three-game series against Virginia. The Sooners dropped the opener, but won two of three games in the series. In 2018, the Sooners began with four games at the Baseball at the Beach event in Conway, S.C.

OPENING DAY STARTERS

► Third-year sophomore left-hander **Jake Bennett** started on the mound for the Sooners to open the 2022 season. He was OU's first left-handed opening day starter since **Jacob Evans** in 2014. He received no decision in OU's 3-0 win over Auburn, leaving a scoreless game after five innings. Incidentally, he was the fourth "Jake" since Evans in 2014 to start on the mound for OU on opening day. Jake Elliott (2015 and '16) and Jake Irvin (2017 and '18) were the others.

NEW SOONERS DEBUTS

► Several players made their first appearance in an Oklahoma uniform during opening weekend. Junior college transfers Robertson, Sandlin, Martinez, Miller, Campbell, **Sebastian Orduno** and **Creed Watkins** all saw action. Redshirt freshman **Cade Horton**, who missed the 2021 season with an injury, started all three games at third base. True freshmen Sundloff, **Aaron Calhoun**, **Max McGwire** and **Jackson Nicklaus** made their collegiate debuts in the major league ballpark. Graduate transfer pitcher **Trevin Michael**, a Piedmont, Okla., native who came from Lamar, earned a save vs. Wichita State (Feb. 22).

WHAT RETURNED IN 2022

► The Sooners returned 18 players and welcomed 22 newcomers for the 2022 season. Among the returning lineup players are redshirt sophomore catcher **Jimmy Crooks**, redshirt sophomore infielder **Peyton Graham** and redshirt senior **Tanner Tredaway**, redshirt junior **Diego Muniz** and redshirt sophomore **Kendall Pettis** in the outfield. OU returns six pitchers from last season: redshirt sophomore **Jake Bennett** (13 starts in 2021), redshirt junior **Braden Carmichael** (14 starts), redshirt junior **Jaret Godman** (19 appearances), redshirt junior **Ben Abram** (13 appearances), redshirt sophomore **Javier Ramos** (15 appearances) and sophomore **Carson Atwood** (12 appearances).

► Oklahoma had to replace much of its production at the plate and on the mound in 2022, including three infield starters, one weekend starting pitcher and a three-year closer. Compared to the final 2021 stats, OU returns 48% of its hits, 45% of RBIs and 49% of extra base hits at the plate, and 47% of innings pitched and 41% of strikeouts on the mound.

SKIP JOHNSON

SIXTH YEAR AT OKLAHOMA, FIFTH AS HEAD COACH

560+ WINS AS A HEAD COACH • 129-90 OVERALL RECORD AT OU

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, Skip Johnson has led the Oklahoma baseball program since June 2017. Since taking over the reins after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach, he has led the Sooners to a 129-90 record in four-plus seasons.

Johnson's influence on the program began immediately and has progressed each year. The OU pitching staffs posted a progressively lower ERA in each of his first four seasons in Norman. Oklahoma's 3.92 team ERA in 2019 was only the seventh team ERA under 4.00 since 1980, and the first since 2015. In his first two seasons, Sooners pitchers posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history. A total of 17 pitchers have heard their name called in the Major League Baseball Draft since 2017 and 23 Sooners overall have been drafted by MLB teams since 2018.

Johnson earned his 100th career victory at OU with a 10-4 victory over Kansas on April 9, 2021. First baseman Tyler Hardman earned second-team All-America honors from three outlets (ABCA, NCBWA and Perfect Game) and was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft. Pitchers

Wyatt Olds (seventh round) and Jason Ruffcorn (eighth round) were also taken in the MLB Draft. Hardman won the Big 12 batting title with a .397 average — the highest by a Sooners since 2001 — and the pitching staff ranked 16th nationally by averaging 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings.

In the 2020 season shortened due to COVID-19, the Sooners compiled a 14-4 record and climbed as high as No. 9 in the national polls. In the process, OU turned in some historic performances. Dane Acker pitched Oklahoma's first individual no-hitter since 1989 against No. 11 LSU in the Shriners College Classic, and the pitching staff combined for a Big 12-record 21 strikeouts in one game against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Cade Cavalli became OU's 10th first-round selection in the regular June Major League Baseball Draft when he was selected 22nd overall. A program-record four Sooners were drafted in the first four rounds, including all three pitchers in the weekend rotation (Cavalli, Levi Prater and Acker).

Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance in 2018. The Sooners posted a 38-25 record — the highest win total since 2013 — and reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional. In the process, Oklahoma pitchers set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Outfielder Steele Walker was named a Second-Team All-American by Baseball America and the NCBWA, and pitcher Levi Prater was selected as a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Outfielder Kyler Murray, who went on to win the 2018 Heisman Trophy with the OU football team, was the ninth overall selection in the 2018 MLB Draft. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds (Walker in the second round, pitcher Jake Irvin in the fourth round, pitcher Austin Hansen in the eighth round and outfielder Cade Harris in the 10th round).

Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more in 2017, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional. Three Oklahoma pitchers were selected in the 2017 MLB Draft. Sooner closer JB Olson was drafted in the 10th round to extend a string of seven straight years with an Oklahoma player chosen in the first 10 rounds. OU saw starter Devon Perez and reliever Vincenzo Aiello selected on day three of the draft.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido, who stepped down from his position as the winningest coach in college baseball in May 2016 to take on new duties in the UT athletics department. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three College World Series appearances.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 Texas pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson also oversaw the development of six Longhorn pitchers who have made it to the big leagues. The Texas pitching staff produced a team earned run average below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons. As Texas reached its second CWS with Johnson on staff in 2011, his pitchers led the Big 12 in ERA (2.35), batting average against (.198) and strikeouts per nine innings (8.28).

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has mentored a number of players outside of those he has coached at OU, UT and Navarro, regularly working with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers, Homer Bailey of the Kansas Oakland Athletics and Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.
