LIVE STATS

- ▶ Oklahoma (31-19, 13-8 Big 12) is looking for its fifth straight Big 12 conference series victory when it concludes the regular season at Texas Tech (35-16, 14-7 Big 12) this weekend at Rip Griffin Park in Lubbock, Texas. Game times are 6:30 p.m. Thursday, 6:30 p.m. Friday and 2 p.m. Saturday.
- ▶ This weekend, the Sooners and Red Raiders are playing for at least a share of the Big 12 conference regular season title and seeding position for next week's Big 12 Championship. Oklahoma can win a share of the regular season title with three wins, while Texas Tech can win the title outright with three wins and a share with two wins.
- ▶ All three games will be televised via Big 12 Now on ESPN+, with John Harris and Mike Gustafson calling the action.
- ► The games will be broadcast on the Sooner Radio Network (locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM KREF, Sportstalk1400. com and the Varsity Network app anywhere), with Toby Rowland on the radio call.
- Live stats will be available at OUStats.com.

LEADING OFF

- ▶ Through 50 games this season, the Sooners are 18-13 against the RPI top 100, including 13 top-50 wins (13-10) and five top-25 wins (5-6). OU's overall strength of schedule is ranked 18th in the country while its non-conference SOS is ranked 35th nationally.
- ▶ Redshirt sophomore first baseman **Blake Robertson** leads the nation in walks (60) and walks per game (1.2) and ranks among the national and Big 12 leaders with his .512 OBP (13th nationally; second in Big 12) and 20 doubles (24th nationally; leads Big 12). Peyton Graham ranks second in the Big 12 and ranks 27th nationally by averaging 1.2 runs scored per game, and his 59 total runs scored rank fourth in the Big 12 and 39th in the nation.
- ▶ Oklahoma is hitting .297 as a team and averaging 7.7 runs, 9.9 hits and 3.2 extra base hits per game (106 doubles, 43 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 5.66 ERA, 435 strikeouts to 190 walks and 489 hits in 445.1 innings and has allowed a .280 opponent batting average.
- ▶ Texas Tech is hitting .297 as a team. The Red Raiders average 9.0 runs, 10.5 hits and 4.2 extra base hits per game (128 doubles, 76 home runs). The pitching staff has compiled a 5.12 ERA, 502 strikeouts to 198 walks and 441 hits in 448.1 innings and has allowed a .255 opponent batting average.
- ▶ Oklahoma has scored double-digit runs in seven of its last 12 conference games and in 10 of its last 20 games overall. The Sooners scored 40 runs in the series against West Virginia last weekend. It was the third Big 12 series this season in which OU scored at least 40 runs in three games (46 vs. Kansas and 43 vs. Kansas State).
- ▶ Oklahoma is in its fifth season under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson** (including the 2020 season that was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic). Johnson, who spent the 2017 season on staff as an assistant coach, has led the Sooners to a 143-99 record since taking over as head coach prior to the 2018 season.

SERIES HISTORY VS. TEXAS TECH

- ▶ Oklahoma leads the overall series against Texas Tech 50-44-1, though the Red Raiders have won eight of the last 11 meetings and 16 of 25 since the start of the 2014 season. In a similar number of games from 2007-13, the Sooners won 17 of 24 meetings. From 2003 through 2013, OU went 28-9 against TTU.
- ► The Sooners won the first meeting this season, 14-9, on April 12 at Hodgetown Stadium in Amarillo, Texas.
- ▶ OU won the Big 12 series opener last season, 9-8 in 10 innings. The Red Raiders the next two games by scores of 15-2 and 13-2, as well as the meeting in Amarillo (14-4).
- ► Texas Tech leads the series in Lubbock, 21-11. The Red Raiders have won three straight series played in Lubbock (2014, '16 and '18) while the Sooners last won a road series against Tech in 2012.

#LAUNCHPAD

- ► The #LaunchPad is back for 2022. For the second straight year, pledged donations to a customized dollar amount for every homer that OU baseball hits in 2022 will go towards the stadium renovation project. For more information, visit TheSoonerClub.com/LaunchPad.
- ▶ All donations from the Pledge Per Home Run Campaign will be treated as charitable donations supporting either the OU Softball Stadium Project or the OU Baseball Stadium Renovation Project and are tax-deductible.

BASE-SNATCHERS

- ► The Sooners have registered 118 stolen bases in 151 attempts through 50 games this season. OU surpassed its total from all of last year (46 steals) in the 18th game of this season.
- ▶ This is the first time an Oklahoma team has collected at least 100 stolen bases since 1996 (104) and the current total of 118 steals is the most since the 1989 season (168). This is the 13th time since 1962 that an OU team has totaled at least 100 stolen bases in a single season. The school record for steals is 192, set in 1975.
- ▶ Oklahoma ranks sixth nationally in stolen bases (118) and eighth in steals per game (2.36). Both figures rank second in the Big 12, only to West Virginia's 144 steals and average of 2.88 steals per game.
- ▶ Peyton Graham leads OU with 23 stolen bases, while Tanner Tredaway has 18 steals, Kendall Pettis has 17, Blake Robertson has 12 steals and catcher Jimmy Crooks has 10 steals. Additionally, John

Spikerman has notched nine stolen bases in his 16 games. A total of 14 players have recorded at least one stolen base this season

- ▶ Graham's 23 steals are the most by a single player since **Chris Ellison** had 24 steals in 2010. This is the first time five Sooners have recorded double digit steals in the same season since 1994 (**Rick Gutierrez** [32], **Chip Glass** [27]), **Aric Thomas** [23], **Jerry Whittaker** [14] and **Rich Hills** [10]).
- ▶ Oklahoma has registered at least 10 steals in a game twice this season. OU collected 11 steals against Wichita State on Feb. 22 (one shy of the school record set against East Central [Okla.] University in 1937), and stole 10 bases on April 16 against Pacific.
- ▶ On five occasions this season, a player has stolen three bases in a game. Three players Graham, Pettis and Tredaway each stole three bases in the Feb. 22 game vs. Wichita State. Graham notched three steals again vs. Texas on April 2 and Tredaway had three steals on April 6 at TCU. Prior to Feb. 22, no single Sooner had stolen three bases in a game since Ross against Hartford in 2012.

RECAPPING THE LAST WEEK

- ▶ Oklahoma won its Big 12 series against West Virginia last weekend in its final home games of the regular season, and fell at Wichita State on Monday night. OU defeated WVU 15-2 Friday, fell 9-8 on Saturday and won 17-7 on Sunday.
- ▶ On Friday night, **Jake Bennett** struck out seven over his six innings and **Wallace Clark** drove in four runs. **Jackson Nicklaus** put the Sooners on the board with a solo home run in the third inning, and OU put up crooked numbers in five of the next six frames. Clark's four RBIs were a season high. **Brett Squires** drove in four runs, including a two-run double with the bases loaded in the fifth inning, and **Kendall Pettis** hit two RBI singles.
- ▶ Oklahoma mounted a late rally on Saturday, scoring five runs in the final three frames, but fell short 9-8. OU trailed 6-3 in the seventh inning when **Peyton Graham** launched his 13th home run of the season to make it 6-5. The teams traded runs in the eighth inning and WVU added two runs in the top of the ninth on a home run to take a 9-7 lead.
- ▶ In the finale, **Tanner Tredaway** and Squires each homered and notched three RBIs. OU scored 10 runs over the fourth and fifth innings and put the game away with two runs in the sixth and seventh frames. Trevin Michael pitched the final 4.0 frames, striking out five batters and limiting WVU to one run and two hits.

NOTING THE SOONERS

- ► For the season, **Blake Robertson** leads the Sooners with a .348 batting average (63 for 181), 60 walks, 20 doubles and a .512 OBP. **Peyton Graham** has team bests of 13 home runs, 49 RBIs (tied) and 59 runs scored while batting .335 (67 for 200). **Tanner Tredaway** is batting .337 (69 for 205) with a teamhigh 49 RBIs (tied), 12 doubles, five homers and 41 runs scored and **Jimmy Crooks** is hitting .298 (51 for 171) with 40 walks, 29 RBIs and 37 runs scored.
- ▶ In Big 12 conference play (21 games), Robertson is batting .387 (29 for 75) with 13 doubles, 21 RBIs, 28 runs scored and 33 walks. **Wallace Clark** is batting a team-best .397 (23 for 58) in 19 games and 15 starts, and has notched 13 RBIs, 18 runs scored, five doubles and 13 walks. Graham is batting .366 (34 for 93) with 37 RBIs, eight home runs, six doubles, three triples and 33 runs scored.
- ► Crooks has thrown out 15 of 51 potential base stealers this season, including 10 of 33 in Big 12 conference play. Since April 23, Crooks has thrown out eight of 13 runners stealing. He threw out three runners stealing in four attempts in the series vs. West Virginia, which entered the weekend ranked second nationally in stolen bases.
- ▶ Robertson has reached base in every game this season, except for two (second game of a March 13 doubleheader vs. UTSA and May 16 at Wichita State), and even in the UTSA contest he drove in two runs. In other words, Robertson has had at least one productive plate appearance in all but one game this season (each of the first 49 contests). He reached base in 35 consecutive games from March 15 through May 15.
- ► Since April 2 (26 games), Robertson has batted .379/.563/.642 (36 for 95) with 30 RBIs, 33 runs, 14 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 38 walks and 18 strikeouts.
- ► Since April 10 (21 games), Graham has hit .375 (33 of 88) with 25 RBIs and 33 runs scored. Fifteen of his 20 walks this season and six of his 13 home runs have come in the last 21 games. He has improved his batting average from .304 to .335 in that time.
- ▶ Jake Bennett has lasted at least 6.0 innings in eight of his 13 starts and allowed three or fewer runs in nine starts.

NOTING THE OFFENSE

▶ Over the first 10 games of the season, Oklahoma scored a total of 35 runs (average of 3.5 per game) and did not score more than six runs in any game. Since then, the Sooners have scored 352 runs over the last 40 games (8.8 per game). OU has scored at least seven runs in 31 of those 40 games, and has posted a 26-14 record in that span (23-8 when scoring at least seven runs during the same timeframe).

- ▶ Oklahoma registered a 12-6 record during the month of April (including wins in nine of its last 11 games of the month). Offensively, the Sooners batted .312 and averaged 9.7 runs, 11.2 hits and 3.9 extra base hits in 18 April games.
- ▶ OU has posted two separate eight-game stretches scoring at least seven runs: March 8-19 and April 12-24. The Sooners had a similar eight-game scoring run between March 9-21 of last season, but have only scored at least seven runs in eight or more games four times in the last 11 years. Oklahoma opened the 2011 season by scoring at least seven runs in nine consecutive games.
- ▶ During a nine-game stretch over two weeks (March 29-April 12), the Sooners played eight games against opponents ranked among the top-8 nationally. OU went 5-4 overall during that stretch (4-4 vs. ranked foes Oklahoma State, Texas and Texas Tech).
- ▶ During its 12-game March homestand (9-3 record at L. Dale Mitchell Park from March 8-27), Oklahoma turned up the offense. The Sooners batted .336 with 40 extra base hits (average of 3.3 per game), 26 doubles, 12 home runs, 67 walks (5.6 per game) and 29 stolen bases. OU totaled 100 runs (8.3 per game) and registered 133 hits (11.1 per game).

THE "GRAHAM SLAM" VS. BAYLOR

- ► The Sooners called on a little "Sooner Magic" in the series-clinching victory vs. Baylor on April 26. **Peyton Graham** hit a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning, and that was after **Tanner Tredaway** hit a game-tying grand slam in the eighth inning. The home runs were the first hit of the game for either player, and Graham's first hit of the series to that point.
- ► The "Graham slam" is believed to be the first walk-off grand slam for Oklahoma in at least 25 years, and potentially longer. It was OU's first walk-of home run since **Renae Martinez** beat TCU in 2017.
- ▶ "That was probably the coolest thing I've ever experienced here at OU," Graham said of his game-winning grand slam.

MARTINEZ EARNED NATIONAL, BIG 12 HONORS

- ► Chazz Martinez fanned 14 batters over 7.0 innings, while allowing only three hits and one walk, in OU's series-clinching 5-1 victory over Northwestern State on Sunday. As a result, he was named the the National Pitcher of the Week by the NCBWA, the Big 12 Pitcher of the Week and a national player of the week by Collegiate Baseball.
- ► Martinez struck out six consecutive batters across the second and third innings, then later retired nine in a row. The 14 strikeouts were the most by an OU pitcher since **Levi Prater** had 15 against Missouri State in 2019. It was also the first time a Sooner pitcher struck out six consecutive batters since **Jake Irvin** against Oklahoma State in 2018.
- ► Martinez was OU's first NCBWA national player of the week since **Dane Acker** on March 2, 2020, after his no-hitter vs. LSU. **Tyler Hardman** was one of Collegiate Baseball's national players of the week last season after hitting for the cycle in a game vs. Arkansas State.



BIG LEAGUE BALLPARKS

- ▶ This is the fourth straight season in which Oklahoma has played at least one game in a Major League Ballpark. OU has played nine games in big league ballparks this season the State Farm College Baseball Showdown at the Texas Rangers' Globe Life Field (Feb. 18-20), a three-game set vs. Northwestern State at Globe Life Field (Feb. 25-27) and the Shriners Children's College Classic at the Houston Astros' Minute Maid Park (March 4-6). The Sooners played two games at Globe Life Field in 2021, three at Minute Maid Park in 2020 (Shriners College Classic) and one contest against Minnesota at Target Field in Minneapolis (2019).
- ▶ In addition to the Red River Rivalry series at Globe Life Field, the 2022 Big 12 Championship, which will include the league's top eight teams in the standings, will be held at Globe Life Field May 25-29.
- ► The Sooners are 5-7 in games played at Major League ballparks this season (5-4 at Globe Life Field, 0-3 at Minute Maid Park). Over the last four years, OU is a combined 9-9 in games played at MLB ballparks.

PRESEASON HONORS

- ▶ Peyton Graham was named on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, awarded by USA Baseball. He was also recognized as a first-team Preseason All-American by Baseball America and named to the Preseason All-Big 12 team by the league's coaches.
- ▶ **Jimmy Crooks** earned third-team preseason All-America honors from the NCBWA and Collegiate Baseball.

- ▶ Six Sooners were listed among the top players in the nation at their respective positions by D1Baseball:

- ▶ Graham was ranked No. 23 on Baseball America's list of the top 150 overall players in the nation. Nine Sooners are ranked among the top 50 players in the Big 12, including seven in the top 20 and four in the top 10, according to D1Baseball: Graham at No. 3, Martinez at No. 5, Crooks at No. 7, **Cade Horton** at No. 8, Bennett at No. 16, Sandlin at No. 17, Miller at No. 20, **Creed Watkins** at No. 31 and **Tanner Tredaway** at No. 34.

OPENING DAY NOTES

- ► Since 1962, Oklahoma is 40-21 on opening day and is 10-4 in its last 14 season openers. The Sooners are 29-4 in home season openers since 1962, including a 25-3 mark at L. Dale Mitchell Park, which opened in 1982.
- ▶ Oklahoma opened the season at a neutral site for the third time in the last five seasons, sandwiching two wins around a loss at the State Farm College Baseball Showdown. OU began the 2020 season in Pensacola, Fla., with a three-game series against Virginia. The Sooners dropped the opener, but won two of three games in the series. In 2018, the Sooners began with four games at the Baseball at the Beach event in Conway, S.C.

OPENING DAY STARTERS

▶ Third-year sophomore left-hander **Jake Bennett** started on the mound for the Sooners to open the 2022 season. He was OU's first left-handed opening day starter since **Jacob Evans** in 2014. He received no decision in OU's 3-0 win over Auburn, leaving a scoreless game after five innings. Incidentally, he was the fourth "Jake" since Evans in 2014 to start on the mound for OU on opening day. Jake Elliott (2015 and '16) and Jake Irvin (2017 and '18) were the others.

NEW SOONERS DEBUTS

► Several players made their first appearance in an Oklahoma uniform during opening weekend. Junior college transfers Robertson, Sandlin, Martinez, Miller, Campbell, **Sebastian Orduno** and **Creed Watkins** all saw action. Redshirt freshman **Cade Horton**, who missed the 2021 season with an injury, started all three games at third base. True freshmen Sundloff, **Aaron Calhoun**, **Max McGwire** and **Jackson Nicklaus** made their collegiate debuts in the major league ballpark. Graduate transfer pitcher **Trevin Michael**, a Piedmont, Okla., native who came from Lamar, earned a save vs. Wichita State (Feb. 22).

WHAT RETURNED IN 2022

- ► The Sooners returned 18 players and welcomed 22 newcomers for the 2022 season. Among the returning lineup players are redshirt sophomore catcher **Jimmy Crooks**, redshirt sophomore infielder **Peyton Graham** and redshirt senior **Tanner Tredaway**, redshirt junior **Diego Muniz** and redshirt sophomore **Kendall Pettis** in the outfield. OU returns six pitchers from last season: redshirt sophomore **Jake Bennett** (13 starts in 2021), redshirt junior **Braden Carmichael** (14 starts), redshirt junior **Jaret Godman** (19 appearances), redshirt junior **Ben Abram** (13 appearances), redshirt sophomore **Javier Ramos** (15 appearances) and sophomore **Carson Atwood** (12 appearances).
- ▶ Oklahoma had to replace much of its production at the plate and on the mound in 2022, including three infield starters, one weekend starting pitcher and a three-year closer. Compared to the final 2021 stats, OU returns 48% of its hits, 45% of RBIs and 49% of extra base hits at the plate, and 47% of innings pitched and 41% of strikeouts on the mound.

OKLAHOMA BASEBALL 2022 GAME NOTES





SKIP JOHNSON

SIXTH YEAR AT OKLAHOMA, FIFTH AS HEAD COACH 560+ WINS AS A HEAD COACH • 143-99 OVERALL RECORD AT OU



idely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, Skip Johnson has led the Oklahoma baseball program since June 2017. Since taking over the reins after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach, he has led the Sooners to a 143-99 record in four-plus seasons.

Johnson's influence on the program began immediately and has progressed each year. The OU pitching staffs posted a progressively lower ERA in each of his first four seasons in Norman. Oklahoma's 3.92 team ERA in 2019 was only the seventh team ERA under 4.00 since 1980, and the first since 2015. In his first two seasons, Sooners pitchers posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history. A total of 17 pitchers have heard their name called in the Major League Baseball Draft since 2017 and 23 Sooners overall have been drafted by MLB teams since 2018.

Johnson earned his 100th career victory at OU with a 10-4 victory over Kansas on April 9, 2021. First baseman Tyler Hardman earned second-team All-America honors from three outlets (ABCA, NCBWA and Perfect Game) and was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft. Pitchers

Wyatt Olds (seventh round) and Jason Ruffcorn (eighth round) were also taken in the MLB Draft. Hardman won the Big 12 batting title with a .397 average — the highest by a Sooners since 2001 — and the pitching staff ranked 16th nationally by averaging 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings.

In the 2020 season shortened due to COVID-19, the Sooners compiled a 14-4 record and climbed as high as No. 9 in the national polls. In the process, OU turned in some historic performances. Dane Acker pitched Oklahoma's first individual no-hitter since 1989 against No. 11 LSU in the Shriners College Classic, and the pitching staff combined for a Big 12-record 21 strikeouts in one game against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Cade Cavalli became OU's 10th first-round selection in the regular June Major League Baseball Draft when he was selected 22nd overall. A program-record four Sooners were drafted in the first four rounds, including all three pitchers in the weekend rotation (Cavalli, Levi Prater and Acker).

Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance in 2018. The Sooners posted a 38-25 record – the highest win total since 2013 – and reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional. In the process, Oklahoma pitchers set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Outfielder Steele Walker was named a Second-Team All-American by Baseball America and the NCBWA, and pitcher Levi Prater was selected as a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Outfielder Kyler Murray, who went on to win the 2018 Heisman Trophy with the OU football team, was the ninth overall selection in the 2018 MLB Draft. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds (Walker in the second round, pitcher Jake Irvin in the fourth round, pitcher Austin Hansen in the eighth round and outfielder Cade Harris in the 10th round).

Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more in 2017, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional. Three Oklahoma pitchers were selected in the 2017 MLB Draft. Sooner closer JB Olson was drafted in the 10th round to extend a string of seven straight years with an Oklahoma player chosen in the first 10 rounds. OU saw starter Devon Perez and reliever Vincenzo Aiello selected on day three of the draft.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido, who stepped down from his position as the winningest coach in college baseball in May 2016 to take on new duties in the UT athletics department. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three College World Series appearances.

During his tenure in Austin, 32 Texas pitchers were selected in the MLB Draft, including 14 in the first 10 rounds and three first-round picks. Johnson also oversaw the development of six Longhorn pitchers who have made it to the big leagues. The Texas pitching staff produced a team earned run average below 3.00 on five occasions and struck out better than 7.5 per-nine-innings in five of his last eight seasons. As Texas reached its second CWS with Johnson on staff in 2011, his pitchers led the Big 12 in ERA (2.35), batting average against (.198) and strikeouts per nine innings (8.28).

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has mentored a number of players outside of those he has coached at OU, UT and Navarro, regularly working with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers, Homer Bailey of the Kansas Oakland Athletics and Chris Davis of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.
