FIRST PITCH

- ▶ Oklahoma (18-16, 3-6 Big 12) plays host to No. 21 Texas Tech (23-11, 4-5 Big 12) for a three-game Big 12 conference series this weekend at L. Dale Mitchell Park. Game times are set for 6:30 p.m. Friday, 4 p.m. Saturday and 2 p.m. Sunday.
- ► This will be the first meeting between the Red Raiders and Sooners and the second Big 12 home conference series this season. Oklahoma earned a 2-1 series victory over then-No. 11 TCU March 17-19.
- ▶ The games will be televised via SoonerVision on ESPN+, with Chad McKee and George Frazier on the call on Friday, and Toby Rowland and Frazier on the call for Saturday and Sunday.
- ► The radio broadcast will be carried on the Sooner Radio Network (locally on Sportstalk 99.3 FM/1400 AM KREF, Sportstalk1400.com and the Varsity Network app anywhere). Rowland will have the radio call for all three games and will be joined by Frazier in a TV simulcast on Saturday and Sunday.
- ► Live stats will be available via OUStats.com.
- ▶ Oklahoma is celebrating its 125th anniversary season in 2023. The program was established in 1898, and OU has competed in 118 seasons since (including 2023).

TICKETS/PROMOTIONS

- ► Tickets are available via SoonerSports.com. Mini plans and flex packages are available for all remaining home games.
- ▶ The L. Dale Mitchell Park ticket office and entrance gates will open two hours prior to the scheduled game time. The ticket office and will call windows are located behind home plate, along W. Imhoff Rd.
- ▶ On Friday, fans can take advantage of \$2 concession pricing on 12 oz. beers and a postgame fireworks display.
- ► Saturday is Bark in the Park. Must sign liability waiver upon arrival at the entrance gate. Every Sunday OU home contest is Sunday Runday. Kids 12 and under can run the bases on the field following the game.

LEADING OFF

- ▶ Oklahoma is in its sixth season under the direction of head coach **Skip Johnson** (including the 2020 season that was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic). Johnson, who spent the 2017 season on staff as an assistant coach, has led the Sooners to a 175-120 record, two NCAA Tournament appearances, the 2022 Big 12 tournament championship and the 2022 College World Series finals since taking over as head coach prior to the 2018 season.
- ▶ Oklahoma ranks eighth nationally and third in the Big 12 with its 205 walks, and ranks 16th nationally and fourth in the Big 12 with its 74 stolen bases. OU batters have also been hit by a pitch 42 times, totaling 247 free passes (an average of 7.2 free passes per game).
- ► The Sooners also rank third nationally with their 26 sacrifice flies (second in the Big 12 to nation-leading 31 by Texas Tech) and 19th nationally with 12 triples (second in Big 12; league leader Texas Tech has 14 triples).

▶ Junior right fielder **Bryce Madron** has registered a nation-leading 42 walks in the season's first 34 games. He also ranks third nationally and first in the Big 12 by averaging 1.2 walks per contest. Freshman catcher **Easton Carmichael** is tied for the Big 12 lead, tied for 15th nationally and ranks second among catchers with his four triples. Junior infielder **Anthony Mackenzie** ranks 22nd nationally and second in the Big 12 with his 19 stolen bases (in 22 attempts). Junior **Carter Campbell** is fifth nationally and first in the Big 12 with his 19 pitching appearances (national leaders have made 23 appearances). Graduate senior **Braxton Douthit** ranks third in the country and leads the Big 12 by allowing 4.6 hits per nine innings.

- ▶ Mackenzie and Madron have each reached in 2 straight contests. Carmichael leads the team with 12 multiple-hit games, Mackenzie and junior infielder **Dakota Harris** each have 11 multiple-hit games and freshman **Rocco Garza-Gongora** and Madron have 10. Carmichael leads the team with 10 multiple-RBI games while Harris has eight.
- ▶ The Sooners have registered 74 stolen bases in 96 attempts (77%) through the first 34 games of the season, which is slightly ahead of the pace set through 33 games of the 2022 season (70 for 91). Last year, OU registered 145 steals, the most by an Oklahoma club since 1989 (168 steals).
- ▶ Carmichael leads the team with 34 RBIs and is batting .325 (39 for 120). He has thrown out seven baserunners stealing. Mackenzie is batting .346 (47 for 136) and leads the team with 33 runs scored. Fourth-year junior outfielder **Kendall Pettis** is batting .333 (27 for 81) with 27 runs scored, five doubles, 20 walks and nine stolen bases. He has hit .413 (19 for 46) with 15 runs, four doubles, a home run, a triple and six steals in his last 13 games (12 starts) since March 19.
- ▶ Oklahoma is batting .285 and averaging 6.6 runs, 9.4 hits, 2.7 extra base hits, 6.0 walks and 2.1 stolen bases per game, and has a 5.38 team ERA and a .965 fielding percentage. OU opponents have batted .258 and averaged 6.1 runs, 8.9 hits, 3.2 extra base hits, 4.5 walks and 7.1 strikeouts per contest.
- ▶ The Red Raiders are batting .319 and averaging 9.3 runs, 11.3 hits, 3.2 extra base hits and 6.2 walks per game and have a 4.50 team ERA and .959 fielding percentage. Texas Tech opponents have batted .255 and averaged 5.9 runs, 8.8 hits, 3.3 extra base hits, 5.2 walks and 9.0 strikeouts per contest.

SERIES HISTORY VS. TEXAS TECH

- ▶ Oklahoma leads the overall series against Texas Tech 53-45-1, and holds a 27-17-1 advantage in Norman.
- ► The Sooners won four of five meetings last season, defeating the Red Raiders in a midweek contest in Amarillo, two of three times in Lubbock and in the Big 12 tournament in Arlington, Texas.
- ▶ Prior to last year, TTU had won eight of the last 11 meetings and 16 of 25 from the 2014 through 2021 seasons. In a similar number of games from 2007-13, the Sooners won 17 of 24 meetings. From 2003 through 2013, OU went 28-9 against TTU.
- ▶ In 2021, OU won the series opener, 9-8 in 10 innings, but the Red Raiders won the next two games by scores of 15-2 and 13-2, as well as the meeting in Amarillo (14-4).
- ▶ Oklahoma last won a series against Texas Tech in Norman in 2017.

#CHAOUS

- ▶ The Sooners have registered 74 stolen bases in 96 attempts (77%) through the first 34 games of the season, which is about the same as its pace through 33 games of the 2022 season (70 for 91). Last year, OU registered 145 steals, the most by an Oklahoma club since 1989 (168 steals).
- ▶ Anthony Mackenzie leads the Sooners and ranks 22nd nationally with his 19 steals (in 22 attempts). John Spikerman is second on the team with 13 steals (13 for 15) and **Kendall Pettis** and **Bryce Madron** have each swiped 10 bases. Twelve players have stolen at least one base this season and six players have notched at leas four stolen bases.
- ▶ Mackenzie has stolen three bases in a game twice this season (vs. Abilene Christian on Feb. 22 and vs. Rider on Feb. 25). On 11 occasions, an OU player has stolen at least two bases in a game. Oklahoma registered a season-high eight steals against Rider on Feb. 25 and has stolen at least three bases seven times this season.
- ▶ #CHAOUS is not only about just stealing bases, but also about being aggressive on offense and putting pressure on the defense. While Oklahoma ranks 16th nationally in steals (74) and 20th in steals per game (2.1), it also ranks eighth nationally in walks (205) and batters have been hit by a pitch 42 times. The Sooners also have 13 sacrifice bunts and 26 sacrifice flies (which ranks third in the country). OU opponents have committed 42 errors (.969 fielding percentage).

idely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, Skip Johnson has led the Oklahoma baseball program since June 2017. Since taking over the reins after serving one year as the Sooners' pitching coach, he has led the Sooners to a 175-120 record in five-plus seasons and a College World Series finals appearance in 2022.

Johnson led Oklahoma to its 11th College World Series appearance (first since 2010) and its first Big 12 tournament championship since 2013. He was named the 2022 ABCA Central Region Coach of the Year.

The Sooners completed a postseason run entirely away from home to finish as national runners-up, winning the Big 12 Championship in Arlington, Texas, the NCAA Gainesville Regional and the NCAA Blacksburg Super Regional to reach the pinnacle of college baseball in Omaha, Neb. OU went 3-0 in bracket play, defeating Texas A&M twice and Notre Dame to reach the CWS finals. The postseason capped an incredible turnaround in which Oklahoma posted a 27-12 record from April 12 through the end of the season after starting the year 18-12.

Overall, Oklahoma ended the 2022 season with a 45-24 record and a 15-9 mark in Big 12 Conference play. OU's 45 wins were the most since 2010, the 15 conference wins were its most since 2010 (15-10), and its second-place finish in the regular season standings was its highest since 2010. The Sooners registered at least 40 victories for the 24th time in program history, and first since 2013. Furthermore, Oklahoma won its final six regular season series and won at least two games each week for 10 straight weeks to end the year.

The 2022 squad set numerous benchmarks. The pitching staff totaled a school record 644 strikeouts. OU's 145 stolen bases were the most in a season since 1989 (168 steals). The team's 73 home runs were its most since 2010 (105) and its .293 batting average was the highest since the 2011 season (.313).

A total of 11 players were selected in the 2022 Major League Baseball Draft, including pitcher Cade Horton, who was picked seventh overall. He became the third first-rounder in Johnson's tenure, joining outfielder Kyler Murray (ninth overall in 2018) and pitcher Cade Cavalli (22nd overall in 2020). Pitcher Jake Bennett and shortstop Peyton Graham were chosen in the second, catcher Jimmy Crooks went in the fourth round, first baseman Blake Robertson was picked in the seventh round, closer Trevin Michael and outfielder Tanner Tredaway were selected in the 10th round and pitcher David Sandlin went in the 11th round of the 2022 draft. It was the second time in three years that OU's entire weekend rotation was drafted.

While 2022 was a tremendous success, Johnson's influence on the program began immediately. The OU pitching staffs posted a progressively lower ERA in each of his first four seasons in Norman. Oklahoma's 3.92 team ERA in 2019 was only the seventh team ERA under 4.00 since 1980, and the first since 2015. In his first two seasons, Sooners pitchers posted two of the top five strikeout totals in program history. A total of 24 pitchers have heard their name called in the Major League Baseball Draft since 2017 and 31 Sooners overall have been drafted by MLB teams since 2018.

Johnson earned his 100th career victory at OU with a 10-4 victory over Kansas on April 9, 2021. First baseman Tyler Hardman earned second-team All-America honors from three outlets (ABCA, NCBWA and Perfect Game) and was selected in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft. Pitchers Wyatt Olds (seventh round) and Jason Ruffcorn (eighth round) were also taken in the MLB Draft. Hardman won the Big 12 batting title with a .397 average — the highest by a Sooners since 2001 — and the pitching staff ranked 16th nationally by averaging 10.6 strikeouts per nine innings.

In the 2020 season shortened due to COVID-19, the Sooners compiled a 14-4 record and climbed as high as No. 9 in the national polls. In the process, OU turned in some historic performances. Dane Acker pitched Oklahoma's first individual no-hitter since 1989 against No. 11 LSU in the Shriners College Classic, and the pitching staff combined for a Big 12-record 21 strikeouts in one game against Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Cade Cavalli became OU's 10th first-round selection in the regular June Major League Baseball Draft when he was selected 22nd overall. A program-record four Sooners were drafted in the first four rounds, including all three pitchers in the weekend rotation (Cavalli, Levi Prater and Acker).

Johnson coached OU to the program's 38th NCAA Regional appearance in 2018. The Sooners posted a 38-25 record – the highest win total since 2013 – and reached the finals of the Tallahassee Regional. In the process, Oklahoma pitchers set a school record with 608 strikeouts. Outfielder Steele Walker was named a Second-Team All-American by Baseball America and the NCBWA, and pitcher Levi Prater was selected as a Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball. Outfielder Kyler Murray, who went on to win the 2018 Heisman Trophy with the OU football team, was the ninth overall selection in the 2018 MLB Draft. Nine players were drafted, including five in the first 10 rounds (Walker in the second round, pitcher Jake Irvin in the fourth round, pitcher Austin Hansen in the eighth round and outfielder Cade Harris in the 10th round).

Oklahoma pitchers surrendered the fewest home runs in the Big 12 Conference in 2017 and combined for 531 strikeouts to rank fourth in the league and fourth in OU single-season history. The Sooners' 9.26 strikeouts per nine innings ranked second in the conference. As a team, OU pitchers struck out 10 or more batters on 24 occasions.

Sooner pitchers combined for 17 starts of six innings or more in 2017, including the first two games of the Louisville Regional. Three Oklahoma pitchers were selected in the 2017 MLB Draft. Sooner closer JB Olson was drafted in the 10th round to extend a string of seven straight years with an Oklahoma player chosen in the first 10 rounds. OU saw starter Devon Perez and reliever Vincenzo Aiello selected on day three of the draft.

Prior to coming to Oklahoma, Johnson spent a 25-year coaching career in the state of Texas, including the most recent 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach at the University of Texas.

Johnson was hired as the pitching coach at Texas for the 2007 season under Augie Garrido, who stepped down from his position as the winningest coach in college baseball in May 2016 to take on new duties in the UT athletics department. In 10 seasons, Johnson helped the Longhorns to seven NCAA Regional appearances, four Super Regionals and three College World Series appearances.

Prior to his time in Austin, Johnson was the head coach for 13 years at Navarro College of the NJCAA's Texas Eastern Athletic Conference. From 1994-2006, he guided the Bulldogs to 13 NJCAA Regionals, nine TEAC championships and four regional titles while compiling 450 wins.

Johnson has mentored a number of players outside of those he has coached at OU, UT and Navarro, regularly working with three-time Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw of the Los Angeles Dodgers, Homer Bailey, formerly of the Cincinnati Reds, and Chris Davis, formerly of the Baltimore Orioles, among others.

A standout baseball player at Denton High School, Johnson began his collegiate playing career at Ranger (Texas) College. After a two-year career there, Johnson moved on to play baseball at the University of North Texas in 1988 before the school dropped its baseball program. He completed his collegiate playing career at UT-Pan American, lettering for the Broncs in 1989 and receiving his bachelor's degree in 1990. Johnson earned a master's degree in education from UT-Tyler in 1993.

A native of Denton, Texas, Johnson and his wife, Cathy, have two sons, Tyler and Garrett.
