LEADING OFF

- **Q** Three-time defending national champion No. 1/1 Oklahoma Softball begins its 2024 campaign with a trip to the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. The Sooners open the season on Thursday, Feb. 8 against Utah Valley at 10:30 a.m. CT before meeting No. 11/9 Duke at 1 p.m.
- **Q** OU faces No. 10/7 Washington on Friday, Feb. 9 at 8:30 p.m. then closes its trip to Mexico with a 1 p.m. start vs. Long Beach State on Saturday, Feb. 10.
- **Q** All four games will be played at Nancy Almaraz Stadium in Puerto Vallarta. Live streaming will be available via FloSoftball (\$) in addition to radio coverage by The Franchise. Thursday's pair of opening-day games will be broadcast on 1560 AM/103.3 FM The Franchise 2 with Friday's and Saturday's contests airing on 107.7 FM The Franchise
- **Q** Three of Oklahoma's four opening-weekend opponents reached the NCAA Tournament last season. Washington advanced to the Women's College World Series, Duke was eliminated by Stanford in the Super Regionals and Long Beach State earned a berth in the Stanford Regional.

RETURNING TO PUERTO VALLARTA

- **Q** The 2024 Puerto Vallarta College Challenge marks Oklahoma's third appearance south of the border. OU last participated in the 2020 event, going 4-0 and outscoring its opponents 27-9. The Sooners competed in the 2017 tournament and went 2-2.
- Widely regarded as one of the premier tournaments designed to launch the softball season, the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge began in 2015. It was the first Division I softball event held outside of the United States.

2023 IN REVIEW

- The Sooners capped a national championship season in 2023 with a 61-1 record, the best win percentage in NCAA Division I softball history (.984) and Big 12 regular season and tournament titles while pacing the country in a plethora of categories, including ERA (0.96), batting average (.367) and fielding percentage (.988).
- **Q** The dominant run included an NCAA-record 53-game win streak, a nation-best and program-record 35 shutouts, 29 wins by run rule and a 28-0 record vs. ranked opponents.
- **Q** Additionally, OU ranked No. 1 over the final 11 weeks of the 2023 season in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and has held the top spot in 42 of the last 43 polls dating back to 2021.
- **Q** A nation-high five Sooners were named NFCA First Team All-Americans, eight Sooners earned All-Big 12 accolades and five were tabbed WCWS All-Tournament Team selections.

COACHES' FAVORITES

- **Q** Oklahoma will enter the season as the unanimous No. 1 in the USA Today/NFCA Top 25 for the third consecutive campaign. The National Fastpitch Coaches Association announced the preseason poll on Jan. 30.
- **Q** Oklahoma's No. 1 spot in the NFCA poll marks the fifth time the Sooners enter a season in the top spot (2017, '18, '22, '23, '24) and the fourth time OU has been the unanimous choice in the coaches poll, joining the 2017, 2022 and 2023 squads.
- **Q** OU received 800 total points and all 32 first-place votes to lead No. 2 Tennessee (731 points). Florida State (729) and Stanford (729) share the No. 3 ranking while No. 5 Clemson (579) rounds out the top five.

- **Q** Additionally, it's the 13th straight year the Sooners have started in the NFCA's top 10, good for the nation's longest active streak. OU has been ranked in the top five 11 of the past 12 years, the most over that stretch.
- **Q** Overall, the Sooners are now alone in second with 24 top-10 appearances in the NFCA preseason poll, trailing only UCLA's 25.
- **Q** Oklahoma, UCLA and Washington are the only programs to be ranked in every NFCA preseason poll, which dates back to 1995. OU also extended its streak of being the only program ranked every week in the 29-year existence of the NFCA's poll, 422 straight polls.

LEADING THE USA POLL

- **Q** The Sooners will also enter the season as the unanimous No. 1 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Preseason Top 25 for the third consecutive campaign. USA Softball announced the preseason poll Jan. 23.
- The Sooners received 625 points and all 25 first-place votes to hold the top spot coming off the program's third consecutive and seventh overall national title in 2023.
- **Q** Tennessee was voted second with 557 points and Stanford third with 546. Florida State (530 points) and Texas (496) round out the top five.
- **Q** This marks the fifth time in program history that the Sooners enter the season as the top-ranked team, joining the 2017, '18, '22 and '23 squads. The Sooners have been ranked in the preseason top 10 for 17 straight seasons and 20 overall in the 22-year history of the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll.

CLIMBING THE LADDER

Q Head coach Patty Gasso is just one win from reaching former longtime Fresno State head coach Margie Wright (1,457) for third all-time in career NCAA victories. Gasso has 1,456 career wins at the NCAA level, all earned during her tenure at OU. Carol Hutchins is the all-time leader in career wins with 1,707 while Mike Candrea is second with 1,674.

CO-CAPTAINS

- **Q** Graduate catcher Kinzie Hansen and senior infielder Tiare Jennings will both wear the "C" on their jerseys in 2024 as the Sooners' co-captains.
- **Q** Hansen, the 2023 Johnny Bench Award winner, blasted 13 home runs and drove in 57 runs last season while slashing .409/.438/.759 for a 1.197 OPS as the Sooners' backstop. The graduate student ranks sixth in program history with a .734 career slugging percentage and 10th with 49 home runs. Hansen's work behind the plate defensively is equally impressive as she owns a .993 career fielding percentage and has thrown out 36% of would-be base stealers.
- **Q** One of the most accomplished hitters in program history, Jennings enters her senior campaign ranked among OU's career leaders in multiple offensive categories. A career .427 hitter with 73 home runs, 49 doubles and 245 RBIs to her credit, Jennings is second in program history in batting average, third in home runs, slugging percentage, runs batted in and extra-base hits, fourth in total bases, fifth in doubles and eighth in runs scored and on-base percentage. Jennings slashed .415/.477/.781 last season for a 1.258 OPS while belting 17 home runs and 16 doubles and registering 66 RBIs.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- Multiple Sooners have garnered preseason honors from the Big 12, Softball America and D1 Softball entering 2024.
- **Q** Senior pitchers Nicole May and Kelly Maxwell, senior outfielders Rylie Boone and Jayda Coleman, senior infielders Alyssa Brito and Tiare Jennings and senior catcher Kinzie Hansen were among the 19 players chosen to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team by the league's head coaches. Jennings was one of three unanimous selections to the team.
- **Q** Oklahoma was one of just two programs to have multiple selections as Texas ranked second with five representatives. Baylor, BYU, Houston, Iowa State, Oklahoma State and Texas Tech each had one honoree. Student-athletes were chosen regardless of position and coaches could not vote for their own players.
- Maxwell, Coleman, Jennings, Brito and Hansen each added first-team preseason All-America honors from both Softball America and D1 Softball while May received a second-team nod from Softball America. Oklahoma led all programs with its five first-team honorees.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR, PART XVI

- Three-time All-American and reigning Big 12 Player of the Year Jayda Coleman returns to the Sooners as one of the most dynamic players in the nation. Last season the then-junior slashed .408/.533/.788 for a 1.320 OPS from the leadoff spot while adding 15 doubles, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 16 steals in 17 tries (94.1%).
- **Q** Coleman enters her final season ranked among the program's career leaders in multiple categories including on-base percentage (3rd, .533), batting average (3rd, .425), slugging percentage (7th, .719), walks drawn (8th, 125), runs scored (9th, 211) and stolen bases (10th, 49).
- **Q** The Big 12 POTY honor marked OU's fourth consecutive claim of the league's most valuable player award. Jocelyn Alo was named player of the year in 2021 and 2022 while Sydney Romero earned the honor in 2019. Oklahoma has garnered 16 Big 12 Player of the Year honors, 12 more than the next highest mark.

MAY DAY

Q Senior righthander Nicole May enters her senior season with a 48-3 career record and a 1.47 ERA across 285.0 innings in the circle, ranking second in program history with a .941 career winning percentage and seventh with 8.0 strikeouts per 7.0 innings pitched. Last season May went 18-0 with a 0.91 ERA while striking out 130 batters over 107.2 innings. She limited opposing batters to a .161 average and recorded the nation's third-best ERA.

MARVELOUS MAXWELL

Q Graduate lefthander Kelly Maxwell joins the Sooners as a transfer in 2024 following a terrific four-season stretch at Oklahoma State. The lefthander has won 58 collegiate games while posting a 1.58 ERA and striking out 746 batters over 494.2 innings pitched (10.6 K/7). A two-year All-America selection, Maxwell earned second-team honors last spring after going 16-7 with a 1.91 ERA and 229 strikeouts in 142.2 innings.

RELIABLE RYLIE

Q Super-senior outfielder Rylie Boone begins her fifth season with OU in 2024 and ranks fourth in program history with a .405 career batting average in 181 collegiate games. A mainstay in the outfield the past two campaigns, Boone hit .392 last season while scoring 38 runs, stealing five bases and drawing 22 walks. She has provided impressive defense in the corners throughout her career, recording eight outfield assists over the past three seasons.

ANCHORING THE INFIELD

Q Senior infielder Alyssa Brito has been a fixture in the Oklahoma lineup since joining the program in 2022, hitting .392 with a 1.251 OPS, 24 doubles, 31 home runs and 106 RBIs across 123 games in the Crimson and Cream. A first-team All-America selection last season, Brito blasted 17 home runs and drove in 60 runs with a .412 batting average as the everyday third baseman. She fielded a strong .960 with just five errors, making a terrific impact both at the plate and in the field.

NEW THREADS

- **Q** The Sooners added four transfers ahead of the 2024 campaign, providing depth at a key position and filling key areas of need on the pitching staff.
- Right-handed pitcher Karlie Keeney, catcher Riley Ludlam and left-handed pitcher Kelly Maxwell joined the program as graduate transfers while righthander Paytn Monticelli came to OU with three

years of eligibility remaining.

- Keeney joined the Sooners following a tremendous four-year career at Liberty. The three-time All-ASUN Second Team selection owns a career 2.32 ERA across 665.0 innings of work while pitching to a 69-29 record. Known for her ability to carve through a lineup, she has limited opponents to an OPS below .632 each of her last three seasons.
- **Q** Ludlam came to the Sooners after four seasons at Furman where she was a career .309 hitter with 45 doubles, 25 home runs and 117 RBIs. The NFCA All-South Region Second Team selection started 49 games for the Paladins last year, hitting .372 with 10 home runs, 15 doubles and 41 RBIs.
- Maxwell headed southwest to OU following a terrific four-season stretch at Oklahoma State. The lefthander has won 58 collegiate games while posting a 1.58 ERA and striking out 746 batters over 494.2 innings pitched (10.6 K/7). A two-year All-America selection, Maxwell earned second-team honors last spring after going 16-7 with a 1.91 ERA and 229 strikeouts in 142.2 innings.
- **Q** Monticelli joined the Sooners following one season at Wisconsin. The hard-throwing righthander led the Badgers in strikeouts with 82 over 80.1 innings, setting the program's singleseason punchout record while going 7-4 with a 2.71 ERA. She walked just 21 to record a solid 3.90 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

Oklahoma head coach Patty Gasso announced on Jan. 29 that JT Gasso has been elevated to associate head coach.

1 JT Gasso, who has served the past eight seasons as Oklahoma's assistant coach, will continue to serve as the hitting coach, directing the offense and working with the outfielders.

• During JT Gasso's tenure, the Sooners have won seven Big 12 regular season titles and four Big 12 tournament crowns (the tournament was not played during Gasso's first season, finished in 2019 or played in 2020) while making seven Women's College World Series appearances and winning five national titles.

• Gasso's lineup has produced nearly 7.8 runs per game over his eight seasons on staff while posting a .350/.439/.613 slash line for a 1.052 OPS. OU has blasted 800 home runs over that span, has struck out in just 9.2% of its plate appearances and has drawn walks at an 11.6% clip during his tenure. His hitters have earned two USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year awards and have garnered six Big 12 Player of the Year honors. Oklahoma led the NCAA in batting average in 2019, 2021, 2022 and 2023 and owns single-season national records for home runs (161), team batting average (.405), slugging (.778), on base percentage (.490), runs scored (638) and total bases (1,279), all set in

Q Love's Field, the new home of Oklahoma softball officially opens March 1, 2024.

The facility features a 10,669-square-foot indoor training center and several team spaces, including a training room, locker room and classroom. It also has space for a recognition area to showcase national championships, All-Americans and other outstanding accomplishments.

• Constructed at the northwest corner of South Jenkins Avenue and Imhoff Road, Love's Field is approximately one-half mile south of the current stadium location and will accommodate a capacity of 4,200.

The complex's overall square footage is 44,000, compared to 15,168 at Marita Hynes Field, OU's previous facility. The team areas grew from 2,598 square feet to 5,593 square feet and the indoor practice facility jumped from 4,744 square feet to 10,669 square feet.

Entering her 30th season at the University of Oklahoma in 2024, NFCA Hall of Fame head coach Patty Gasso has molded the OU softball program into a national power and permanently placed herself among the elite college softball coaches in the country.

Oklahoma has won seven national championships (2000, 2013, 2016, 2017, 2021, 2022 and 2023) and is one of just three programs in NCAA history to win more than two national titles. Gasso has reached the Women's College World Series 16 times during her tenure, and has advanced to the postseason in each one of her 29 seasons (no tournament in 2020).

With 33 seasons as a head coach to her name, Gasso has a career collegiate coaching record of 1,617-404-3 (.799) and holds a record of 1,456-345-2 (.808) at OU.

She has won more Big 12 games (394-87; .819) than any coach in the league's history and has more than twice as many overall wins as any other coach in OU annals. The Sooners have claimed 15 Big 12 regular season titles, including an unprecedented 11 straight since the 2012 season, and eight conference tournament titles under her direction. Gasso's teams have finished second or higher 23 times in the 27 years since the inception of the Big 12 in 1996.

Numerous Sooner players have prospered under Gasso's tutelage and garnered national, regional and conference recognition. Most recently, Jocelyn Alo helped lead the Sooners to back-to-back titles en route to winning consecutive USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year awards in 2021 and 2022. Keilani Ricketts was also a two-time USA Softball Player of the Year in 2012 and 2013. Gasso has recruited and coached 79 All-Americans, 145 All-Region honors and 192 all-conference selections at OU.

In the Big 12 era, Sooners have been named Big 12 Player of the Year a total of 16 times and Big 12 Pitcher of the Year nine times, while nine have been selected as Big 12 Freshman of the Year and one as Big 12 Newcomer of the Year. In 2010, Amber Flores became the first player in league history to earn player-of-theyear honors twice, Shelby Pendley joined her in 2015 before Alo claimed the honor in consecutive seasons in 2021 and 2022.

The OU softball success under Gasso has also spilled over into the classroom where the Sooners have been honored with 170 academic all-conference honors. Twenty of those have gone on to become Academic All-Americans, including Lana Moran, the 2000 Academic All-American of the Year.

Gasso and her staff have consistently been recognized for their efforts on and off the field. The staff was awarded three consecutive Speedline/NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year awards from 1999-2001 and received the national honor in 2000, 2013, 2016, 2017 and 2023. Gasso and staff have claimed the regional honor in 15 of their 29 seasons, with the most recent award coming in 2023. In addition, Gasso has been named the Big 12 Coach of the Year 15 times: 1996, 1999, 2000, 2009, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2023.
