### **NEED TO KNOW**

- Head coach Marissa Young enters her seventh season at the helm of the program and holds a 213-97 overall ledger.
- Duke returns 15 letterwinners from last year's team that compiled a program-best 48 wins and earned the right to host an NCAA Super Regional for the first time.
- The Blue Devils also welcomed four newcomers in freshmen Amiah Burgess and Linh Le and transfer sophomore Aleyah Terrell (Boston College) and graduate transfer Dani Drogemuller (Pittsburgh).
- The Blue Devils open the season against No. 1 Oklahoma for the second straight year, while facing lowa State, No. 18 Nebraska and Long Beach State for the first time in program history.
- Following a vote from the league's head coaches, Duke softball finished tied for second in the 2024 ACC Softball Coaches Poll.
- The tied for second ranking marks the best preseason ranking in the program's six-year history,
- after the Blue Devils finished fourth in 2023, 2022 and 2021, eighth in 2020 and sixth in 2019. Junior **Ana Gold** and sophomores **Cassidy Curd**, **D'Auna Jennings** and **Aminah Vega** also earned individual recognition after being named to the Preseason All-ACC Team.
- Graduate student **Gisele Tapia** and redshirt-sophomore **Jada Baker** were selected as captains for the 2024 campaign, following a team vote.

### **TEAM NOTES**

#### **TEAM SEVEN**

After its inaugural season in 2018, Duke has quickly made its mark on the softball world, accumulating 213 wins and finishing above .500 in five of its last six years.

The Blue Devils have already recorded an ACC Championship (2021) and made three consecutive NCAA Regionals appearances, including hosting in 2022 and 2023.

Last season, the Blue Devils reached the NCAA Super Regionals for the second consecutive year and earned hosting duties for the first time in program history after receiving the No. 8 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

### **BLUE DEVILS ON THE ROAD**

Duke held a 13-2 record on the road last season while outscoring its opponents 124-54.

All-time, the Blue Devils are 62-39 when playing on the road.

### NATIONALLY RANKED OPPONENTS

Duke's 2024 schedule includes eight matchups with teams featured in the NFCA Preseason Top-25 poll.

The Blue Devils are set to face No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 3 Florida State, No. 5 Clemson and No. 18 Nebraska, while Virginia Tech, Liberty, Boston University and Charlotte received votes.

#### **DUKE IN THE RANKINGS**

The Blue Devils have earned a spot in the top-25 of all four major preseason polls for the third time in program history.

### **RUN-RULE**

During their six-year history, the Blue Devils are 55-3 in games decided by the run-rule.

### **BAKER AND TAPIA NAMED 2024 CAPTAINS**

Redshirt-sophomore **Jada Baker** and graduate student **Gisele Tapia** were selected as captains for the 2024 campaign, following a vote from the team.

The duo previously served together as representatives on the team's leadership council during the 2023 season, which was created in an effort to develop leadership across every class.

#### **GOOD AS GOLD**

Junior **Ana Gold** has proven to be a powerhouse at the plate for the Blue Devils after her first two seasons in Durham.

The Ballston Spa, N.Y., native led the team in home runs (19), RBI (56), and runs scored (53) last season. Gold's 19 home runs ranked seventh nationally and second in the ACC.

Gold saw action in 59-of-60 games last season and finished second in the conference in home runs (19), home runs per game (0.32), RBIs (56), RBIs per game (0.95) and runs per game (0.90).

She collected numerous accolades throughout the 2023 season, earning NFCA All-Region, All-ACC and two ACC Player of the Week nods.

Heading into her junior year campaign, Gold was recognized as one of the top-50 best players in the country by D1Softball and SoftballAmerica. She checked in at No. 46 in D1Softball's top-100 player rankings and ranked No. 37 by SoftballAmerica.

#### **HISTORY OF NO-HITTERS**

The Blue Devils have recorded six overall no-hitters in school lore, including three last season.

Sophomore **Cassidy Curd** recorded the first solo seven-inning no-hitter in program history in the Blue Devils' 2-0 win over No. 9 Clemson in the ACC semifinals last season. The lefty became the first rookie to throw a no-no at the ACC tournament and recorded the sixth overall at the postseason event.

Duke's first no-hitter of 2023 was a combined effort from seniors **Jala Wright** and **Lillie Walker** in game two of a doubleheader with Charleston Southern on Feb. 22.

Senior **Claire Davidson** and sophomore **Sophie Garner-MacKinnon** recorded the second combined no-hitter last season after the Blue Devils defeated Elon, 4-0, at Duke Softball Stadium on April 10.

Davidson's performance in the circle marked her second combined no-no as she was also part of the program's first combined no-hitter in an effort with **Shelby Waters** against NC State in 2021.

Wright and Walters each tossed solo five-inning no-nos after shutting out Army West Point in 2022 and NC Central in 2021, respectively.

### **CURD CAUSING CHAOS**

Sophomore **Cassidy Curd** was stellar for the Blue Devils inside the circle and concluded her first season in Durham with an 18-3 record after 35 appearances.

The Port St. Lucie, Fla., native became the first player in program history to reach 100-plus strikeouts during their initial season and finished with 159 on the year.

She also became the first rookie to throw a no-hitter at the 2023 ACC Tournament and recorded the sixth overall at the postseason event, after Duke defeated Clemson, 2-0, in the semifinals. Curd tallied Duke's third no-hitter of the year and first solo seven-inning no-no in program history.

Curd was named a top-10 finalist for the TUCCI/NFCA Freshman of the Year, joining classmate **D'Auna Jennings** as the first two Blue Devils to represent the program as finalists.

The preseason honors continue to pour in for the sophomore as she was named to D1Softball's 2024 Preseason All-America teams, USA Softball Collegaite Player of the Year Watch List and tabbed to D1Softball and Softball America's top-100 player rankings at No. 43 and No. 44, respectively.

### **BRINGING HER A-GAME**

Sophomore **Aminah Vega** was one of the 34 student-athletes named to the 2024 Softball America Preseason All-America teams.

Vega was also tabbed to Softball America and D1Softball's top-100 player rankings, checking in at No. 79 and 95, respectively.

### **TEAM NOTES**

Vega made her presence known in her first season, batting .371 with 19 multihit games on the year. She led the team in triples (3) and total bases (119) and finished second behind Gold in home runs (12) and RBI (50).

The starting second baseman was one of two players on the team to have competed in all 60 games in 2023, earning 59 starts.

The DeBary, Fla., native set the freshman single-season home run record after tallying 12 on the year, including a two-run blast to lift the Blue Devils over No. 6 Florida State, 2-1, on March 25.

Vega's performance on the field also earned her multiple national and all-conference accolades last season in NFCA All-Region Second Team, All-ACC First Team and ACC All-Tournament team honors.

### **JETTIN' JENNINGS**

A 2023 NFCA All-American, sophomore **D'Auna Jennings** finished her first year at Duke in strong fashion, setting school single-season records in batting average (.462) and hits (80) and ranks sixth nationally in both categories.

She placed second all-time in stolen bases with 21 on the year, which sits behind Deja Davis' mark of 24 in 2019. The Houston, Texas, native proved her power on offense and earned her spot in the starting lineup in 58-of-60 games last year.

Last season, Jennings joined Curd as the first two Blue Devils to represent the program as top-10 finalists for the 2023 TUCCI/NFCA Freshman of the Year. She was later named one of the top three finalists for the award.

The preseason honors continue to pour in for the sophomore as she was named to D1Softball's 2024 Preseason All-America teams, USA Softball Collegaite Player of the Year Watch List and tabbed to D1Softball and Softball America's top-100 player rankings at No. 51 and No. 33, respectively.

### **TAPIA'S ON TOP**

Graduate student **Gisele Tapia** returned for one final season in Durham. In 2023, Tapia played a crucial role in moving the Blue Devils' baserunners tallying 10 sacrifice flies, which led the NCAA since April 12th. She was also one of the hardest batters to strikeout with just eight strikeouts in 177 plate appearances.

Duke softball finished tied for second in the recent 2024 ACC Softball Coaches

Poll. The tied for second ranking marks the best preseason ranking in the program's six-year history, after the Blue Devils finished fourth in 2023, 2022

Gold, Curd, Jennings and Vega all earned the honor for the first time in their collegiate careers and joined former Duke softball standouts Deja Davis, Jameson Kavel and Raine Wilson as the seven Blue Devils to receive the preseason recognition.

### **40-WIN SEASONS**

The Blue Devils earned their 48th win of the year in the Durham Regional final against Charlotte before falling to No. 7 Stanford in the NCAA Super Regional to close out the season with a 48-12 ledger. The Blue Devils have now registered 40-plus wins in each of the last three seasons.

### YOUNG NAMED 2023 ACC UNITE AWARD RECIPIENT

Head coach Marissa Young came to Duke as its first African American female head coach. She was not only the first Black woman in this role, but also the first person in the role period. In this role, Young has spread diversity amongst her team through different education and engagement initiatives. As of 2020, Young was one of two Black Power Five head softball coaches.

Following the events of the summer of 2020, Young took it upon herself to address racial and societal inequality with her team. For Young, it was important her athletes were equipped to deal with what was going on in the world, not just in the world of Duke University. She made sure to give space to the Black athletes on the team at the time to address their teammates and share life experiences.

Since then, Young continues to remain passionate about racial justice and equality for all. Young is one of the key contributors in the promotion of the MLK Partnership Day at Duke and the first person to bring the anti-racism program "Real Talk" to campus. Many other teams and programs then learned about "Real Talk" and incorporated this training into their programs.

A current member of ACC CORE (Champions of Racial Equity), Young seeks to be an example for young minority women and open the door to the world of college athletics.

### **MEET THE COACHES**

### Marissa Young - Head Coach

Seventh Season Michigan, 2003

In her seventh year at the helm of the Duke softball program, Marissa Young holds a 213-97 (.687) career record.

Young guided the program to a record-setting 2023 campaign, compiling a program-best 48 wins, earning the Blue Devils the No. 8 national seed in their third NCAA appearance and the right to host the NCAA Super Regional for the first time. Young's coaching and leadership allowed the program to reach new heights and led to the development of freshman All-American D'Auna Jennings, Jennings became the fourth NFCA All-American in the program's six-year history after earning second team honors.

Under her leadership, the Blue Devils became ACC Champions for the first time and reached the NCAA Regionals, as part of a 44-12 campaign in 2021. Before the 2020 season was shortened by COVID-19, Young's squad saw its best start in program history with a 23-4 record. The Blue Devils ended their season at No. 25 in the final ESPN.com/USA Softball Collegiate Top 25 Poll, marking the first time Duke has cracked into the national polls. Young put together a challenging schedule in 2019, playing 11 teams who went on to play in the NCAA Tournament, and finished Duke's second season at 25-31. In the program's inaugural season, Young led the Blue Devils to a 29-27 record, including a 13-11 finish in ACC action to earn the No. 7 seed in the 2018 ACC Tournament. The Blue Devils' 29 wins were the fifth most by an ACC program in its first season while becoming the second school in league history to finish its inaugural campaign with a winning record.

Prior to being tabbed to build the Duke softball program, Young spent the prior two seasons across town at North Carolina, with her primary responsibilities included coaching the pitchers and catchers. In the spring of 2015, Young helped the Tar Heels to a 37-16 overall record and a berth in the NCAA Tournament after the squad won 24 contests the prior season. Young's pitchers posted a 3.30 earned run average with 234 strikeouts in 335.1 innings pitched.

Young spent the 2012 and 2013 seasons as an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan, where she served as the compliance liaison, recruiting coordinator and managed team travel and the operational budget, among other duties. She helped coach five Academic All-America picks and five player of the week selections during her tenure at Eastern Michigan, Prior to her stint at EMU. Young was the head coach at Concordia University (NAIA) in Ann Arbor, Mich. from 2008-11. In less than three years, she turned the 2-20 program to a 23-23 record, the second-most wins in a single season since an appearance in the 2002 NAIA National Tournament.

As a player, Young was a three-time All-America selection as a pitcher at the University of Michigan and was named the 2002 Big Ten Pitcher of the Year and 2003 Big Ten Player of the Year, Young graduated from Michigan in 2003 as the all-time strikeout leader (927) and her 88 career wins became the second highest in program history. She also matched the then-program single-season home run record with 13 in 2003. Young played two years of professional softball, one overseas in Italy and the second year with the Texas Thunder of the National Pro Fastpitch.

Olivia Watkins was named an assistant coach on July 5, 2022 and enters her second season at Duke. Watkins coaches the defense and slappers, while overseeing baserunning and the short game. Watkins came to Durham after a three-year stint as an assistant coach at Boston College, where she worked on the defense, baserunning and slap-hitting. Under Watkins' guidance, the Eagles saw improvement during each of her three seasons in Chestnut Hill. Prior to her time at Boston College, Watkins spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Dartmouth College, where she coached hit-ting, baserunning and infield defense. During her time with the Big Green, Dartmouth took home a share of the Ivy League title in 2018. Watkins began her coaching career as a volunteer assistant coach at the University of Illinois for two seasons (2016-17). Watkins has been active in promoting diversity initiatives, serving as a member of the Boston College Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee. For her efforts, Watkins was awarded the 2021 NFCA Natasha Watley Scholarship for Social Change, which is awarded to a Black coach who has created educational or athletic opportunities for their community, has removed and overcome obstacles through social change, or has opened doors for growing the game of fastpitch for Black girls or women. A 2015 graduate of Western Kentucky University with a degree in interdisciplinary studies and a concentration in science, Watkins had a standout softball career as a Hilltopper. A two-time NFCA All-Region and All-Sun Belt first team honoree, Watkins graduated as the program's all-time leader in batting average (.380) and stolen bases (117). Watkins also spent time in professional softball, as the first Western Kentucky alumni to sign with National Pró Fastpitch (NPF). Watkins played for the Akron Racers, Pennsylvania Rebellion and Houston Scrap Yard Dawgs.

Taylor Wike was named an assistant coach on July 1, 2023 and enters her first season at Duke. Wike serves as the team's hitting and infield coach. Wike joins the program after a four-year stint at Charlotte as an assistant coach before being promoted to associate head coach in 2022. During her time with the 49ers, Wike played an important role in leading the program to its first ever Conference USA East Division title in 2021 and first appearance in the national polls in 2022. Wike's coaching and leadership led to the development of many Charlotte student-athletes, including two-time Conference USA Player of the Year Bailey Vannoy. The fifth-year catcher also became the program's first NFCA All-American, after garnering second team honors in 2022. Prior to her time at Charlotte, Wike spent one season as a volunteer assistant coach at South Carolina. During her time with the Gamecocks, Wike helped guide them to a 38-19 overall record and reach the NCAA Regional finals for the fourth-straight season.

A 2018 graduate of North Carolina with a degree in Exercise and Sport Science, Wike had a standout softball career as a Tar Heel. The Hiddenite, N.C., native led the Tar Heels to three consecutive NCAA Tournaments from 2015 to 2017. She earned All-ACC honors in each of her four seasons, while starting a staggering 225 games. Wike was named the 2018 ACC Defensive Player of the Year. She was also a finalist for NFCA Freshman of the Year in 2015 and earned All-Southeast Region honors as a junjor and a senior. in 2015 and earned All-Southeast Region honors as a junior and a senior.

Bryan Jones was named an assistant coach on September 7, 2023 and enters his first season at Duke. Jones will work primarily with the team's catchers and infield. Jones joins the program after a three-year stint as the head coach of Barons Christian Baseball, a Christian-based homeschool high school team in Duluth, Ga. A native of Plantation, Fla., Jones has also spent time as the hitting and infield coach for the Brookhaven Bucks, Prince Avenue Christian School and Florida Pokers Baseball. Aside from coaching, Jones played professional baseball for eight years after being drafted by the Detroit Tigers organization in 1994. During those eight years, he spent time with the Nashua Pride (2001-03), Amarillo Dillas (1999), Nicaragua Matagalpa (1997-99), Thunder Bay Whiskey Jacks (1997) and Lakeland Flying Tigers (1994-96). He was also a fundamental part of two MilB championship teams in 1995 and 1999. Jones retired from playing in 2006 and opened Evolution Baseball and Softball Academy in Lawrenceville, Ga., a 53,000 square-foot training facility designed to train athletes that hope to play at the collegiate and professional level. He served in various roles at the facility, including Director of Baseball and Softball Operations, Director of Community Outreach and Mentor Programs and a hitting and defense coach.
