OPENING TIP

► Oklahoma (15-14, 5-11 SEC) goes for its fifth win in seven games when it hosts Missouri (20-9, 10-6) on Tuesday at 6 p.m. CT at Lloyd Noble Center on senior night. Sooners **Tae Davis**, **Jadon Jones**, **Reid Lovelace**, **Nijel Pack** and **Mohamed Wague** will be honored during a pregame on-court ceremony.

► Tuesday's game will be televised by ESPNU with **John Schriffen** (play-by-play) and **Rodney Terry** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► After losing nine straight games, Oklahoma has won four of its last six (at No. 15 Vanderbilt, vs. Georgia, vs. Auburn and at LSU). In those four victories, OU led for 136:24 of 160 minutes and by double digits for a combined 69:01, and six Sooners averaged double figures in scoring. OU shot a combined 53% from the field and 51% (46 for 91) from 3-point range in the four wins.

► Oklahoma leads the SEC in league play with its 38.1% 3-point field goal mark and ranks third with its 9.6 treys per outing. Over the last five games, the Sooners are shooting 46.3% (56 for 121) from behind the arc. On the season, OU is averaging 10.0 treys per game (the school record is 10.3 in 2015-16).

► Pack, a first-year Sooner who is in his sixth year overall, ranks first among active Division I players (and 24th all-time) with 410 career 3-point field goal makes and third with 2,213 points. He leads the SEC with his .453 3-point field goal percentage and 3.3 treys per game. Over the last five outings, Pack is a sizzling 21 for 35 (60%) from long distance.

► Oklahoma has committed single-digit turnovers 16 times, already its most such outings for an entire season in at least 40 years. The Sooners average just 10.0 turnovers per contest. Over the past 50 seasons, the fewest turnovers OU averaged per game was 11.0 in 2020-21.

SATURDAY'S OU-LSU RECAP

► The guard trio of **Nijel Pack**, **Xzayvier Brown** and **Dayton Forsythe** accounted for 54 points to power Oklahoma to an 83-67 win at LSU on Saturday evening. It was OU's largest victory margin in an SEC road game in its two years in the league.

► The Sooners outshot the Tigers 47% to 35% from the field and 38% (10 for 26) to 26% (6 for 23) from 3-point range. They also shot a season-high 94% (17 for 18) from the free throw line in winning for the fourth time in the last six games.

► Pack made five 3-pointers en route to a game-high 21 points, Brown was 6 for 10 from the field and made all six of his free throw attempts to finish with 20 points and Forsythe also went 6 for 6 from the charity stripe to score 13 off the bench.

► Center **Mohamed Wague** registered 10 points and game highs of nine rebounds (five offensive) and three blocks. It marked the first time in Wague's career to score in double figures in three consecutive contests.

► LSU scored the game's first five points, but OU countered with the next 10 and took a 20-11 lead 7 1/2 minutes in. Pack's first 3-pointer with 16:51 left in the opening half put the Sooners up for good, as they led for 36:51 on the night. His second 3 came with three seconds left and gave OU a 41-33 halftime lead.

► After the Tigers pulled to within five points at 53-48 with 13:24 to go in the second half, Oklahoma took control by mounting an 18-4 run to go up 71-52 with 7:48 remaining. OU pushed its advantage to 22 points two minutes later behind back-to-back 3-pointers from **Jadon Jones** and Pack, and the Sooners cruised to their second win in two all-time outings at LSU.

► Oklahoma committed just eight turnovers to LSU's 10 and outscored the Tigers 13-9 off those mistakes. It marked the Sooners' third straight single-digit-turnover game and 16th of the season, most in at least the last 40 years. LSU's 67 points and .349 field goal percentage represented OU opponent lows in SEC play.

SCENE SETTERS

► Despite its 5-11 SEC record, Oklahoma has held a halftime lead in eight of the 16 games. In fact, it has held a double-digit advantage in seven of the last 12 outings (four wins).

► OU is the only SEC team and one of just five out of 361 nationally to start the same lineup every game this season (Houston is the only other Power Five squad). Its starters have been guards **Xzayvier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**. Missouri has started seven different lineups.

► This marks the second straight season for the Sooners to host Missouri in their home finale. Last year on March 5, OU shot 57% from the field and 96% from the foul line (25 for 26) in a 96-84 win over the No. 15 Tigers. Freshman guard **Jeremiah Fears** scored a career-high 31 points on 9-for-13 field goal and 12-for-12 free throw shooting. Playing in his last home game, senior forward **Sam Godwin** made all five of his field goal tries en route to 12 points before leaving the game at the 5:32 mark of the first half with a season-ending injury. He was replaced by **Mohamed Wague**, who tied a career high with 12 points (4 for 4 each on field goals and free throws) and grabbed five rebounds.

► Wague is coming off the most productive three-game stretch of his career, averaging 13.3 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.0 blocked shots and 1.7 steals while going 16 for 20 (80%) from the free throw line against Texas A&M, Auburn and LSU. The fifth-year center recorded 12 points, 13 rebounds and two blocks against the Aggies, 18 points, nine boards and career highs of four blocks and four steals vs. Auburn and 10 points, nine caroms and three rejections at LSU. He entered the three-game stretch averaging 6.2 points, 6.4 rebounds, 1.3 blocks and 0.5 steals while shooting 60% from the charity stripe.

► The resurgence of guard **Dayton Forsythe** has boosted OU the last few weeks. After a 10-game stretch in which he averaged 1.3 points and went 2 for 31 from the field (he battled sprains of both ankles), the sophomore is averaging 9.8 points over the last eight contests. Over the last six games, he is averaging 11.0 points (four double-digit efforts).

OU-MIZZOU: RIVALRY RENEWED

► Oklahoma and Missouri have been members of the same conferences for 95 years (from 1919-20 through 2011-12 and starting again in 2024-25). Shared league membership began with the Missouri Valley Conference in 1919-20 and continued with the Big Six Conference in 1928-29, the Big Seven in 1947-48, the Big Eight in 1957-58 and the Big 12 in 1996-97. Missouri left the Big 12 for the SEC in July 2012, and OU joined the SEC in July 2024.

► The Sooners hold a 116-99 series lead and have won 17 of the last 28 meetings. OU is 65-22 against MU in Norman and has won nine of the last 12 meetings at Lloyd Noble Center.

► Tuesday's game will mark the 216th in the series, making Missouri the fourth-most-played opponent in OU history. The Sooners have faced Oklahoma State 251 times, Kansas 227 and Kansas State 218.

► OU and Missouri have met in some significant matchups, including 14 times in Big Eight/Big 12 Tournament play and twice in the NCAA Tournament. The programs each won four meetings in Big Eight Tournament action, with Mizzou winning title-game contests in 1982 (68-63) and 1989 (98-86) in Kansas City, Mo. The Sooners posted a 5-1 head-to-head record in the Big 12 Tournament, which included a 49-47 win in the 2003 championship game in Dallas.

► In 2002, OU and MU met in an Elite Eight game in San Jose, Calif. **Kelvin Sampson's** No. 2 seed Sooners pulled out an 81-75 win over **Quin**

OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

Snyder's 12th-seeded Tigers for OU's first Final Four berth since 1988. **Hollis Price** scored 18 points.

► The programs also met in the 2021 NCAA Tournament first round, a 72-68 OU win in Indianapolis. **Lon Kruger's** No. 8-seeded OU squad got 23 points from **Austin Reaves** to down **Cuonzo Martin's** ninth-seeded Tigers.

EARLIER THIS YEAR AT MISSOURI

► On the verge of a big road win, Oklahoma fell victim to a pair of buzzer-beating 3-pointers — the first at the end of regulation and the second in overtime — in an 88-87 loss to Missouri on Jan. 24.

► After **Tae Davis** hit two free throws to give OU an 81-78 lead with 5.6 seconds left in the second half, Missouri's Trent Pierce hit a 37-footer with no time left to force overtime. In the extra session, the Sooners took an 87-85 advantage on an **Xzayvier Brown** shot in the lane with 4 seconds remaining, but MU forward Mark Mitchell dribbled up the floor and made a 3-pointer at the horn for the one-point win. OU didn't trail in OT until Mitchell's 3.

► OU outshot Missouri 48%-45% from the field and 44%-29% from 3-point range (12 makes to six), but was outrebounded 41-29 and outscored 19-3 in second-chance points. MU grabbed 17 offensive boards to OU's five and attempted 11 more shots.

► **Nijel Pack** (25) and Brown (19) accounted for more than half of the team's points and 11 of its 12 assists. Pack was 8 for 13 from the field, 5 for 8 from 3-point range and 4 for 4 from the free throw line. Brown was 5 for 11 from the floor, hit a pair of triples, was 7 for 9 from the foul line and handed out a game-high six assists.

PACK MENTALITY

► First-year Oklahoma guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and has 2,213 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.

► Pack leads active Division I players and ranks 24th all-time with 410 career 3-point field goals. The only player to ever wear an OU uniform who has made more career treys is **Umoja Gibson** (428; was a Sooner during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons).

► Pack leads the SEC with his .453 season 3-point field goal percentage and 3.3 treys per game. Nationally, he ranks fifth and 13th, respectively.

► Pack has scored 20-plus points in six of the last 10 games (25 at Missouri, 22 vs. Arkansas, 23 vs. Texas, 20 at Tennessee, 22 vs. Auburn and 21 at LSU).

► Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 27 of 29 games, at least three in 19 contests and at least five in nine outings. He buried at least three treys in six consecutive games between Nov. 11 and Dec. 2, the first Sooner to accomplish the feat since consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** during OU's 2015-16 Final Four campaign.

► A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points, made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 150 of his 151 career games.

OU'S 'X' FACTOR

► After scoring at least 13 points 14 times in a 15-game stretch (he averaged 18.7 points in the 15), junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has been held to an average of 10.8 points over the last five games.

► Brown has a team-high-tying seven outings of at least 20 points in SEC play (23 in a win over Ole Miss, a season-high 24 against No. 19 Florida, 21 vs. No. 18 Alabama, 22 at South Carolina, 21 at Kentucky, 20 in a victory at No. 15 Vanderbilt and 20 in a win at LSU).

► Brown leads the SEC by shooting 91% from the free throw line (85 for 93) but only has 14 attempts over the last nine games. For comparison, he attempted 43 free throws over the previous nine contests. He assembled a streak of 27 makes, which ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida.

► After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's, Brown has a team-high 12 games of 20-plus in 29 outings this season. He has 32 career games of at least 20.

MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

► Oklahoma has led for over 20 minutes in seven of the last 10 games and has been ahead for 213 out of 285 minutes (75%) in those seven contests.

► The Sooners have scored at least 85 points in 14 of their 29 games (48%), already their most 85-point efforts in a season since 2017-18 (15). For perspective, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%).

► OU is averaging 24.0 bench points in its five SEC wins and 15.1 bench points in its 11 league losses.

► OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Nijel Pack** averages a team-high 16.1 points per game, while **Xzayvier Brown** (15.6), **Tae Davis** (12.1) and **Derrion Reid** (11.3) also average double figures. **Mohamed Wague** rounds out the starting five with his 6.9 per contest.

► Davis surpassed 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds this season and now has 1,234 and 598.

► OU announced on Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a 6-11, 240-pound center from Russia who is averaging 4.3 points and 2.3 rebounds in 15.1 minutes per contest over his 17 games. He is shooting 53% from the field, 38% (9 for 24) from 3-point range and 73% (16 for 22) from the foul line.

► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones** is averaging 5.8 points in 18.9 minutes per game over his 25 outings. The sixth-year guard, who is 12 for 23 (52%) from 3-point range over the last six outings, has drawn 13 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 17 steals and 11 blocks over the past 12 games.

► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 38 3-point makes (shooting 43%) despite playing in just 21 of 29 games and averaging only 12.2 minutes in those contests. He is 27 for 52 (52%) from long distance in home games, including 18 for 32 (56%) over his last five outings at Lloyd Noble Center. He has played in just five of OU's last 12 games. In the Sooners' Feb. 14 home win against Georgia, he scored 18 points on 6-for-7 3-point shooting.

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sheffield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first play in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
