The Southern Connecticut State University men's basketball team will play two games this week beginning on Wednesday, Nov. 16 at 7:30 p.m. as it plays host to Adelphi University, followed by a road game against the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia on Saturday, Nov. 19 at 3 p.m.

#### ALL-TIME VS ADELPHI

SCSU leads the all-time series versus Adelphi, 19-6. The Owls won both meetings against the Panthers last season.

#### SCOUTING ADELPHI

The Panthers are 2-0 on the year after defeating Felician University, 77-76, followed by a 95-78 victory over Georgian Court. Adelphi has three players averaging over 15 points per game - Michael Coffey (23.5 ppg and seven rebounds), Manny Suarez (20.5 ppg and 11 rebounds) and Jack Laffey (16.5 ppg and 7.5 rebounds).

#### ALL-TIME VS. UNIVERSITY OF THE SCIENCES

The Devils lead the all-time series 1-0. Both teams played each other for the first time last season. The Owls were ousted by the Devils, 104-92 in that game.

#### SCOUTING UNIVERSITY OF THE SCIENCES

The Devils kicked off the 2016-17 season with a 78-66 win over LIU Post. In its second game, the Devils fell short to NYIT, 68-62. Junior Will Gregortis leads his team in scoring with 20 points per game, followed by senior Jon McGill who is averaging 15 ppg.

#### FIRST TWO GAMES FOR THE OWLS

SCSU posted a 1-1 record through its first two games on the year starting with a 105-103 win over Holy Family University. In game two, SCSU fell short to the University of Bridgeport, 100-89.

#### THREE OWLS POSTED DOUBLE-DOUBLES

In its win over Holy Family, freshman Taurus Adams II notched 18 points and 11 rebounds, junior Jerry Luckett, Jr. poured in 30 points along with 13 rebounds and Austin Carter totaled a season-high 17 points and 12 rebounds.

#### A STEP CLOSER

After scoring 50 points through the first two games, Michael Mallory is now 92 points shy of breaking the all-time scoring record held by Rich Radicioni (1936), who set the record in 1990. Mallory entered the 2016-17 season with 1,795 points, which was sixth all-time. Mallory now has 1,845 points.

#### **DYNAMIC DUO**

Michael Mallory (25 ppg) and Jerry Luckett, Jr. (27.5 ppg) have scored 105 of the Owls' 194 points this season.

#### LUCKETT, JR. NAMED TO THE NE-10 HONOR ROLL

Jerry Luckett Jr. was named to the week one NE-10 Honor Roll. The junior is averaging a team-high 27 points per game along with 9.5 rebounds.

#### **DROPPING DIMES**

Sophomore Joey Wallace scored 11 points against Bridgeport and dished out a career-high eight assists.

#### ATTACKING THE GLASS

Through two games, SCSU is averaging 48 rebounds per game. The Owls recorded 51 rebounds against Holy Family, and 45 rebounds against Bridgeport.

#### IN THE PRESEASON RANKINGS

The Owls are ranked No. 4 in the preseason poll released by the Division II Bulletin, No. 13 in the NABC Coaches' Poll and No. 15 in the D2SIDA National Poll and No. 1 in the NE-10 Conference Southwest Division.

#### **RECAPPING LAST YEAR**

The Owls are coming off a year in which they went 22-8, finished first in the NE-10 Conference Southwest Division and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third straight year. The Owls elevated as high as No. 2 in the national rankings last season.

#### RETURNING STARTERS

Southern Connecticut will be led by senior Michael Mallory, who led the team with 23 points per game and was selected as an All-American, All-ECAC, All-Region and All-Northeast-10 Conference performer. Classmate Austin Carter averaged 9.8 points per game, 7.7 rebounds and 2.1 blocks and was named 2015-16 Northeast-10 Conference Defensive Player of the Year, Sophomore Joey Wallace averaged 7.7 points per game and 4.2 rebounds and was named to the NE-10 All-Rookie Team.

# MALLORY NAMED SPORTING NEWS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

For the second year in a row, Michael Mallory was named to the Sporting News preseason All-America Team.

#### SOME RECORDS OWNED, MORE WITHIN REACH

Michael Mallory set a new SCSU single-season program record with 95 three-pointers made last year and is also currently the Owls' all-time leader in three-pointers made with 266 and three-point attempts with 688. He also holds Southern's single-game scoring record with 47 points in a January, 2016 win over Bentley.

#### CARTER DOES IT DEFENSIVELY

Austin Carter enters his senior season ranked third all-time at SCSU with 169 blocked shots. He's also 12th all-time in career rebounds with 529 boards.
