The Southern Connecticut State University men's basketball team will play three games this week beginning on Monday, Dec. 5 at 7 p.m. against Molloy College, followed by two Northeast-10 Conference showdowns against Pace University on Wednesday, Dec. 7 at 7:30 p.m. and Le Moyne College on Saturday, Dec. 10 at 3:30 p.m.

### ALL-TIME VS. MOLLOY COLLEGE

SCSU is 1-0 all-time versus Molloy College. Both teams played for the first time on November 9, 2013 where the Owls soared to a 93-75 win.

### SCOUTING THE LIONS

The Lions have wins over Philadelphia University, Florida Southern and Adelphi. Molloy has three players scoring in double figures in seniors Charlie Marquardt (23.9 ppg and 3.3 rpg) Jaylen Morris (17.6 ppg and 7.5 rpg) and Mike Guzzardi (12.0 and 7.3 rpg). Both, Marquardt and Morris are the top two scorers in the ECC.

### ALL-TIME VS. PACE

Pace holds a 21-13 all-time record over SCSU. The Owls defeated the Setters twice last season.

### SCOUTING THE SETTERS

Pace stands sixth in the NE-10 Southwest Division. The Setters have wins over Georgian Court, Felician, Post and AIC. Pace has three players scoring in double figures in sophomores Ryan Peterson (12.3 ppg and 5.3 rpg), Mike Demello (11.6 ppg and 2.8 rpg) and junior Victor Jusino (11.0 ppg and 4.3 rpg). Pace ranks last in the NE-10 in both scoring (65.5 ppg) and points allowed (66.6 ppg).

### ALL-TIME VS. LE MOYNE

Le Moyne leads the all-time series versus the Owls with a record of 18-19. SCSU defeated Le Moyne in both of its meetings last season.

### MALLORY TAKES FIRST PLACE ALL-TIME

After a 30-point performance in a 92-87 victory over AIC, Mallory passed Rich Radicioni as the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,938 career points and counting.

### NATIONAL RANKS

Michael Mallory (25.9 ppg) currently ranks fourth in the country in scoring.

### 2K POINT CLUB

After his 20-point performance in a 68-66 win over Saint Rose, Michael Mallory has upped his career point total to 2,002 points and counting, ranking 15th all-time in NE-10 history. Mallory is nine points shy of 12th all-time in the NE-10.

### AUSTIN CARTER CLOSING IN

Senior Austin Carter is three blocks shy in becoming the program's second all-time leader in blocked shots, trailing Trevon Hamlet (188).

### THE SOPHOMORES

Joey Wallace is fifth in the NE-10 Conference in assists with 4.9 apg and ranks third on the team in scoring with 13.3 ppg. Isaiah McLeod (9.8 ppg) has scored over 10 points in six of the Owls' eight games this season.

### D2SIDA WEEKLY REGIONAL RANKINGS

SCSU is ranked second in this week's D2SIDA East Regional Poll.

### NE-10 RANKINGS

The Owls rank first in both offensive rebounding (13.5 rpg) and blocks (5.0 bpg), second in both rebounding (39.6 rpg) and free throw percentage (78.2) and third in points per game (83.5 ppg). SCSU leads the Southwest Division with a conference record of 4-0.

### IN THE PRESEASON RANKINGS

The Owls were ranked No. 4 in the preseason poll released by the Division II Bulletin, No. 13 in the NABC Coaches' Poll and No. 15 in the D2SIDA National Poll and No. 1 in the NE-10 Conference Southwest Division.

### RECAPING LAST YEAR

The Owls are coming off a year in which they went 22-8, finished first in the NE-10 Conference Southwest Division and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third straight year. The Owls elevated as high as No. 2 in the national rankings last season.

### A FINE FIRST SEASON

Owls' coach Scott Burrell was selected the 2016 ECAC Coach of the Year after leading the Owls to 22 wins and a NCAA berth in his first season.

### RETURNING STARTERS

Southern Connecticut will be led by senior Michael Mallory, who led the team with 23 points per game and was selected as an All-American, All-ECAC, All-Region and All-Northeast-10 Conference performer. Classmate Austin Carter averaged 9.8 points per game, 7.7 rebounds and 2.1 blocks and was named 2015-16 Northeast-10 Conference Defensive Player of the Year, Sophomore Joey Wallace averaged 7.7 points per game and 4.2 rebounds and was named to the NE-10 All-Rookie Team.

### CARTER DOES IT DEFENSIVELY

Austin Carter earned the 2015 Northeast-10 Conference Defensive Player of the Year Award.

### MALLORY CHOSEN TO PRESEASON "SUPER 16" TEAM

Michael Mallory has been selected to the Division II Bulletin's preseason "Super 16" Team.

### MALLORY NAMED SPORTING NEWS PRESEASON ALL AMERICAN

For the second year in a row, Michael Mallory was named to the Sporting News preseason All-American Team.

### WELCOME TO THE CLUB

The Owls welcome junior Jerry Luckett, Jr. sophomore Bernard Brantley and freshmen Noah Miree, Donte Etheridge and Taurus Adams II to the team this year.

### WELCOME BACK

Southern Connecticut returns eight players from last year's squad - seniors Michael Bozzuto, Austin Carter, Michael Mallory, Dominic Migliaro, Jonathan Paul and sophomores Toby Christensen, Isaiah McLeod and Joey Wallace.

### TOUGH PLACE TO PLAY

Moore Field House has been a tough place to play the Owls are 39-8 (.829) at home since the start of the 2013-14 season. SCSU has been even better in NE-10 action with a 32-2 mark (.941) in league games.

### FACING SOME TOUGH COMPETITION

The Owls will face five teams that reached the NCAA Division II Tournament a year ago - Bentley, Holy Family, Southern New Hampshire, Stonehill and Saint Anselm.

### SOME RECORDS OWNED

Michael Mallory set a new SCSU single-season program record with 95 three-pointers made last year and is also currently the Owls' all-time leader in three-pointers made with 286 and three-point attempts with 734.

### THRIVING IN THE CLASSROOM

For the second year in a row, the Southern Connecticut State University men's basketball team was recognized by the National Association of Basketball Coaches as a recipient of the 2015-16 Team Academic Excellence Award for its success in the classroom. In addition, five members of the team were selected as honorees for the 2016 NABC Honors Court - Michael Bozzuto, Austin Carter, Michael Mallory, Jonathan Paul.

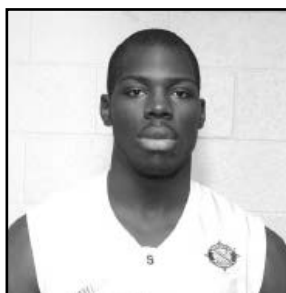

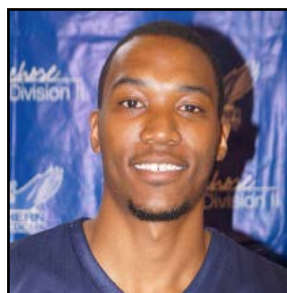
